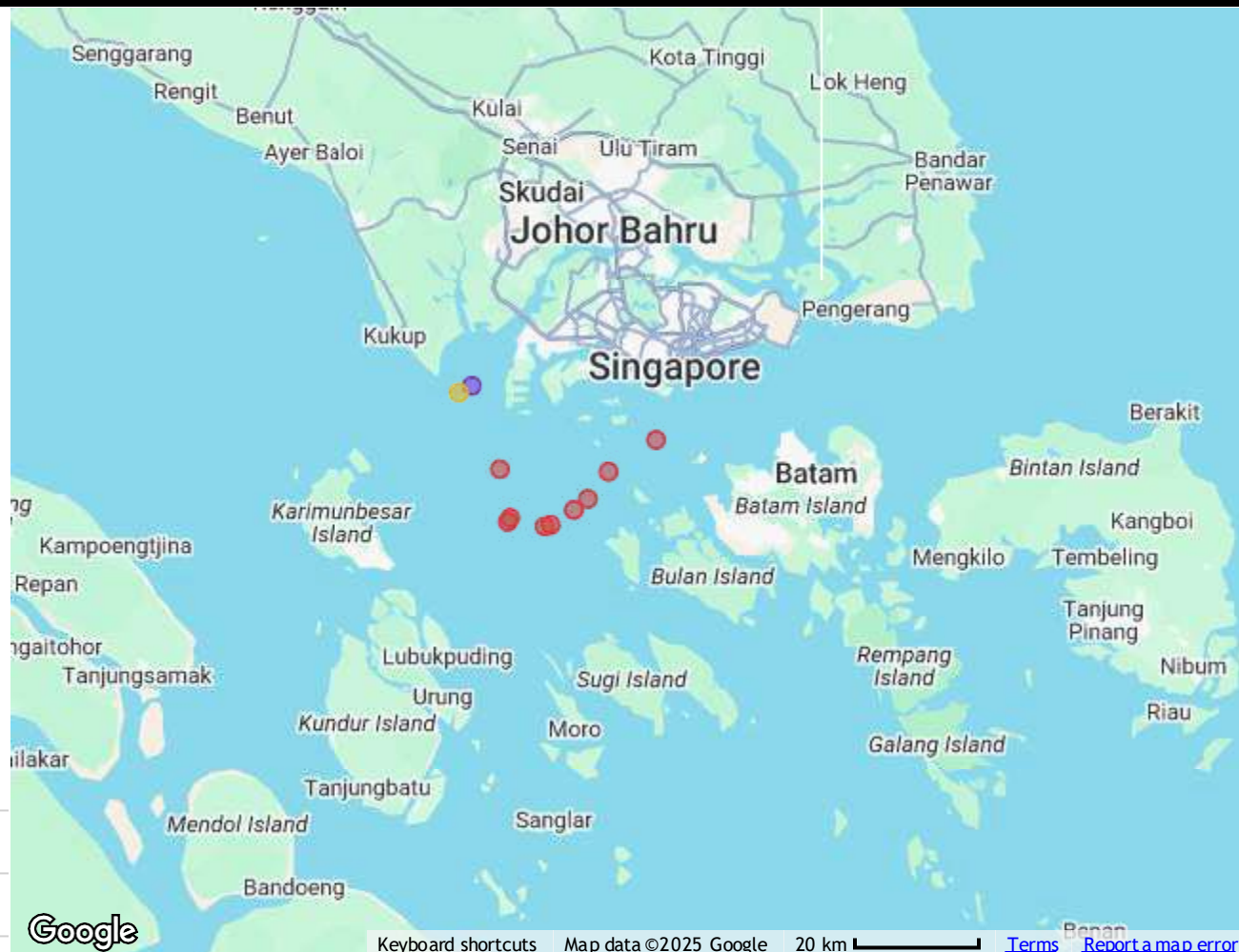


# Overview of MARSEC Incidents in the Singapore Strait

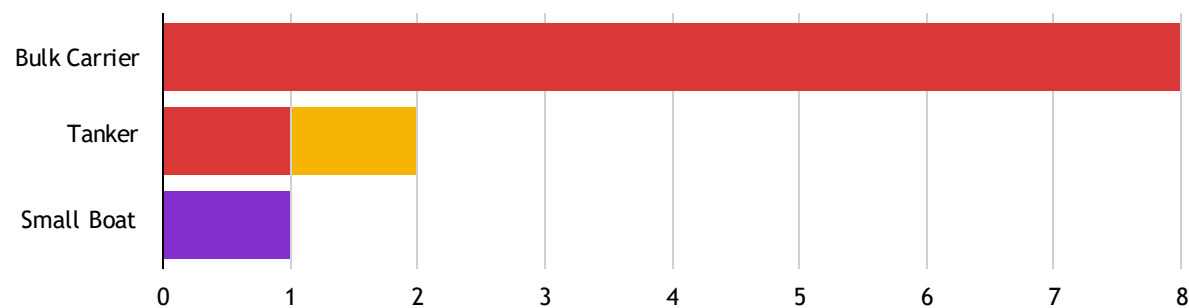

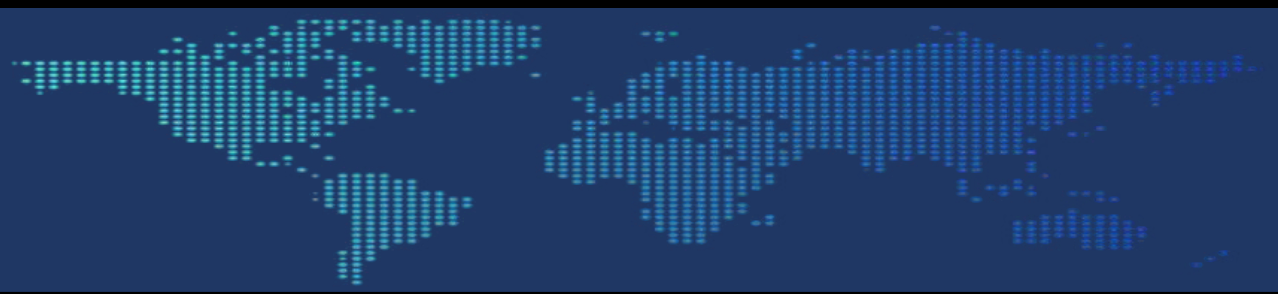

# Executive Summary



**Theft, Robbery and Piracy at Sea:** 12 TRAPS incidents (12 Boardings) were reported this month. This is lower than previous years Jan 2024 (15 incidents) and higher than Jan 2023 (9 incidents).

**Maritime Incidents:** The IFC recorded a total of 31 incidents for this month, the highest number of incidents occurred in the waters of the Indonesia (11), Philippines (10) and Vietnam (6).

**Illegal, Unreported, and Unregulated Fishing:** Total: 53 IUUF incidents were recorded this month. This figure is notably lower compared to January 2024 (55) and January 2024 (37). The drop in incidents could be attributed to efforts from regional countries' agencies to prevent IUUF.

**Contraband Smuggling:** 30 CS incidents were recorded in Jan 2025. Fuel smuggling account for the largest proportion of reported incidents this month.

**Irregular Human Migration:** 6 IHM incidents were reported this month. IHM activity continues to be consistently low compared to previous years.

**Environmental Security:** There were no reports of Environmental Security this month.

**Cyber Security:** 1 Cyber Security incident was recorded this month. A Hong Kong owned vessel was suspected of damaging a subsea telecommunication cable off Keelung port.

## OBSERVATIONS

### Statistics

- 12 TRAPS incidents (12 Boardings) were reported in Jan 2025. This is lower than previous years Jan 2024 (15 incidents) and higher than Jan 2023 (9 incidents).
- 9 incidents occurred in the Singapore Strait (SS), 2 in Indonesia and 1 in Bangladesh.
- These incidents involved 10 bulk carriers and 2 tankers. 9 incidents occurred while ships were underway, and 3 occurred while ships were at anchored.
- Fortunately, there were no injuries reported in any of the incidents.

### Singapore Strait (SS)

- 6 (Sea Theft) incidents occurred in the Phillip Channel and 3 (Sea Theft) in Eastbound Lane of TSS while ships were underway.
- All 9 incidents reportedly involved perpetrators (2 to 6 pax) armed with knives and 'gun-like object' (8, 9, 16, 19, 22 and 28 Jan). The perpetrators stole engine spare parts before fleeing the scene. Upon being noticed by the crew, the alarms were raised and the perpetrators escaped. Items stolen included ship's store item and engine parts (9, 22 and 29 Jan). There were no confrontations or injuries reported.
- The ships were able to continue their voyages to the next port without requiring any assistance.

### Indonesia

- 2 Sea Theft incidents (17 and 23 Jan) occurred at Belawan and Balikpapan Anchorage while ships were anchored.
- An incident on 17 Jan involved 2 unarmed perpetrators, while another on 23 Jan involved 6 perpetrators armed with hammers. However, there were no confrontations with the ship's crew, and the perpetrators fled the scene once alarms were raised.
- 1 incident (17 Jan) reportedly ship's store were stolen, and no injuries were reported in both incidents.

### Bangladesh

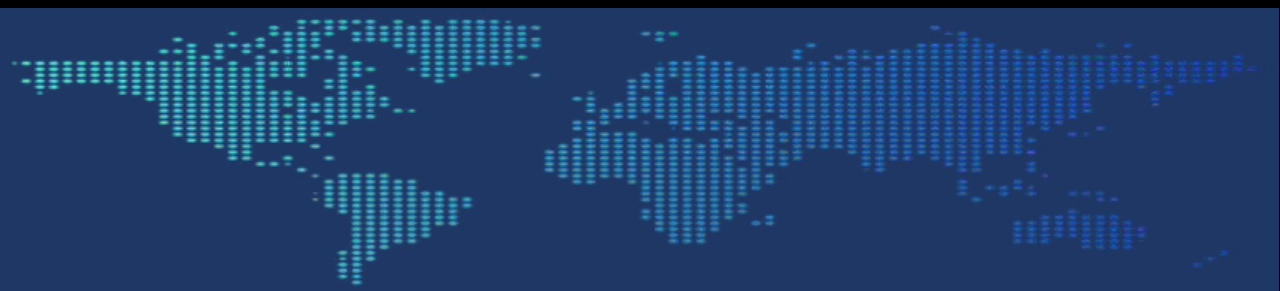
- 1 Sea Robbery incident (12 Jan) occurred at Payra Outer Anchorage while the ship was at anchor. It involved a confrontation with 8 perpetrators armed with knives and steel bars, and 1 crew member was reportedly tied up.
- However, no injuries were reported, ship's properties and stores were reported stolen.

### Comments

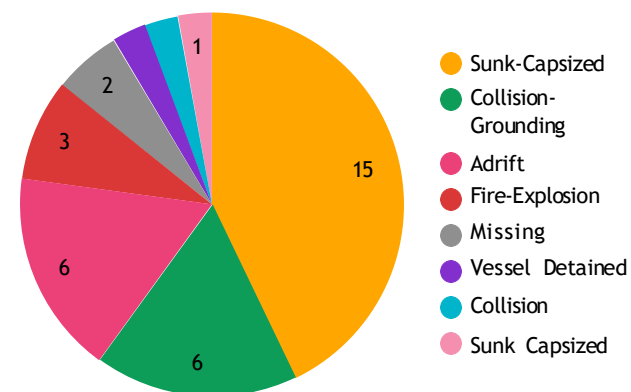
- Perpetrators continue to target slow-speed and low-freeboard vessels such as bulk carriers and tugs.
- Most of the incidents occurred during the period of darkness, between 2200H (UTC +8) to 0600H (UTC +8).
- As such, all companies, sea users, and ship masters are advised to remain vigilant when transiting known hotspots, such as the Phillip Channel, waters off Batam and Bintan islands, and Batam Anchorages.



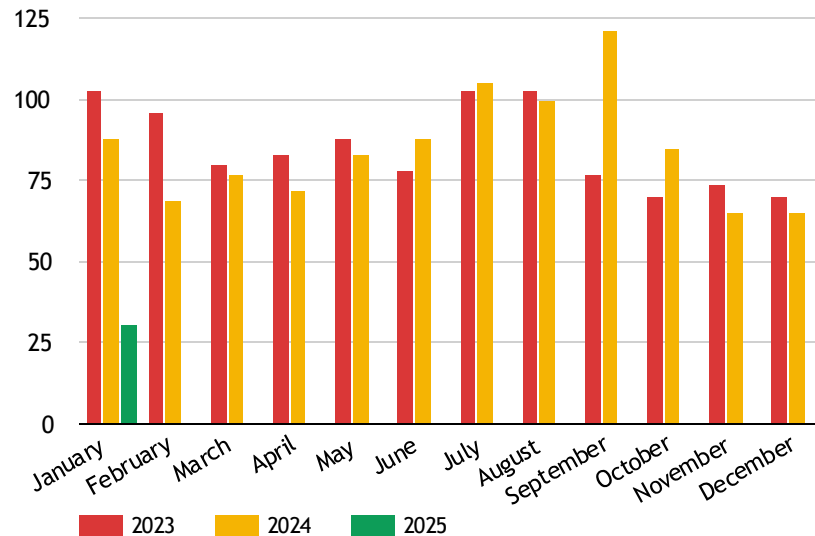
# Maritime Incidents (MI)



## Number of Vessels, by Type of Incident



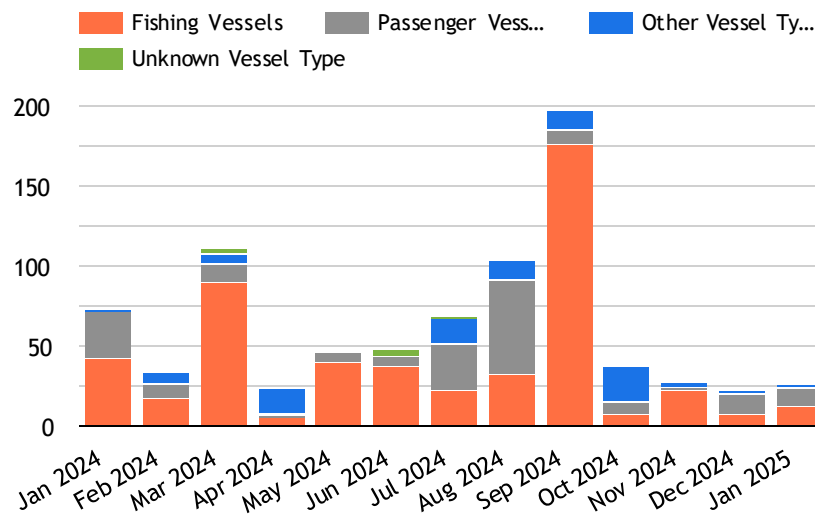

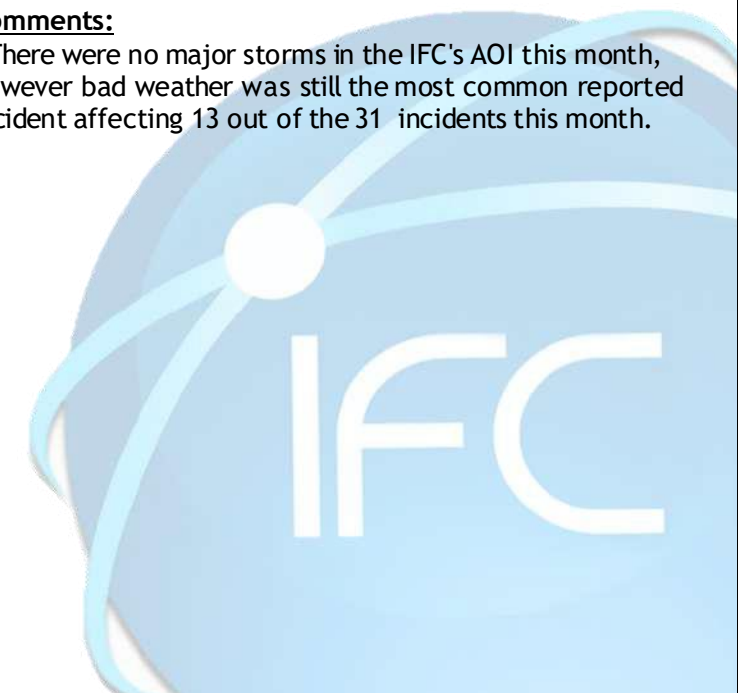
## OBSERVATIONS

### Statistics:

- A total of 31 maritime incidents were reported this month, which is lower than the number recorded in the same period in 2024 (88) but higher than the figure for 2023 (103).
- The largest number of reported incidents was sunk-capsized (18), followed both by adrift (6) and collision-grounding (5) and fire-explosion (4).
- In terms of location, the highest number of reported incidents occurred in the waters of the Indonesia (11), Philippines (10) and Vietnam (6).
- A total of 19 individuals were reported dead or missing for the month which is lower than both the previous month (22) and the same period in 2024 (73). Overall, 34 SAR operations were conducted which led to the rescue of 578 individuals.

### Comments:

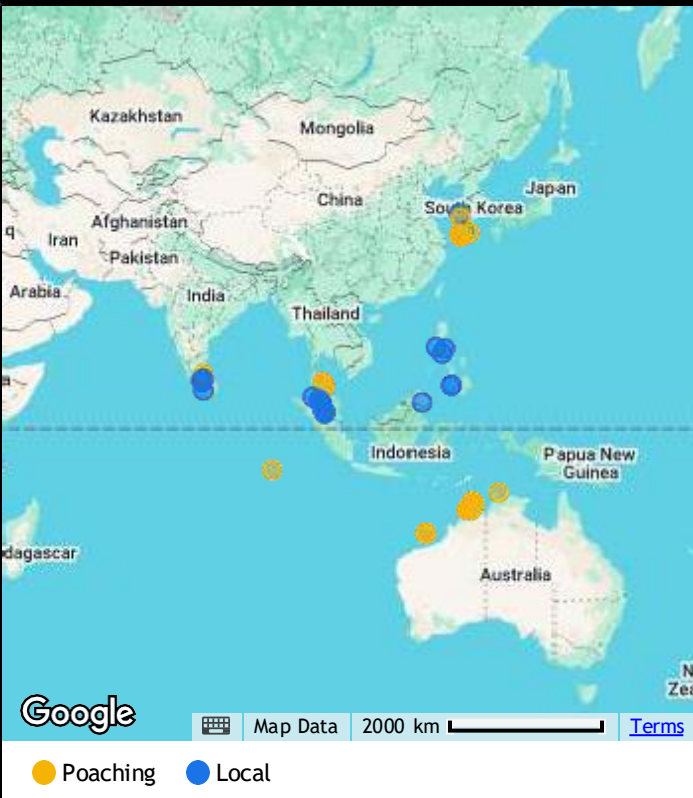
- There were no major storms in the IFC's AOI this month, however bad weather was still the most common reported incident affecting 13 out of the 31 incidents this month.



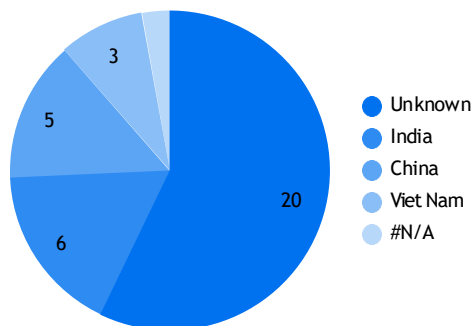




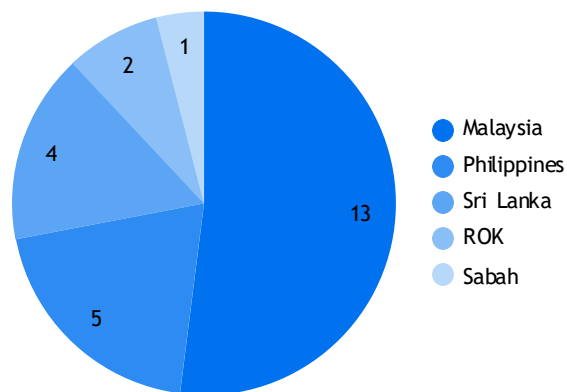

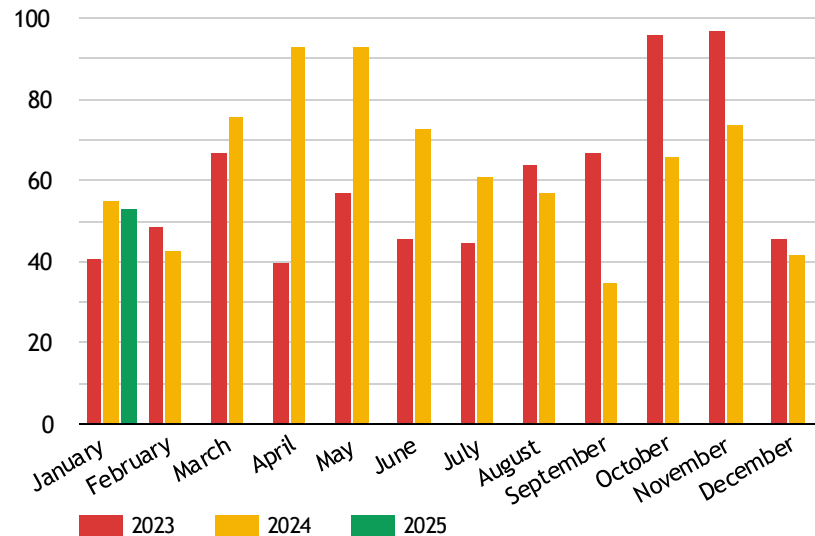
Number and Flag of Vessels, Poaching

## OBSERVATIONS

### Statistics:

• **Total:** 53 IUUF incidents were recorded in IFC's AOI in January 2025. This figure is notably lower compared to January 2024 (55) by 8 January 2023 (43) by 10, but higher than December 2024 (37) by 16.

• **Local :** 22 local incidents were recorded in January 2025. This figure is lower than the number of January 2024 (37) by 15, but higher than December 2024 (15) by 7.

• **Majority of FVs involved in local incidents occurred in Malaysia with 13 FVs (56.5%), followed by Sri Lanka 4 FVs, (17.4%) Philippines with 3 FVs (13%) and ROK by 2 FVs. (8.7%)**

• **Poaching :** 25 poaching incidents were recorded in January 2025. This figure is notably higher than in January 2024 (18) by 7 also than December 2024 (22) by 3.

• **The largest proportion of poaching incidents is unspecified country, 14 FVs (48.3%), followed by India, 6 FVs (20.7%), and China, 5 FVs (17.2%).**

• **International :** No international incident was recorded in January 2025.

### Comments :

• The number of incidents this month is relatively lower compared to January 2024 but higher than December 2024. This could be attributed to the efforts of countries' agencies to prevent IUUF including MMEA, BAKAMLA, TNI AL and Thai-MECC. But an ongoing fishing season in China, which can affect the number of IUUF, notwithstanding the bad weather during this month.

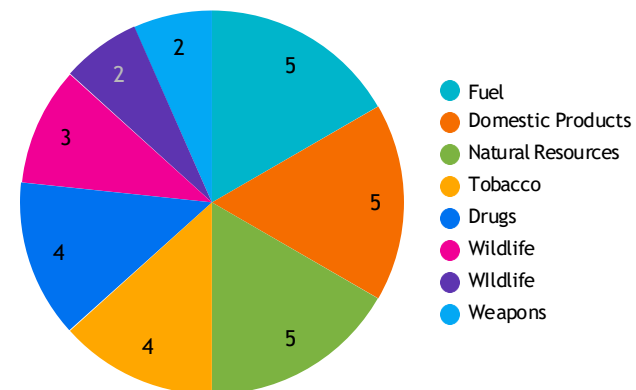




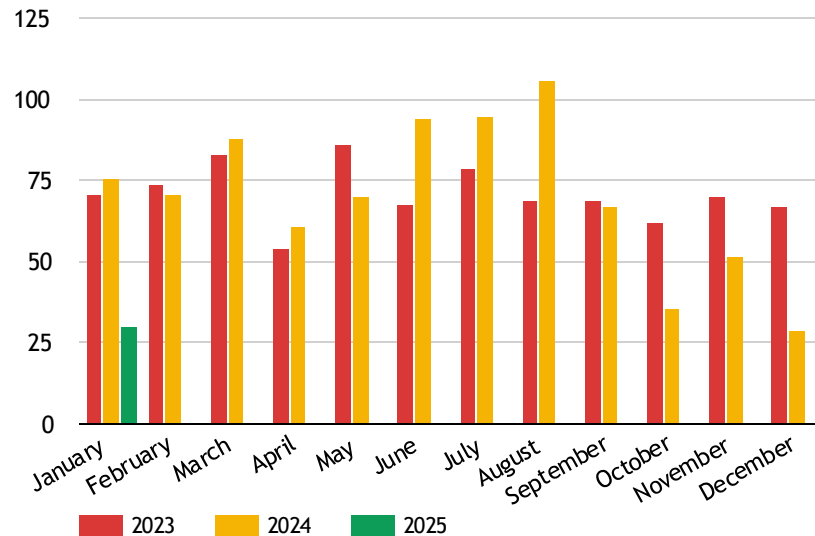

## Types of Smuggled Goods



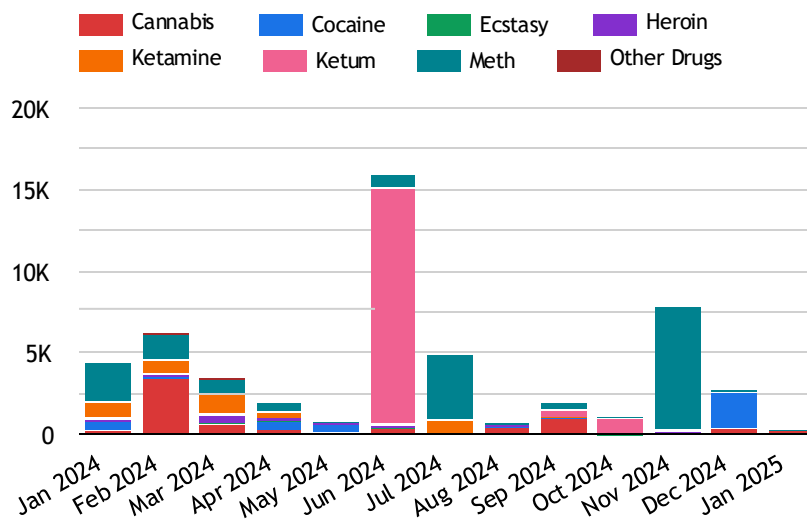

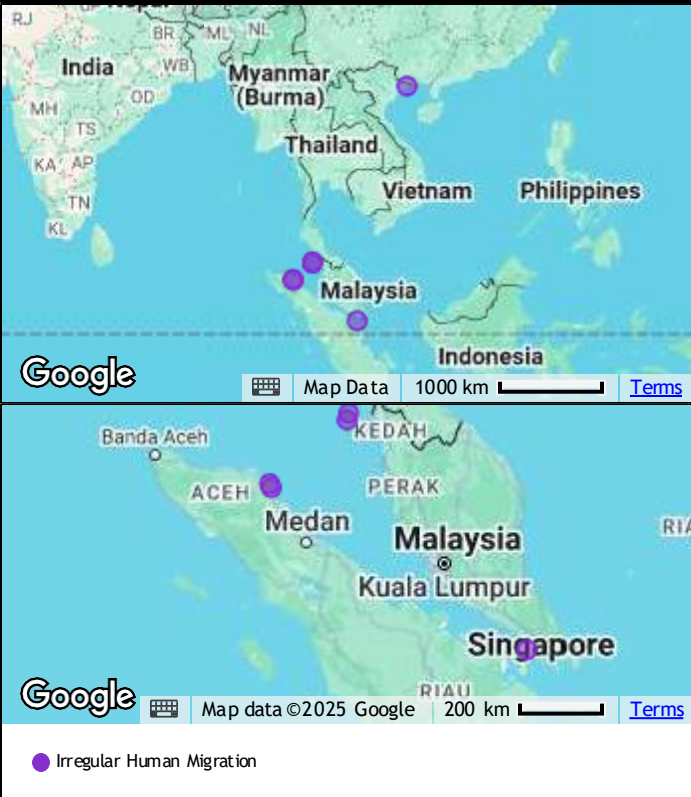
### Comments:

- In January 2025, IFC reported contraband smuggling incidents similar to last month, but it was two times lower compared to the same period in the previous year.

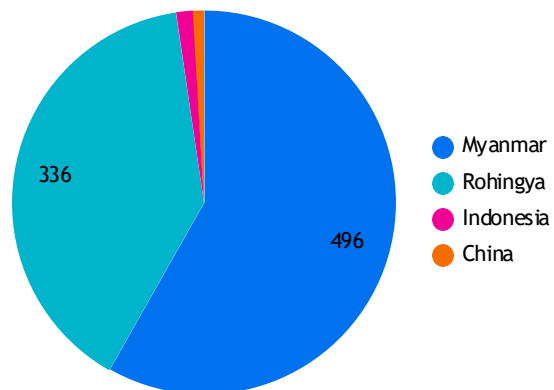
- Fuel was the largest proportion of reported incidents, following by domestic incidents and wildlife with the similar numbers of incidents. Whereas, drugs smuggling dropped about 50 % compared to previous month.



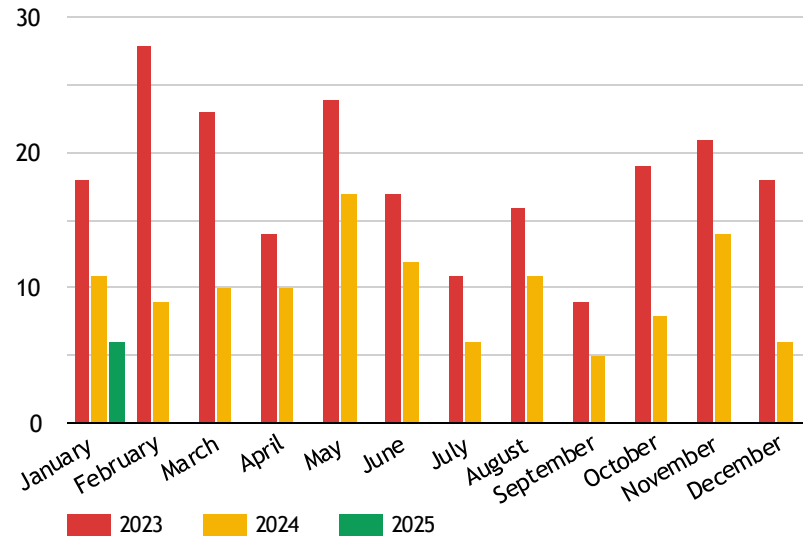
# Irregular Human Migration (IHM)



Number and Nationality/Ethnicity of Migrants



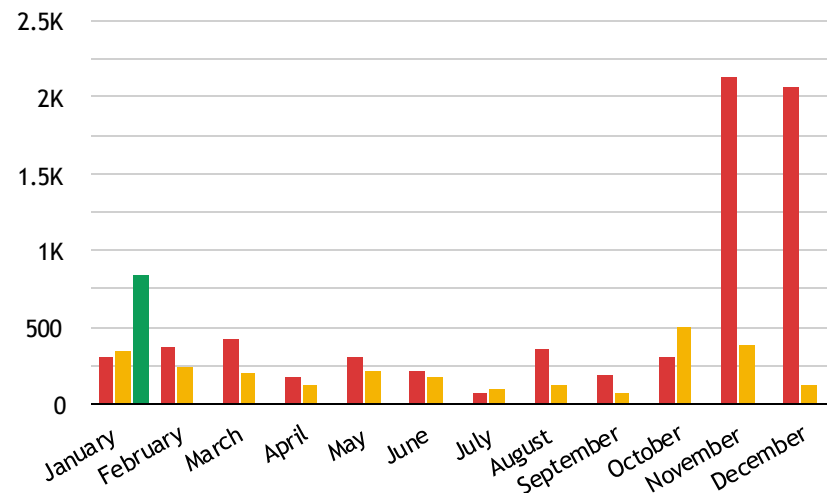

## OBSERVATIONS

### Statistics:

- **6 incidents were recorded this month** - 3 Irregular Human Migration (IHM) incidents and 3 cases involving migrants from Myanmar.

### Comments:

- This month's incidents include several small boat landings and interceptions. One significant case involved 76 Rohingya migrants landing in Aceh, Indonesia. Another involved 260 Rohingya migrants landing in Indonesia's East Aceh region. A small boat with 12 Indonesian migrants was also intercepted attempting to leave Malaysia.

- IHM activity remains a concern, particularly with Rohingya refugees attempting to travel via small boats. The pattern is consistent with the ongoing challenge of managing human migration across this region, particularly to and from Indonesia, Malaysia, and Thailand. It's possible that more such incidents may arise as the season changes.

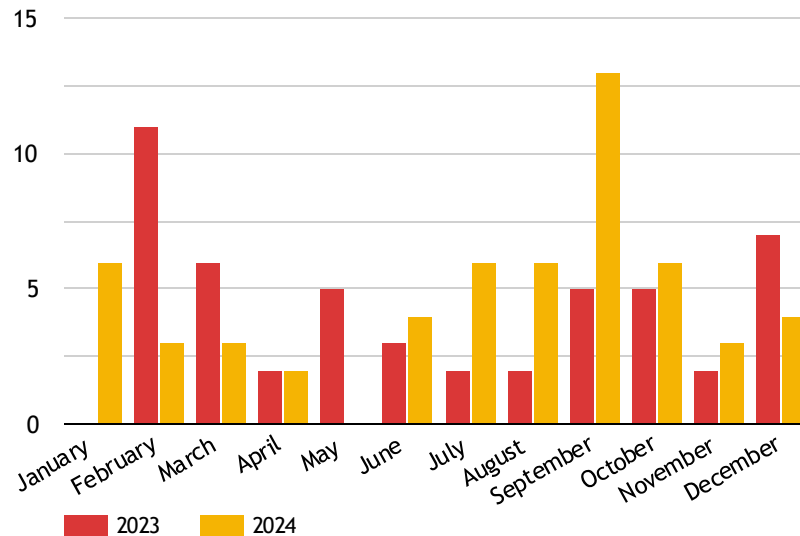

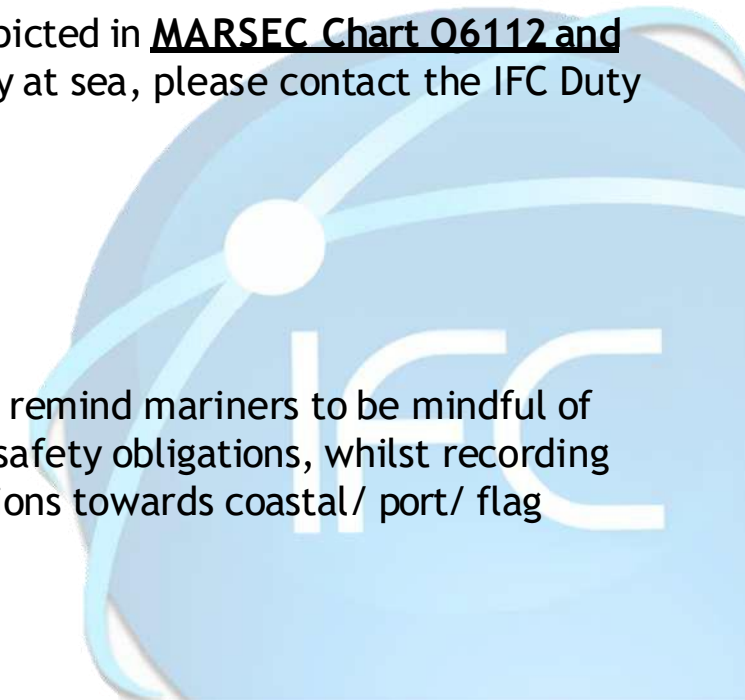


# IFC Recommendations



1. All mariners to report any maritime security incidents timely to the nearest coastal state and inform the IFC at the earliest possible time.
2. All mariners are strongly recommended to be vigilant, in particularly when operating in IFC identified hotspots (**Westbound lane of Traffic Separation Scheme in Singapore Strait, Eastbound lane of Traffic Separation Scheme in Singapore Strait, Belawan and Dumai Anchorages in Indonesia, Manila Anchorage in the Philippines, and Chittagong Outer Anchorage in Bangladesh**).
3. All mariners are advised to adopt **Ship Protection Measures** recommended in the **Regional Guide to Counter Piracy and Armed Robbery Against Ships in Asia** (e.g., illuminating the accommodation block and poop deck, deploying sentries and increase frequency of security rounds).
4. All mariners to take note on the description of the perpetrators and to take photos of the perpetrators if possible. Where available, CCTV footage capturing the incident should be provided to **the coastal state authorities** for follow-on investigation.
5. All mariners are advised to participate in **IFC Voluntary Community Reporting (VCR)** as depicted in **MARSEC Chart O6112 and O6113**. In case of any doubt, incident at sea, suspicious approach or unusual observed activity at sea, please contact the IFC Duty Officer:
