# Executive Summary



**Theft, Robbery and Piracy at Sea:** 7 TRAPS incidents were recorded throughout the AOI. This number lower than what was recorded in September 2023 (8 incidents) and higher than that of October 2022 (6 incidents). Among these incidents, 6 occurred in the Singapore Strait (SS) and 1 in Indonesia.

**Maritime Incidents:** 78 MI were recorded this month. A total of 2 Typhoons have impacted the Pacific area of the IFC's AOI, which resulted in the contribution of incidents occurring in the region.

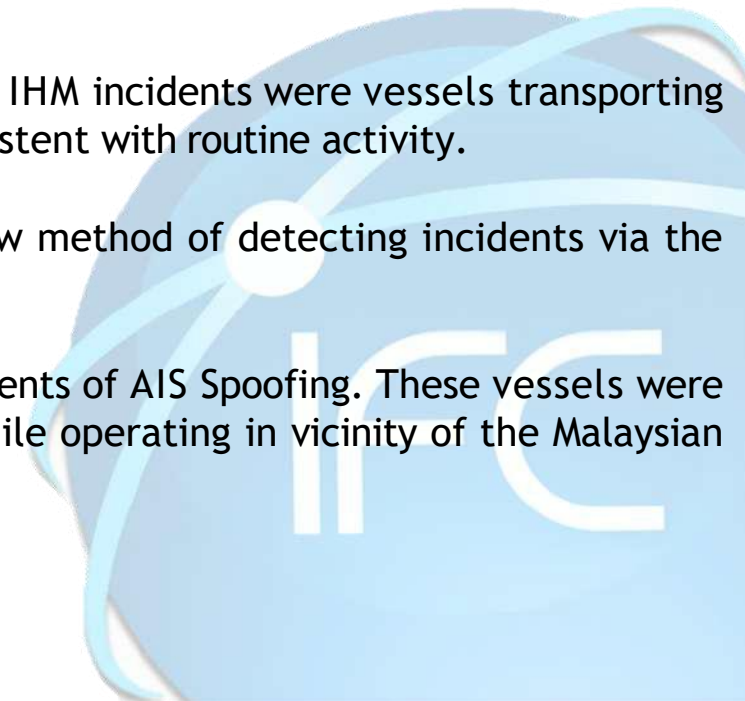
**Illegal, Unreported, and Unregulated Fishing:** The total number of IUUF incidents recorded this month is 31, this is almost half the number of previous month and September 2023. This reduction could be attributed to the beginning of the monsoon season, which might cause a decrease in fishing activities.

**Contraband Smuggling:** 30 CS incidents were recorded this month. The number of smuggling incidents reported by the IFC in September 2024 decreased compared to the previous month, cigarette smuggling was reported to be the most common type of sized contraband this month.

**Irregular Human Migration:** A total of 5 IHM incidents were recorded this month. Majority of IHM incidents were vessels transporting Indonesian migrant workers between Indonesia and Malaysia, in either direction, and is consistent with routine activity.

**Environmental Security:** A total of 8 ENVSEC incidents were reported this month. The new method of detecting incidents via the usage of satellite imagery, contributed to the increased in active reporting.

**Cyber Security:** 22 CYBSEC incidents were recorded for this month, all of which were incidents of AIS Spoofing. These vessels were identified as presenting false locations, flag state and/or identification details with AIS while operating in vicinity of the Malaysian Peninsular.

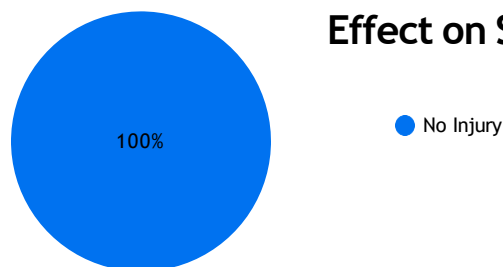

## OBSERVATIONS

### Statistics

- 7 TRAPS incidents (all boardings) were reported in Oct 2024. This number lower than previous years Oct 2023 (8 incidents) and higher than Oct 2022 (6 incidents).
- 6 out of 7 incidents occurred while the vessels were underway, involving 4 Bulk Carriers and 3 Tankers.
- Fortunately, there were no injuries reported in any of the incidents.

### Singapore Strait (SS)

- 6 Sea Thefts occurred while ships were underway: 5 incidents in the Philip Channel (2, 18 and 23 Oct) and 1 in the Eastbound Lane of the Traffic Separation Scheme (26 Oct).
- 3 incidents occurred in one night (18 Oct) between 0055H (UTC +8) and 0233H (UTC +8); nothing stolen and no injury reported. [Note: Ref IFC Spot Commentary 2/24 on 19 Oct 2024, Based on proximity of the first two (2) incidents, time interval and number of perpetrators (5 to 7 pax), it was likely that the same group of perpetrators were involved in both incidents. The last incident (~12nm from second incident) was likely conducted by a different group of perpetrators].
- Of the 6 incidents, 5 involved perpetrators reportedly armed with knives (2, 18 - 0208H and 0255H (UTC+8), 23 and 26 Oct); Notably, 1 incident involved confrontation with the perpetrators (18 Oct - 0208H (UTC+8)) and only 1 incident (2 Oct) reported ship tools stolen.
- The ships were able to continue their voyages to the next port without requiring any assistance. No injuries were reported to ship's crew in any of the incidents.

### Indonesia

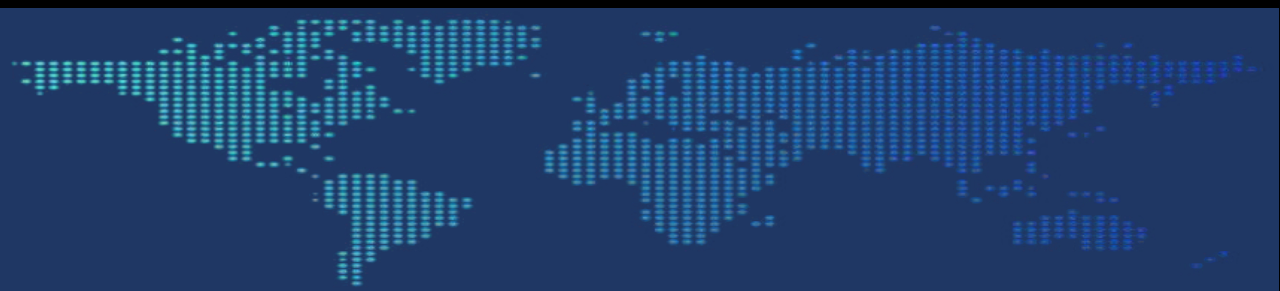
- An incident of Sea Theft occurred at Belawan Anchorage, Indonesia involving a Tanker on 17 Oct 24 while ship at anchored. The crew reportedly observed 1 small boat near the anchor chain and one of the perpetrator threatened ship crew (Confrontation) with a machete. Some of the ship's spare parts and tools were reported stolen, but no injuries were reported.
- The ship did not require assistance and continued her voyage to her next destination.

### Comments

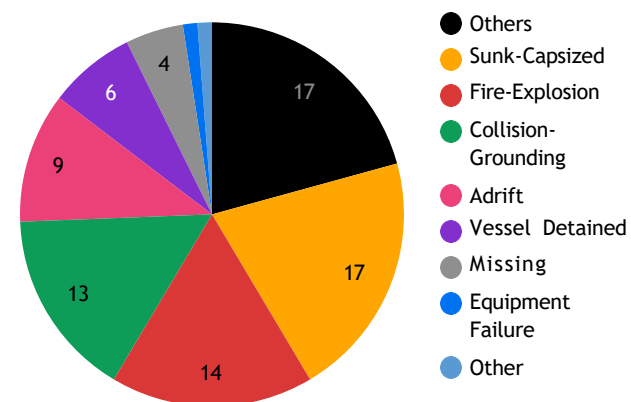
- 3 incidents occurred in one night is the second incidents occurred in the same night for 2024 (First incidents in 14 Sep 2024). IFC assesses that the same group of perpetrators are predicted to carry out the next boarding attempt if they are unsuccessful on their initial attempt.
- Perpetrators continue to target slow-speed and low-freeboard vessels such as bulk carriers and tugs. All incidents occurred during the period of darkness, between 2355H (UTC +8) to 0233H (UTC +8).
- All companies, sea users, and ship masters are advised to remain vigilant when transiting known hotspots, such as the Phillip Channel, waters off Batam and Bintan Islands, and Batam Anchorages.



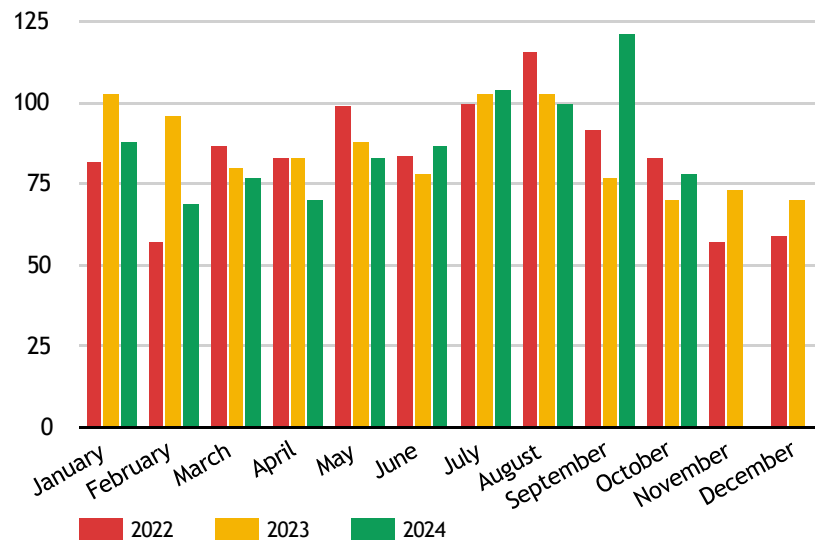

## Number of Vessels, by Type of Incident



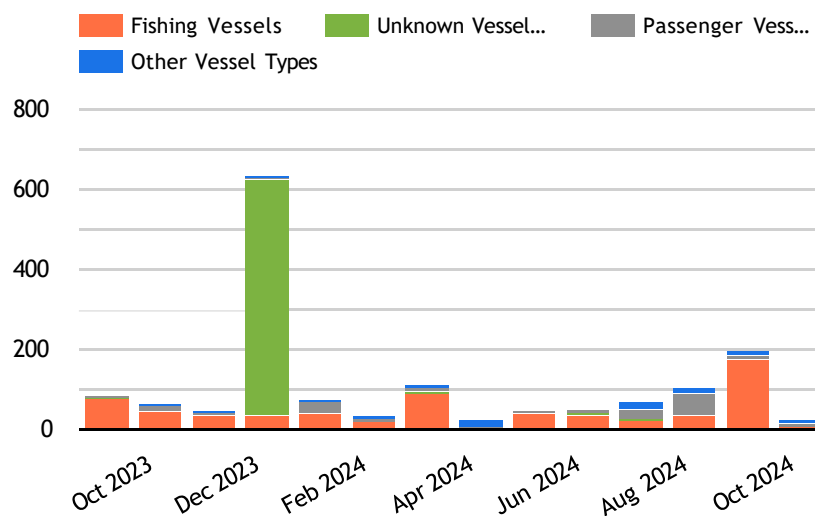

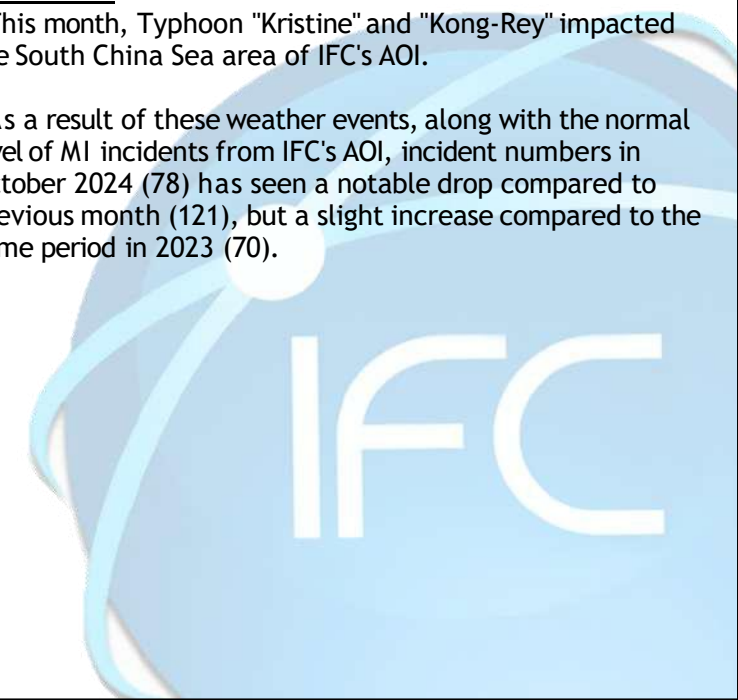
## OBSERVATIONS

### Statistics:

- A total of 78 maritime incidents were reported this month, which is higher than incidents recorded in the same period in both 2023 (70) and lower than the figures in 2022 (83).
- The largest number of reported incidents was sunk-capsized (17), followed by fire-explosion (14) and collision-grounding (13).
- In terms of location, the highest number of reported incidents occurred in the waters off Indonesia (16), Vietnam (11) and Malaysia (10).
- A total of 23 individuals were reported dead or missing for the month which is lower compared to the previous month (197) and the same period in 2023 (63).

### Comments:

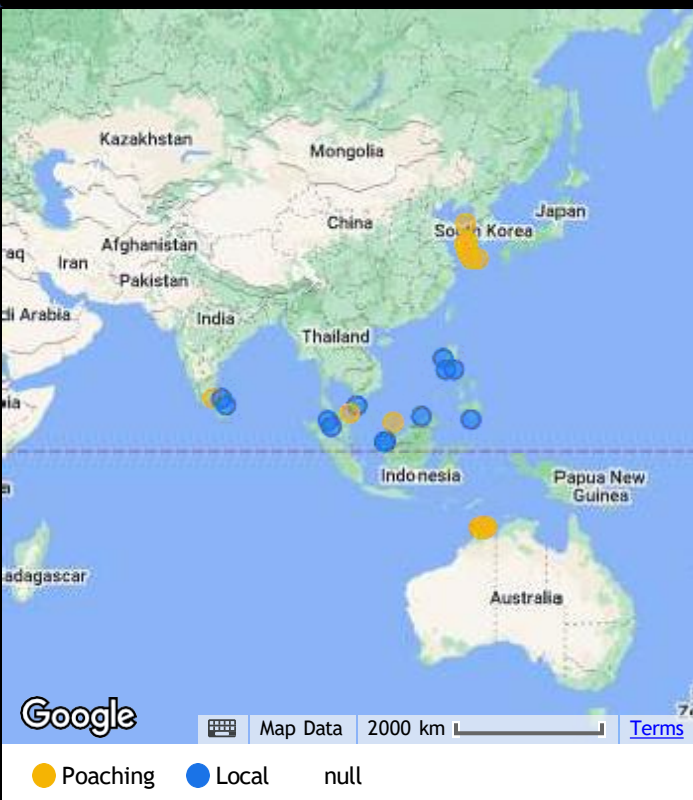
- This month, Typhoon "Kristine" and "Kong-Rey" impacted the South China Sea area of IFC's AOI.
- As a result of these weather events, along with the normal level of MI incidents from IFC's AOI, incident numbers in October 2024 (78) has seen a notable drop compared to previous month (121), but a slight increase compared to the same period in 2023 (70).



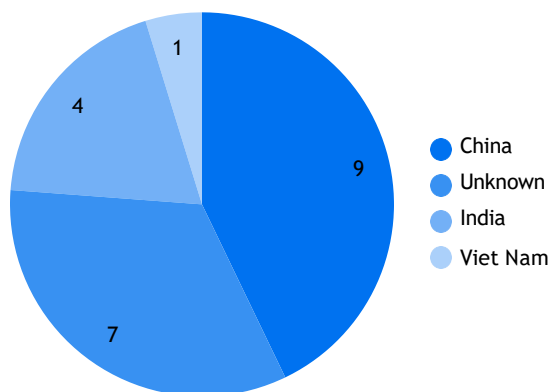




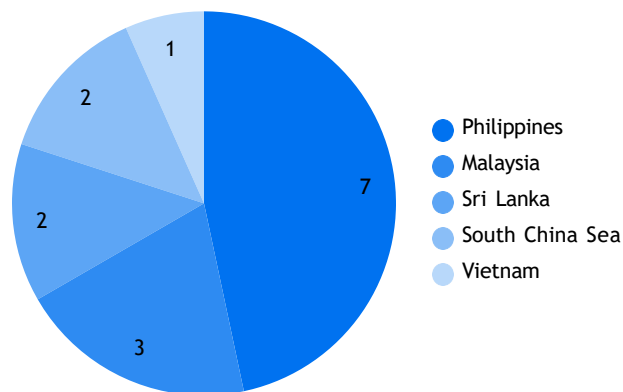

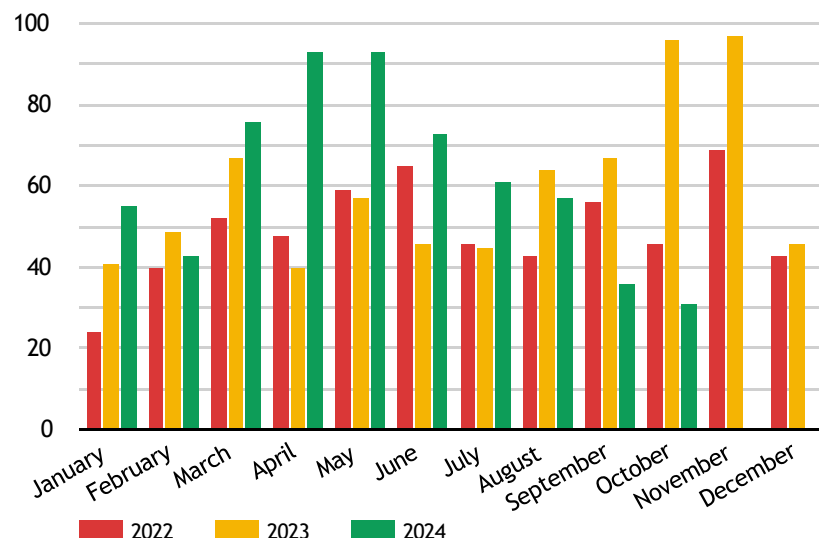
Number and Flag of Vessels, Poaching

## OBSERVATIONS

### Statistics:

• **Total:** 31 IUUF incidents (36 FVs) were recorded in IFC's AOI in October 2024. This figure is notably lower compared to October 2023 (96) by 65 and September 2024 (36) by 5 incidents.

• **Local:** 14 local incidents (15 FVs involved) were recorded in October 2024. This figure is lower than the number of October 2023 (29) by 16, and also September 2024 (15) by 2.

• Majority of FVs involved in local incidents are in Philippines with 7 FVs (46.7%), followed by Malaysia with 3 FVs (20%) and Sri Lanka with 2 FVs (13.3%) .

• **Poaching:** 17 poaching incidents (21 FVs involved) were recorded in October 2024. This figure is lower than in October 2023 (67) by 50 and increase September 2024 (16) by 1.

• The largest proportion of poaching involved 9 FVs of China (42.9%), followed by 7 unknown nationality of FVs (33.3%) and 4 FVs of India (19%).

• **International:** No international incident was recorded in October 2024.

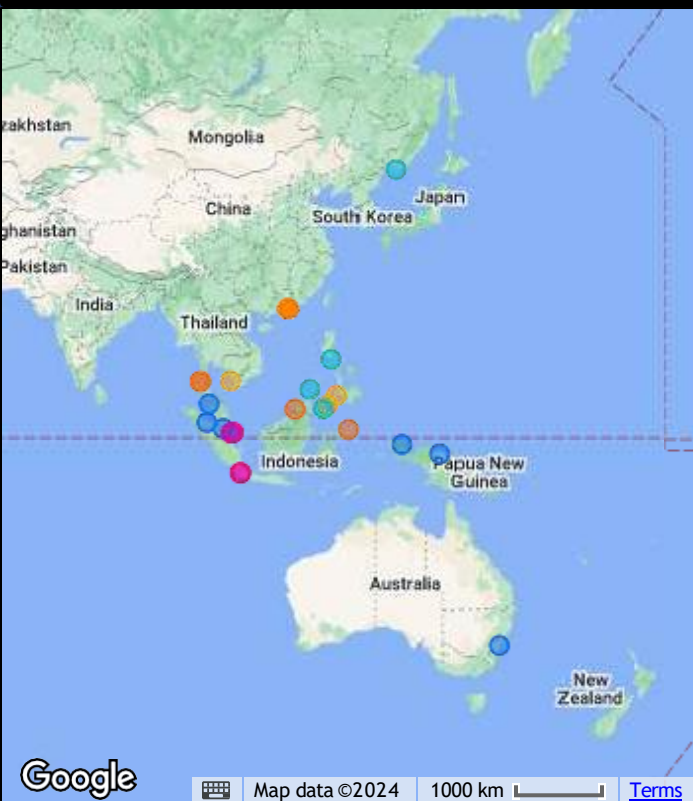
### Comments:

• The number of incidents in September is relatively low compared with October 2023 and August 2024. The trend might happen not only due to efforts of countries' agencies to prevent IUUF including MMEA, BAKAMLA, and Thai-MECC, but also the beginning of Monsoon season in South East Asia, which might cause fishing activities in the region.

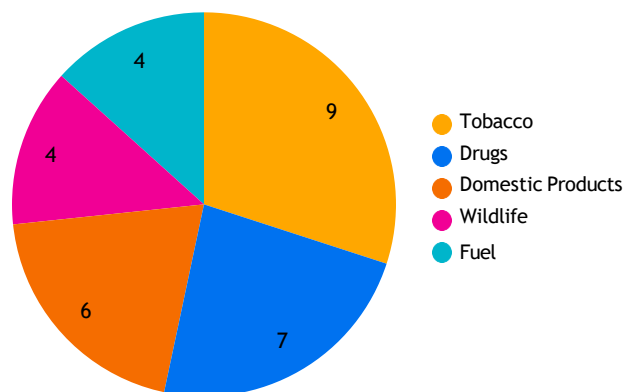




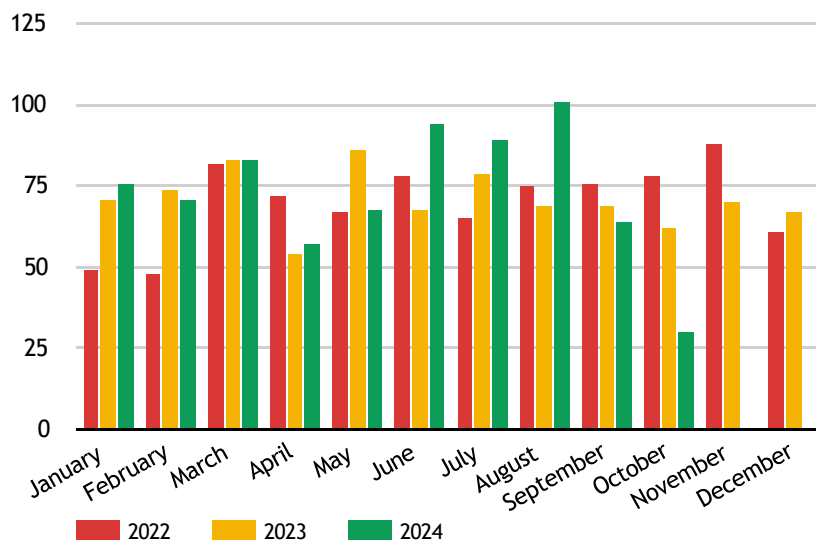

## Types of Smuggled Goods



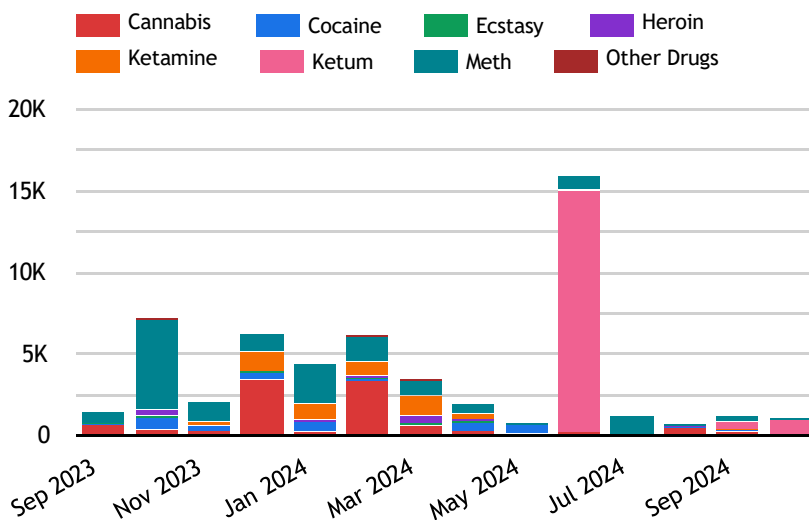

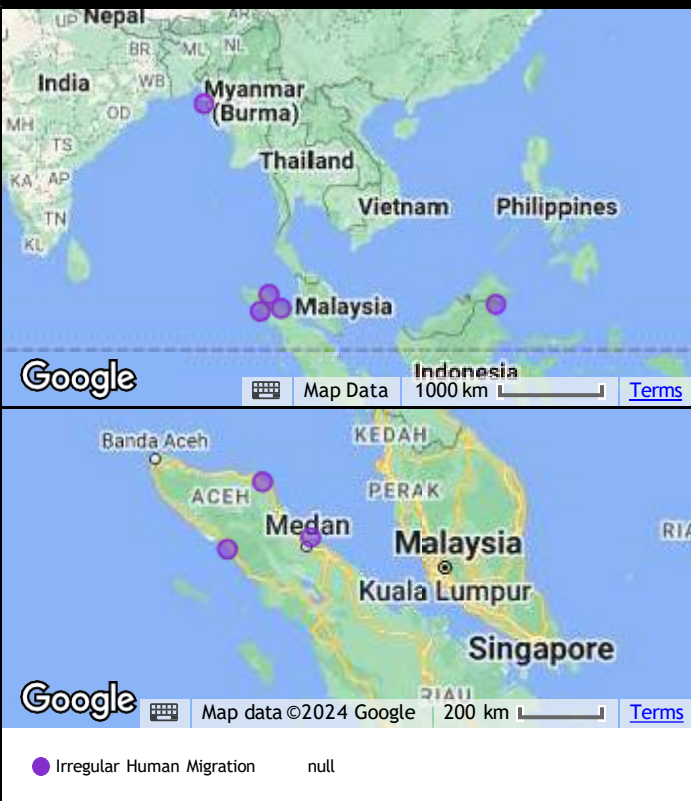
### Comments:

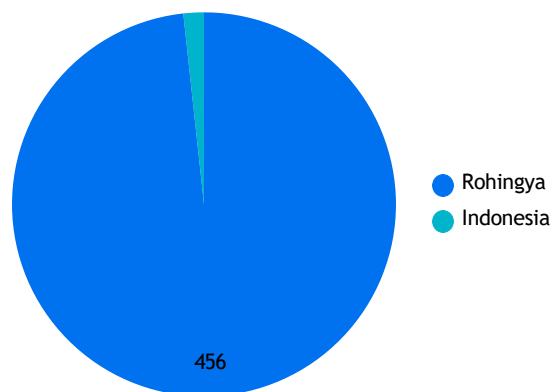

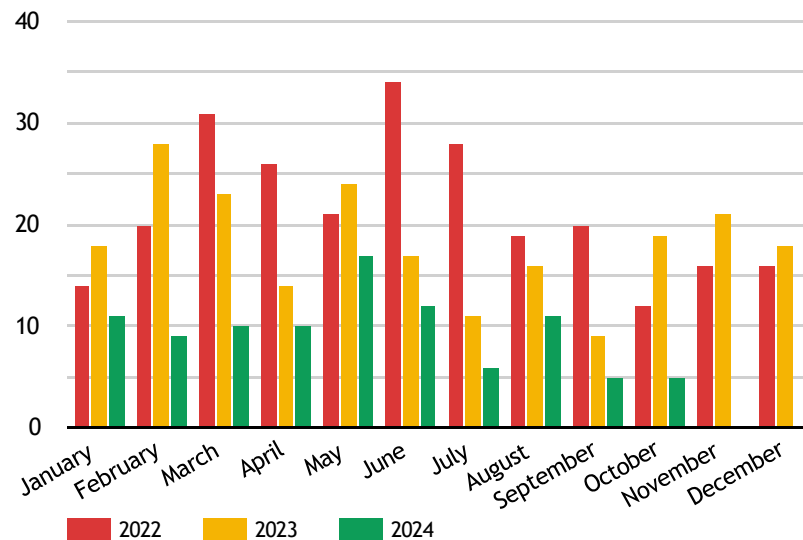
# Irregular Human Migration (IHM)



## Number and Nationality/Ethnicity of Migrants



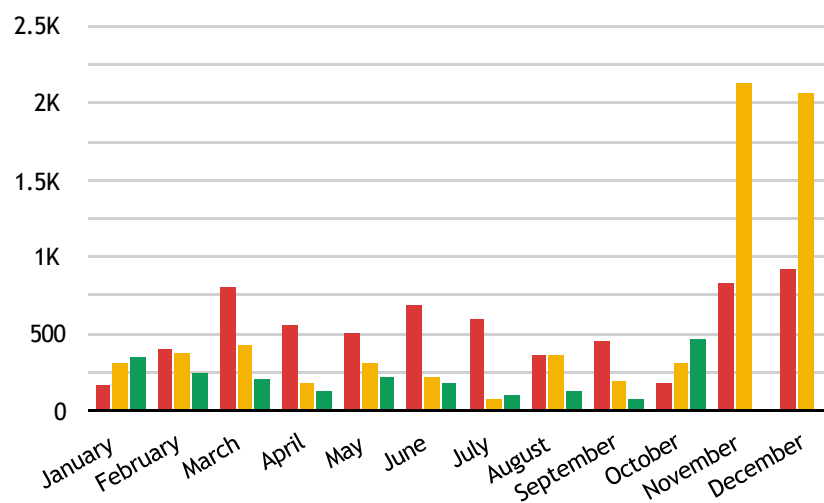

## OBSERVATIONS

### Statistics:

• 5 incidents were recorded this month - all of which were categorised as IHM.

### Observations:

• 4 of the 5 incidents were related to the movement of Rohingya migrants from the Bay of Bengal. Three migrant boats, approximately 300 people, arrived in Aceh during the month, and one was prevented from leaving Cox's Bazaar, Bangladesh.

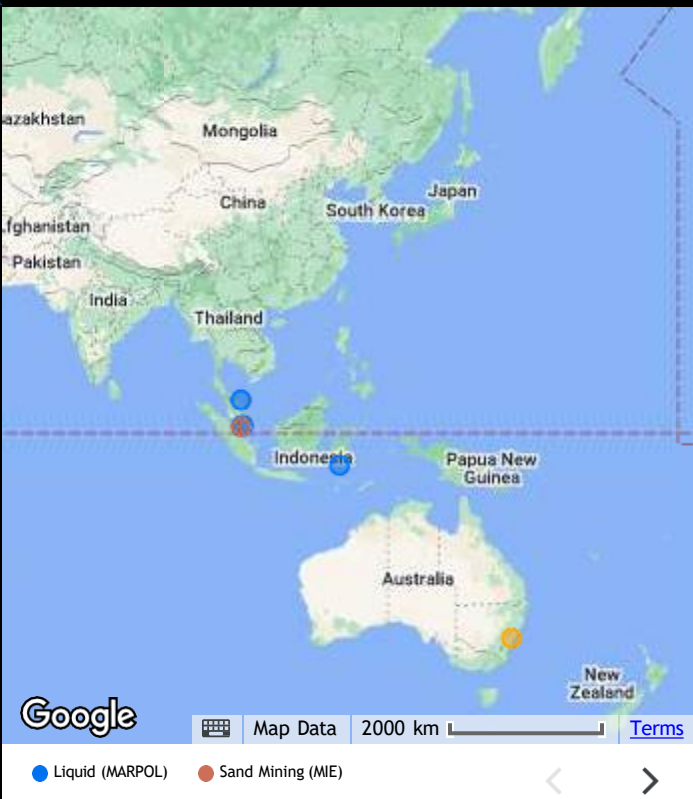
This increase in Rohingya activity is consistent with historical trends, with ventures increasing in Oct-Feb due to weather conditions most conducive to small boat voyages.

• IHM activity continues to be consistently low compared to previous years.

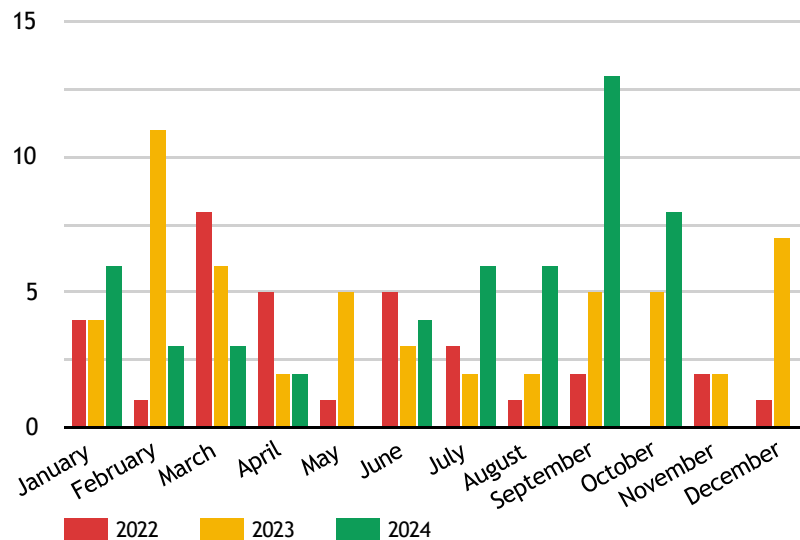

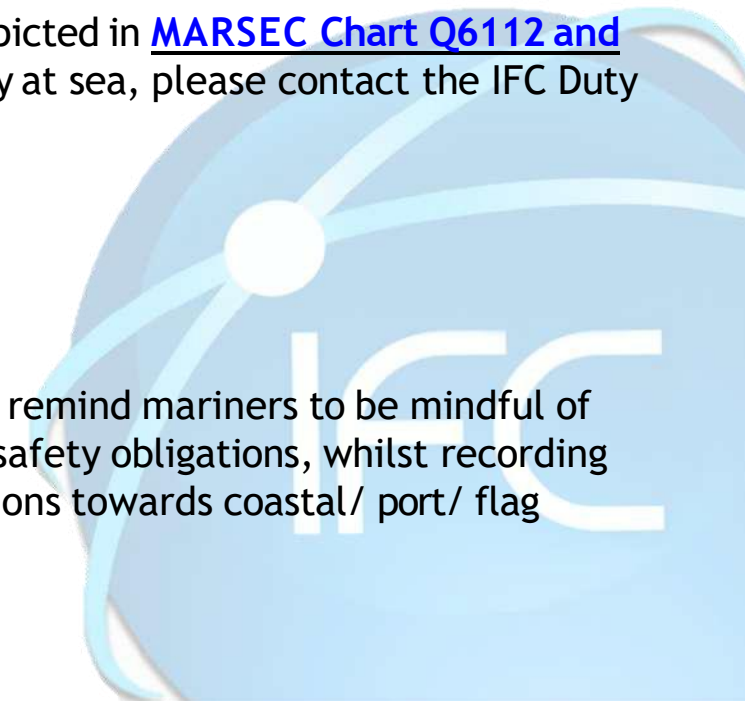


# IFC Recommendations



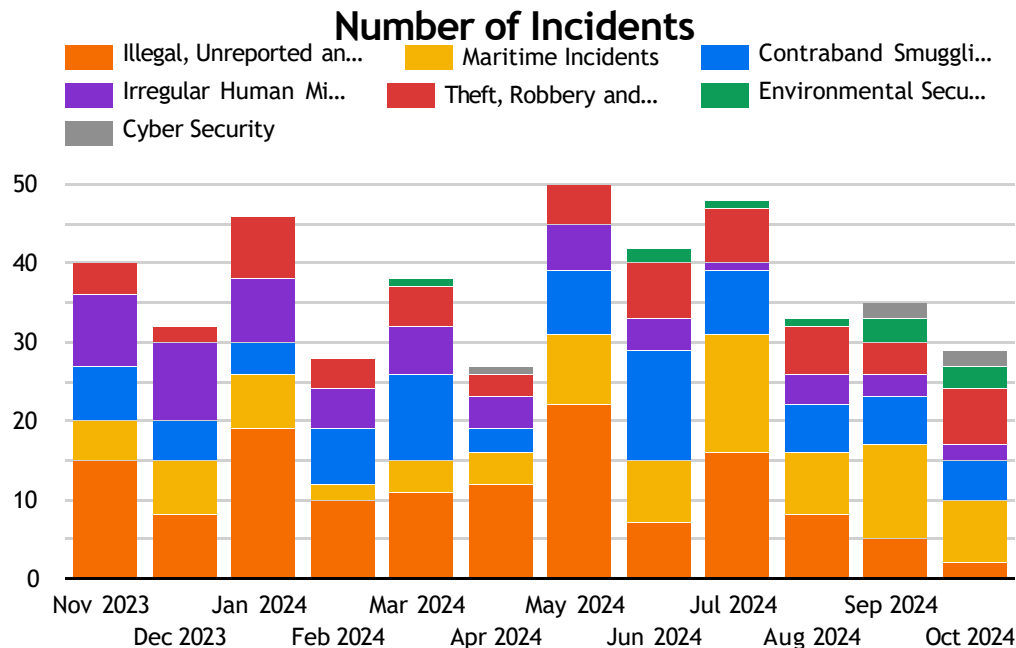
1. All mariners to report any maritime security incidents timely to the nearest coastal state and inform the IFC at the earliest possible time.
2. All mariners are strongly recommended to be vigilant, in particularly when operating in IFC identified hotspots (**Westbound lane of Traffic Separation Scheme in Singapore Strait, Eastbound lane of Traffic Separation Scheme in Singapore Strait, Belawan and Dumai Anchorages in Indonesia, Manila Anchorage in the Philippines, and Chittagong Outer Anchorage in Bangladesh**).
3. All mariners are advised to adopt **Ship Protection Measures** recommended in the [Regional Guide to Counter Piracy and Armed Robbery Against Ships in Asia](#) (e.g., illuminating the accommodation block and poop deck, deploying sentries and increase frequency of security rounds).
4. All mariners to take note on the description of the perpetrators and to take photos of the perpetrators if possible. Where available, CCTV footage capturing the incident should be provided to [the coastal state authorities](#) for follow-on investigation.
5. All mariners are advised to participate in **IFC Voluntary Community Reporting (VCR)** as depicted in [MARSEC Chart Q6112 and Q6113](#). In case of any doubt, incident at sea, suspicious approach or unusual observed activity at sea, please contact the IFC Duty Officer:
