




## Rescue 303

#### Rescue Operation - Extensive coverage by media and social media












MV Helios Leader, a Vehicles Carrier managed by NYK Shipmanagement was on a voyage from Japan to Singapore.





"Information Fusion Centre (IFC)" received info from LTC Grette Nette (Canada International Liaison Officer) on a sinking fishing vessel in the South China Sea, which had requested help.


LCDR Hoang Cong Linh, the Vietnam ILO immediately shared the information with the Vietnam People's Navy who deployed their navy ship "VPN ship 471" and "VPN ship 640" to proceed to the location to conduct the rescue operation.

MV Helios Leader also received the broadcasted by the Singapore Maritime Rescue Coordination Centre on the distress call.

The location of the distressed craft was about 6nm away with 300 persons.

## Search for the distressed vessel was immediately launched

#### Overcrowded 30m long boat (including women and children).







- Unconventional approach Maneuvered the ship to bring alongside the boat.
- Challenging approach Strong winds and a big windage area.
- Master managed to slowly creep up alongside the boat and passed mooring lines.

- 6. Disembarking of survivors

Around 1745 hrs vessel started rescuing, with priority to women and children.


















Started at 1630 Hrs
