Speakers from various MARSEC domains shared their views: LCDR Tim Laird, Australia International Liaison Officer briefed on other MARSEC threats monitored by the IFC; Dr Vu Hai Dang presented on Illegal, Unregulated, Unreported Fishing; Dr Jolene Jerard shared insights on Maritime Terrorism; Dr Asyura Salleh presented trends on drug trafficking in this region and Mr Joe Chan spoke about maritime cyber crimes, with Prof Christian Bueger facilitating the Q&A session thereafter.
