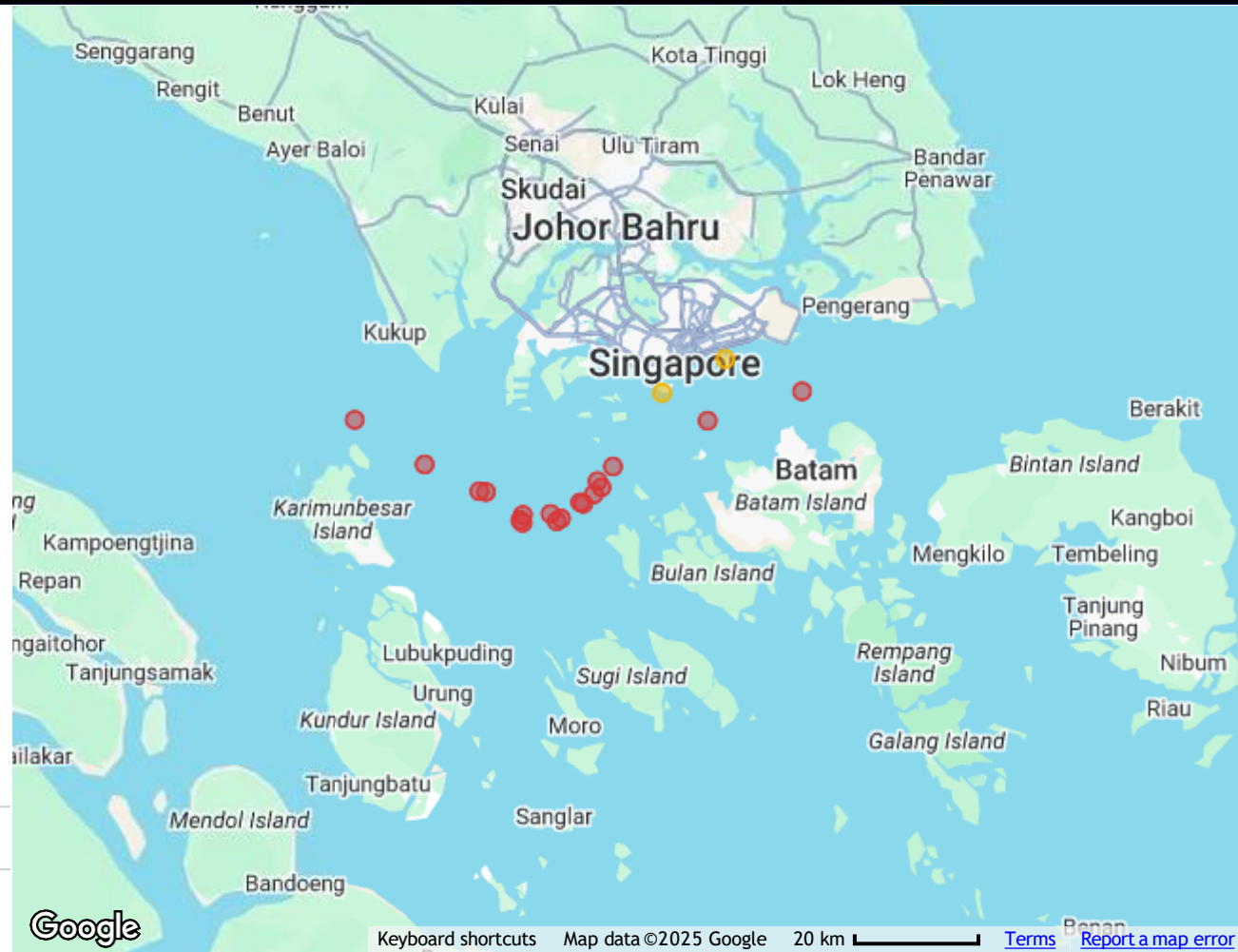
Overview of MARSEC Incidents in the Singapore Strait

Number of Incidents

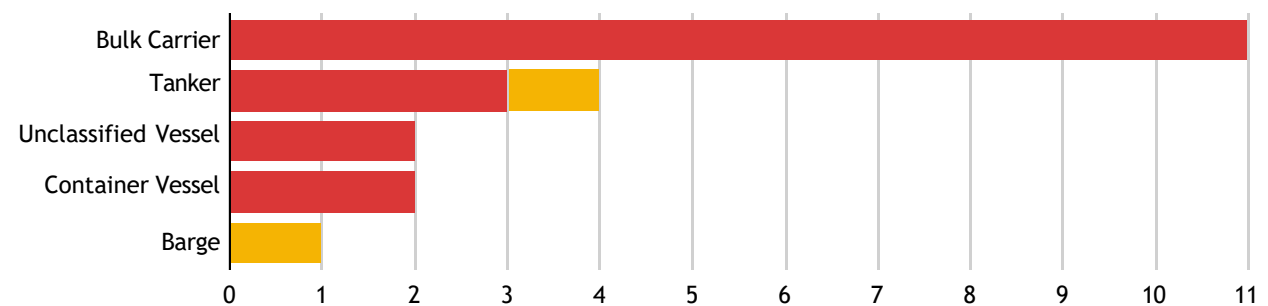

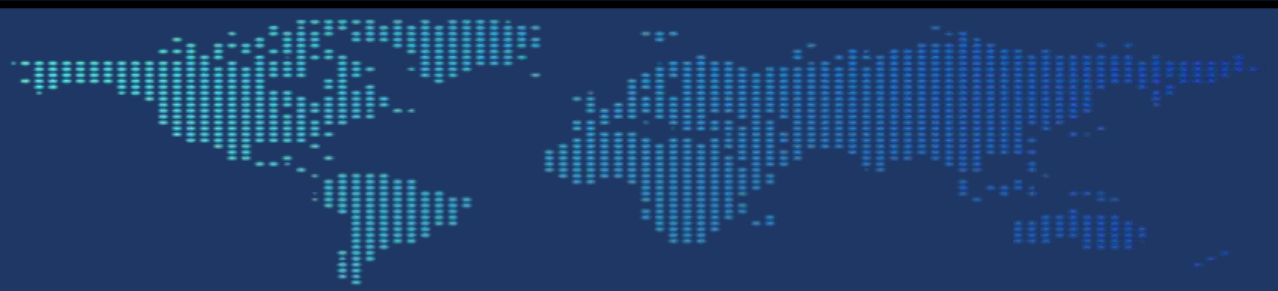

Executive Summary



Theft, Robbery and Piracy at Sea: 21 TRAPS incidents were reported in Jun 2025 throughout the AOI. This number recorded higher than previous years June 2024 (9) and June 2023 (13). 17 incidents occurred in the Singapore Strait (SS), 2 in Chattogram Anchorage, Bangladesh, 1 in Straits of Malacca and 1 in Kakinada Anchorage, India.

Maritime Incidents: 54 MI incidents were recorded in Jun 2025 throughout the AOI. Bad weather was still the most common reported incident cause (17 of 54 incidents).

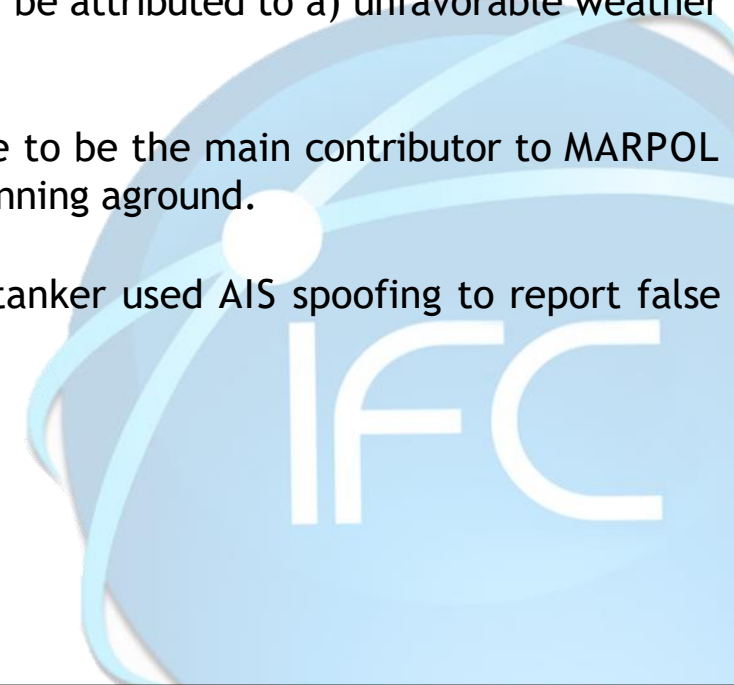
Illegal, Unreported, and Unregulated Fishing: 29 IUUF incidents were recorded in Jun 2025. The number of incidents this month shows a significant downtrend.

Contraband Smuggling: 45 CS incidents were recorded in Jun 2025. Compared to last month, drug smuggling has dropped significantly, by almost two times.

Irregular Human Migration: 2 IHM incidents were recorded in Jun 2025. The decrease could be attributed to a) unfavorable weather conditions and b) incidents passing detections by regional authorities.

Environmental Security: 4 ENVSEC incidents were recorded in Jun 2025. Oil spills continue to be the main contributor to MARPOL violations. For this month, one incident involved damaged to coral reef caused by a vessel running aground.

Cyber Security: One cyber security incident was reported in Jun 2025. A sanctioned oil tanker used AIS spoofing to report false names, identification and positions.

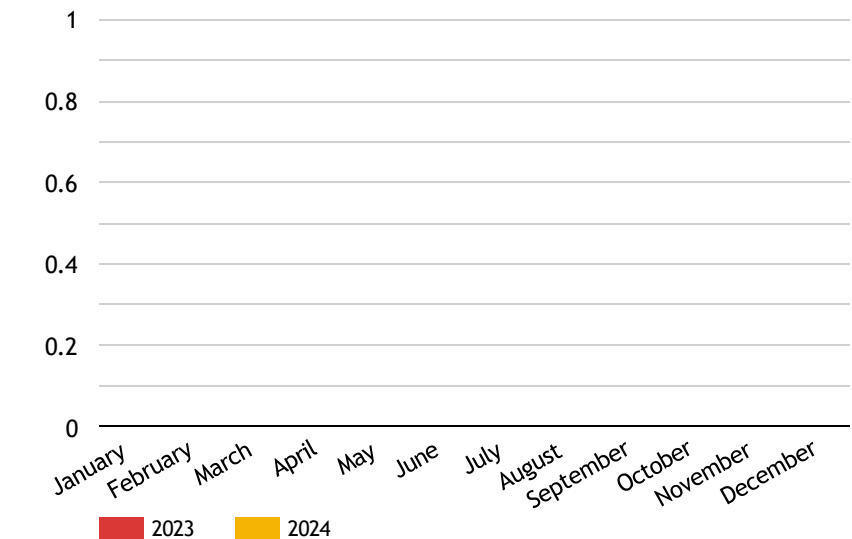

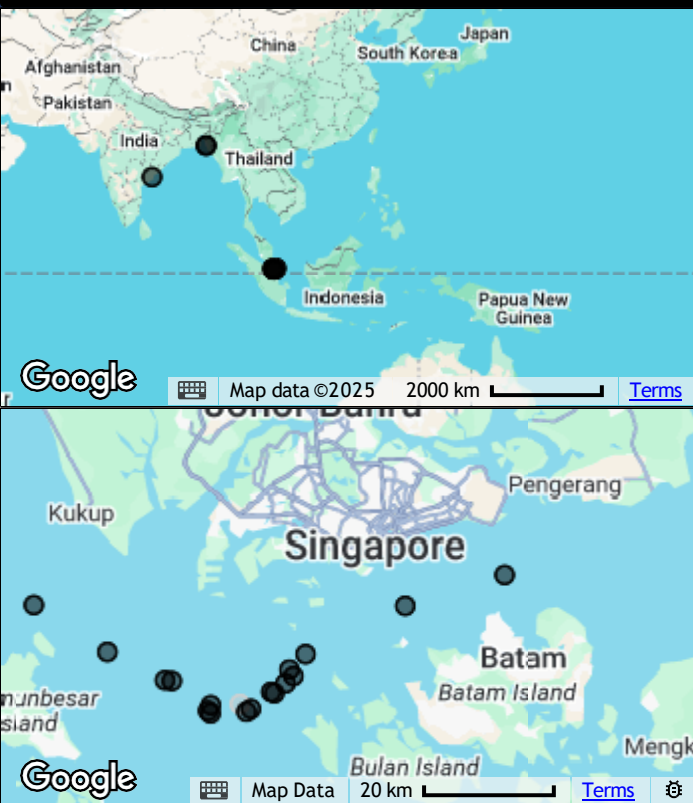

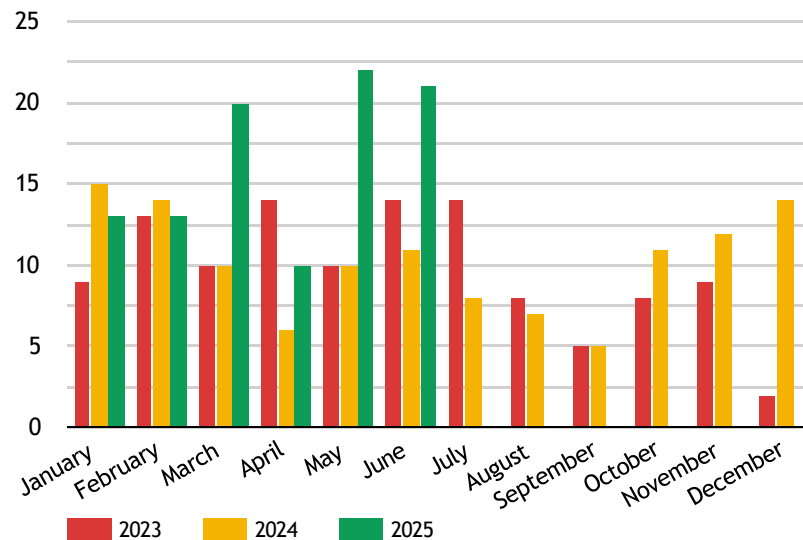




Theft, Robbery and Piracy at Sea (TRAPS)



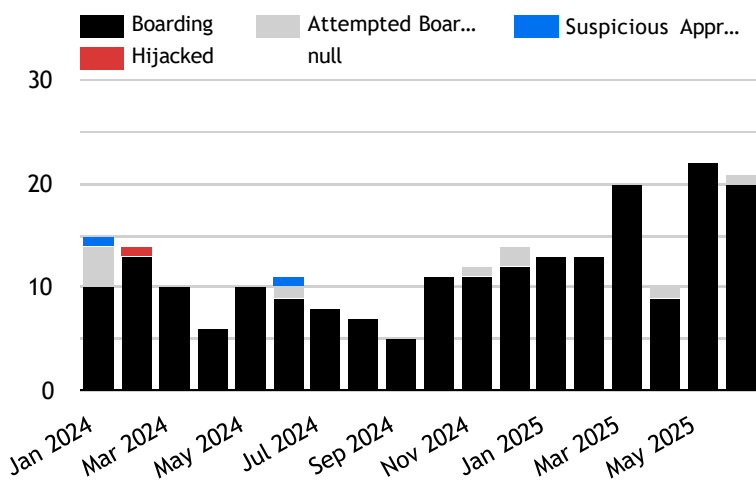

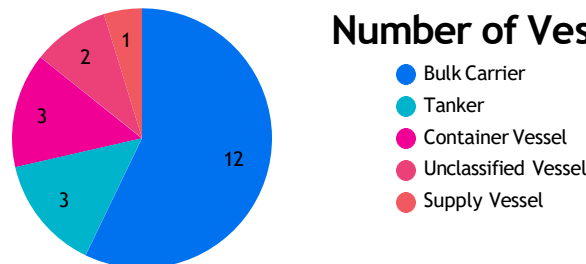

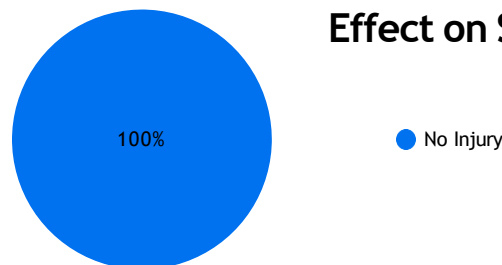

OBSERVATIONS

Statistics

- Total of 21 TRAPS incidents, comprising 20 boardings and 1 attempted boarding, increased compared to June 2024 (9) and June 2023 (13).
- 17 incidents occurred in the Singapore Strait (SS), 2 in Chattogram Anchorage, Bangladesh, 1 in Straits of Malacca and 1 in Kakinada Anchorage, India. These incidents involved 12 bulk carriers, 4 tankers, 3 container vessels, 1 supply vessel and 1 tug and barge.
- Of note, 19 incidents occurred during the Period of Darkness (PoD) whilst 2 incidents were recorded during daylight. All incidents occurred while vessels were underway less 3, while at anchor (2 in Bangladesh, 1 in India).

Singapore Strait (SS)

- 17 Sea thefts recorded while ships were underway: 13 incidents occurred in the Phillip Channel and 4 incidents in the Eastbound Lane of Traffic Separation Scheme (TSS).
- Of the 13 incidents in Philip Channel, 8 incidents [3, 5, 12, 13, 15, 23, 27 and 28 Jun] involved perpetrators reportedly armed [knives or "gun-like" objects], however no confrontation or crew injury reported. Of note, 2 incidents [23 and 28 Jun] reported items and engine parts stolen [i.e. paint drums, pistons].
- Of the 4 incidents in Eastbound Lane of TSS, 1 incident (7 Jun) reported scrap metal stolen and 1 incident (16 Jun) reported a full SCBA set, an SCBA bottle compressor and two radio transceivers missing. No confrontation and injury were reported.
- All ships were able to continue their voyages to the next port without requiring any assistance.

Bangladesh

- 2 Sea theft incidents were reported off Chattogram Anchorage, involving a bulk carrier and a container ship. In both cases, the perpetrators were armed with knives. The container ship reported the theft of ship's property. No confrontation or injuries were reported in either incident.

Straits of Malacca

- 1 Sea theft incident was reported involving a bulk carrier, where five armed perpetrators boarded the vessel and stole ship's items. No confrontation or injuries were reported.

India

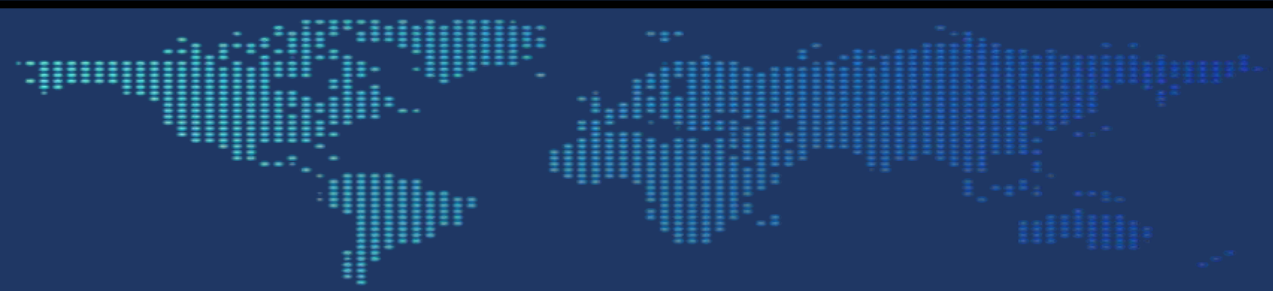
- 1 Sea theft incident occurred involving 1 supply vessel, which involved five perpetrators, but were successfully apprehended by Indian authorities.

Comments

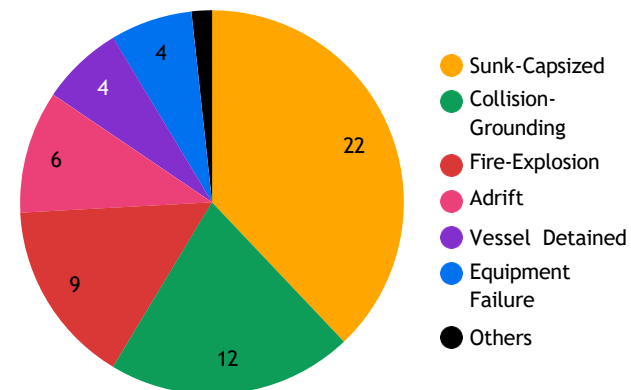
- The number of incidents in June 2025 is the second highest recorded this year, particularly in the SS, likely linked to heightened financial pressures ahead of the June festivities, prompting a rise in petty crimes. Based on historical trends, incident numbers are expected to decline in July 2025, mainly due to improved weather conditions in the South China Sea that support the resumption of fishing activities.
- Perpetrators continue to target vulnerable vessels, particularly bulk carriers, tugs with barges, and container ships with freeboards ranging from 3 to 7 meters. Consistent with past trends, these vessels are likely to remain preferred targets due to their low operating speeds and low freeboard.



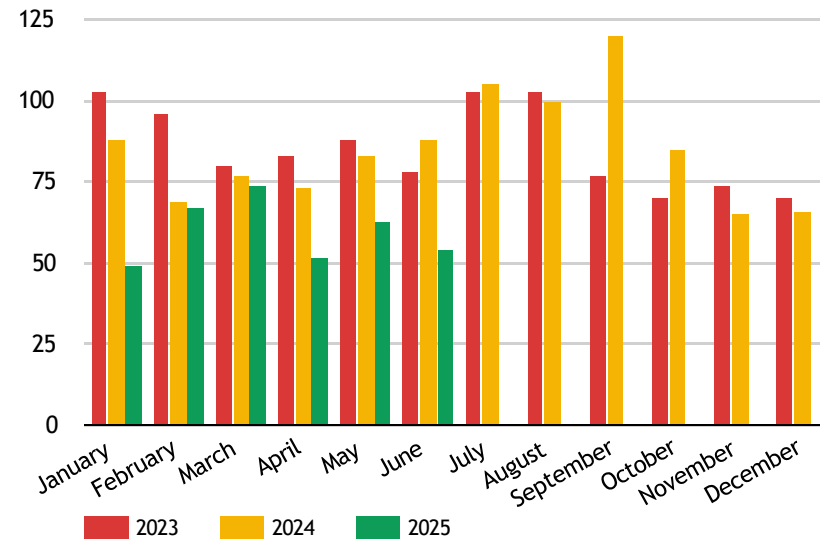
Maritime Incidents (MI)



Number of Vessels, by Type of Incident



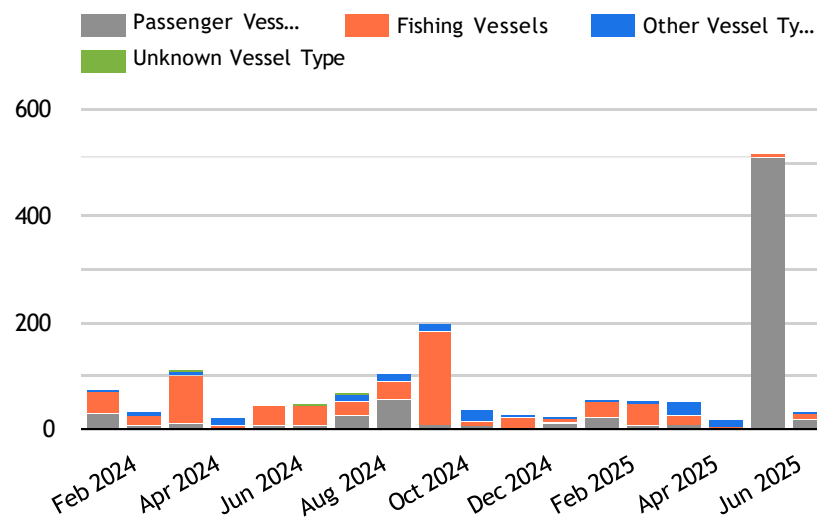

OBSERVATIONS

Statistics:

• A total of 54 maritime incidents were reported this month, which is lower than the figures recorded for the same period in 2024 (88) and 2023 (78) incidents.

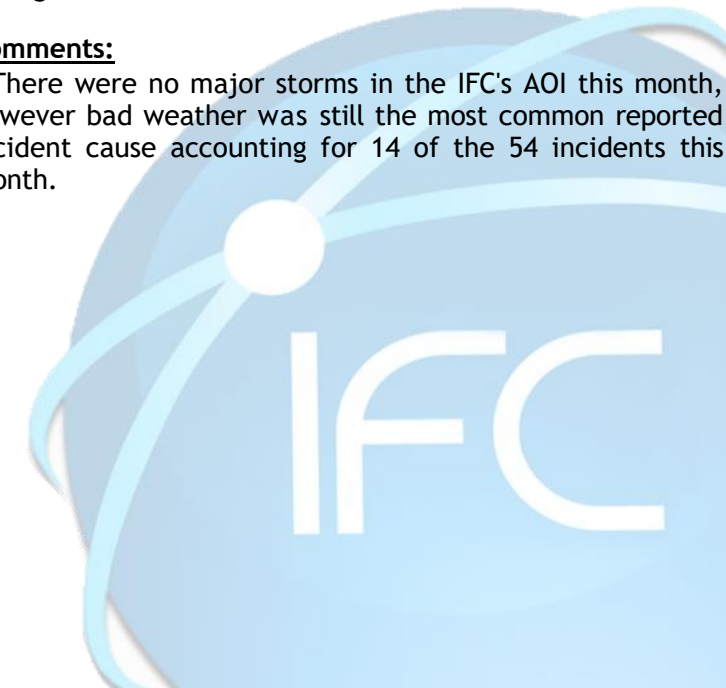
• The largest number of reported incidents was sunk-capsized (22), followed by collision grounding(12), fire Explosion(9) and Adrift(6).

• In terms of location, the highest number of reported incidents occurred in the waters of the Malaysia(10), ROK (10),Vietnam (9) and Philippines (8).

• A total of 35 individuals were reported dead or missing this month, which is less than the last month (518) also less than the same period in 2024 (48). Overall, 41 SAR operations were conducted, resulting in the rescue of 486 individuals during this month.

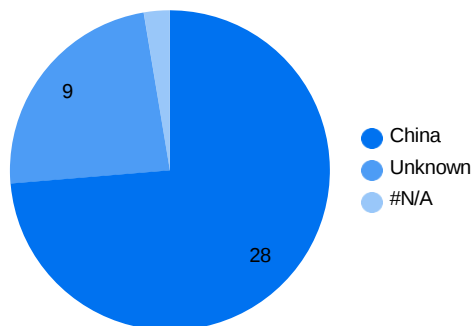
• There were no major storms in the IFC's AOI this month, however bad weather was still the most common reported incident cause accounting for 14 of the 54 incidents this month.



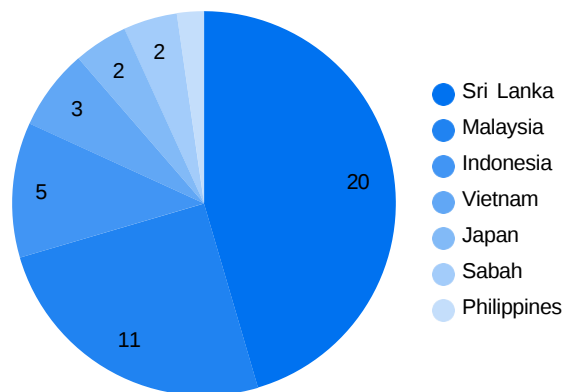
Illegal, Unreported, and Unregulated Fishing (IUUF)



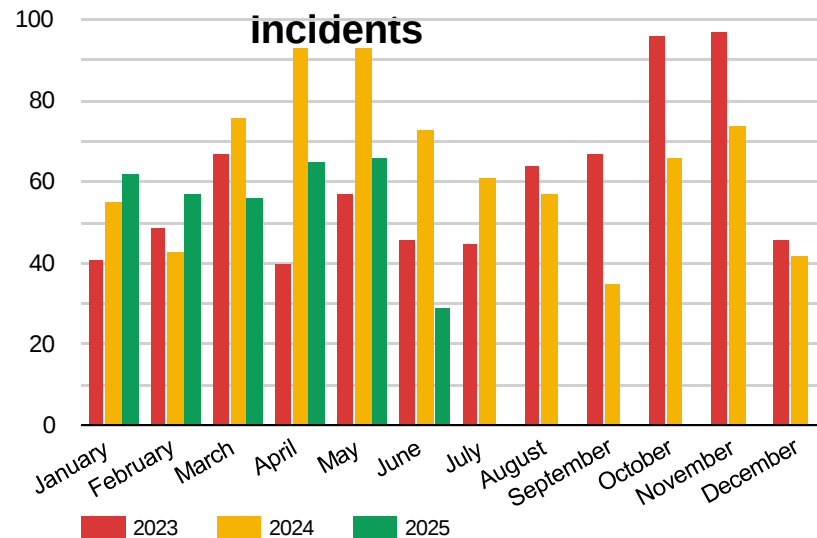
Number and Flag of Vessels, Poaching

OBSERVATION

Statistics :

- **Total:** 29 IUUF incidents were recorded in IFC's AOI in June 2025. This figure shows a significant decrease of 44 incidents compared to June 2024 (73), and of 17 incidents compared to June 2023 (46), as observed from the annual data (YoY). When viewed a comparison to the previous month (66), there was a decrease of 37 incidents, reflecting a overall downtrend (MoM).

- **Local:** 21 local incidents were recorded in June 2025. This figure shows a lower value compared to June 2024 (35) by 14 and June 2023 (30) by 9 (YoY). When compared to the previous month (36), it also shows a decrease of 15 incidents (MoM).

- The majority of FVs involved in local incidents were reported in Malaysia, with 13 incidents (61.9%), followed by Indonesia with 4 incidents (19%). One incident each was reported in Japan, the Philippines, Sri Lanka, and Vietnam, bringing the total for these countries to 4 incidents (19%).

- **Poaching:** 8 poaching incidents were recorded in June 2025. This figure shows an annual decrease in the same month, with 30 incidents compared to June 2024 (38), and 8 incidents decrease compared to June 2023 (16) (YoY). When compared to the previous month (30), it decreased by 22 incidents (MoM).

- Unspecified nationalities accounted for the largest number of poaching incidents with 6 cases (75%), followed by Chinese and Indian vessels with one incident each (2 in total, 25%).

- **International :** NSTR.

Comments :

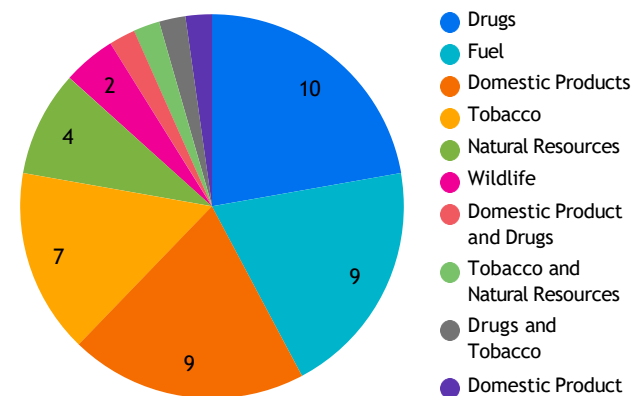
- The number of incidents this month shows a significant downtrend compared to both the same month in previous years (YoY) and to the last month (MoM). While it is likely that the efforts of enforcement agencies have effectively curbed illegal fishing, it remains possible that illegal fishing methods to evade detection has evolved. We will continue to monitor the changes on data, taking various variables into consideration.



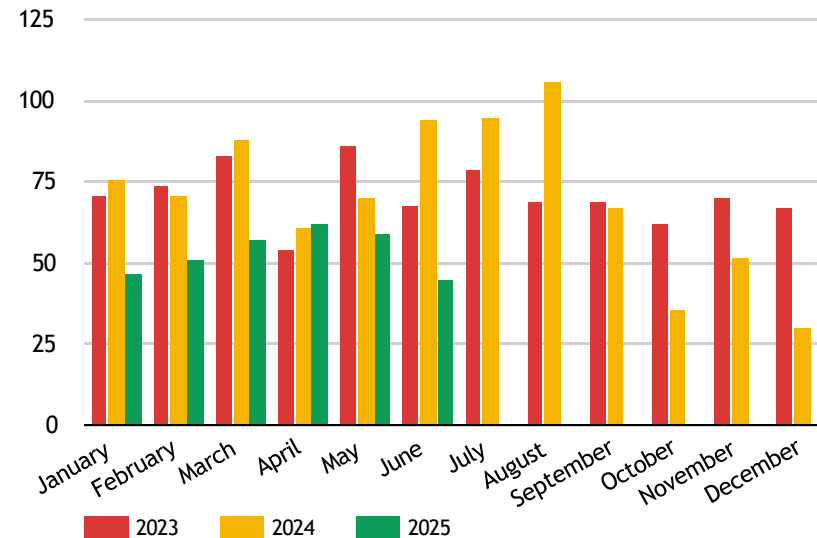
Contraband Smuggling (CS)



Types of Smuggled Goods



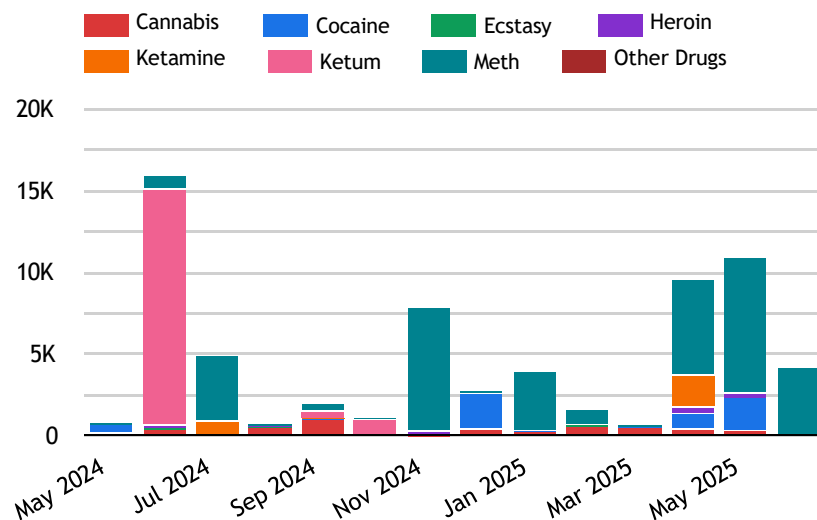

OBSERVATIONS

Statistics:

In June 2025, IFC recorded 45 contraband smuggling incidents.

Drugs (x10, 3,948.5kg): Philippines(x2, Meth1,524.5kg, 2x Unknown drugs), Indonesia (x3, Meth 17.5kg, Unknown drugs), Sabah (Meth 3kg) Thailand (Meth 2,399kg), Malaysia (Meth 5 packets).

Fuel (x9 253,230 litres): Vietnam (x4, Diesel 101,000 litres), Philippines (x2 Diesel 200,000Liters, Petroleum 16 drums), Sabah(x1 Diesel 450 Liters), Indonesia (x2, Diesel 980 Liters, Peralite Fuel 800 Liters).

Domestic Products (x11 55,675kg): Indonesia (x5), Bangladesh(x1), Malaysia(x1), Sabah(x1), Philippines (x1), Viet Nam (x1), Myanmar (x1).

Natural Resources (x5, 42,914kg): Sri Lanka (x2), Indonesia (x2).

Wildlife (x2): Indonesia (x2).

Tobacco (x8, 760 cases): Philippines (x4),Indonesia (x1), China (x1), Viet Nam (x1), Sri Lanka (x1).

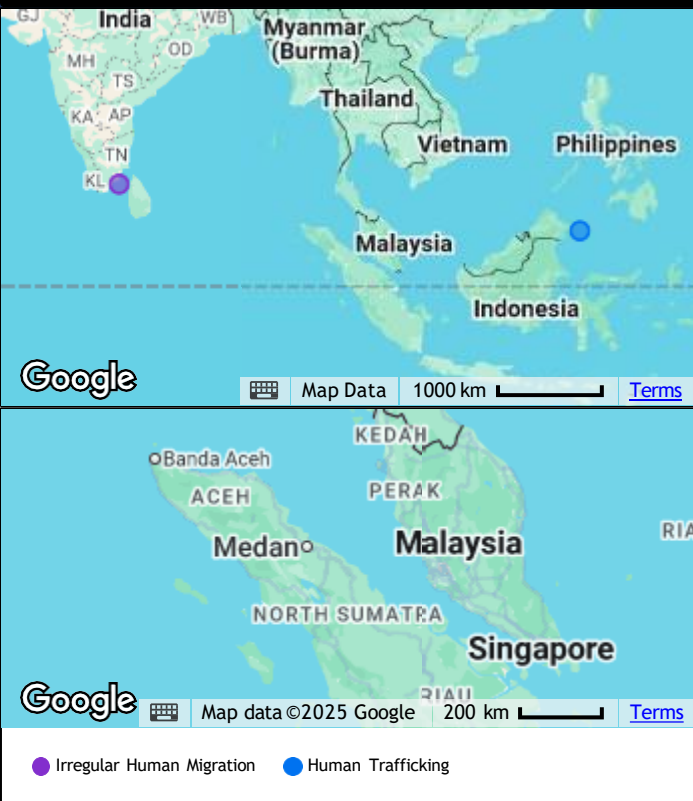
- For this month, IFC reported a total of 45 incidents compared to 54 incidents last month. And it was two times lower compared to the same period in the previous years.

- Compared to last month, drug smuggling has dropped significantly almost two times lower. Fuel seizures has increased by about 30 %. Tobacco cases have remained the same incidents, but the individual seizures were smaller. Wildlife smuggling cases were also remained stable.

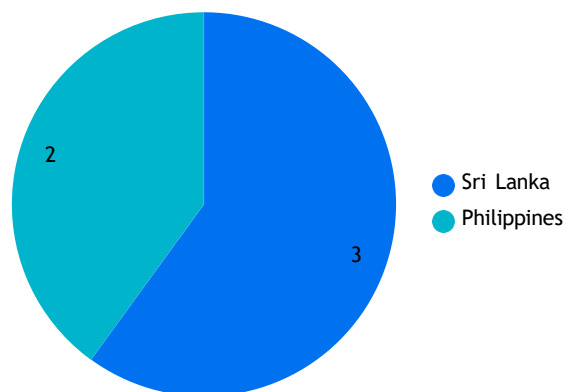
- With Drugs smuggling being the major part of incidents this month, followed by Domestic Products, but higher volume of domestic products were seized for each incidents.



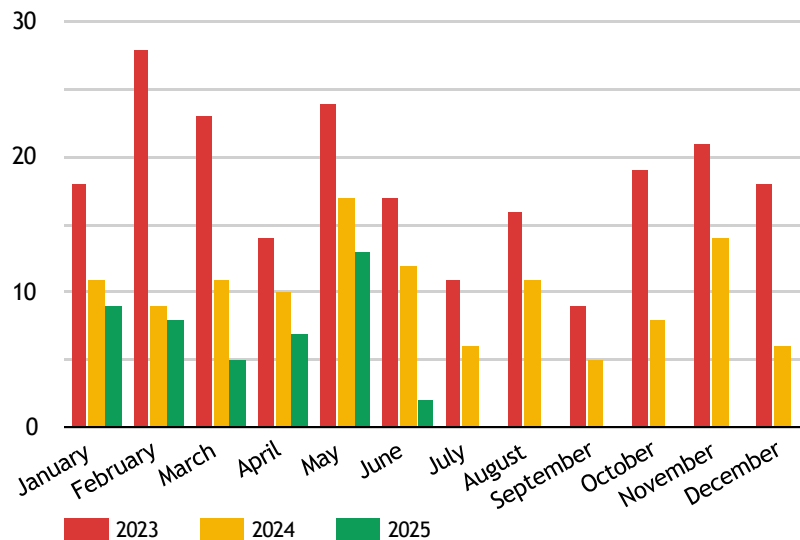
Irregular Human Migration (IHM)



Number and Nationality/Ethnicity of Migrants



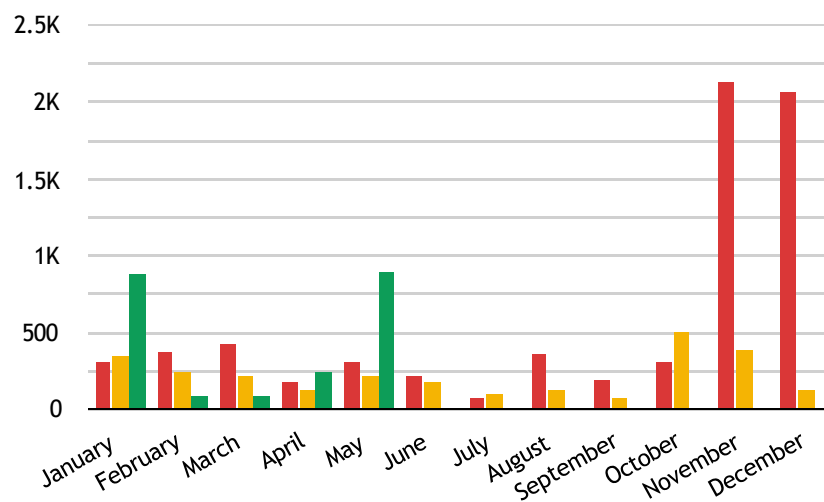

- 2 incidents were recorded this month - with one classified as routine Irregular Human Migration (IHM) incident, and another as Human Trafficking.

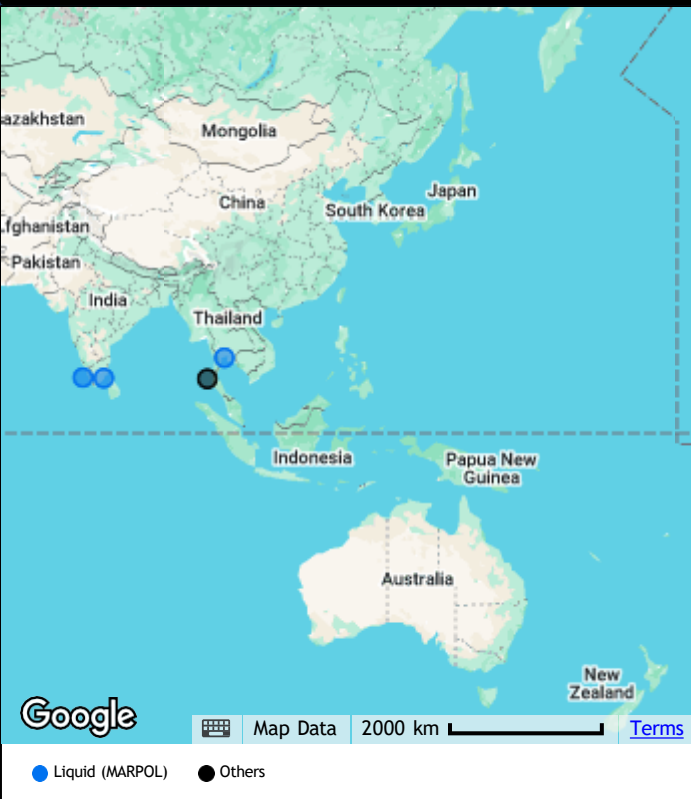
Comments:

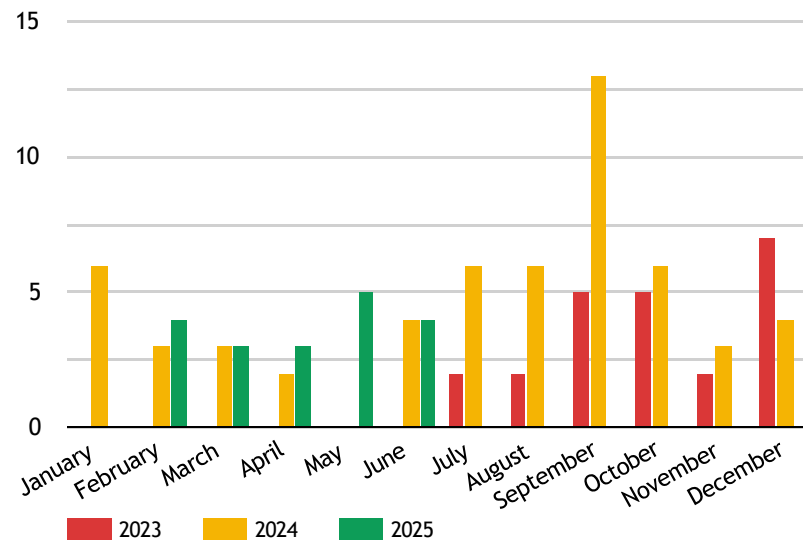

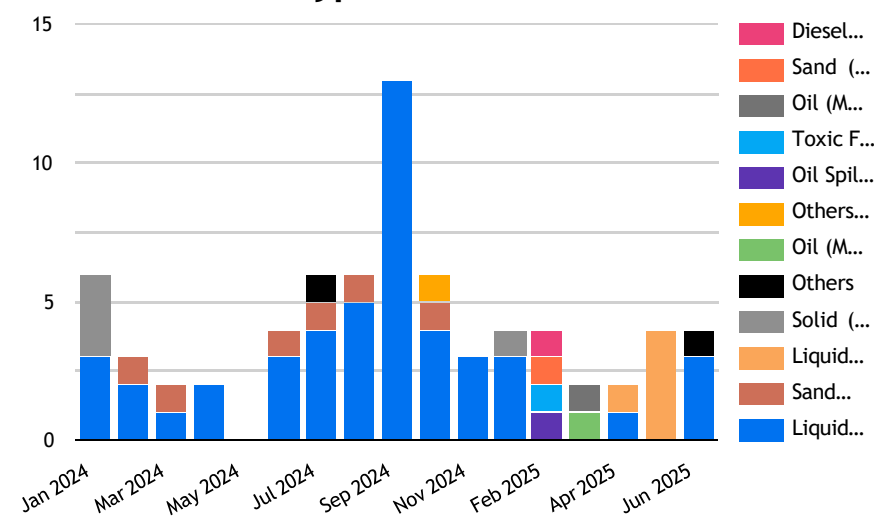

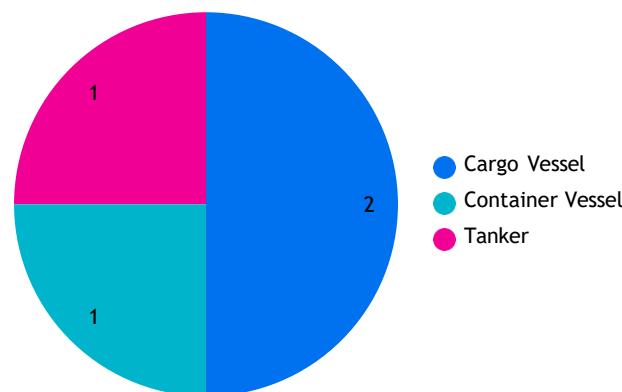

Statistics : 4 incidents were recorded in IFC's AOI in J 2025, it remained same compared to may 2024 (4) (YoY). In addition, this figure shows a slightly decreased to the previous month (5) (MoM).

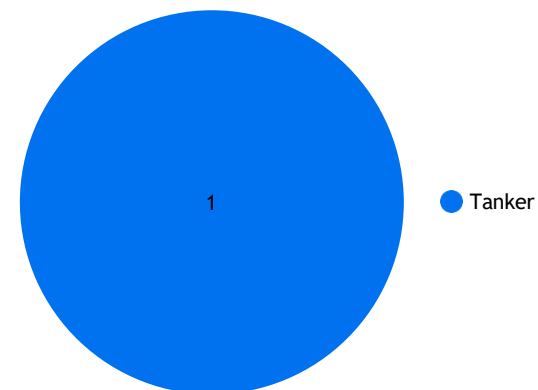

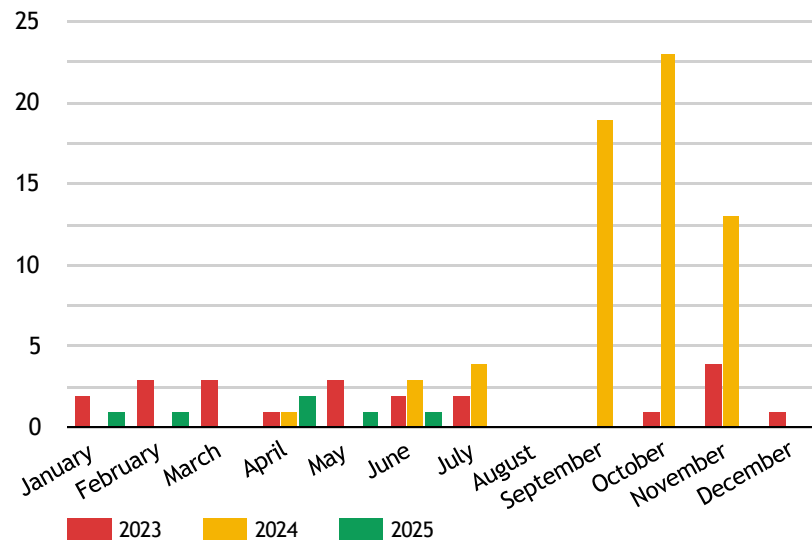

Vessels/Organisations Involved



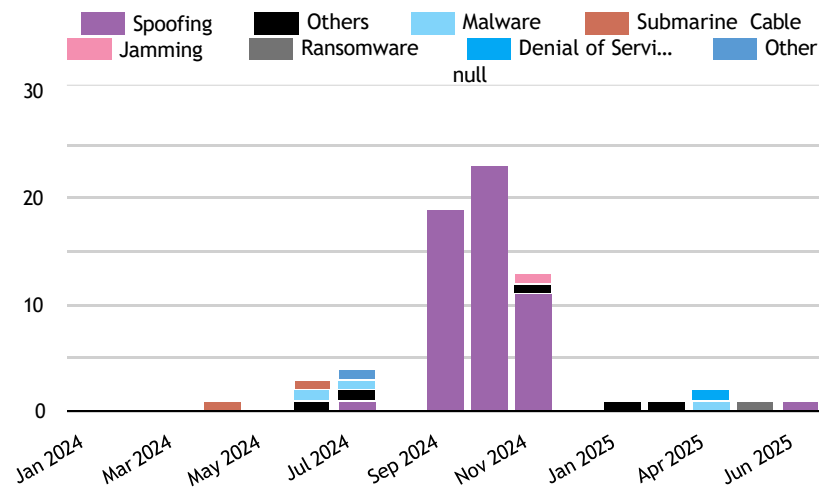

Comments:

- There was one Cyber Security incident reported this month.
- In order to make detection and tracking more difficult, a sanctioned oil tanker spoofed AIS/GNSS data to change its position and conceal its real identity.

Dark fleet oil tankers present a range of risks that affect maritime safety, environmental protection, geopolitical stability, and economic security. Addressing these risks requires coordinated efforts from international regulatory bodies, flag states, and the maritime industry.





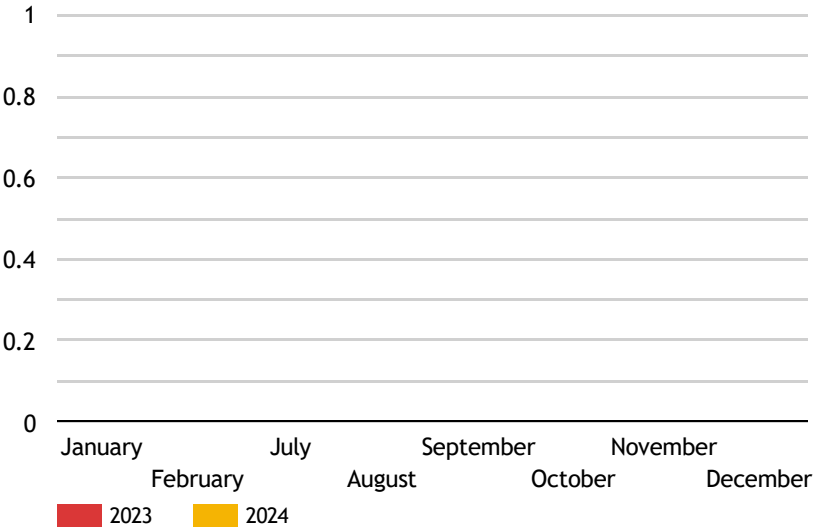

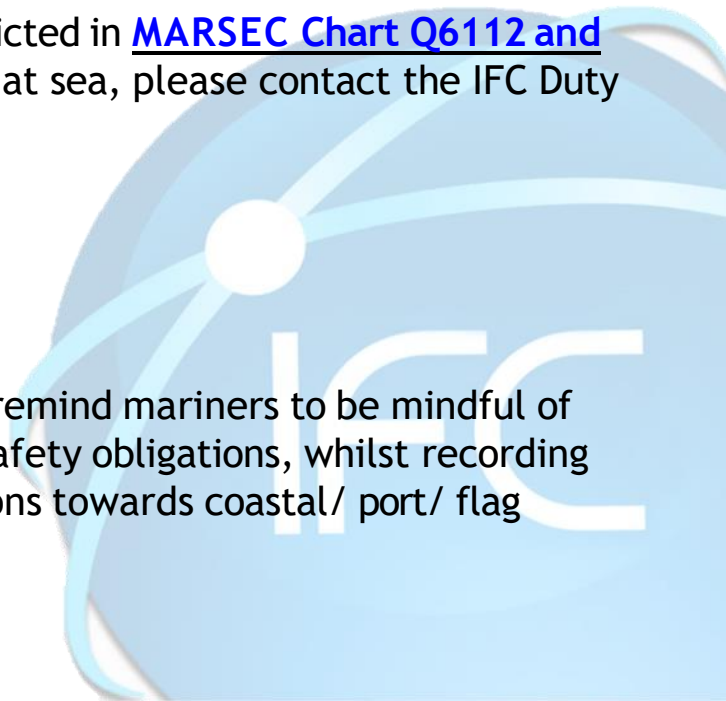


IFC Recommendations



1. All mariners to report any maritime security incidents timely to the nearest coastal state and inform the IFC at the earliest possible time.
2. All mariners are strongly recommended to be vigilant, in particularly when operating in IFC identified hotspots (**Westbound lane of Traffic Separation Scheme in Singapore Strait, Eastbound lane of Traffic Separation Scheme in Singapore Strait, Belawan and Dumai Anchorages in Indonesia, Manila Anchorage in the Philippines, and Chittagong Outer Anchorage in Bangladesh**).
3. All mariners are advised to adopt **Ship Protection Measures** recommended in the [Regional Guide to Counter Piracy and Armed Robbery Against Ships in Asia](#) (e.g., illuminating the accommodation block and poop deck, deploying sentries and increase frequency of security rounds).
4. All mariners to take note on the description of the perpetrators and to take photos of the perpetrators if possible. Where available, CCTV footage capturing the incident should be provided to [the coastal state authorities](#) for follow-on investigation.
5. All mariners are advised to participate in **IFC Voluntary Community Reporting (VCR)** as depicted in [MARSEC Chart Q6112 and Q6113](#). In case of any doubt, incident at sea, suspicious approach or unusual observed activity at sea, please contact the IFC Duty Officer:
