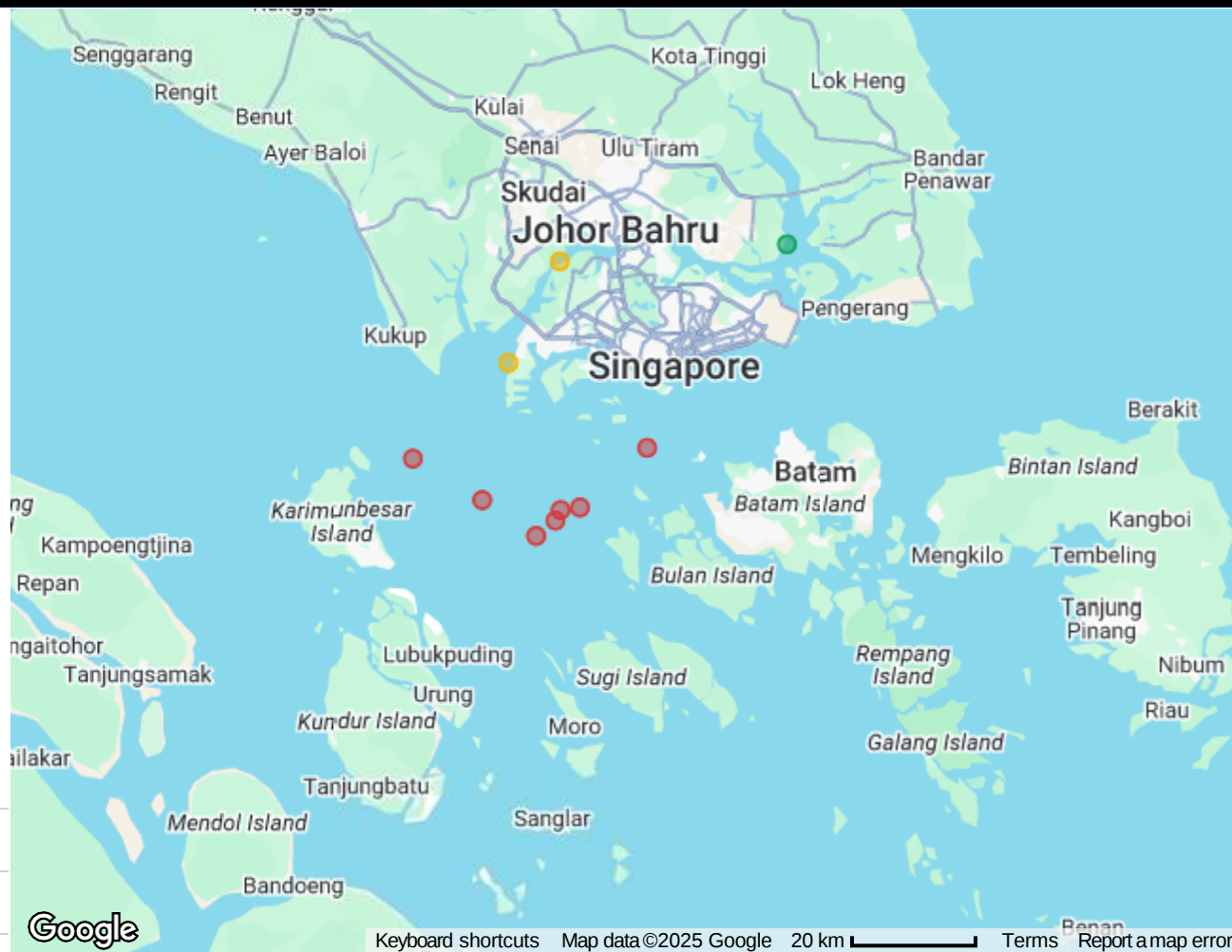


Overview of MARSEC Incidents in the Singapore Strait

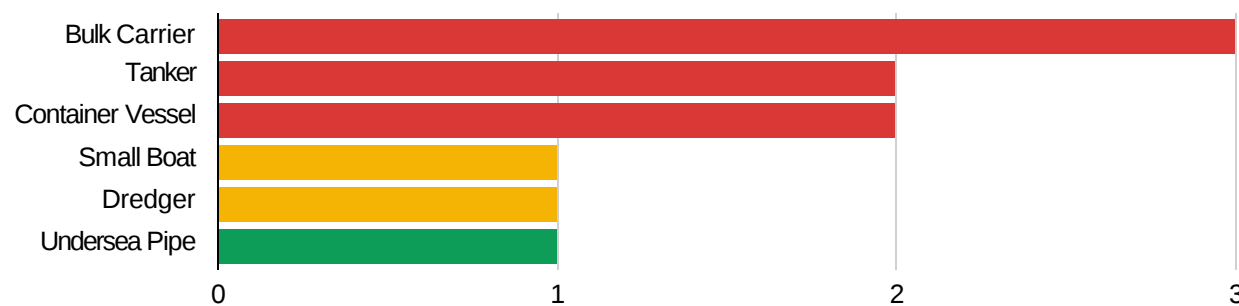

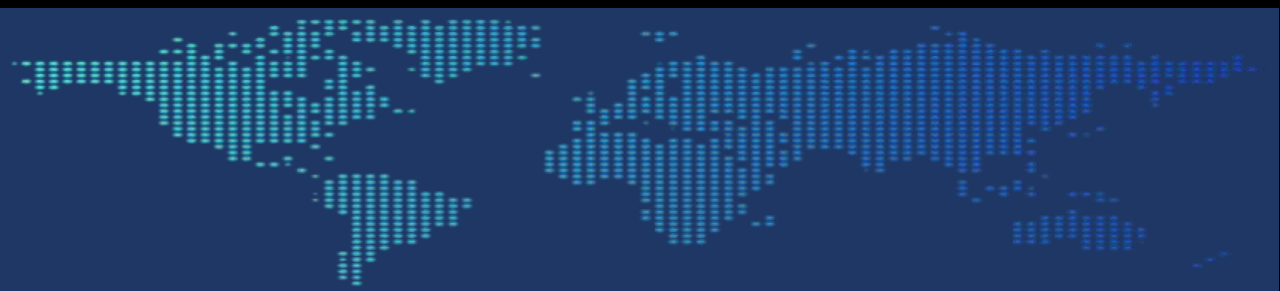

Executive Summary



Theft, Robbery and Piracy at Sea: 8 TRAPS incidents were reported in April throughout the AOI. This number recorded slightly higher than April 2024 (6 incidents) but significantly reduced compared to April 2023 (14 incidents). 7 incidents occurred in the Singapore Strait (SS) and 1 in Bangladesh.

Maritime Incidents: The IFC recorded a total of 50 incidents for the month of April the highest number of incidents happened in the waters of the Malaysia (10), Philippines (10), Vietnam (7) and Indonesia (6). The total number of maritime incidents that occurred in April 2025 lower than 2024 (73) and 2023 (83 incidents).

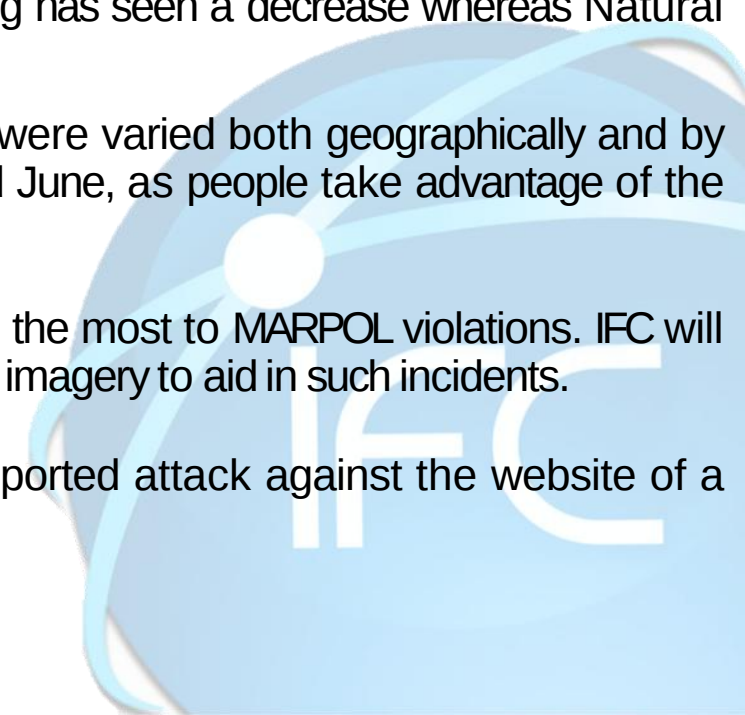
Illegal, Unreported, and Unregulated Fishing: A total of 60 IUUF incidents were reported for the month of April. The number of incidents this month decreased compared to the same month in previous years. This could be attributed to the effort of enforcement agencies that help curb the increase of incidents.

Contraband Smuggling: 41 CS incidents were reported in April, this figure is lower compared in the same period in the previous year. Domestic product smuggling account for the largest portion, wildlife and tobacco smuggling has seen a decrease whereas Natural Resources has increased almost two times compared with last month.

Irregular Human Migration: 4 IHM incidents were reported in April, incidents this month were varied both geographically and by nationality of migrants. IHM activity remains a concern with a historical peak in May and June, as people take advantage of the warmer and drier weather in South East Asia during these months.

Environmental Security: 3 ENVSEC incidents were reported this month, oil spills contributed the most to MARPOL violations. IFC will continue to monitor the trend, considering the effect of regional authorities adopting satellite imagery to aid in such incidents.

Cyber Security: 1 CYBSEC incident was reported this month, this incident involved a reported attack against the website of a Taiwanese container shipping company.

OBSERVATIONS

Statistics

- Total of 8 (Boardings) TRAPS incidents, increased compared to April 2024 (6) but significantly reduced in April 2023 (14).

- 7 incidents occurred in the Singapore Strait (SS) and 1 in Bangladesh. These incidents involved 3 bulk carriers, 2 tankers, 2 container vessels and numbers of fishing vessel (10 boats).

- All incidents occurred during the Period of Darkness (PoD) while vessels were underway.

Singapore Strait (SS)

- All incidents occurred in Philip Channel, which classified as Sea Theft. Of the five (7) incidents, four (4) incidents (3, 4, 5, and 6 Apr) involved perpetrators reportedly armed (i.e. knives, "gun-like" objects), however, no confrontation and injury reported.

- Four (4) incidents (3, 7, 23 and 25 Apr) reported lashing equipment, breathing apparatus (BA) compressors, padlocks and generator spares were stolen.

- The ships were able to continue their voyages to the next port without requiring any assistance.

Bangladesh

- 1 incident (Sea Robbery) occurred off Patharghata involving 10 fishing vessels but unknown numbers of perpetrators. This marks the first reported maritime incident of 2025 involving fishing vessel off Bangladesh waters, which resulted in injuries to 50 fishermen. The individuals were subsequently rescued by the Sri Lankan Navy.

Comments

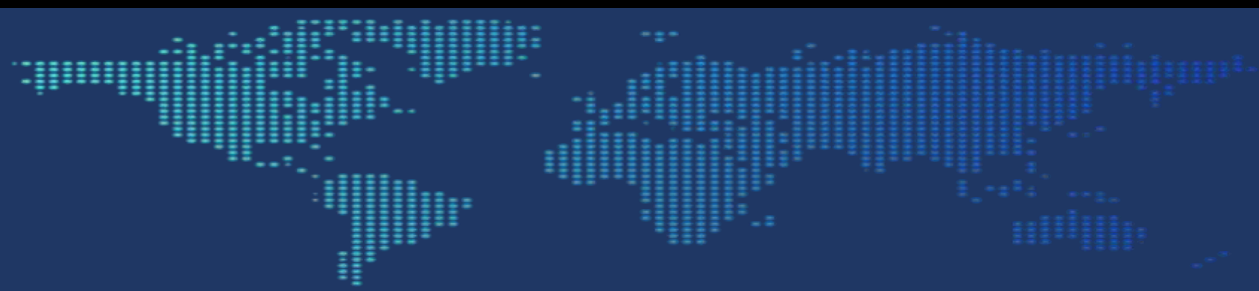
- The number of incidents in Apr 2025 showed a significant decrease compared to Mar 2025 (20 incidents). This decline is likely attributed to the abatement of the Northeast Monsoon, leading to improved weather conditions in the South China Sea and the resumption of fishing activities. If regional authorities continue to enhance enforcement in known areas of concern, incident numbers are expected to continue declining in the coming months, consistent with past trends.

- Perpetrators continue to target vulnerable vessel types, particularly bulk carriers, tugs with barges including container vessels [freeboard 3 to 7m]. In line with previous trends, these vessels are likely to remain preferred targets due to their inherent characteristics, such as low operating speeds and low freeboard. IFC assesses that the perpetrators' modus operandi is expected to remain consistent, primarily involving acts of petty crime.

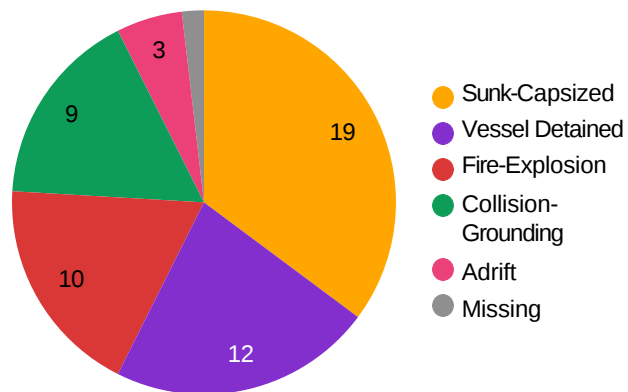
- As such, all companies, sea users, and ship masters are advised to remain vigilant when transiting known hotspots, such as the Phillip Channel, waters off Batam and Bintan Islands.



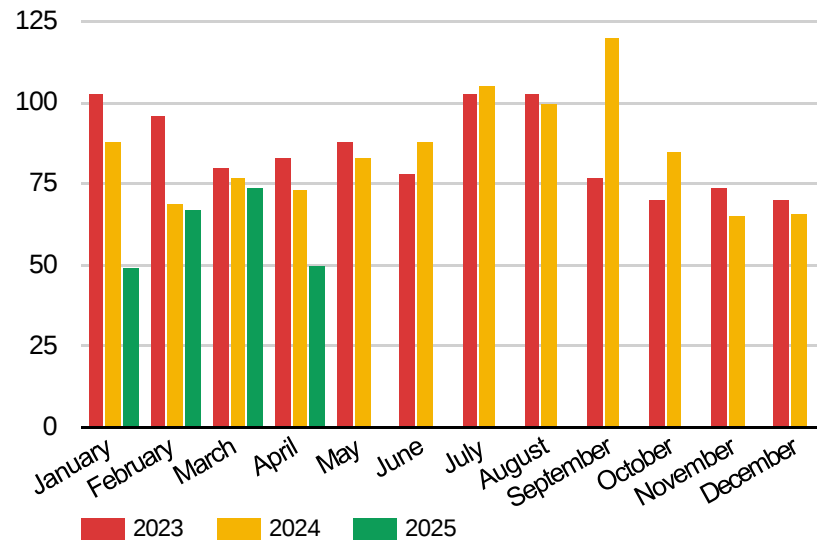
Maritime Incidents (MI)



Number of Vessels, by Type of Incident



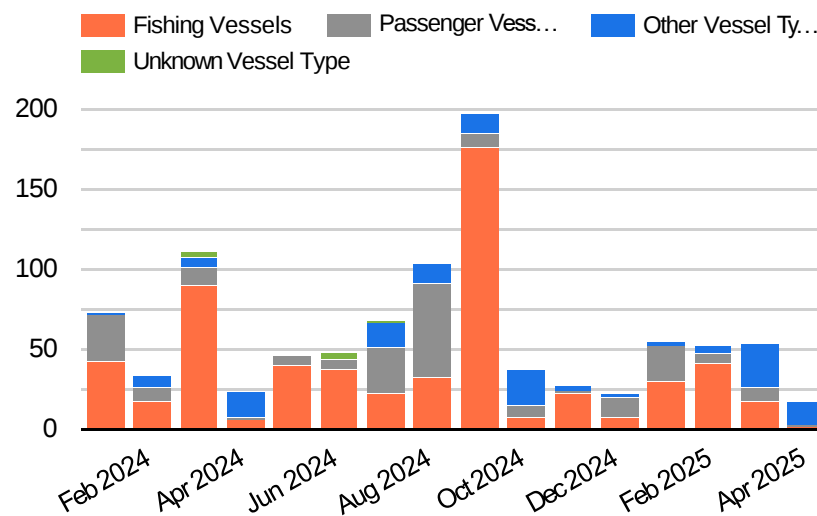

Statistics:

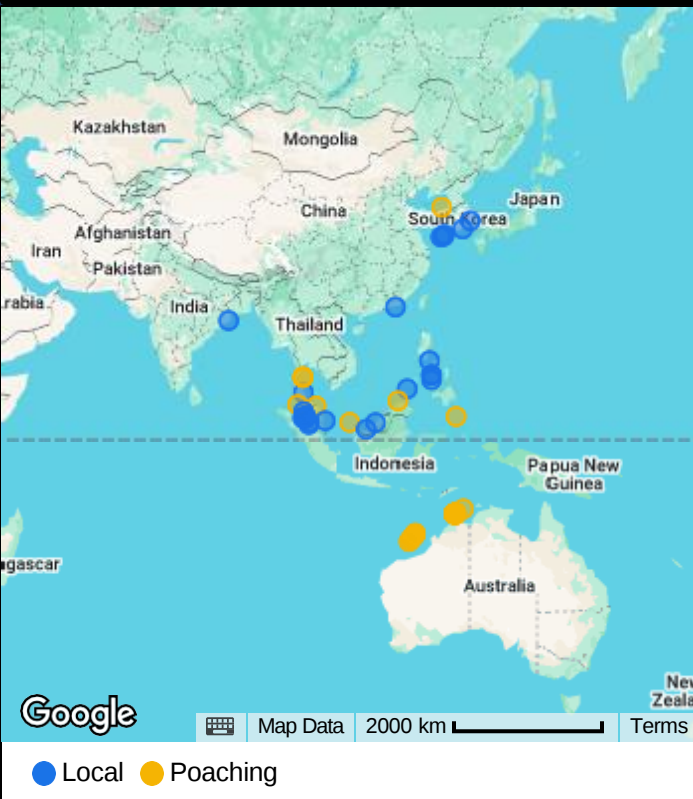
- A total of 50 maritime incidents were reported this month, which is lower than the figures recorded for the same period in 2024 (73) and 2023 (83) incidents.
- The largest number of reported incidents was sunk-capsized (19), followed by Vessel Detained(12), Fire - Explosion (10) and Collision Grounding (9).
- In terms of location, the highest number of reported incidents occurred in the waters of the Malaysia (10), Philippines (10), Vietnam (7) and Indonesia (6).
- A total of 18 individuals were reported dead or missing this month, which is less than the last month (54) also less than the same period in 2024 (24). Overall, 36 SAR operations were conducted, resulting in the rescue of 824 individuals during this month.

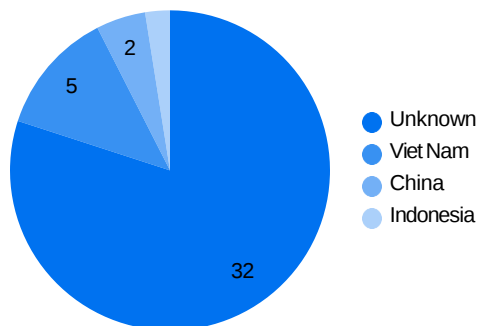
- Fire Explosion were the most common reported incident cause (8 of 50 incidents).
- Among the reported classifications, the number of Vessel Detained cases in Malaysia is increasing (11 of 50 incidents).



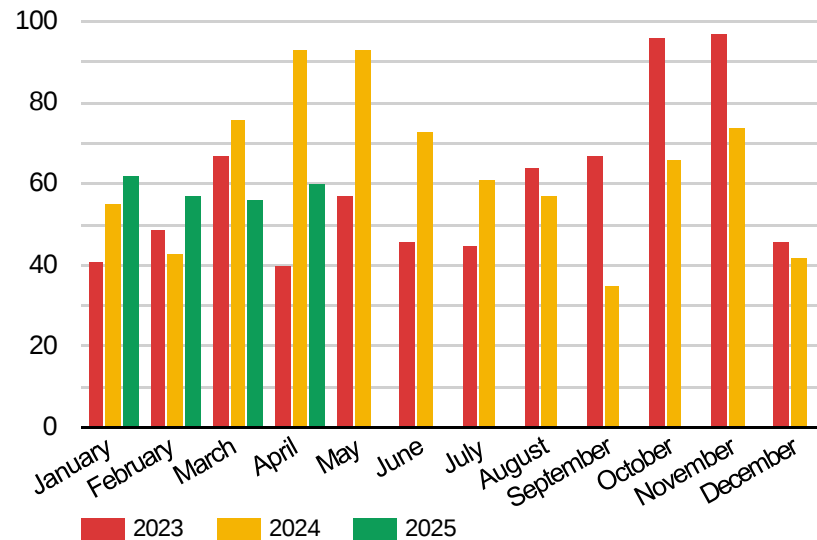
Illegal, Unreported, and Unregulated Fishing (IUUF)



Number and Flag of Vessels, Poaching



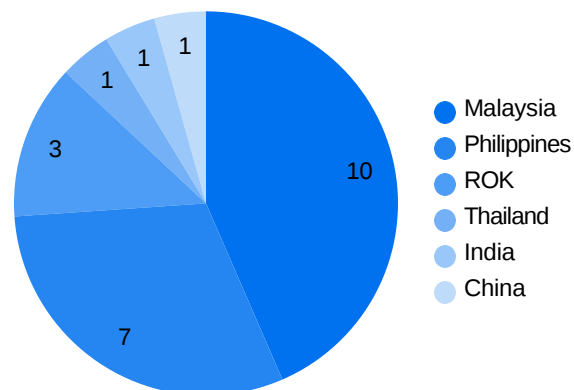

OBSERVATIONS

Statistics :

• **Total** : 60 IUUF incidents were recorded in IFC's AOI in April 2025. This figure (60) shows a significant decrease of 33 incidents compared to April 2024 (93), however it increase of 20 incidents compared to April 2023 (40), as observed from the annual data (YoY). Nevertheless, when viewed a comparison to the previous month (56), there was a slightly rise of 4 incidents, reflecting a notable increase (MoM).

• **Local** : 23 local incidents were recorded in April 2025. This figure shows a lower value compared to April 2024 (62), but a slight increase on April 2023 (22) by 1 (YoY). When compared to the previous month (32), it decreased 9 incidents (MoM).

• Majority of FVs involved in local incidents occurred in Malaysia with 10 FVs (43.5%), followed by the Philippines with 7 FVs (30.4%), South Korea with 3 FVs (13%). Other incidents occurred in Thailand, India and China, each accounting for 1 FV (4.3%).

• **Poaching** : 37 poaching incidents were recorded in April 2025. This figure shows an annual increase in the same month, with 6 incidents compared to April 2024 (31), and 20 incidents compared to April 2023 (17) (YoY). When compared to the previous month (24), it increased by 13 incidents (MoM).

• The largest proportion of poaching incidents is unspecified nationality with 32 FVs (80%), followed by Viet Nam with 5 FVs (12.5%), China with 2 FVs (5%) and Indonesia with 1 FV (2.5%).

• **International** : NSTR.

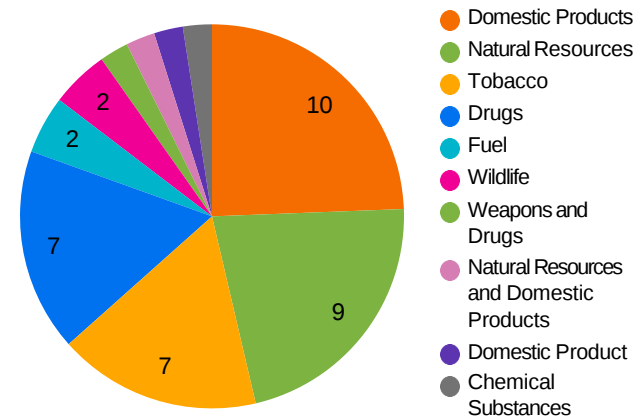
• The number of incidents this month decreased compared to the same month in the previous years (YoY), but slightly increase when compared to the last month (MoM). The major contributor to this downward trend is local incidents, it's assessed that the efforts of enforcement agencies likely helped curb the increase of incidents. We will continue to monitor the changes on data, taking various variables into consideration.



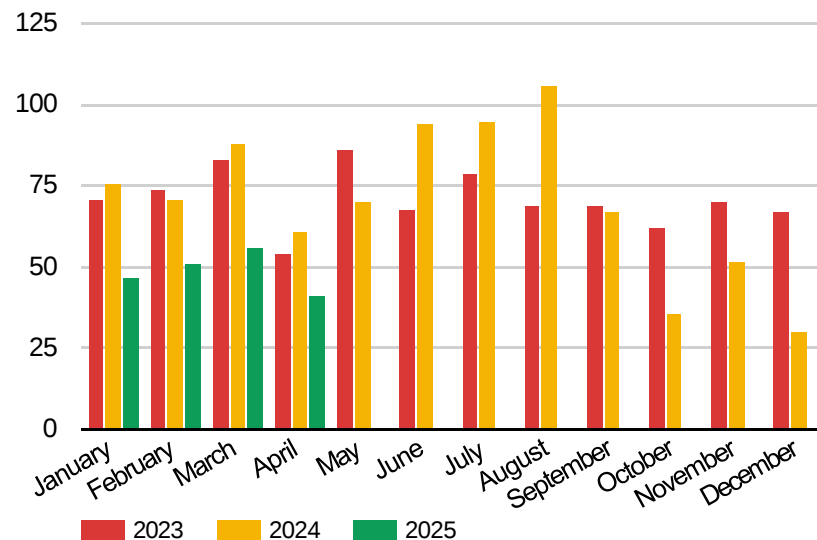
Contraband Smuggling (CS)



Types of Smuggled Goods



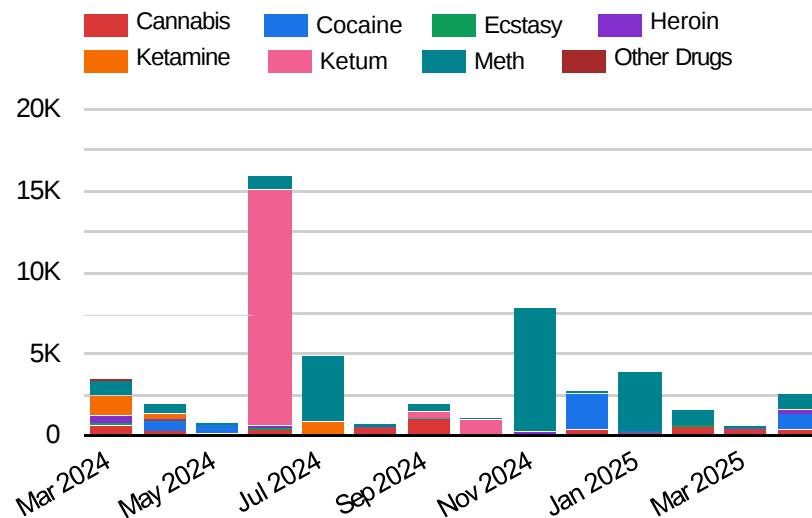

OBSERVATIONS

Statistics:

In April 2025, IFC recorded 41 contraband smuggling incidents.

Drugs (x9, 4,879.098kg): Sri Lanka(x4, Meth 713.786kg, Heroin 269.236kg, Cannabis 322.8kg), Malaysia(x1, Meth 480.29kg, Heroin 109.89kg), India (x1 Meth 311kg), Philippines (x1 Marijuana 72.1kg), Taiwan (x1 Ketamine 1,600kg), ROK (x1 Cocaine 1,000kg).

Fuel (x3 228,000 litres): Vietnam (x2, Diesel 78,000 litres), Sabah(x1, Petrol 150,000 litres).

Domestic Products (x10 100,895kg): Sri Lanka (x3), Indonesia (x2), China(x2), India(x2), Hong Kong(x1), Brunei (x1).

Natural Resources (x9, 6,139.26kg): Sri Lanka (x5), India(x3), Viet Nam(x1).

Wildlife (x2): China (x1), Sabah (x1).

Tobacco (x7, 94 cases): Philippines (x4), Indonesia (x1), Sri Lanka(x1), Brunei (x1).

Chemical Substances (x1): Thailand (HT LI 79,000Kg).

Comments:

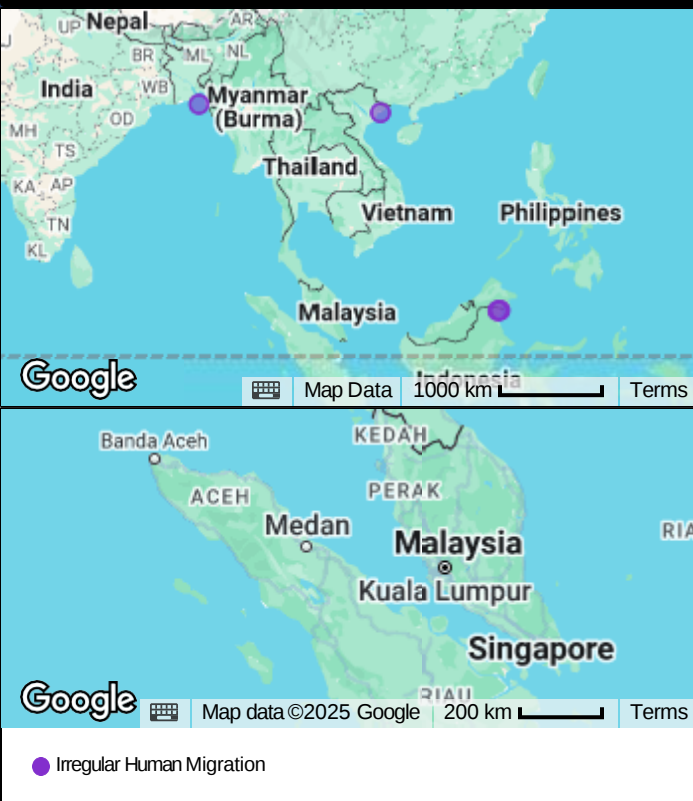
- For this month, IFC reported a total of 41 incidents compared to 47 incidents last month, which was lower compared in the same period in the previous year.

- Compared to last month, drug smuggling surged significantly, whereas fuel seizures decreased by about two times. Tobacco cases have dropped significantly, and individual seizures were smaller. Wildlife smuggling cases remained stable.

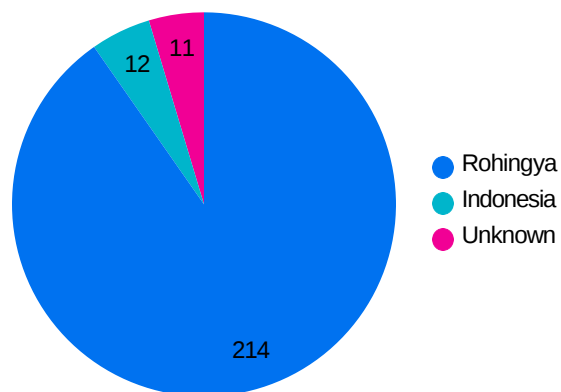
- With Domestic Product accounting for the largest proportion, wildlife smuggling dropped from last month to 2 incidents, while tobacco smuggling has dropped to 8 incidents. Drugs are also dropped 10% from last month with 9 incidents, whereas Natural Resources has increased almost two times compared with last month.



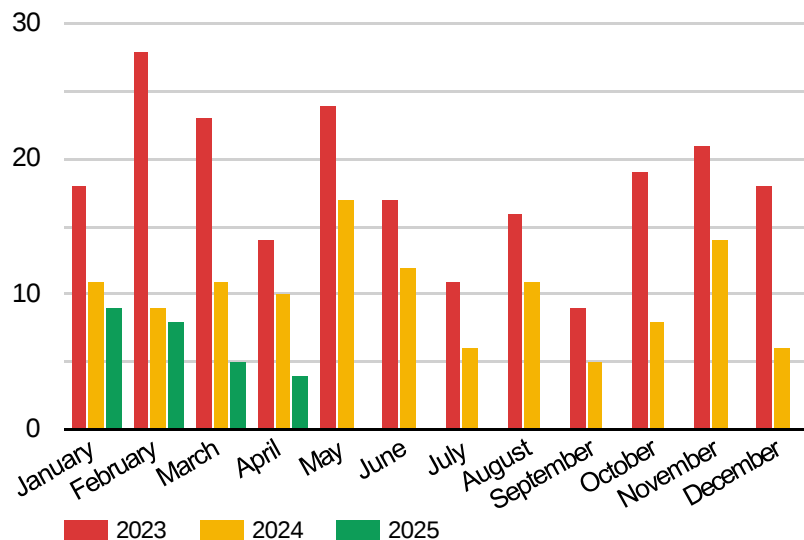
Irregular Human Migration (IHM)



Number and Nationality/Ethnicity of Migrants



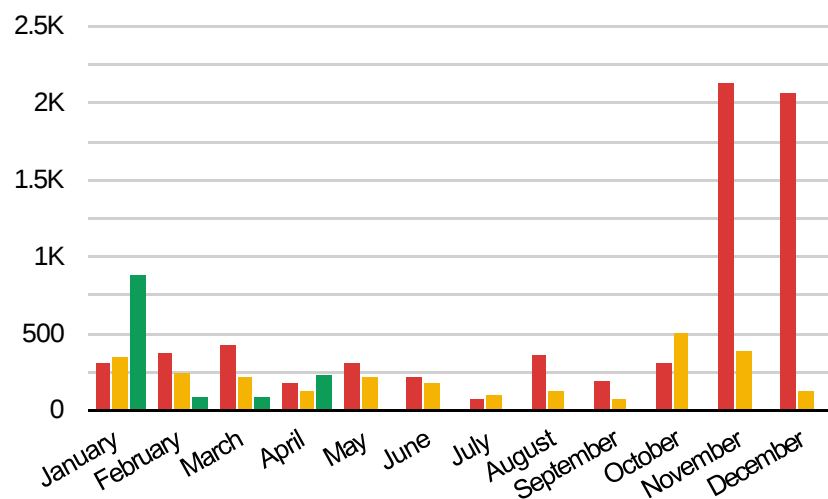

Statistics:

• **Four incidents were recorded this month** - all are classified as routine Irregular Human Migration (IHM) incidents.

Comments:

• Incidents this month were varied, both geographically and by nationality of migrants.

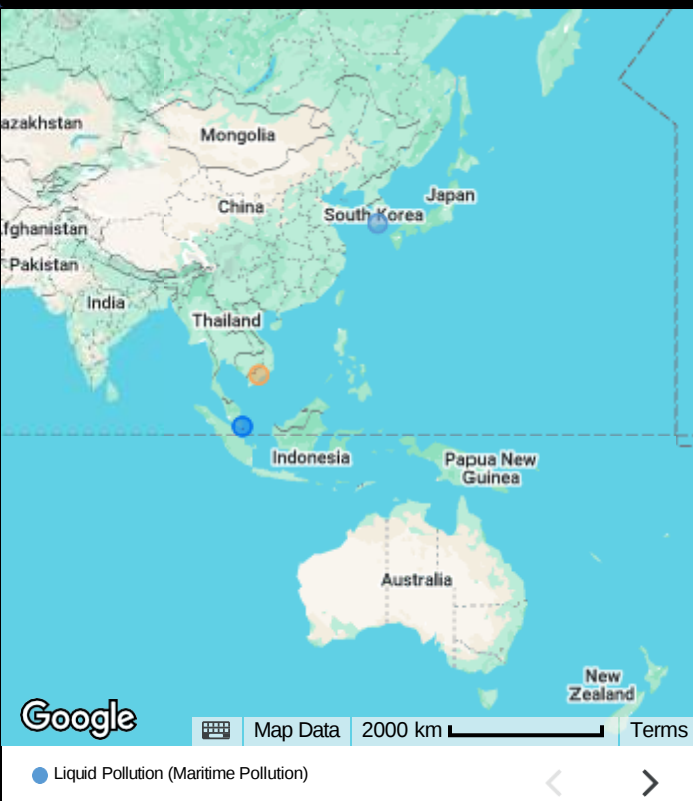
• One large Rohingya IHM vessel was reported by Bangladesh Navy in the Bay of Bengal, holding 214 migrants attempting to reach Malaysia. This incident comes at the end of the historical peak for Rohingya IHM, with April/May being the final Rohingya venture for 2023/2024, until the return of more favourable weather in around November.

• IHM activity remains a concern, with a historical peak in May and June as people take advantage of the warmer and drier weather in south east Asia during these months.

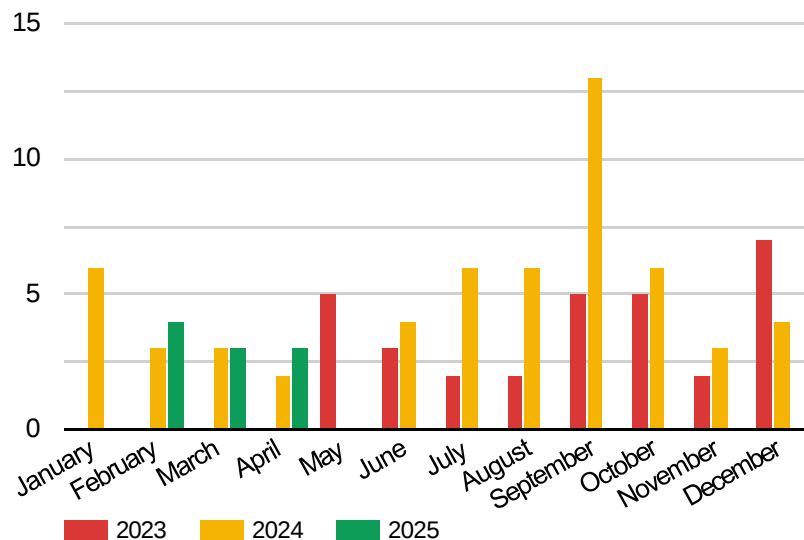

Vessels/Organisations Involved



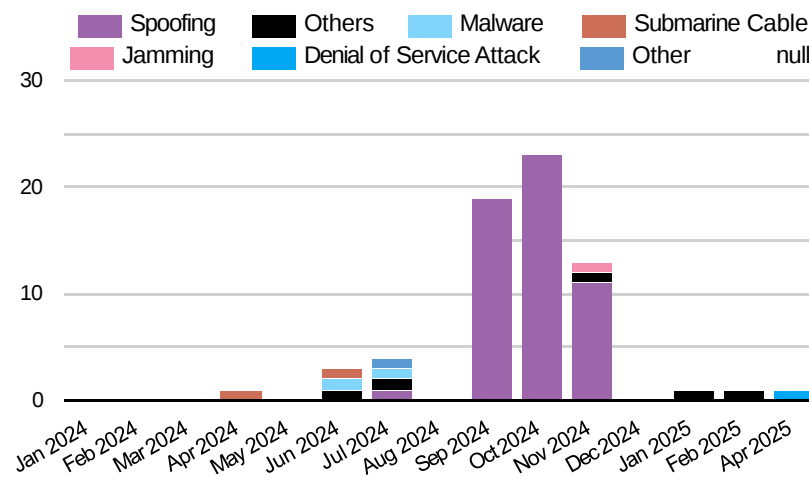

- The single incident consisted of a reported attack against the website of a Taiwanese container shipping company. The perpetrators of the attack were not identified.





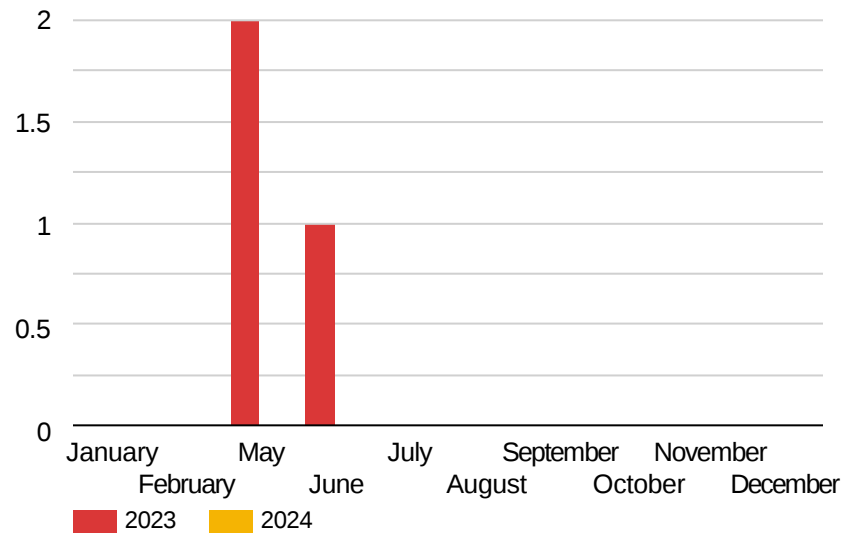

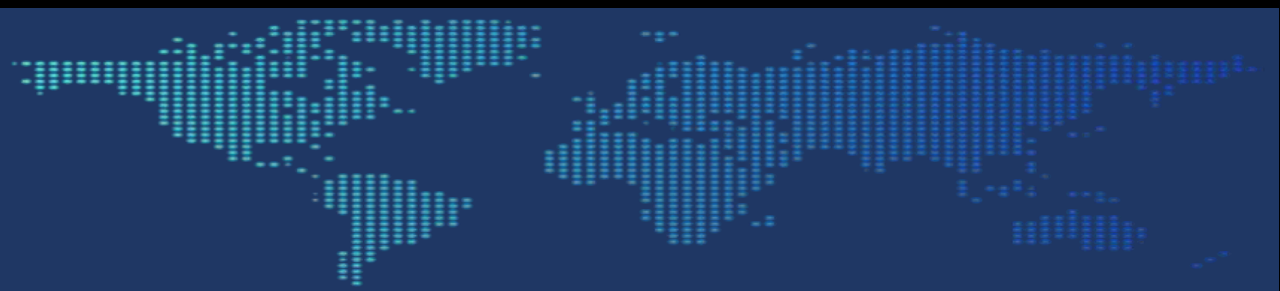

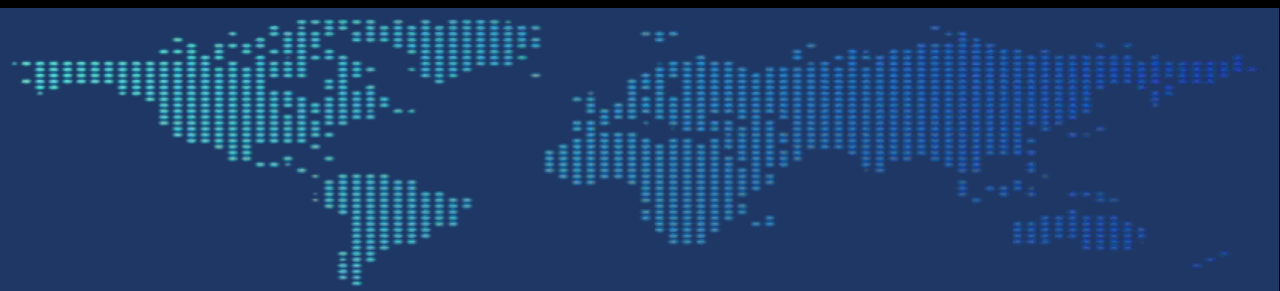

IFC Recommendations



1. All mariners to report any maritime security incidents timely to the nearest coastal state and inform the IFC at the earliest possible time.
2. All mariners are strongly recommended to be vigilant, in particularly when operating in IFC identified hotspots (**Westbound lane of Traffic Separation Scheme in Singapore Strait, Eastbound lane of Traffic Separation Scheme in Singapore Strait, Belawan and Dumai Anchorages in Indonesia, Manila Anchorage in the Philippines, and Chittagong Outer Anchorage in Bangladesh**).
3. All mariners are advised to adopt **Ship Protection Measures** recommended in the Regional Guide to Counter Piracy and Armed Robbery Against Ships in Asia (e.g., illuminating the accommodation block and poop deck, deploying sentries and increase frequency of security rounds).
4. All mariners to take note on the description of the perpetrators and to take photos of the perpetrators if possible. Where available, CCTV footage capturing the incident should be provided to the coastal state authorities for follow-on investigation.
5. All mariners are advised to participate in **IFC Voluntary Community Reporting (VCR)** as depicted in MARSEC Chart Q6112 and Q6113. In case of any doubt, incident at sea, suspicious approach or unusual observed activity at sea, please contact the IFC Duty Officer:
