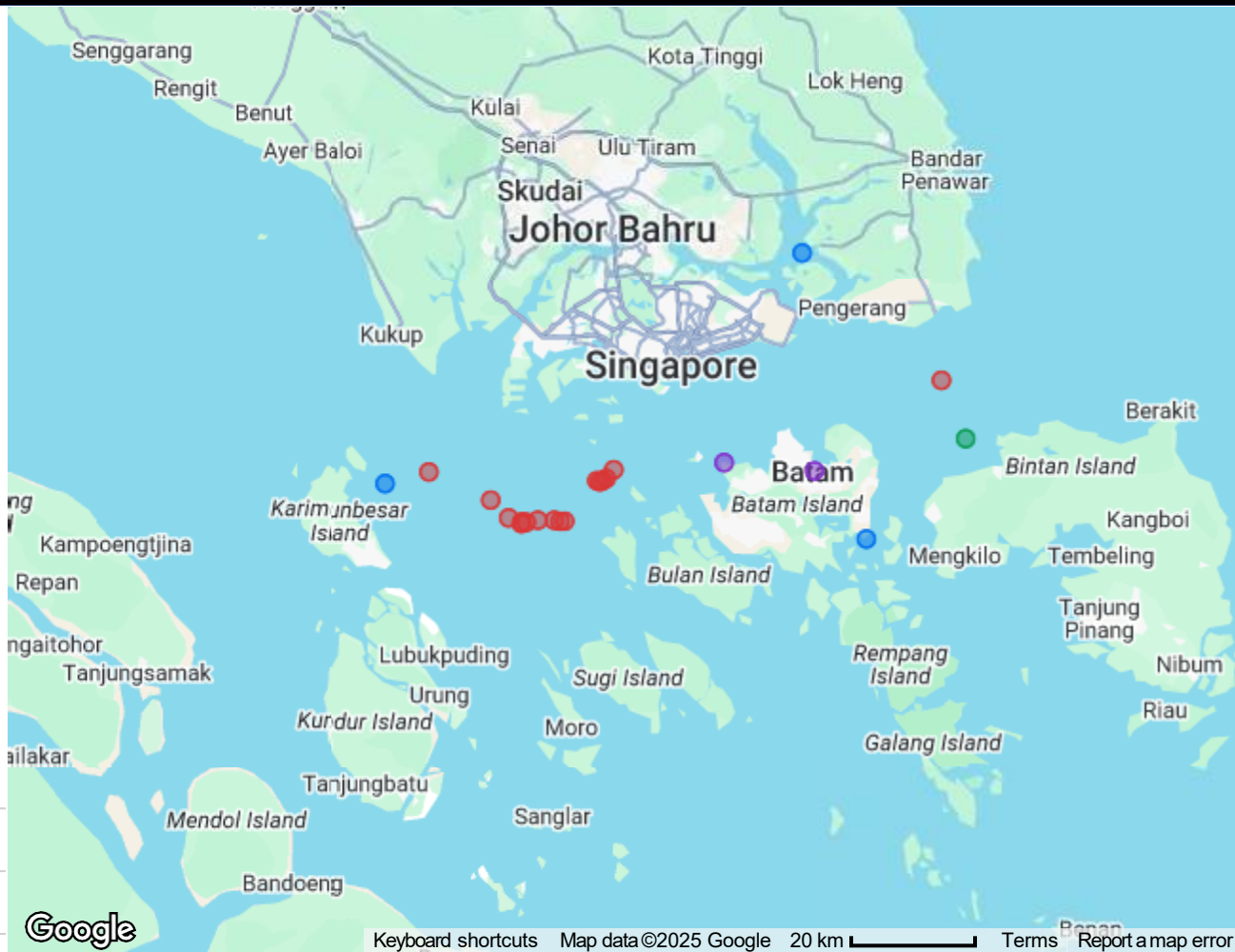


Overview of MARSEC Incidents in the Singapore Strait

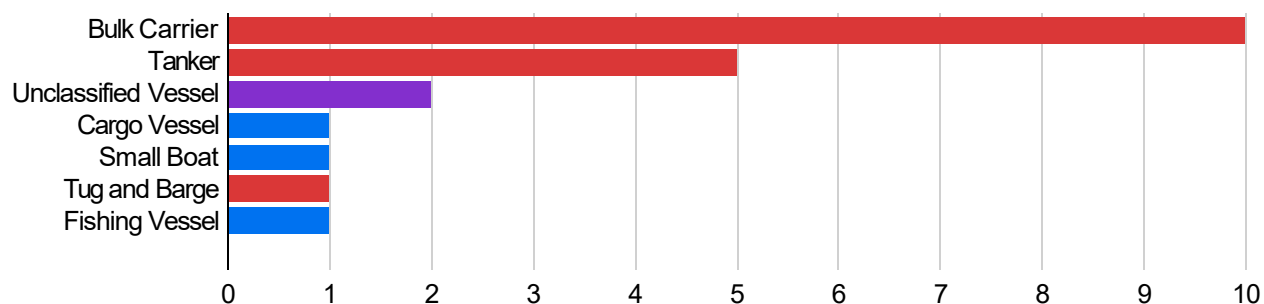

Executive Summary



Theft, Robbery and Piracy at Sea: 17 TRAPS incidents were reported in May 2025 throughout the AOI. This number recorded higher than previous years May 2024 (10 incidents) and May 2023 (10 incidents). 16 incidents occurred in the Singapore Strait (SS) and 1 in Pussur Channel, Bangladesh.

Maritime Incidents: 54 MI incidents were recorded in May 2025 throughout the AOI. Bad weather was still the most common reported incident cause(14 of 54 incidents).

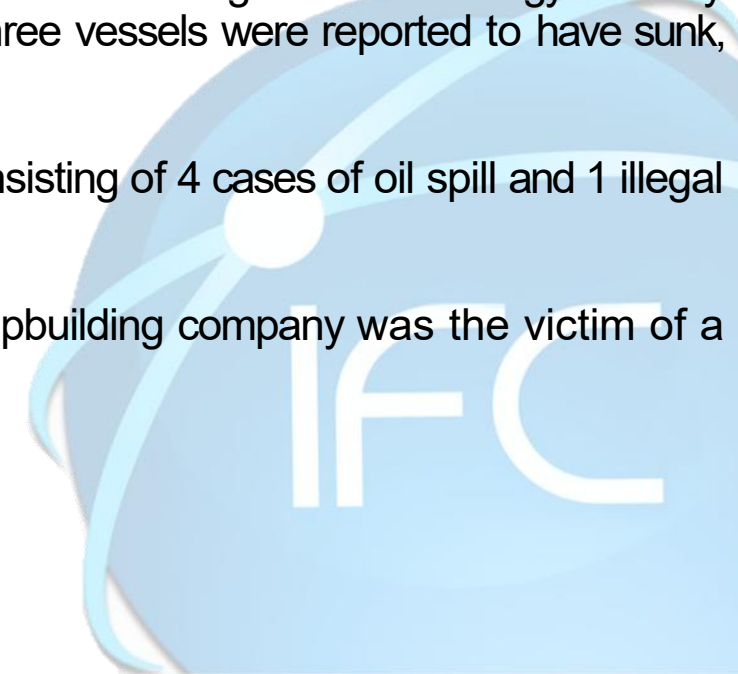
Illegal, Unreported, and Unregulated Fishing: 49 IUUF incidents were recorded in IFC's AOI in May 2025. It's assessed that the efforts of enforcement agencies and weather likely helped curb the increase of incidents.

Contraband Smuggling: For the month of May, IFC reported a total of 54 incidents compared to 41 incidents last month (Apr). There has been a noticeable surge in drug smuggling, two times higher than previous month.

Irregular Human Migration: The IFC recorded a total of 12 incidents for the month of May, there was a high level of Rohingya activity this month, with three incidents occurring in the Bay of Bengal. Unfortunately two of the three vessels were reported to have sunk, resulting in the deaths of at least 427 people.

Environmental Security: Five Environmental Security incident was reported in May 2025. consisting of 4 cases of oil spill and 1 illegal disposal of waste

Cyber Security: One Cyber Security incident was reported in May 2025. A Japanese shipbuilding company was the victim of a ransomware attack.

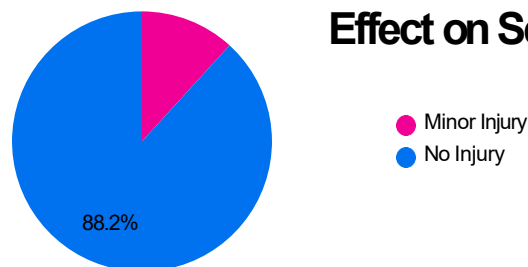

OBSERVATIONS

Statistics

- Total of 17 (Boardings) TRAPS incidents, increased compared to both May 2024 and May 2023 (10 incidents respectively).
- 16 incidents occurred in the Singapore Strait (SS) and 1 in Bangladesh. These incidents involved 10 bulk carriers, 5 tankers, 1 cargo vessel and 1 tug and barge.
- Of note, 14 incidents occurred during the Period of Darkness (PoD) and 3 incidents were recorded in the morning. All incidents occurred while vessels were underway less one, while it was alongside at harbour.

Singapore Strait (SS)

- 15 Sea Thefts and 1 Sea Robbery recorded while ships were underway: 15 incidents occurred in the Phillip Channel and 1 incident in the Eastbound Lane of Traffic Separation Scheme (TSS).
- Of the fifteen (15) incidents in Philip Channel, six (6) incidents [7, 17, 20, 22 23 and 27 May] involved perpetrators reportedly armed with knives and gun-like object respectively with one (1) confrontation reported [27 May]. Resulted from the confrontation, one (1) minor injury (head injury) was reported. Three (3) incidents [2, 20 and 23 May] reported engines spare parts stolen, and 3 drums of 20-litres of lube oil [23 May].
- Incident in the Eastbound Lane of TSS involved a tug and barge, however, no confrontation, no injury and no items stolen reported.
- All ships were able to continue their voyages to the next port without requiring any assistance.

Bangladesh

- 1 incident (Sea Robbery) occurred at Mongla Port, Bangladesh involving 1 general cargo vessel, Shejyoti. The incident involved fourteen armed robbers with reported stolen key equipment, fuel oil, food supplies, and crews' personal belongings, including mobile phones. Resulted from the confrontation, three crew members were injured and received medical aid onboard the vessel.

Comments

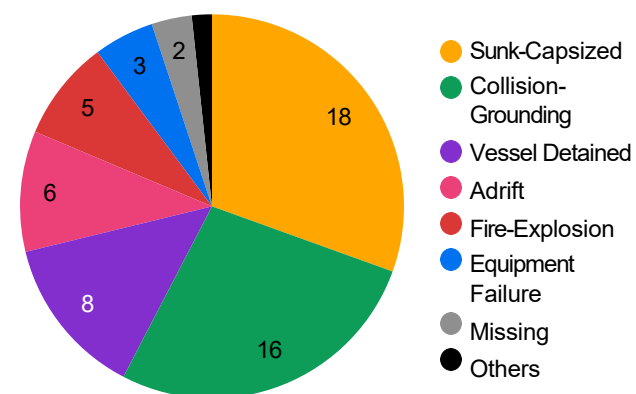
- The number of incidents in May 2025 is the second highest in 2025 thus far, especially in SS, likely attributed to heightened financial pressures in the lead-up to the June festivities, prompting some individuals to engage in petty crimes as a means of alleviating economic strain. Based on historical trends, incident numbers in June 2025 are expected to decline compared to earlier months of the year, primarily due to improved weather conditions in the South China Sea, which facilitate the resumption of fishing activities.
- Perpetrators continue to target vulnerable vessel types, particularly bulk carriers, tugs with barges including container vessels [freeboard 3 to 7m]. In line with previous trends, these vessels are likely to remain preferred targets due to their inherent characteristics, such as low operating speeds and low freeboard. IFC assesses that the perpetrators' modus operandi is expected to remain consistent, primarily involving acts of petty crime.
- All companies, sea users, and ship masters are advised to remain vigilant when transiting known hotspots such as the Phillip Channel waters off Batam and Bintan



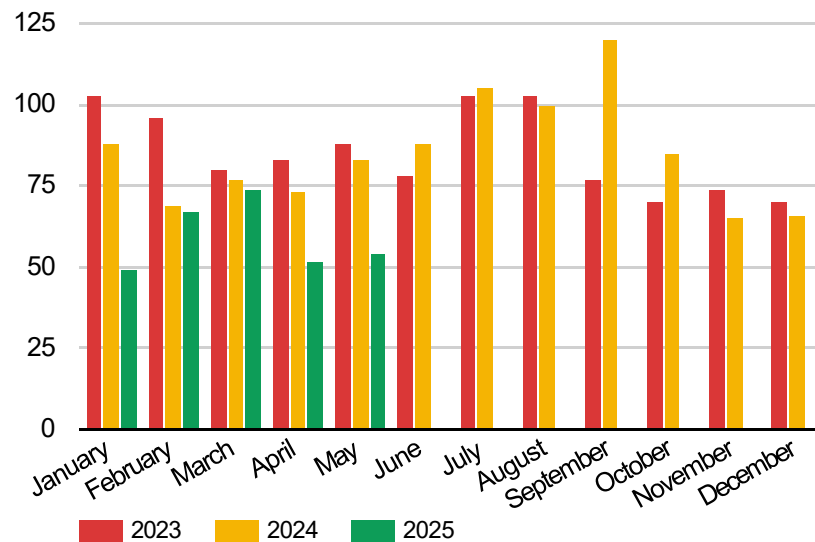
Maritime Incidents (MI)



Number of Vessels, by Type of Incident



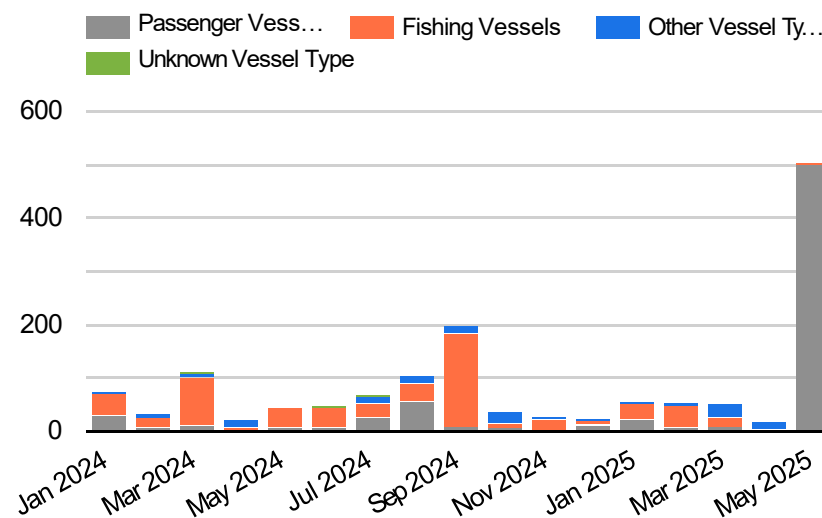

OBSERVATIONS

Statistics:

- A total of 54 maritime incidents were reported this month, which is lower than the figures recorded for the same period in 2024 (83) and 2023 (88) incidents.

- The largest number of reported incidents was sunk-capsized (18), followed by Collision Grounding(16), Vessel Detained(8) and Adrift(6).

- In terms of location, the highest number of reported incidents occurred in the waters of the Indonesia (12), ROK (11), Malaysia (10) and Philippines (7).

- A total of 516 individuals were reported dead or missing this month, which is more than the last month (18) also more than the same period in 2024 (46). Overall, 43 SAR operations were conducted, resulting in the rescue of 924 individuals during this month.

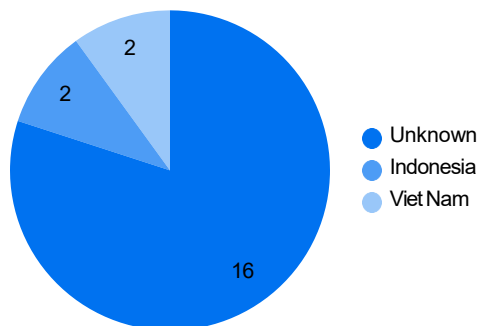
- There were no major storms in the IFC's AOI this month, however bad weather was still the most common reported incident cause(14 of 54 incidents).



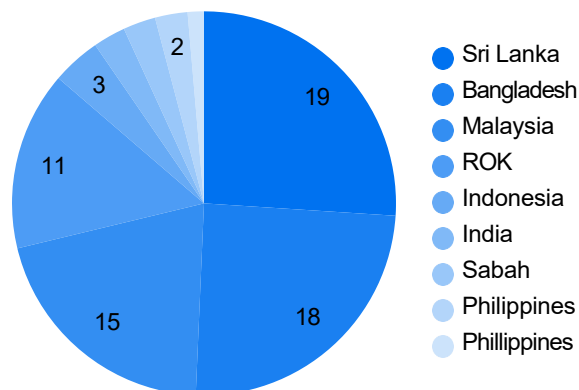
Illegal, Unreported, and Unregulated Fishing (IUUF)



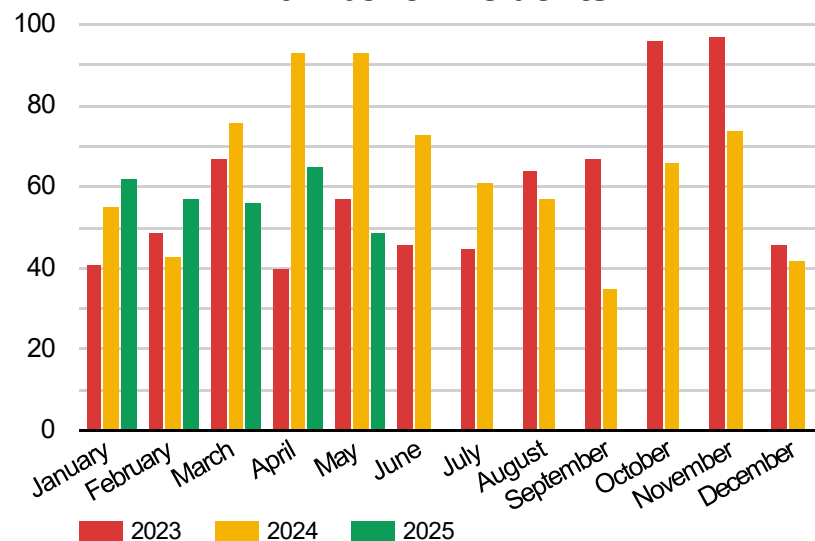
Number and Flag of Vessels, Poaching

OBSERVATIONS

Statistics :

• **Total** : 49 IUUF incidents were recorded in IFC's AOI in May 2025. This figure shows a significant decrease of 44 incidents compared to May 2024 (93), a little bit decrease of 8 incidents compared to May 2023 (57), as observed from the annual data (YoY). When viewed a comparison to the previous month (65), there was a slightly decrease of 16 incidents, reflecting a notable increase (MoM).

• **Local** : 36 local incidents were recorded in May 2025. This figure shows a lower value compared to May 2024 (69), but a slight increase on May 2023 (35) by 1 (YoY). When compared to the previous month (27), it increased 9 incidents (MoM).

• Majority of FVs involved in local incidents occurred in Sri Lanka with 19 FVs (26%), followed by the Bangladesh with 18 FVs (24.7%), Malaysia with 15 FVs (20.5%), ROK with 11 FVs (15.1%).

• **Poaching** : 13 poaching incidents were recorded in May 2025. This figure shows an annual increase in the same month, with 6 incidents compared to May 2024 (31), and 20 incidents compared to May 2023 (17) (YoY). When compared to the previous month (24), it increased by 13 incidents (MoM).

• The largest proportion of poaching incidents is unspecified nationality with 32 FVs (80%), followed by Viet Nam with 5 FVs (12.5%), China with 2 FVs (5%) and Indonesia with 1 FV (2.5%).

• **International** : NSTR.

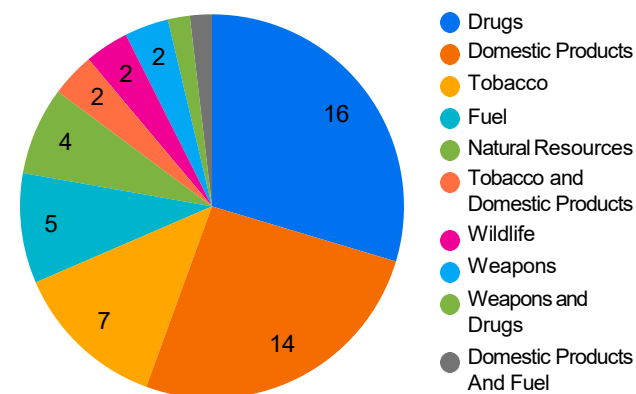
• The number of incidents this month decreased compared to the same month in the previous years (YoY), but slightly increase when compared to the last month (MoM). The major contributor to this downward trend is local incidents, it's assessed that the efforts of enforcement agencies likely helped curb the increase of incidents. We will continue to monitor the changes on data, taking various variables into consideration.



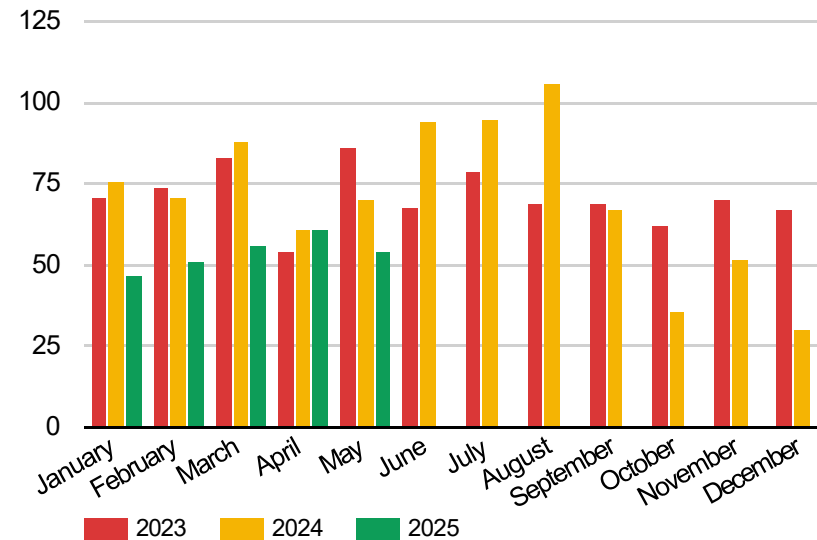
Contraband Smuggling (CS)



Types of Smuggled Goods



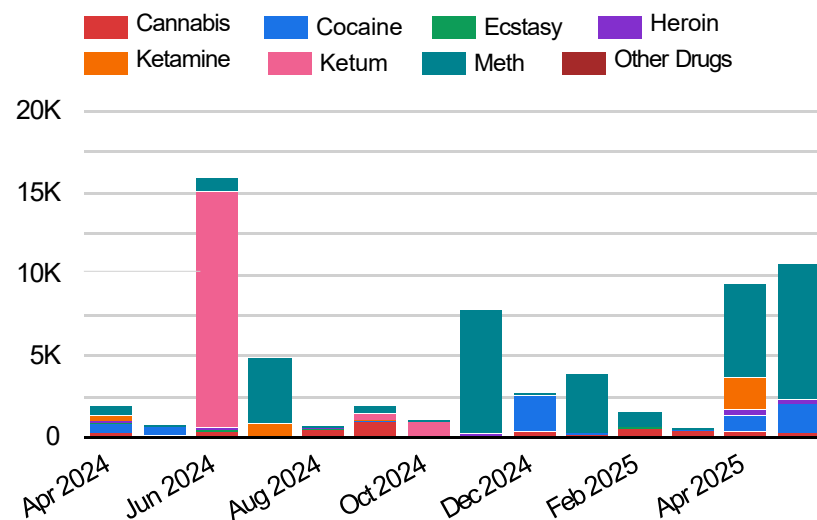

OBSERVATIONS

Statistics:

In May 2025, IFC recorded 54 contraband smuggling incidents.

Drugs (x17, 10,076.6kg): Indonesia(x6, Meth7,501.5kg), Bangladesh(x4, Meth 360,000Pills, Anesthetic), Malaysia (x3 Meth 300kg, Cannabis 409 Packs, Synthetic drugs 179 Litres), Sri Lanka (x2 Meth 503.6kg, Heroin 275.5kg, Cannabis 301.1kg), Australia (x1 Cocaine 1,400kg), ROK (x1 Cocaine 720kg).

Fuel (x6 132,000 litres): Vietnam (x2, Diesel 130,000 litres), Indonesia (x1 Diesel 2,200kg), India(x1 Petrol 600 Liters), Sabah (x1, Petrol 16 Barrels), Malaysia (x1 Petrol 64.4Liters).

Domestic Products (x15 7,108kg): Indonesia (x9), Bangladesh(x3), Thailand(x1), Sri Lanka (x1), Sabah (x1).

Natural Resources (x4, 21,568.4kg): Sri Lanka (x3), Indonesia (x1).

Wildlife (x2): Malaysia (x1), Indonesia (x1).

Tobacco (x8, 7378 cases): Philippines (x3), Indonesia (x1), China (x1), Singapore(x1), Bangladesh(x1), Brunei (x1).

Weapons (x2): Indonesia (x2 Air Rifle 88).

Comments:

- For this month, IFC reported a total of 54 incidents compared to 41 incidents last month. But was lower compared to the same period in the previous years.

- Compared to last month, drug smuggling surged significantly almost two times higher, Particularly, we have seen the big volume of drugs siezed in Indonesia. Fuel seizures decreased by about 30 %. Tobacco cases have increased slightly , but the individual seizures were smaller. Wildlife smuggling cases remained stable.

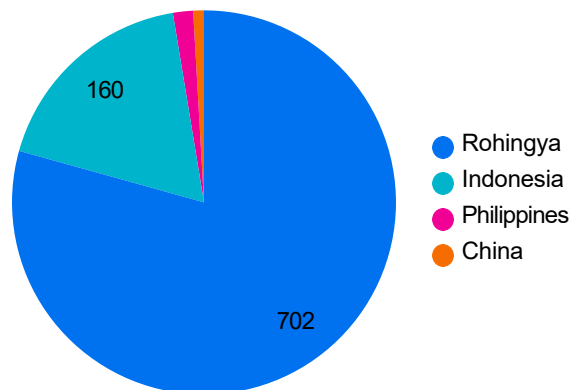
- With Drugs smuggling being the major part of incidents this month, followed by Domestic Products, but low volume of domestic products were siezed for each incideetns. Off Note, Weapons smuggling was seen moving in Indonesia water for at least two times.



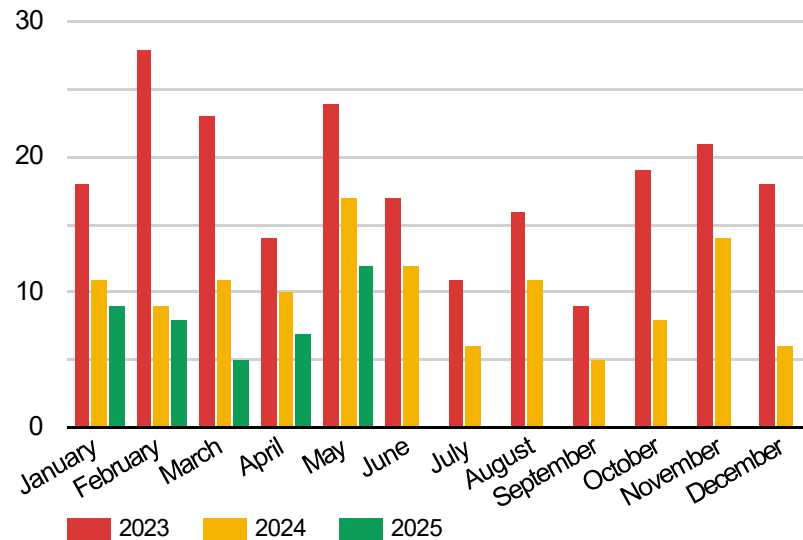
Irregular Human Migration (IHM)



Number and Nationality/Ethnicity of Migrants



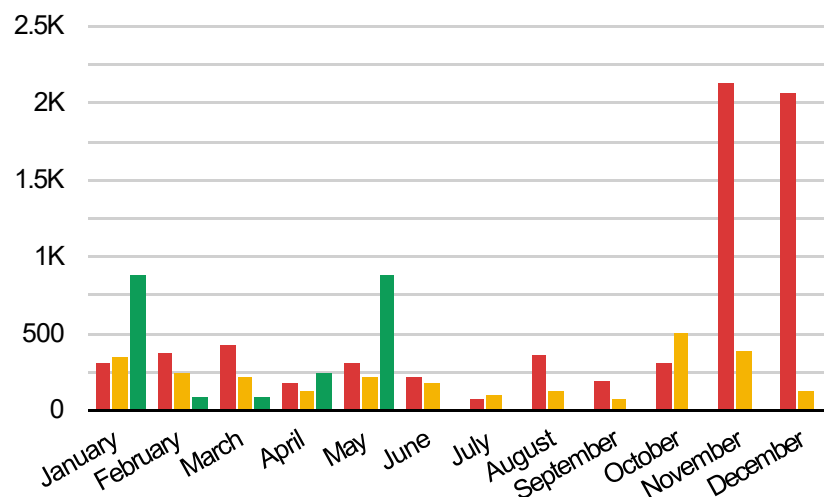

Statistics:

• **12 incidents were recorded this month** - with all twelve classified as routine Irregular Human Migration (IHM) incidents, and two classified as .

Comments:

• Incidents this month were varied, both geographically and by nationality of migrants. The increase in May over the preceding months is in line with historical trends

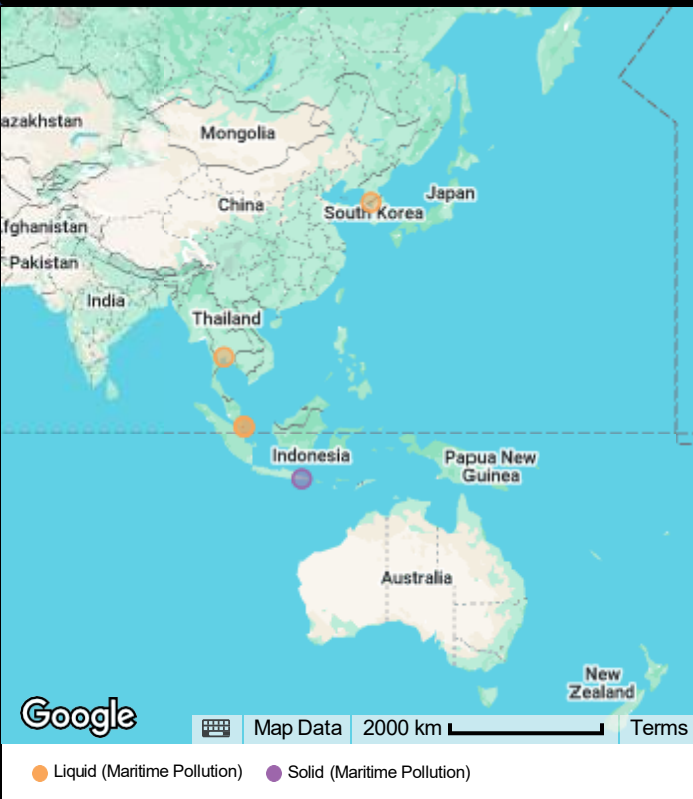
• There was a high level of Rohingya activity this month, with three incidents occurring in the Bay of Bengal. This is late in the year for Rohingya IHM due to the increasingly adverse weather at this time of year. Unfortunately two of the three vessels were reported to have sunk, resulting in the deaths of at least 427 people.

• IHM activity remains a concern, with a historical peak in May and June as people take advantage of the warmer and drier weather in south east Asia during these months.

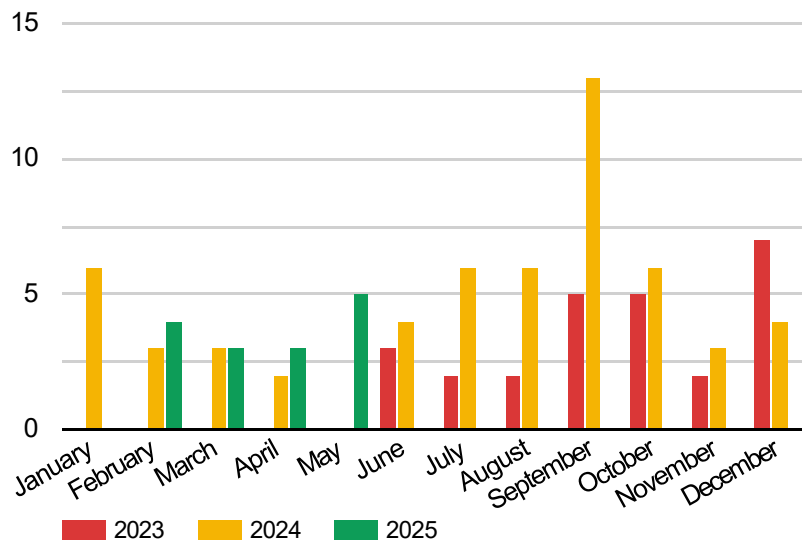

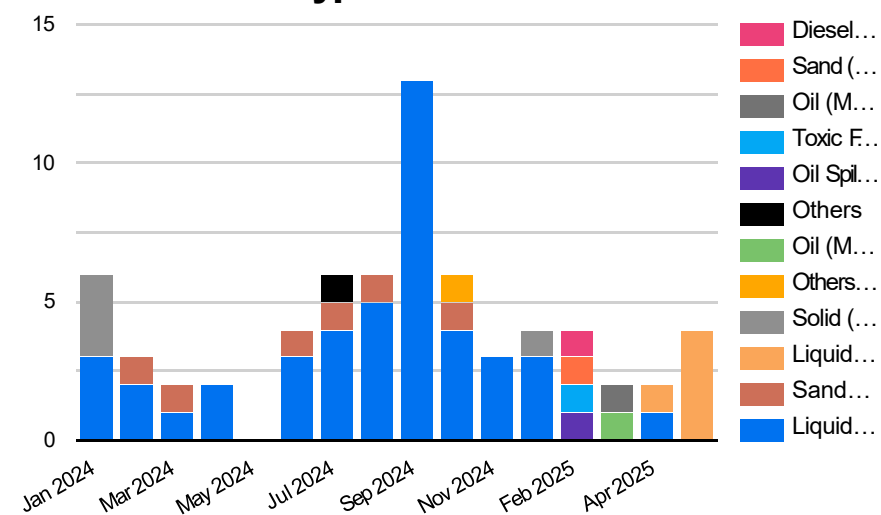

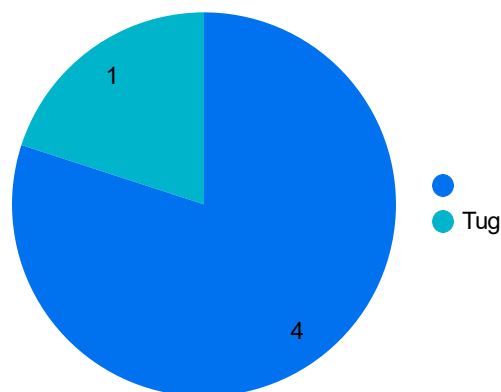

Comments:

- There was one Cyber Security incident reported this month.
- Japanese shipbuilding company NSS was targeted by the "Qilin Group" and fell victim to a ransomware attack. The breach was reported on May 6th, 2025 and resulted in the theft of internal documents.

Although the number of reported Cyber Security incidents is down this year, the true number of attacks is likely much higher. All maritime stakeholders are urged to follow cyber security best practices and report all attacks, successful and otherwise, to the appropriate authorities.





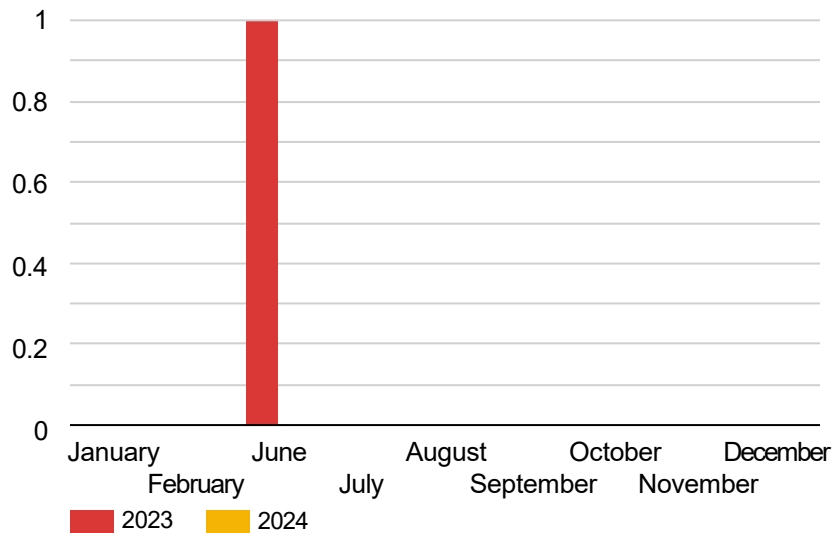

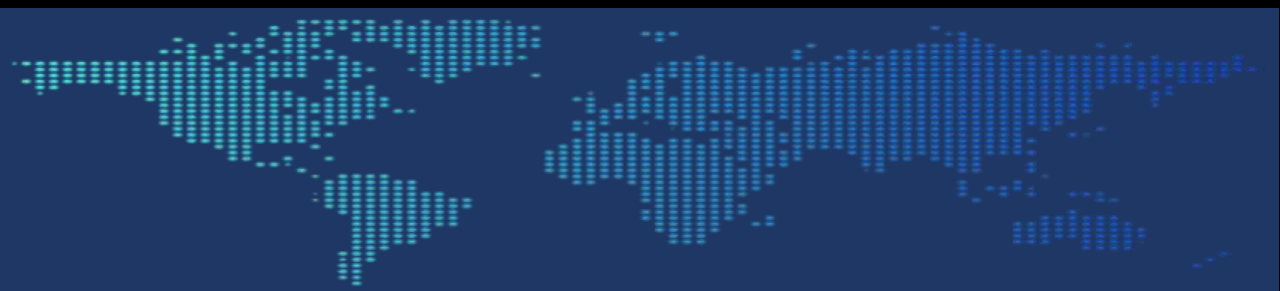

IFC Recommendations



1. All mariners to report any maritime security incidents timely to the nearest coastal state and inform the IFC at the earliest possible time.
2. All mariners are strongly recommended to be vigilant, in particularly when operating in IFC identified hotspots (**Westbound lane of Traffic Separation Scheme in Singapore Strait, Eastbound lane of Traffic Separation Scheme in Singapore Strait, Belawan and Dumai Anchorages in Indonesia, Manila Anchorage in the Philippines, and Chittagong Outer Anchorage in Bangladesh**).
3. All mariners are advised to adopt **Ship Protection Measures** recommended in the Regional Guide to Counter Piracy and Armed Robbery Against Ships in Asia (e.g., illuminating the accommodation block and poop deck, deploying sentries and increase frequency of security rounds).
4. All mariners to take note on the description of the perpetrators and to take photos of the perpetrators if possible. Where available, CCTV footage capturing the incident should be provided to the coastal state authorities for follow-on investigation.
5. All mariners are advised to participate in **IFC Voluntary Community Reporting (VCR)** as depicted in MARSEC Chart Q6112 and Q6113. In case of any doubt, incident at sea, suspicious approach or unusual observed activity at sea, please contact the IFC Duty Officer:

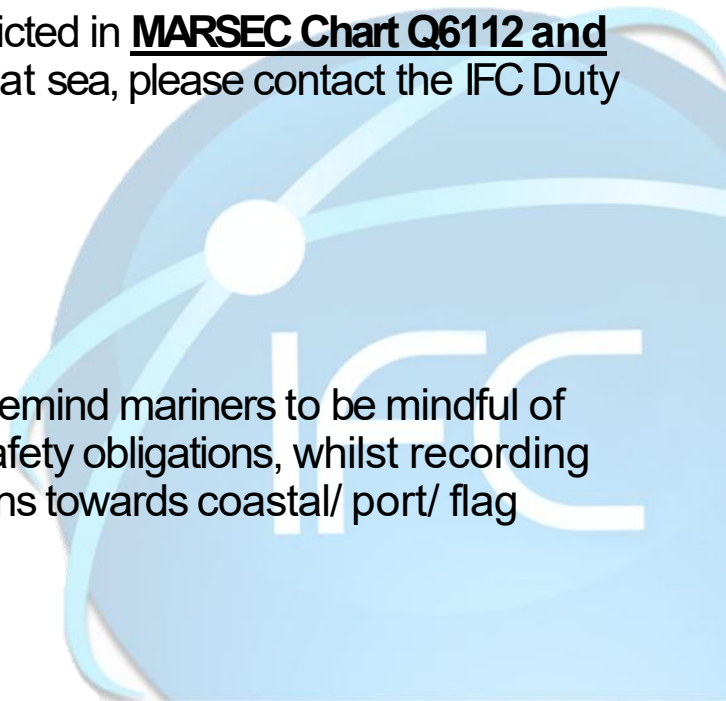
