Number of Incidents



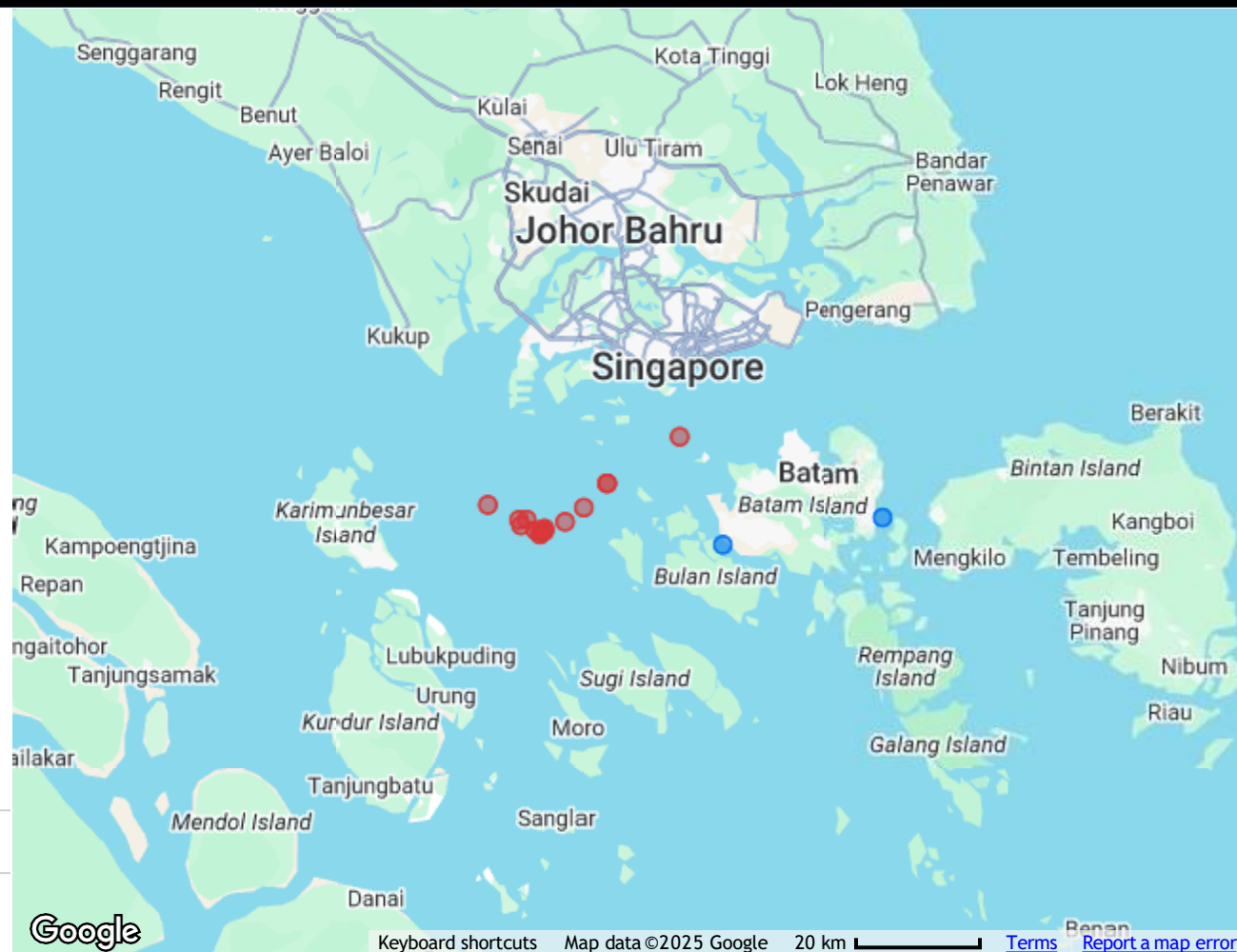

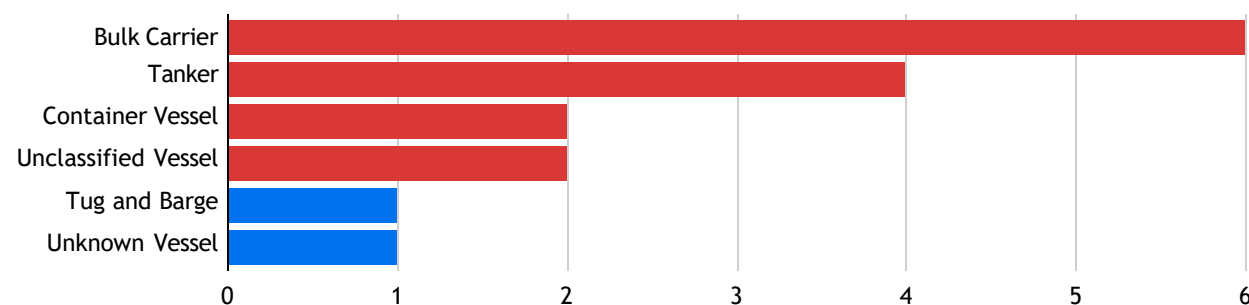

Executive Summary



Theft, Robbery and Piracy at Sea: 16 TRAPS incidents were reported in July 2025 throughout the AOI. This number recorded higher than previous years July 2024 (8) and July 2023 (14). 14 incidents occurred in the Singapore Strait (SS), 1 in Chattogram Anchorage, Bangladesh and 1 in Belawan Anchorage, Indonesia.

Maritime Incidents: 66 MI incidents were recorded in July 2025 throughout the AOI. Bad weather was still the most common reported incident cause (28 of 66 incidents).

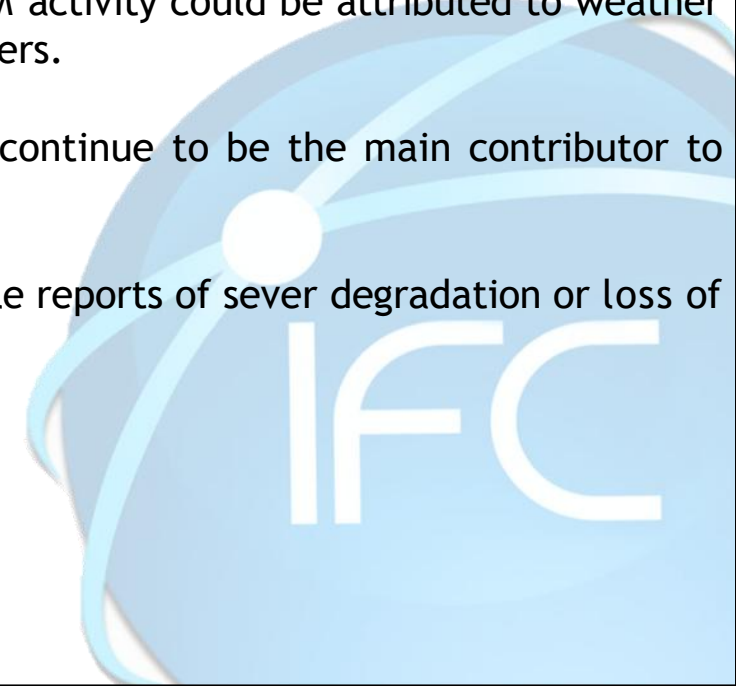
Illegal, Unreported, and Unregulated Fishing: 19 IUUF incidents were reported in July 2025. It is likely that the efforts of enforcement agencies have effectively curbed illegal fishing.

Contraband Smuggling: 48 CS incidents were reported in July 2025. Drugs smuggling being the major part of incidents, followed by fuel and tobacco.

Irregular Human Migration: 1 IHM incident was recorded in July 2025. The decrease in IHM activity could be attributed to weather conditions or a changed in law enforcement activity particularly in Indonesian/Malaysian waters.

Environmental Security: 1 ENVSEC incident was recorded in July 2025. While oil spills continue to be the main contributor to MARPOL violations over the years.

Cyber Security: 1 CYBSEC incident was recorded in July 2025. This incident covered multiple reports of sever degradation or loss of GPS signals in vicinity of North/South Korean border.

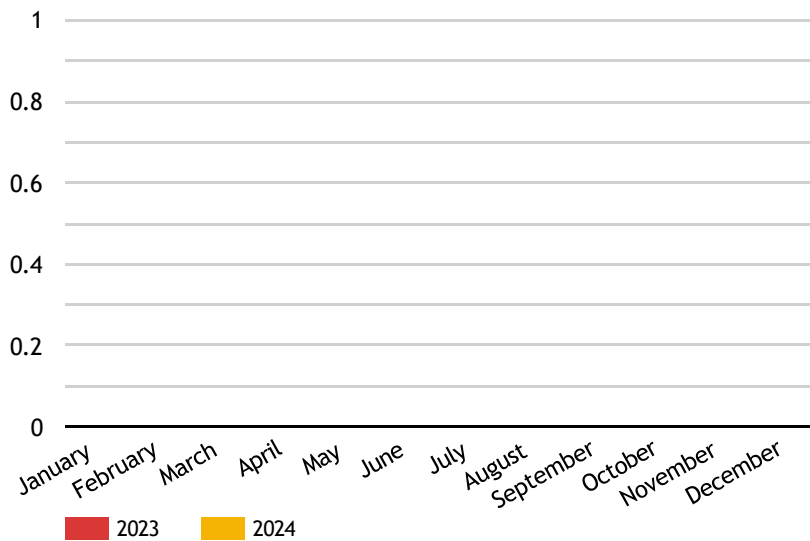

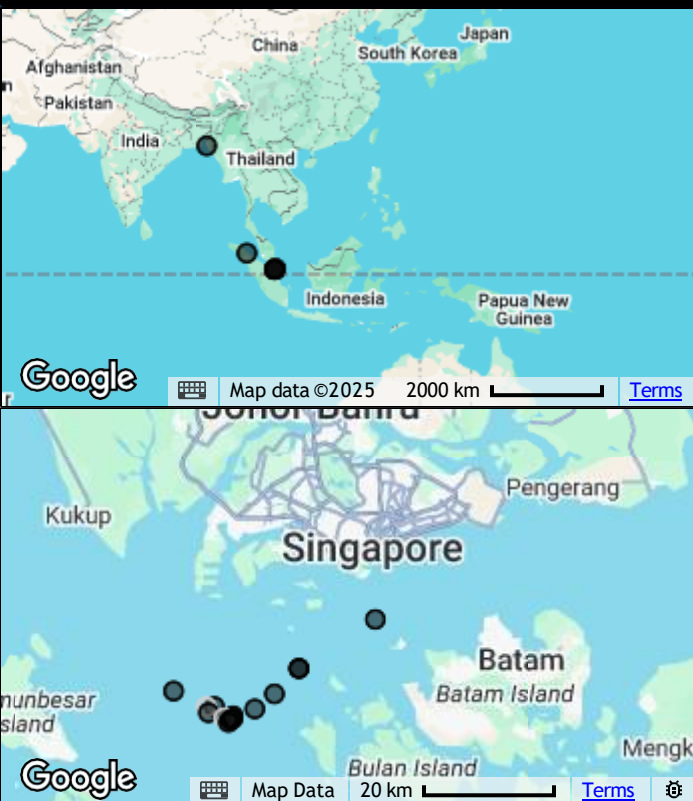

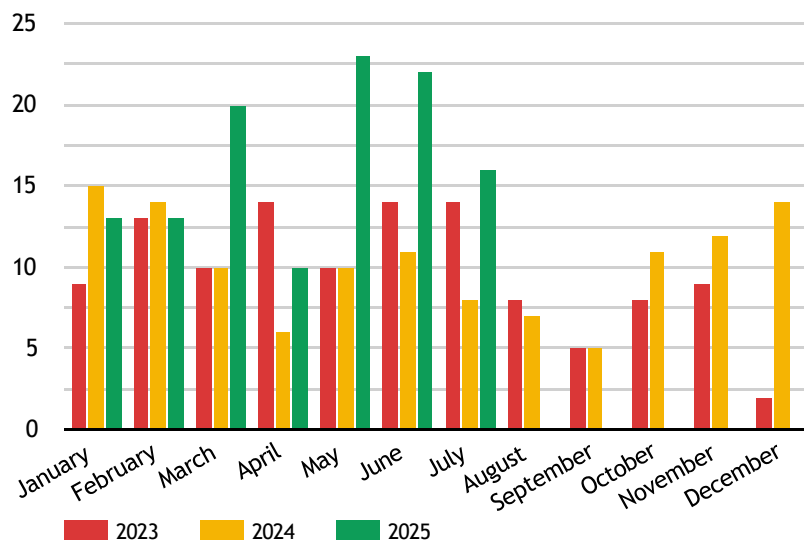




Theft, Robbery and Piracy at Sea (TRAPS)



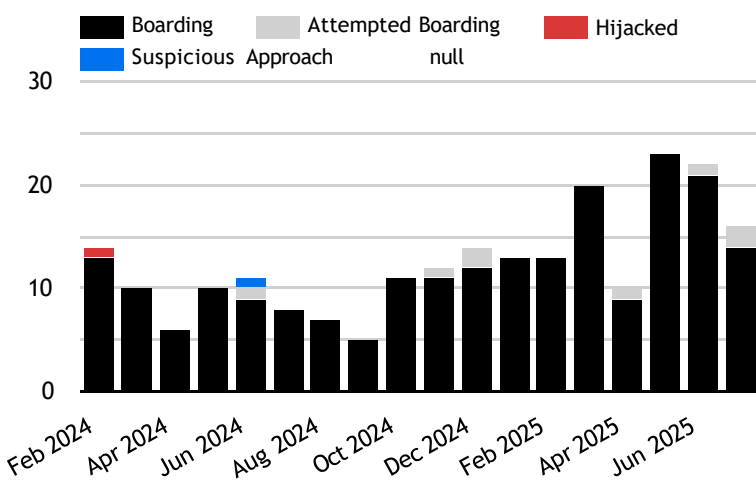

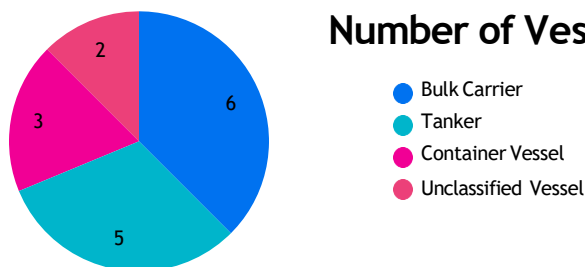

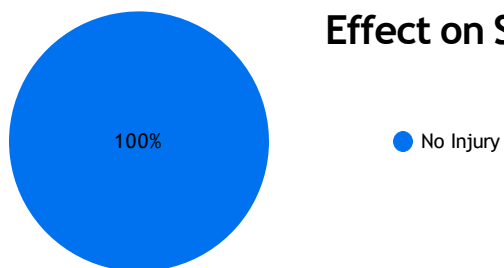
Incident Types

OBSERVATIONS

Statistics

• Total of 16 TRAPS incidents, comprising 14 boardings and 2 attempted boarding, increased compared to July 2024 (8) and July 2023 (14).

• 14 incidents occurred in the Singapore Strait (SS), 1 in Chattogram Anchorage, Bangladesh and 1 in Belawan Anchorage, Indonesia. These incidents involved 6 bulk carriers, 5 tankers, 3 container vessels, including one attempted boarding involving 1 container ship and 1 tanker respectively.

• Of note, all incidents occurred during the Period of Darkness where perpetrators tend to exploit limited visibility and reduced crew responsiveness to board vessels. All incidents occurred while vessels were underway less 2, while at anchor (1 in Bangladesh, 1 in Indonesia).

Singapore Strait (SS)

• A total of 14 incidents occurred in Jul 2025; all of which occurred in the Phillip Channel. Of note, two (2) incidents were attempted boarding involving multiple perpetrators who tried to board the vessel(s) but fled upon being sighted by the ship crew and/or after the ship's alarm was sounded.

• Of the 14 incidents, three (3) incidents involved perpetrators reportedly armed (i.e. with knives, "gun-like" objects); however, no confrontation and crew injury were reported. Of note, five (5) incidents reported engine spares stolen.

• All ships were able to continue their voyages to the next port without requiring any assistance.

Bangladesh

• 1 Sea Theft incident was reported off Chattogram Anchorage involving a tanker. Of note, seven perpetrators boarded the vessel. Perpetrators escaped after the ship's crew raised the alarm, and nothing was stolen. All crew were reported safe.

Indonesia

• 1 Sea Theft incident was reported off Belawan Anchorage involving a container ship. Four perpetrators, armed with knives, illegally boarded the vessel and restrained the ships' crew. Perpetrators flee with ship's properties once the alarm was raised. No injuries were reported.

Comments

• The incident numbers in Jul 2025 was slightly lower than Jun 2025 [16 incidents], likely due to ongoing enforcement efforts by regional authorities, especially in the Singapore Strait.

• IFC anticipates that incident numbers in August 2025 will remain low, provided regional authorities sustain their enforcement efforts in identified high-risk areas. Nevertheless, all vessels are strongly encouraged to maintain a high level of vigilance and implement appropriate ship protection measures to deter potential threats and prevent unauthorised boarding.

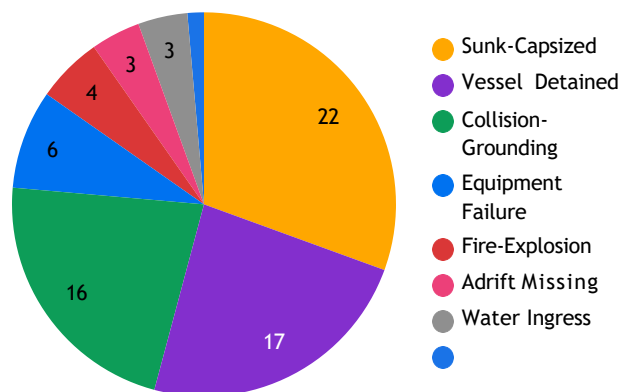
• Perpetrators continue to target vulnerable vessels, particularly bulk carriers, tugs with barges, and container ships with freeboards ranging from 3 to 7 meters. Consistent with past trends, these vessels are likely to remain preferred targets due to their low operating speeds and low freeboard. The modus operandi is expected to remain unchanged, involving mainly acts of petty theft.



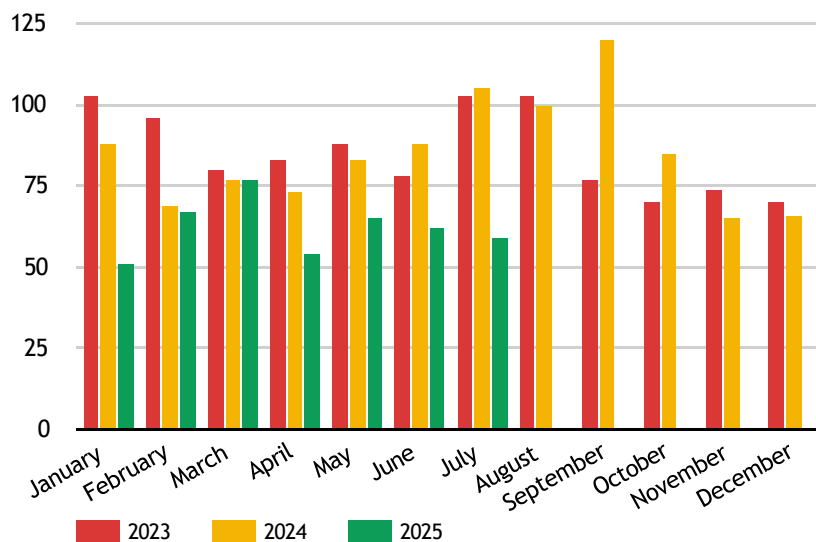
Maritime Incidents (MI)



Number of Vessels, by Type of Incident



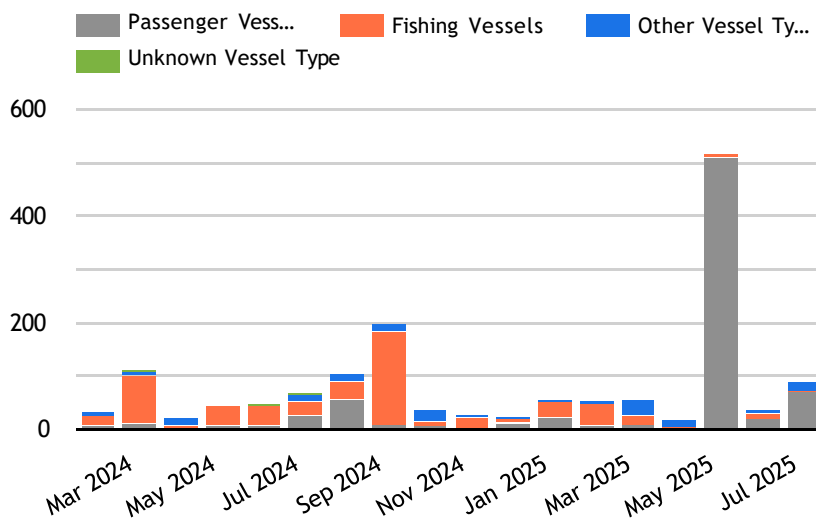

OBSERVATIONS

Statistics:

• A total of 59 maritime incidents were reported this month, which is lower than the figures recorded for the same period in 2024 (105) and 2023 (103) incidents.

• The largest number of reported incidents was sunk-capsized (27), followed by collision-grounding (11), Vessel Detained (10) and Equipment Failure (6).

• In terms of location, the highest number of reported incidents occurred in the waters of Philippines (19), Indonesia (12), Malaysia(11), ROK (6)and Vietnam (5) .

• A total of 47 individuals were reported dead or missing this month, which is larger than the last month (18). Overall, 44 SAR operations were conducted, resulting in the rescue of 1025 individuals during this month.

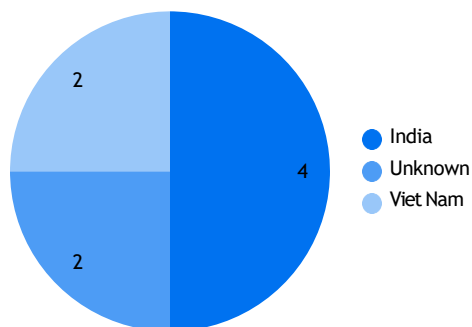
• There were no major storms in the IFC's AOI this month, however bad weather was still the most common reported incident cause accounting for 28 of the 66 incidents this month.



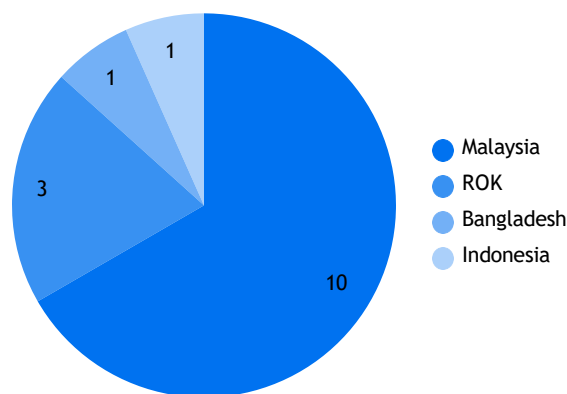
Illegal, Unreported, and Unregulated Fishing (IUUF)



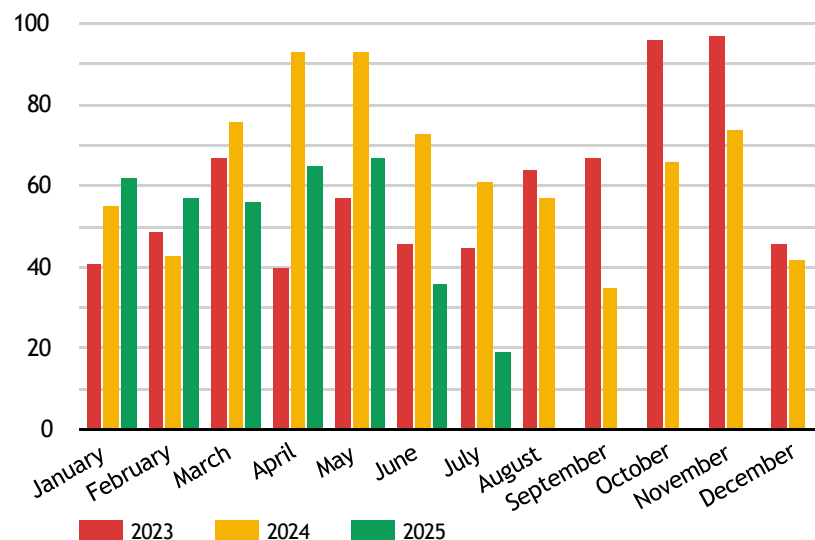
Number and Flag of Vessels, Poaching

OBSERVATIONS

Statistics :

• **Total:** 19 IUUF incidents were recorded in IFC's AOI in July 2025. This figure shows a significant decrease of 42 incidents compared to July 2024 (61), and of 26 incidents compared to July 2023 (45), as observed from the annual data (YoY). When viewed a comparison to the previous month (36), there was a decrease of 17 incidents, reflecting a overall downtrend (MoM).

• **Local:** 13 local incidents were recorded in July 2025. This figure shows a lower value compared to July 2024 (44) by 31 and July 2023 (23) by 10 (YoY). When compared to the previous month (23), it also shows a decrease of 10 incidents (MoM).

• **Majority of FVs involved in local incidents** were reported in Malaysia, with 8 incidents (61.5%), followed by ROK with 3 incidents (23%). One incident each was reported in Bangladesh and Indonesia, bringing the total for these countries to 2 incidents (15.5%).

• **Poaching:** 6 poaching incidents were recorded in July 2025. This figure shows an annual decrease in the same month, with 11 incidents compared to July 2024 (17), and 16 incidents decrease compared to June 2023 (22) (YoY). When compared to the previous month (13), it decreased by 7 incidents (MoM).

• The largest proportion of poaching incidents is India, with 4 cases (66.7%), followed by Viet Nam vessels and unspecified country with one incident each (2 in total, 33.3%).

• **International :** NSTR.

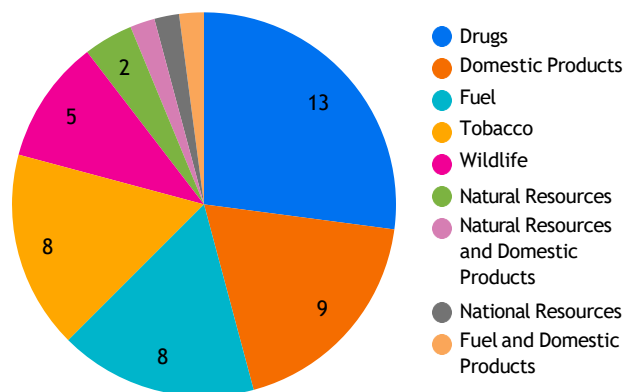
• The number of incidents this month shows a significant downtrend compared to both the same month in previous years (YoY) and to the last month (MoM). While it is likely that the efforts of enforcement agencies have effectively curbed illegal fishing, it remains possible that illegal fishing methods to evade detection has evolved. We will continue to monitor the changes on data, taking various variables into consideration.



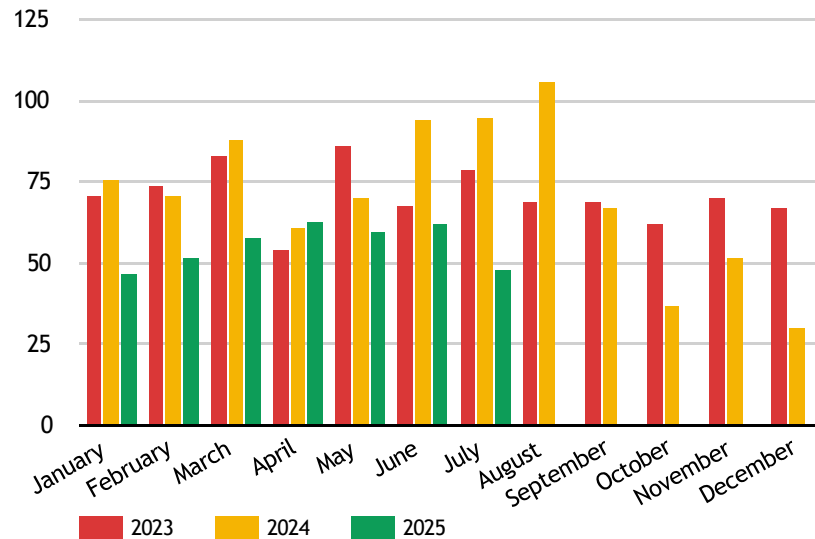
Contraband Smuggling (CS)



Types of Smuggled Goods



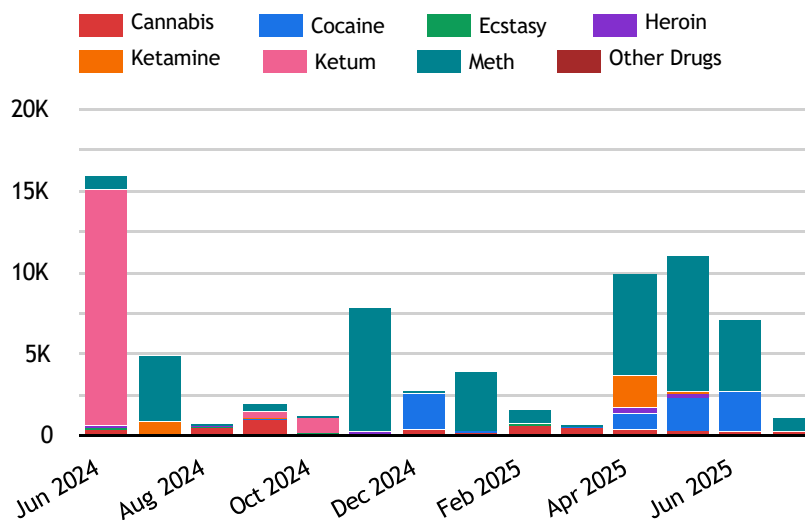

OBSERVATIONS

Statistics:

In July 2025, IFC recorded 48 contraband smuggling incidents.

Drugs (x13, 1,267.68kg): Indonesia (x5, Meth 68kg, Marijuana 0.5kg), Sri Lanka (x3, Cannabis 140.3kg, Prescription drugs(1,349,640), Philippines (x2 Meth 220.48kg), Australia (Meth 597kg), Malaysia (Cannabis 170kg).

Fuel (x8 1,393,046 litres): Malaysia (x2 Petrol 51,550 Litres, Diesel 3,000litres), Vietnam (x2, Diesel 300,000 litres), Philippines (x2 Diesel 6,000Litres, Gasoline 2,696Litres), Sabah(x2 Oil 32,800 Liters, Petrol 52 Jerry Cans), ROK (Oil 1,000,000litres).

Domestic Products (x9 850,801kg): Sri Lanka (x4), China(x3), Indonesia (x1), Sabah(x1).

Natural Resources (x2, 2,057kg): Sri Lanka (x2).

Wildlife (x5): Indonesia (x5).

Tobacco (x8, 6,472 cases): Philippines (x4), China (x3), Brunie (x1).

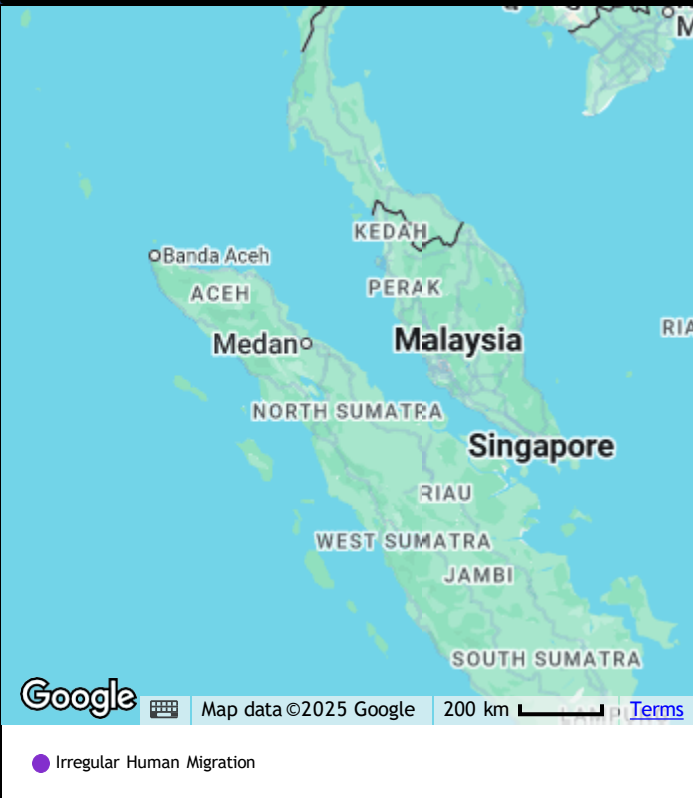
- For this month, IFC reported a total of 48 incidents compared to 45 incidents last month. And it was two times lower compared to the same period in the previous years.

- Compared to last month, drug smuggling has increased significantly but the individual seizures were smaller. Fuel seizures has remained the same incidents. Tobacco cases have slightly increased. Wildlife smuggling cases were also remained stable.

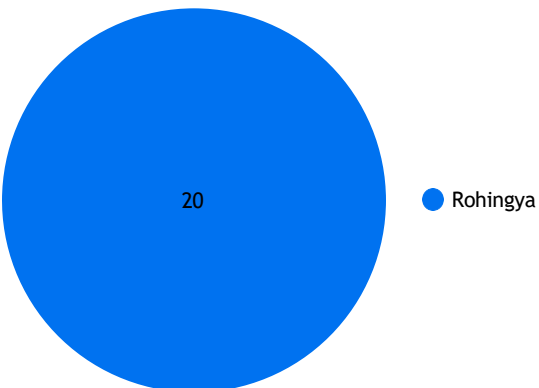
- With Drugs smuggling being the major part of incidents this month, followed by Fuel, Tobacco. Of note, Domestic Products were similar in numbers but higher in volume for each seizure.



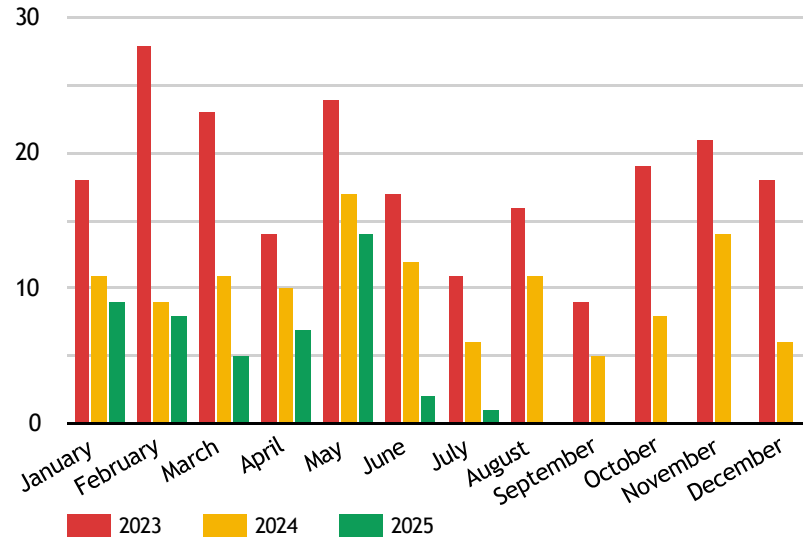
Irregular Human Migration (IHM)



Number and Nationality/Ethnicity of Migrants



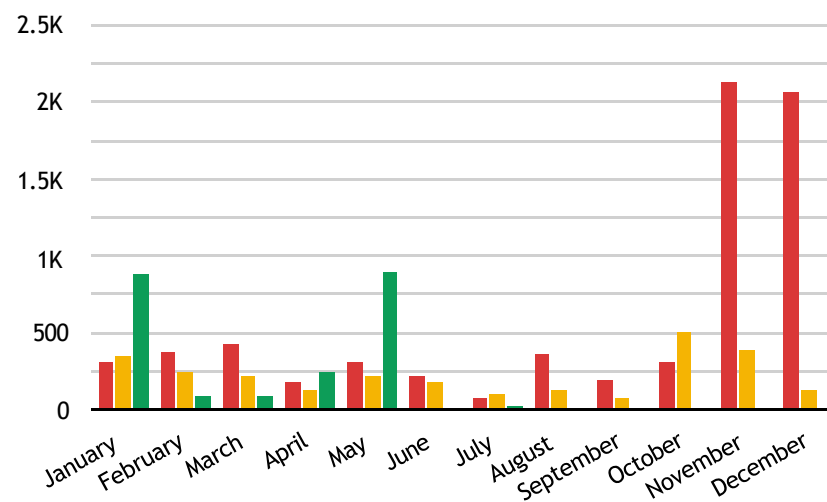

- Only 1 IHM incident was recorded this month - classified as a routine Irregular Human Migration (IHM) incident.

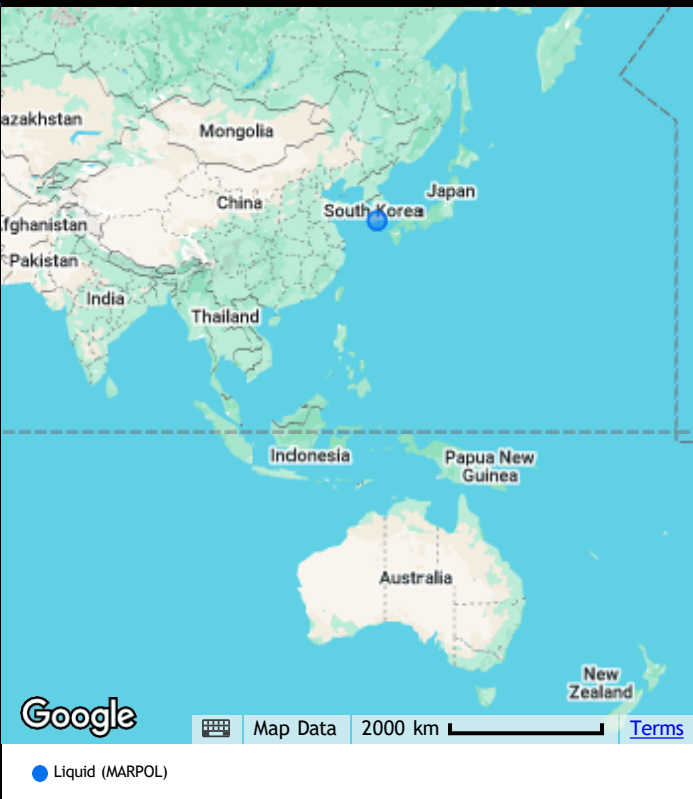
Comments:

- The incident occurred along the Myanmar/Bangladesh border, with likely Rohingya migrants being forced ashore on St Martin's island due to poor weather.
- The decrease in IHM activity over June and July is in line with historical trends, which sees a decrease in IHM activity in the middle of the year. However, activity is notably low in 2025 compared to previous years, possibly due to weather conditions or a changed in law enforcement activity, particularly in Indonesian/Malaysian waters.

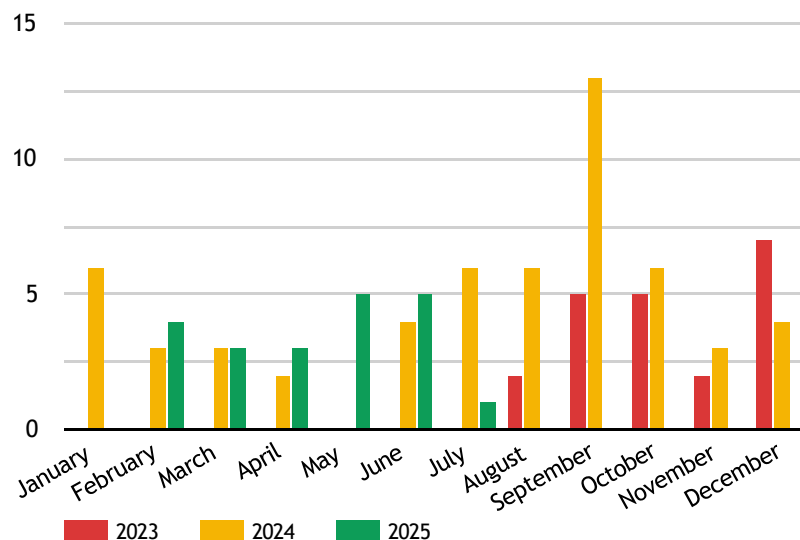




Environmental Security (ENVSEC)



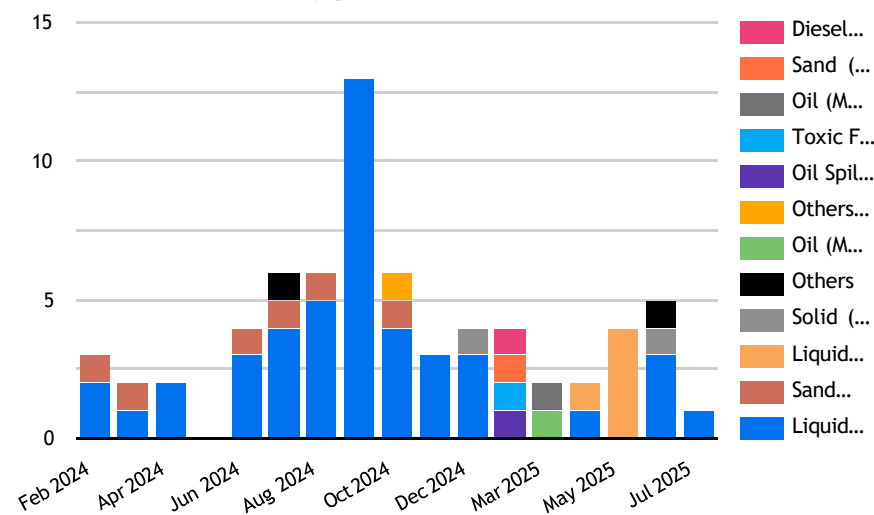

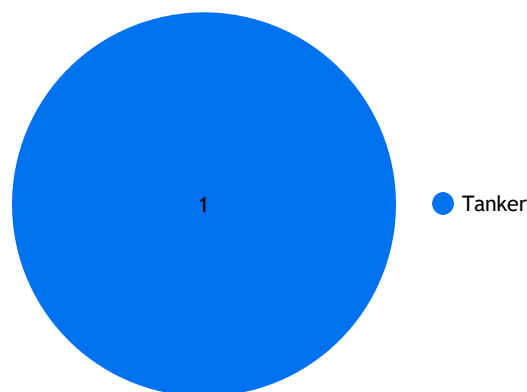

IFC Recommendations



1. All mariners to report any maritime security incidents timely to the nearest coastal state and inform the IFC at the earliest possible time.
2. All mariners are strongly recommended to be vigilant, in particularly when operating in IFC identified hotspots (**Westbound lane of Traffic Separation Scheme in Singapore Strait, Eastbound lane of Traffic Separation Scheme in Singapore Strait, Belawan and Dumai Anchorages in Indonesia, Manila Anchorage in the Philippines, and Chittagong Outer Anchorage in Bangladesh**).
3. All mariners are advised to adopt **Ship Protection Measures** recommended in the **Regional Guide to Counter Piracy and Armed Robbery Against Ships in Asia** (e.g., illuminating the accommodation block and poop deck, deploying sentries and increase frequency of security rounds).
4. All mariners to take note on the description of the perpetrators and to take photos of the perpetrators if possible. Where available, CCTV footage capturing the incident should be provided to **the coastal state authorities** for follow-on investigation.
5. All mariners are advised to participate in **IFC Voluntary Community Reporting (VCR)** as depicted in **MARSEC Chart O6112 and O6113**. In case of any doubt, incident at sea, suspicious approach or unusual observed activity at sea, please contact the IFC Duty Officer:

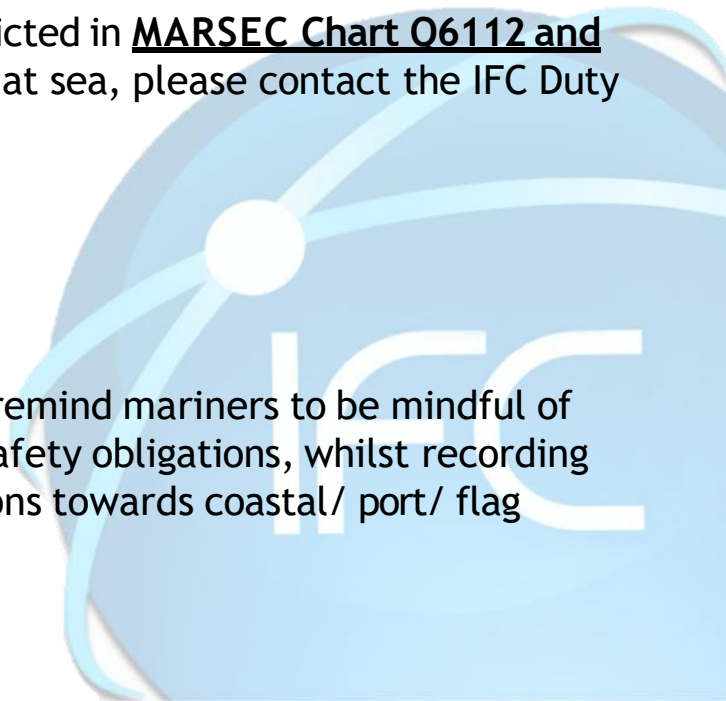
