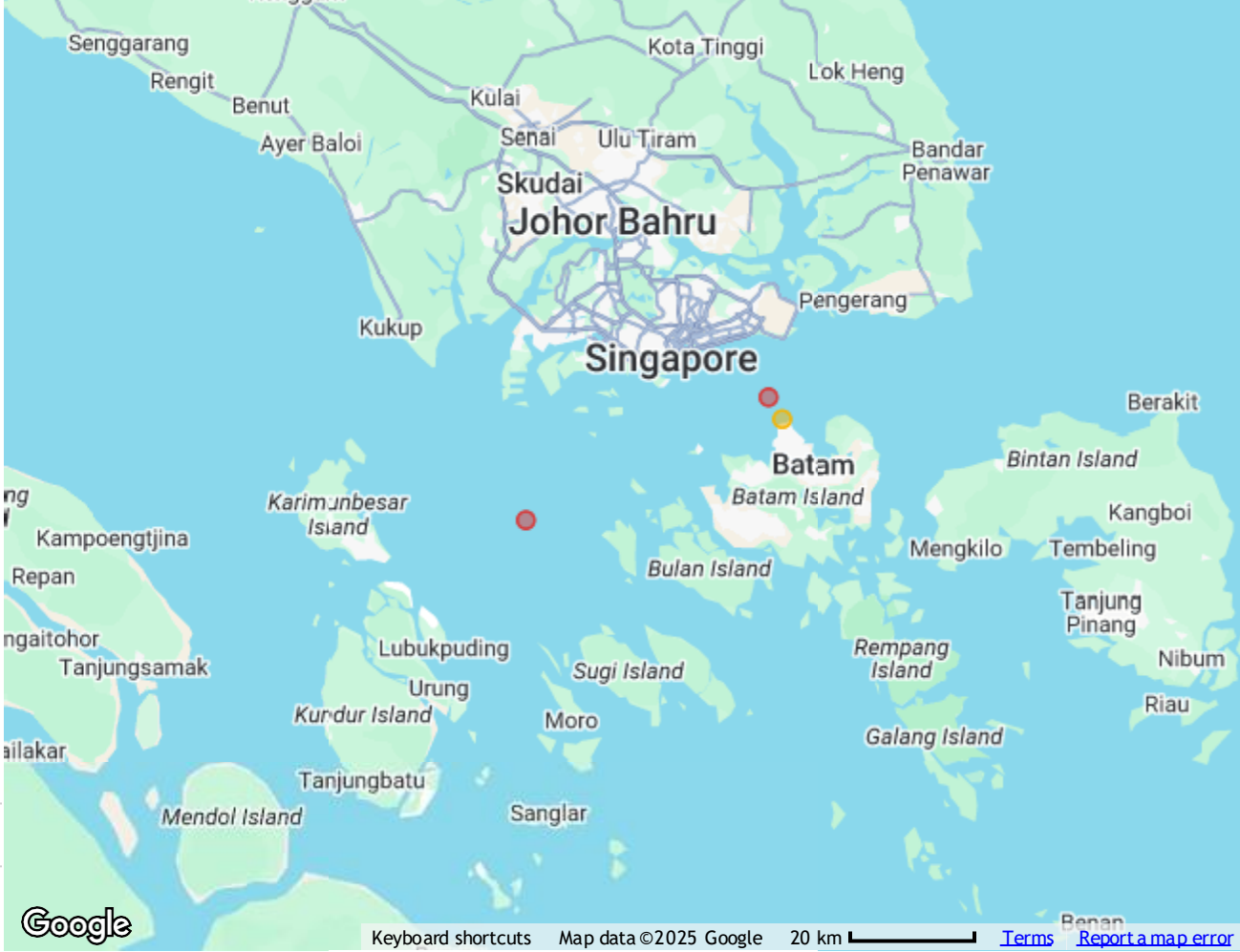
Overview of MARSEC Incidents in the Singapore Strait

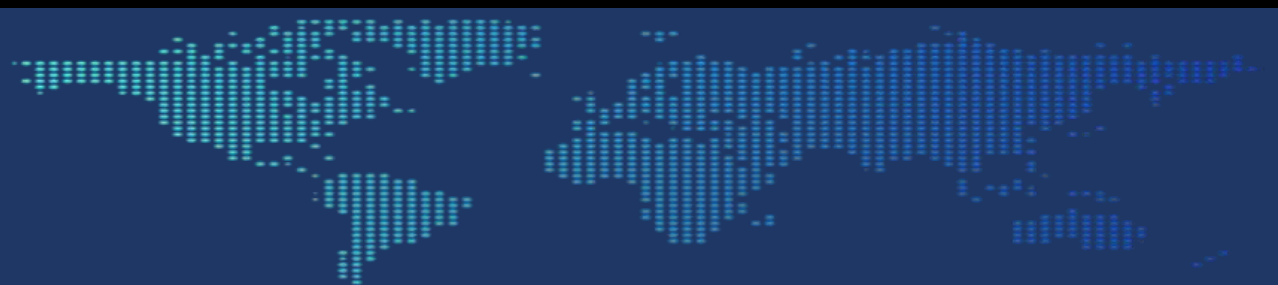

Executive Summary



Theft, Robbery and Piracy at Sea: 2 TRAPS incidents were reported in Aug 2025, with both incidents occurring in the Singapore Strait. This marks a significant decrease as compared to 2024 (7), and 2023 (8).

Maritime Incidents: 68 MI incidents were reported in Aug 2025. Bad Weather was the most common reported incident cause (18 out of 68 incidents).

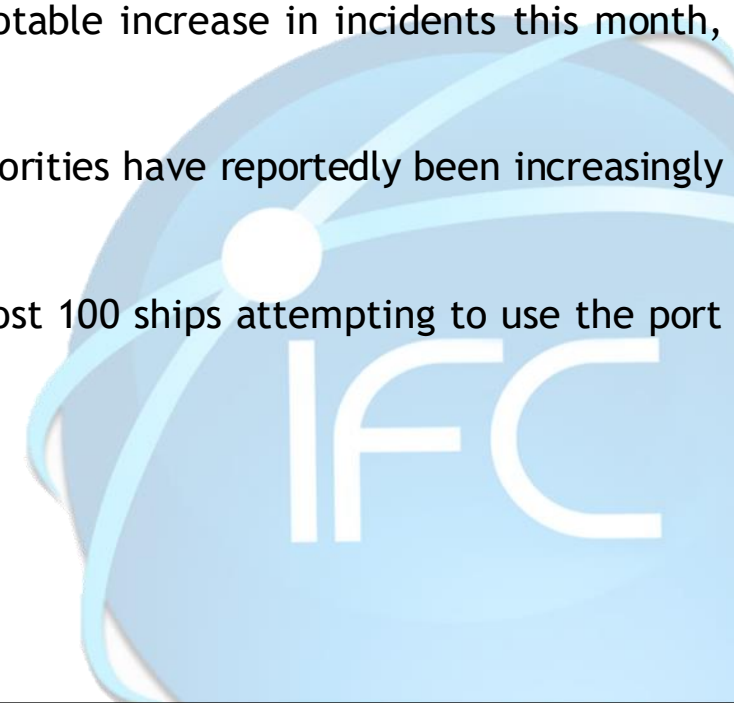
Illegal, Unreported, and Unregulated Fishing: 39 IUUF incidents were reported in Aug 2025. It was observed that illegal fishing methods were evolving to evade detection by enforcement agencies.

Contraband Smuggling: 47 CS incidents were reported in Aug 2025. Drugs smuggling continues to dominate the contraband smuggling this month. The number of cases were lower than last month, but higher in volume. Whereas fuel smuggling remains the same numbers but lower in volume.

Irregular Human Migration: 9 IHM incidents were reported in Aug 2025. There was a notable increase in incidents this month, primarily driven by occurrences off the coast of the Philippines.

Environmental Security: 1 ENVSEC incident was reported in Aug 2025. Notably, regional authorities have reportedly been increasingly utilising satellite imagery to detect and respond to ENVSEC incidents.

Cyber Security: 1 CYBSEC incident was reported in Aug 2025. This incident affected almost 100 ships attempting to use the port of Nakhodka.

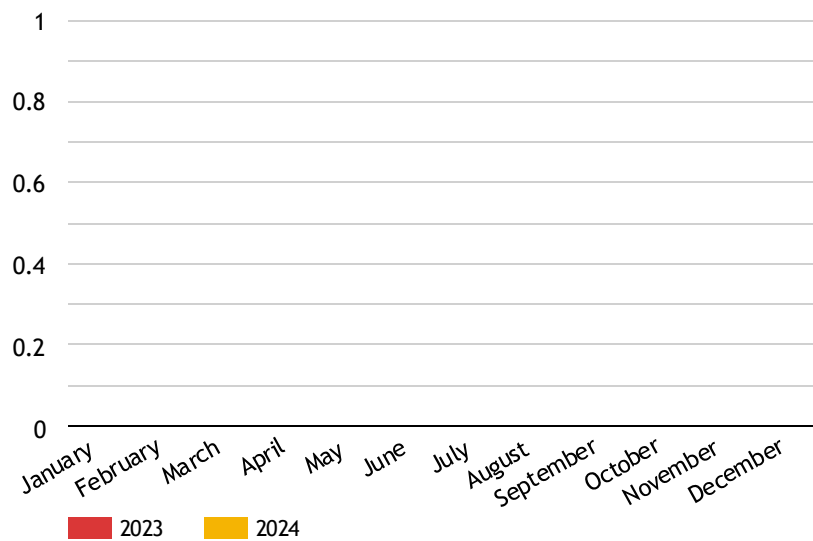

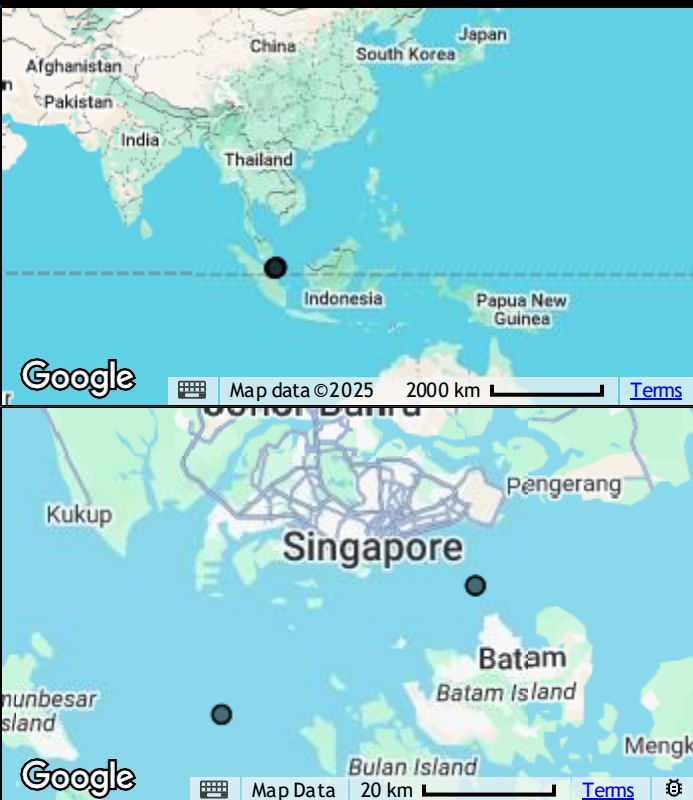

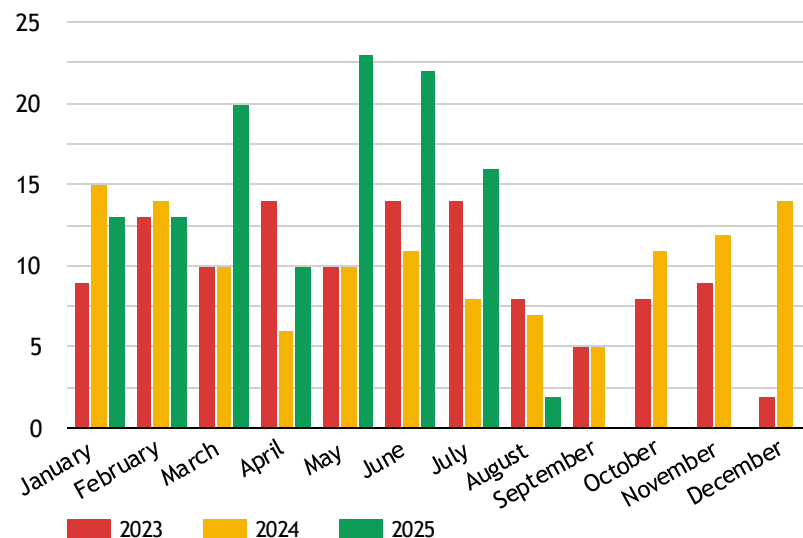




Theft, Robbery and Piracy at Sea (TRAPS)



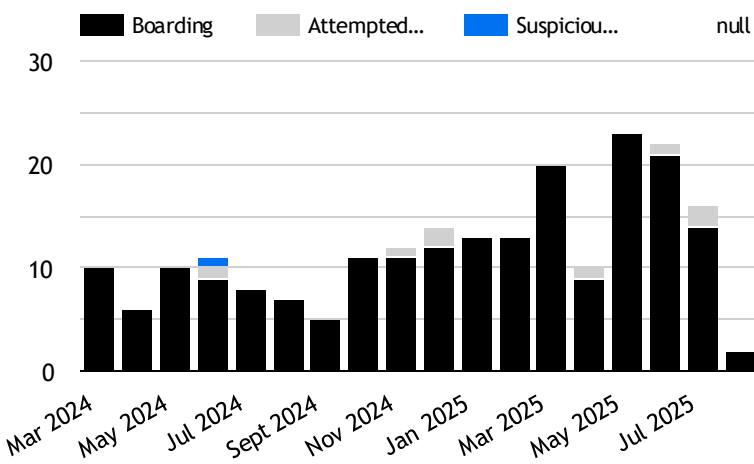

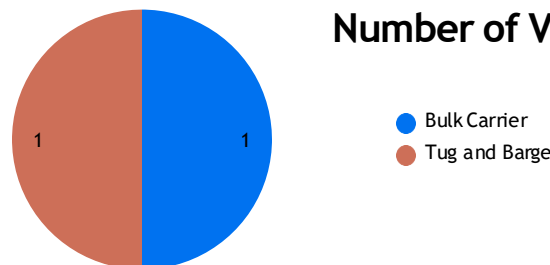

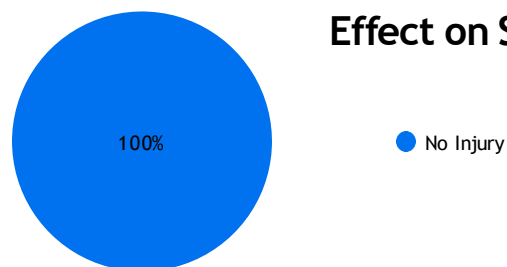

OBSERVATIONS

Statistics.

- Total of 2 TRAPS incidents in Aug 2025. This represented a significant decrease as compared to the same period in 2024 (7), and 2023 (8).
- 2 incidents were reported in Aug 2025; 1 in Eastbound Lane of the Traffic Separation Scheme (TSS) and 1 in Phillip Channel.

Eastbound Lane of TSS.

- 1 incident involving a tug and barge during daylight hours. Based on incident reports, there were nine sampans approaching the barge, and approximately 10 unarmed perpetrators boarded. No confrontation and injury were reported, and some scrap metal was stolen.

Philip Channel.

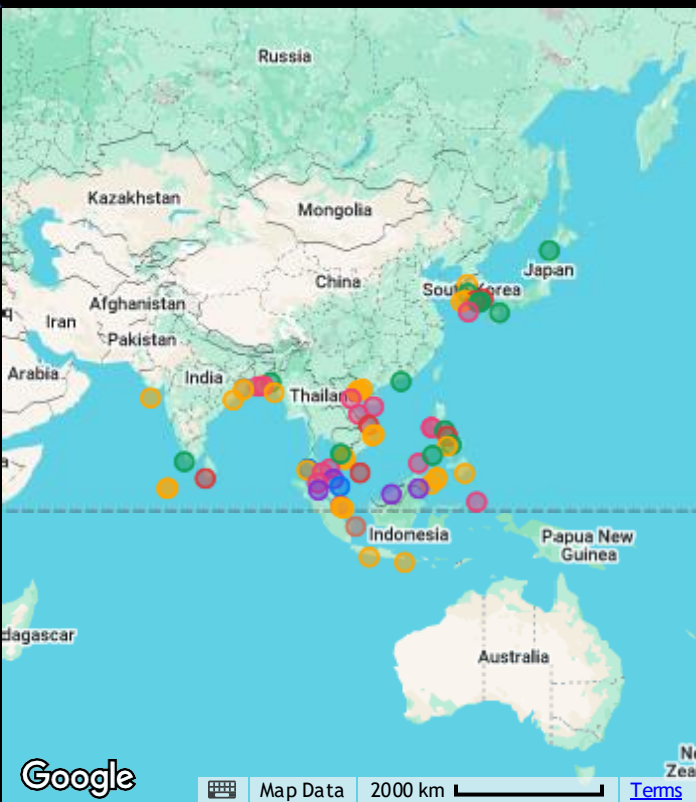
- 1 incident involving a bulk carrier during hours of darkness. Ship crew sighted 4 unarmed perpetrators on board, who fled immediately after the ship's alarm was raised. No confrontation and injury were reported, and nothing was stolen.

Comments.

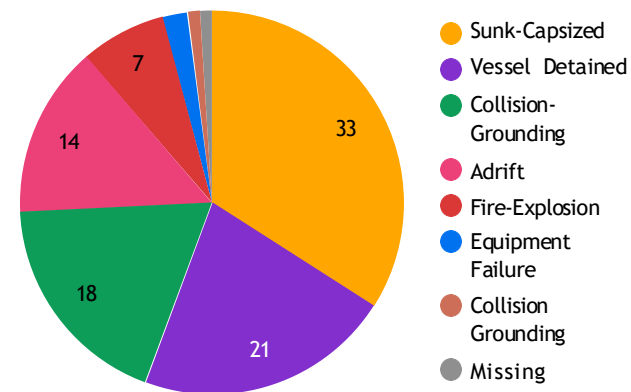
- The number of incident in Aug 2025 was significantly lower than in previous months. This decline likely due to the effective joint operations conducted by the Indonesian authorities in Jul 2025, which sent a strong deterrent message to the would-be perpetrators.
- IFC assess low incident rates for Sep 2025, supported by ongoing enforcement in key areas. However, vessels are urged to stay vigilant and apply appropriate protection measures to deter threats and prevent unauthorised boarding.
- Perpetrators continue to target vulnerable vessels, particularly bulk carriers, tugs with barges, and container ships with freeboards less than 8 meters. Consistent with past trends, these vessels are likely to remain preferred targets due to their low operating speeds and low freeboard. The modus operandi is expected to remain unchanged, involving mainly acts of petty theft.



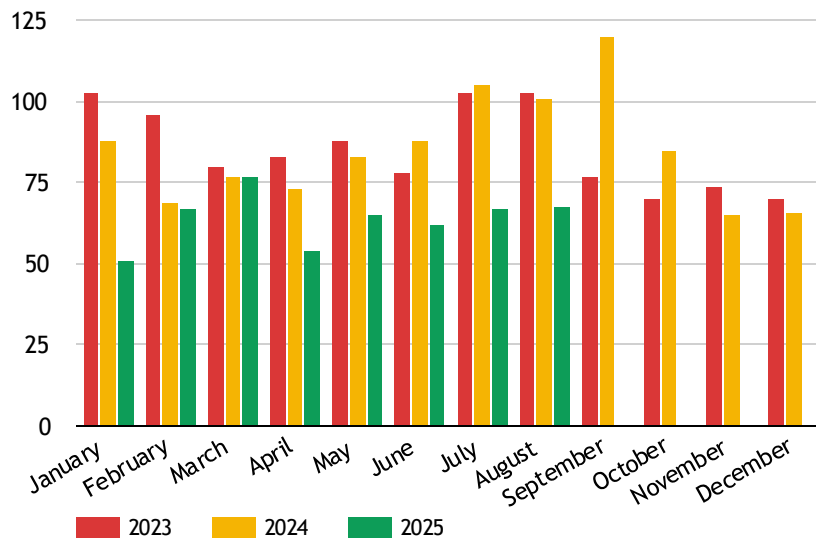
Maritime Incidents (MI)



Number of Vessels, by Type of Incident



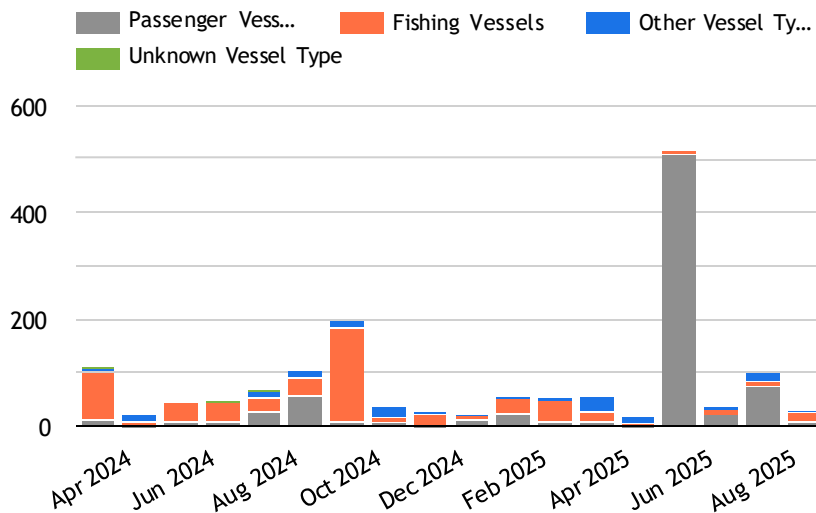

OBSERVATIONS

Statistics:

• Total of 68 MI incidents in Aug 2025, which is lower as compared to the same period in 2024 (101), and 2023 (103).

• The largest number of reported incidents was sunk-Capsized (28), followed by Adrift(14), Collision-Grounding (12), and Fire-Explosion (6).

• In terms of location, the highest number of reported incidents occurred in the waters of Vietnam (13), Philippines (12), ROK (9), Indonesia (6), and India (5) .

• Total of 30 individuals was reported dead or missing this month, which is less than the last month (103). Overall, 44 SAR operations were conducted, resulting in the rescue of 493 individuals during this month.

Comments:

• This month, the impact of Typhoon Kajiki caused severe weather in Vietnam, leading to heavy rains and strong winds. The interaction between Typhoon Kajiki and the strengthened SW Monsoon amplified rainfall and wind across parts of Philippines, leading to floods in low lying areas. Of note, Bad Weather remained the most commonly reported cause of incidents, accounting for 18 of the 68 incidents this month.

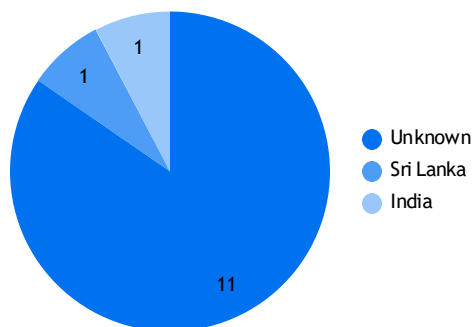
• The high number of vessels detained under the “Number of Vessels by Type of Incident” category was mainly due to a special operation conducted by the Malaysian Maritime Police in the waters around Pulau Perhentian from 15 to 17 Aug, which resulted in 18 passenger ships being detained.



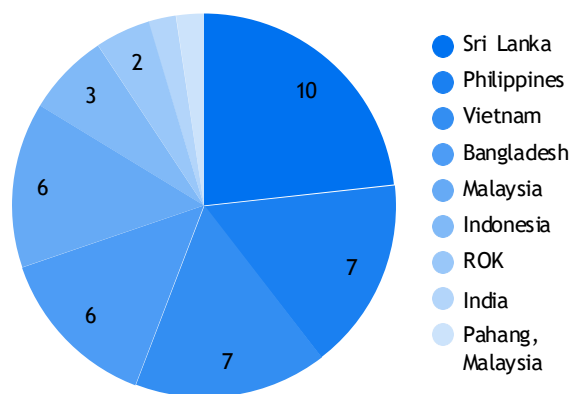
Illegal, Unreported, and Unregulated Fishing (IUUF)



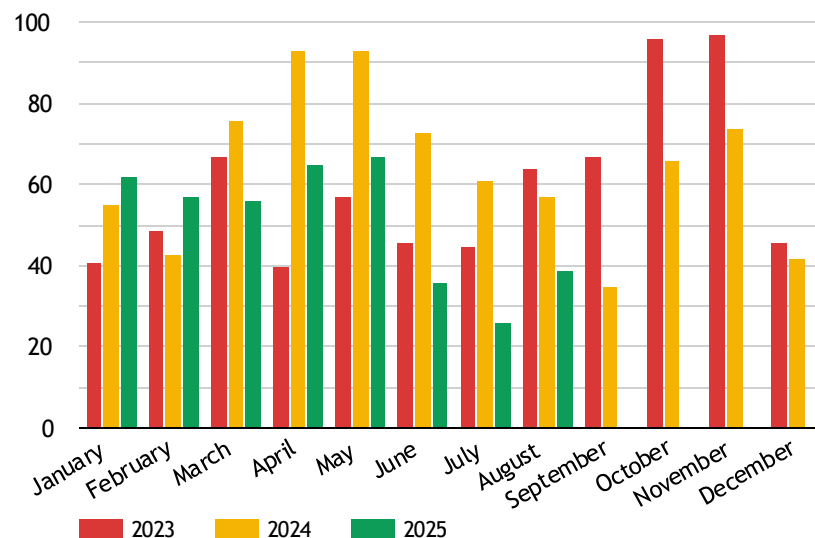
Number and Flag of Vessels, Poaching

OBSERVATIONS

Statistics :

• **Total** of 39 IUUF incidents in Aug 2025. This represented a significant decrease as compared to the same period in 2024 (57), and 2023 (64). However, this month recorded 13 incidents more than in Jul 2025, reflecting an overall upward trend in incident numbers.

• **Local**: 26 Local incidents were recorded in Aug 2025, which is lower as compared to the same period in 2024 (28), and 2023 (27). However, this month recorded 12 more incidents than in Jul 2025.

• Majority of Local incidents were reported in the Philippines (7 incidents; 26.9%), followed by Malaysia (6 incidents; 23.1%). Indonesia and Vietnam recorded 3 incidents each (11.5%). Bangladesh, Sri Lanka and ROK reported 2 incidents each (7.7%). 1 incident was reported in India (3.8%).

• **Poaching**: 13 Poaching incidents were recorded in Aug 2025, which is lower as compared to the same period in 2024 (29), and 2023 (37). However, this month recorded 1 more incident than in Jul 2025.

• The largest proportion of Poaching incidents involved fishing vessels with "Unknown" nationalities (11 incidents; 84.6%), followed by Sri Lanka and India with 1 incident each (2 in total; 15.4%).

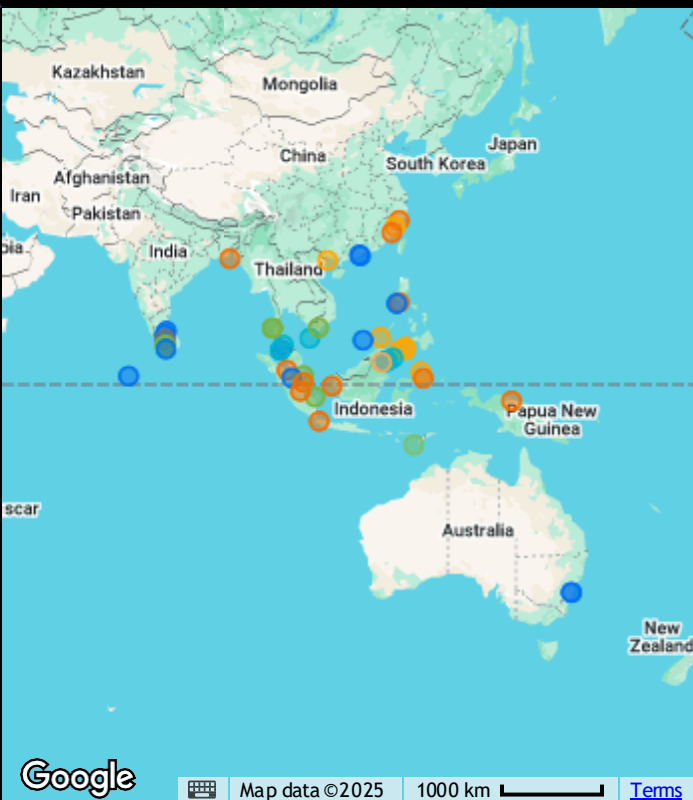

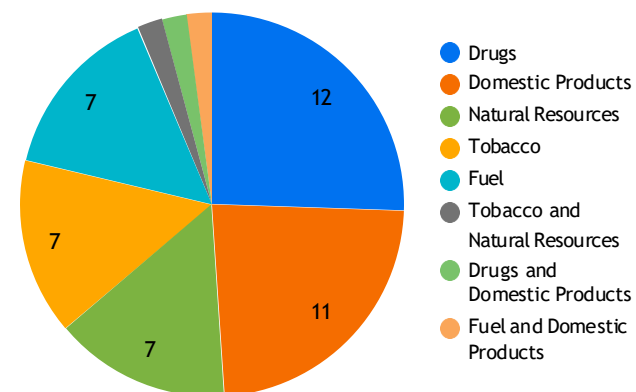
• While it is likely that the regional enforcement efforts have effectively curbed illegal fishing, it is possible that illegal fishing methods to evade detection has evolved. IFC will continue to monitor the changes in data, taking various variables into consideration.



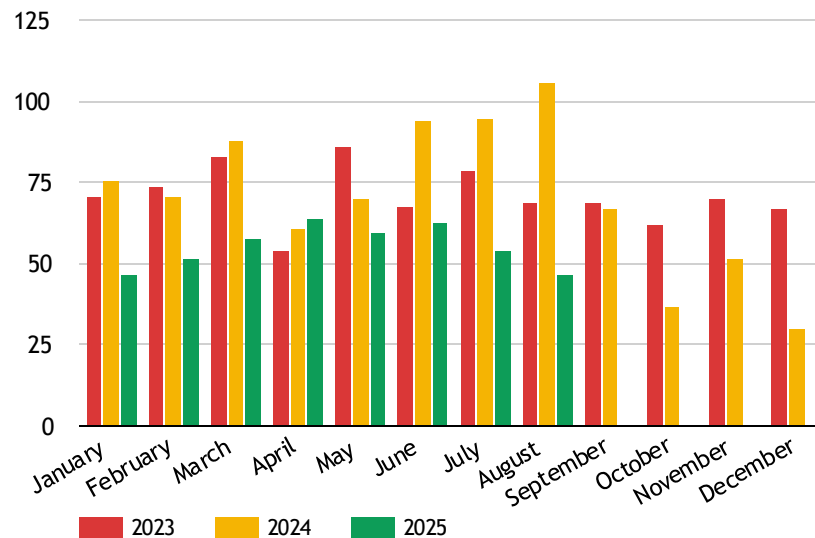
Contraband Smuggling (CS)



Types of Smuggled Goods



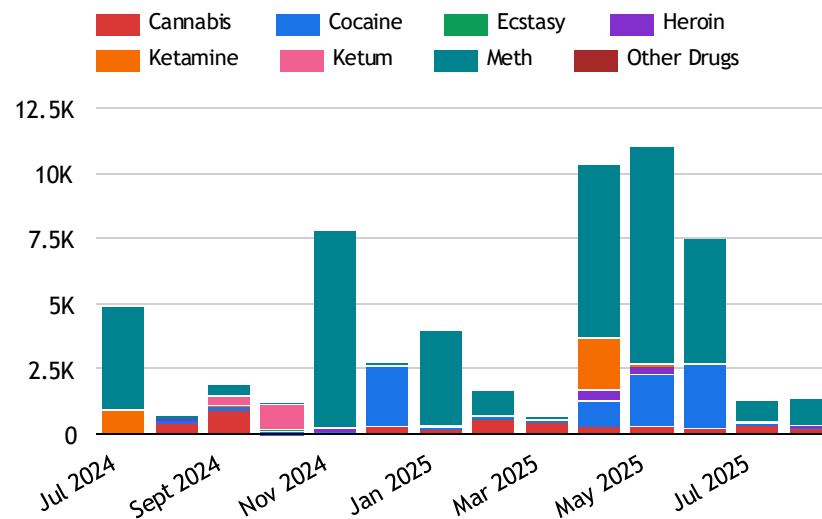

OBSERVATIONS

Statistics:

Total of 47 CS incidents in Aug 2025. This represented a significant decrease as compared to the same period in 2024 (106), and 2023 (69).

Drugs (x12, 1,405.28kg): Sri Lanka (x2, Cannabis 332kg, Heroin 1.175kg), Australia (Meth 900kg, Ketamine 45kg), Hong Kong (x2 Heroin 7.6kg, Meth 3.9kg), South China Sea (Meth 42kg), Malaysia (Cannabis 30kg), Indonesia (Meth 10kg), Maldives (Cannabis 82g), Philippines (Meth 118kg).

Fuel (x7 17,975.68 litres): Malaysia (x2 Petrol 14 gallons, 450 Litres), Vietnam (x2, Diesel 210,000 Litres), Thailand (Diesel 28,000 Litres), Sabah (x2 Petrol 1,100 Litres, Petrol 26 Jerry Cans), Philippines (Gasoline 9,725 Litres).

Domestic Products (x11 965,310kg): Indonesia (x6), China (x2), Malaysia (x1), Philippines (x1), Bangladesh (x1).

Natural Resources (x7, 667,200kg): Sri Lanka (x2), Thailand (x2), Malaysia (x1), Vietnam (x1), Indonesia (x1).

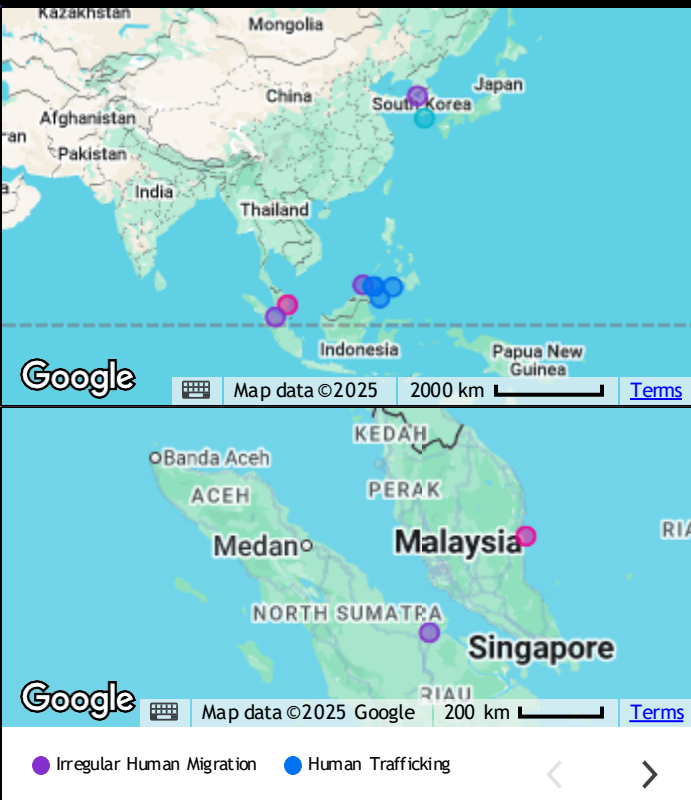

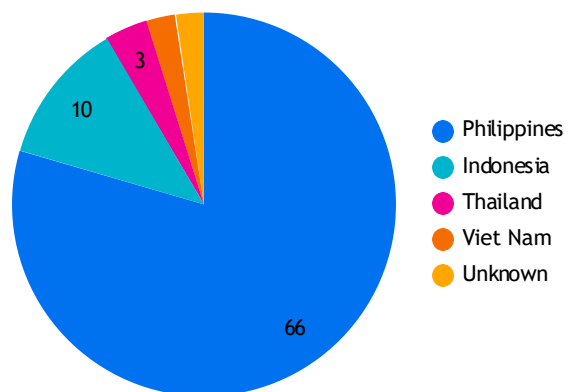
- IFC reported a similar number of CS incidents in Aug 2025 as compared to Jul 2025.
- Drug-related incidents were similar, but involved several larger shipments seized; notably in Australia (900kg Meth), and Sri Lanka (332kg Cannabis). This is reflective of the variability of drug smuggling within the region, which can range from localised small-scale operations to multi-national organised crime syndicates.
- Fuel seizures declined in volume. The figures in Jul 2025 were dominated by large-scale diesel smuggling, whereas Aug 2025 reflected a shift toward small-scale smuggling. This is likely a reflection of the dynamic scope of fuel smuggling within the region.
- Domestic Products remained consistent; Indonesia remained dominant, and incident occurred in China and Bangladesh. Natural Resources was elevated with 40% increase in incidents.



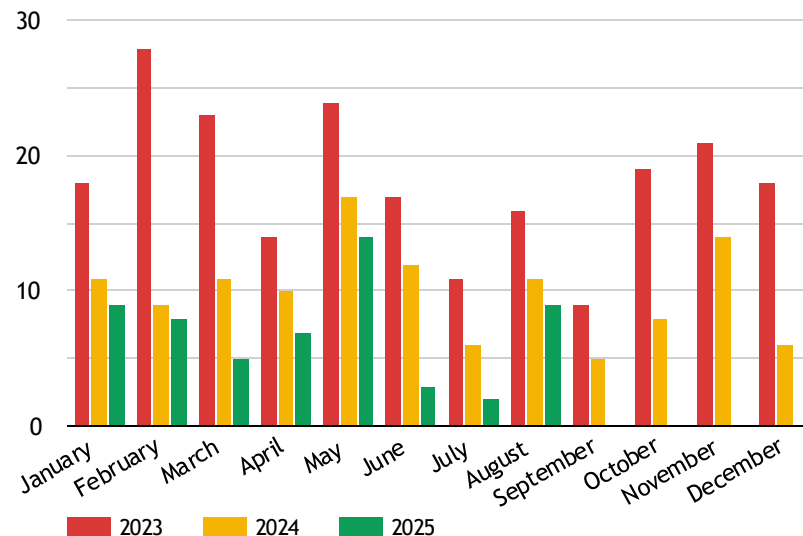
Irregular Human Migration (IHM)



Number and Nationality/Ethnicity of Migrants



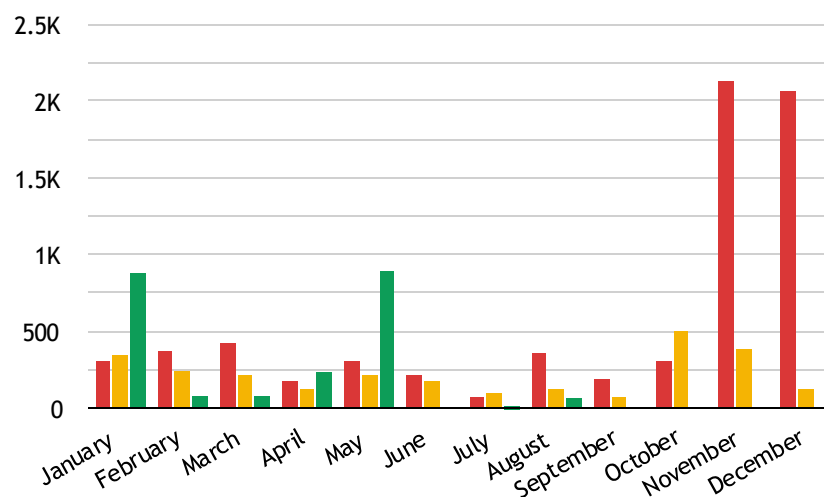

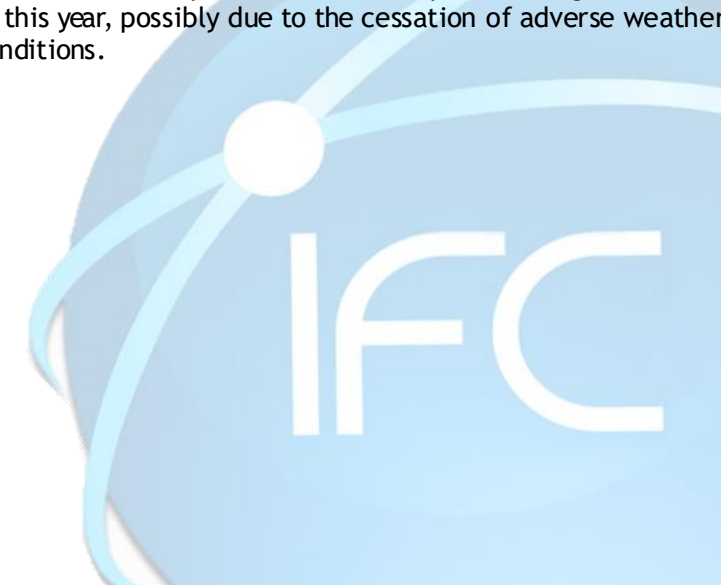
OBSERVATIONS

Statistics:

- Total of 9 IHM incidents in Aug 2025 - 5 were Human Trafficking, 2 were routine Irregular Human Migration, 1 was Illegal Documentation, and 1 was Human Exploitation.

Comments:

- All 5 Human Trafficking incidents were reported in vicinity of the Philippines, where all IHM incidents are routinely classified and prosecuted as human trafficking.
- The Human Exploitation incident occurred off ROK, where several Indonesian seafarers were being poorly treated onboard a South Korean merchant vessel. The ROK Navy assisted the seafarers on behalf of the Indonesian Embassy, enabling their return home.
- There was a notable increase in incidents this month compared to the previous two months. While this aligns with historical trends, the rise was sharper than usual. The increase was primarily driven by incidents in the Philippines, where IHM activity had been relatively low during the middle of this year, possibly due to the cessation of adverse weather conditions.

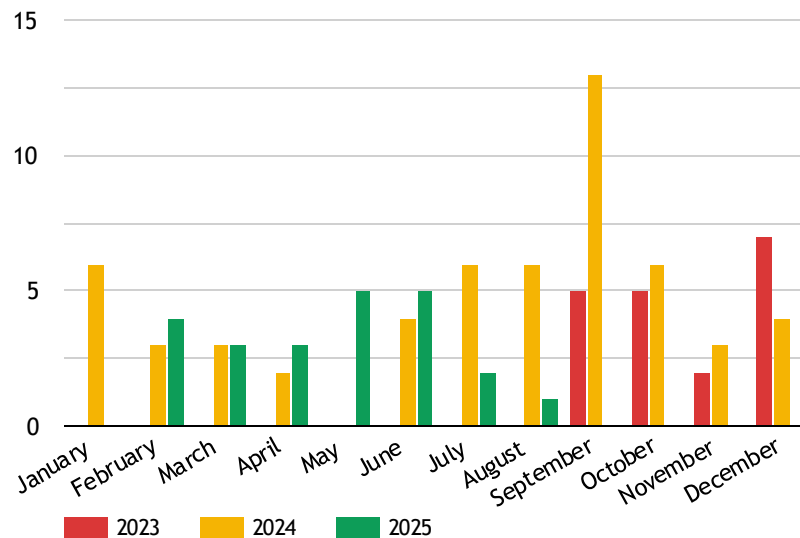




Environmental Security (ENVSEC)



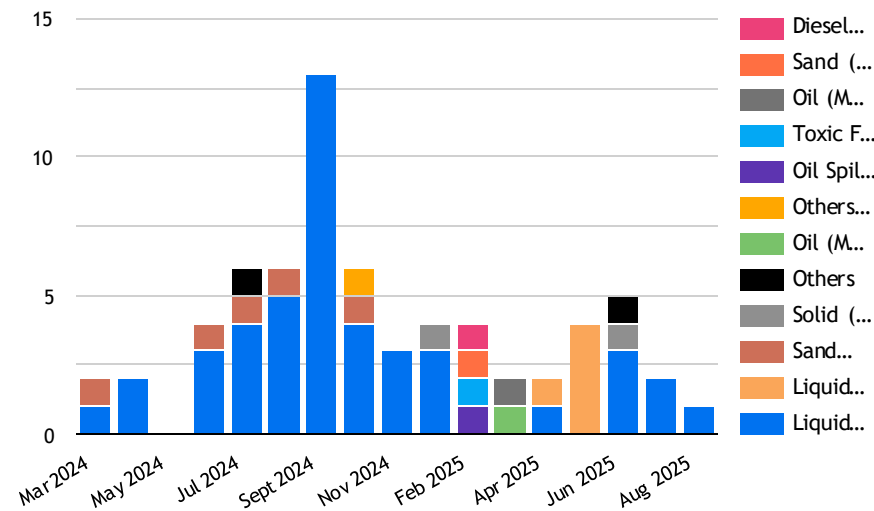

Vessels/Organisations Involved



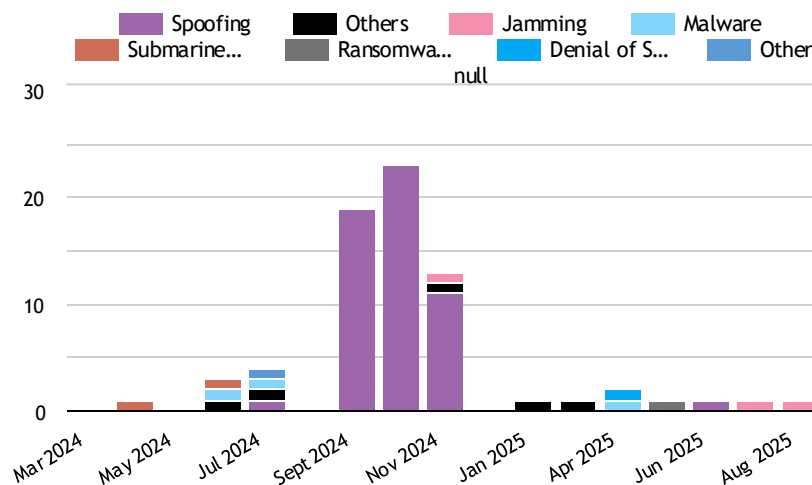

Comments:

- 1 CYBSEC incident in Aug 2025.

- This incident covered multiple reports of GNSS degradation and spoofing in vicinity of the Russian port of Nakhodka. The degradation led to significant issues with AIS in the region, which affected almost one hundred ships attempting to use the port during a week in early Aug 2025. It is possible that this activity was engineered to allow criminal dark shipping activity to occur under the cover of the wider AIS disruption.



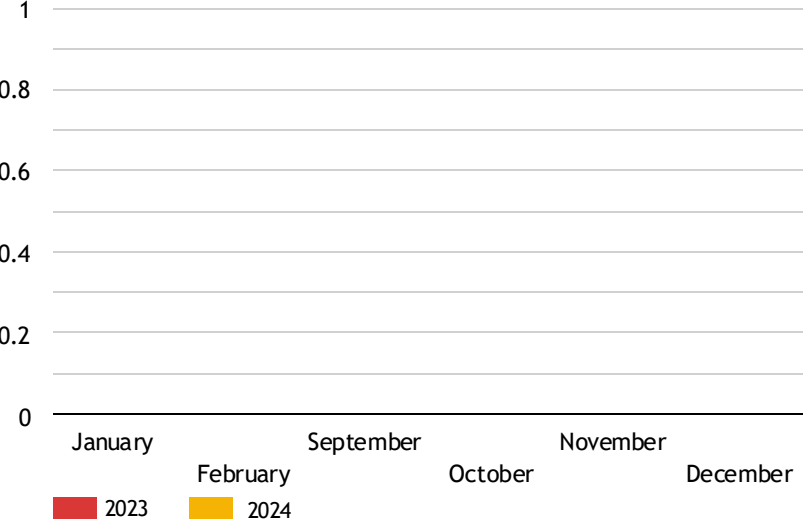

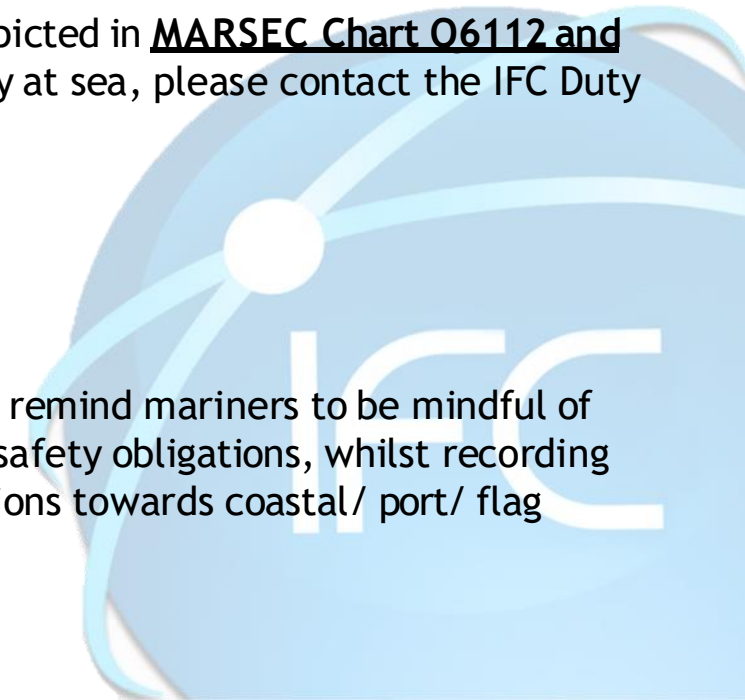


IFC Recommendations



1. All mariners to report any maritime security incidents timely to the nearest coastal state and inform the IFC at the earliest possible time.
2. All mariners are strongly recommended to be vigilant, in particularly when operating in IFC identified hotspots (**Westbound lane of Traffic Separation Scheme in Singapore Strait, Eastbound lane of Traffic Separation Scheme in Singapore Strait, Belawan and Dumai Anchorages in Indonesia, Manila Anchorage in the Philippines, and Chittagong Outer Anchorage in Bangladesh**).
3. All mariners are advised to adopt **Ship Protection Measures** recommended in the **Regional Guide to Counter Piracy and Armed Robbery Against Ships in Asia** (e.g., illuminating the accommodation block and poop deck, deploying sentries and increase frequency of security rounds).
4. All mariners to take note on the description of the perpetrators and to take photos of the perpetrators if possible. Where available, CCTV footage capturing the incident should be provided to **the coastal state authorities** for follow-on investigation.
5. All mariners are advised to participate in **IFC Voluntary Community Reporting (VCR)** as depicted in **MARSEC Chart O6112 and O6113**. In case of any doubt, incident at sea, suspicious approach or unusual observed activity at sea, please contact the IFC Duty Officer:
