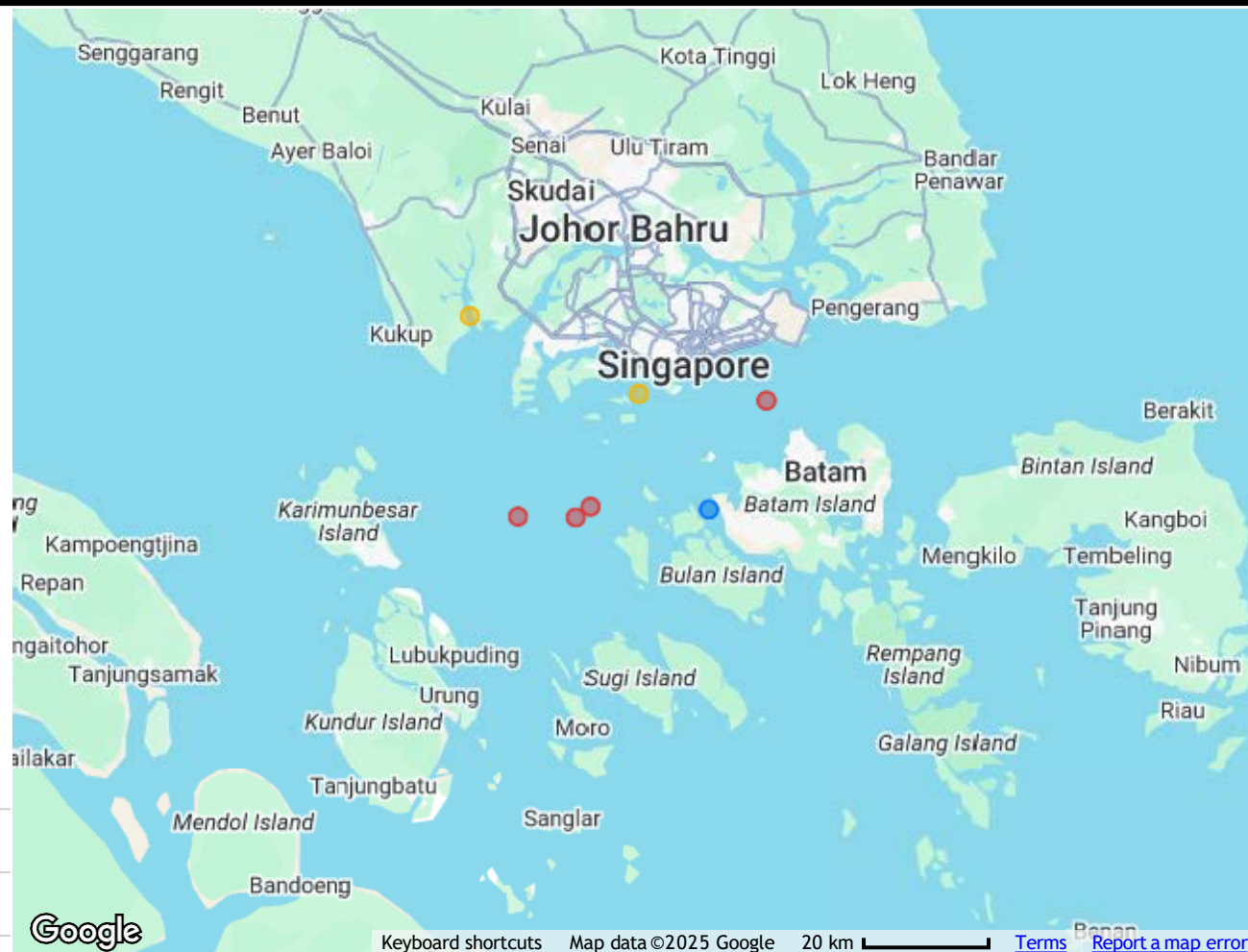
Overview of MARSEC Incidents in the Singapore Strait

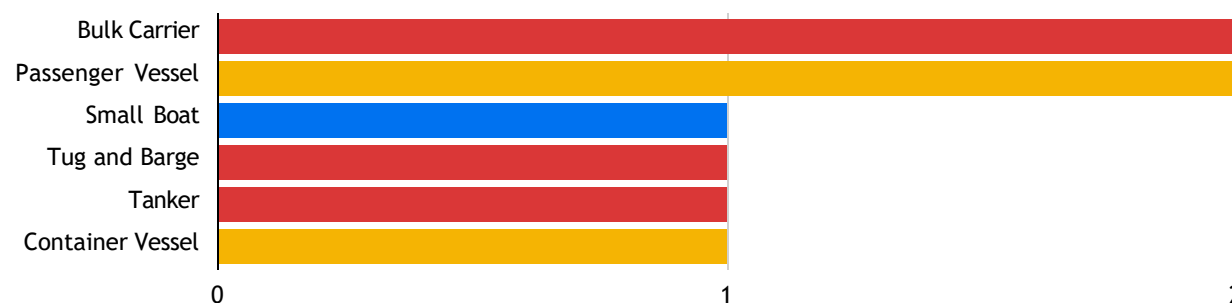

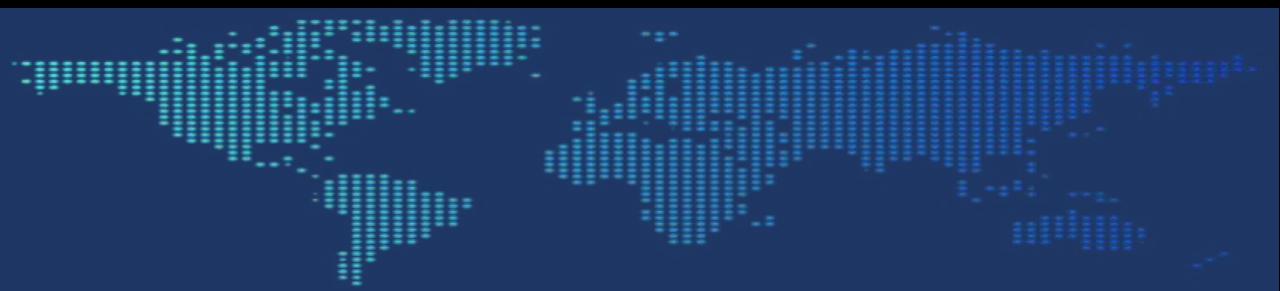

Executive Summary



Theft, Robbery and Piracy at Sea: 6 TRAPS in Nov 2025 throughout the AOI. This marks a decrease as compared to Nov 2024 (11) and Nov 2023 (9). To note, 4 incidents occurred in Singapore Strait (SS), 1 off Belawan, Indonesia and 1 on an unmanned oil rig off Terengganu, Malaysia.

Maritime Incidents: 57 MI were reported in Nov 2025. This month, Bad Weather conditions were the leading cause of reported incidents, accounting for 24 of the 61 cases. Severe tropical cyclones, including Typhoons Kalmaegi and Fung-wong, inflicted extensive damage, particularly across the Philippines and Vietnam.

Illegal, Unreported, and Unregulated Fishing: 41 IUUF incidents were reported in Nov 2025, reflecting a sustained long-term downward trend compared to the same period in 2024 and 2023 despite minor month-to-month fluctuations. Local and poaching activity similarly declined overall, with lower incident volumes across most regions, reaffirming the continued reduction in IUUF activities throughout 2025

Contraband Smuggling: 47 CS incidents were reported in Nov 2025, lower than previous months with drug smuggling showing a significant drop and Australia emerging as the primary hotspot for larger-vessel drug movements. Domestic-product smuggling and fuel-seizure activity also saw slight declines, with Bangladesh accounting for most domestic-product cases during the month.

Irregular Human Migration: 6 IHM incidents were reported in Nov 2025. Routine small-boat movements from Indonesia and the Philippines into Malaysia continued, consistent with established irregular-human-movement patterns, with overall activity expected to rise during the October-February peak crossing season

Environmental Security: 1 ENVSEC incident was reported in Nov 2025, involving illegal dumping of waste oil by a fishing vessel near Gamcheon Port in Busan.

Cyber Security: 2 CYBSEC incident reported in Nov 2025. The incidents were observed in the South China Sea involving vessels broadcasting falsified identities and non-existent flags. Both cases highlight continued misuse of AIS for deceptive positioning, prompting ongoing monitoring by relevant maritime authorities.

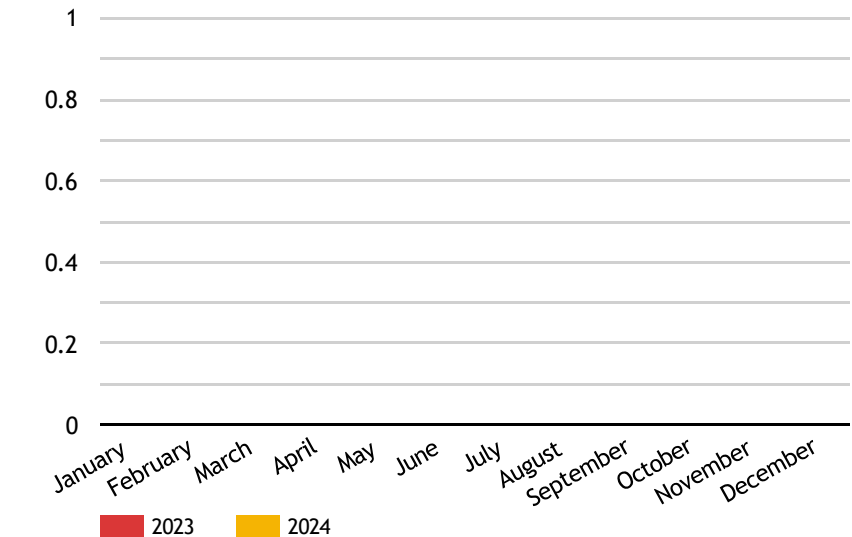

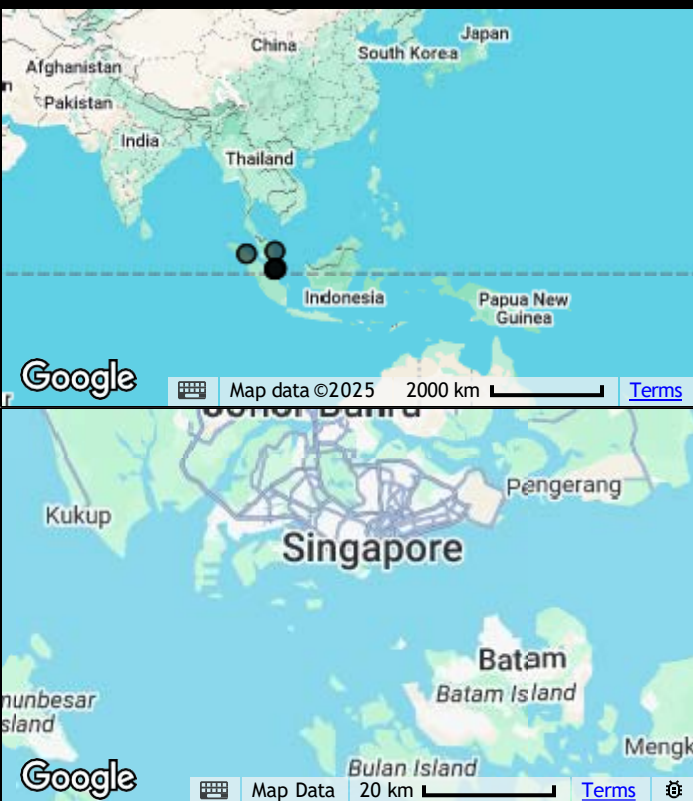

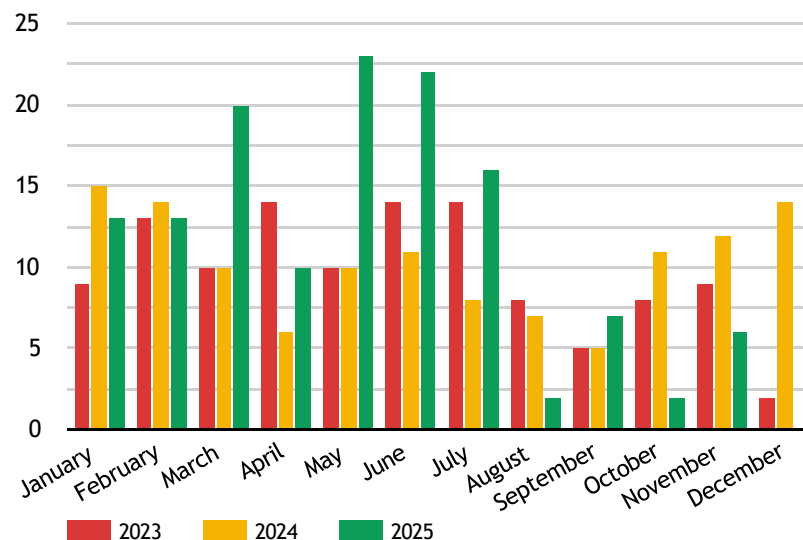




Theft, Robbery and Piracy at Sea (TRAPS)



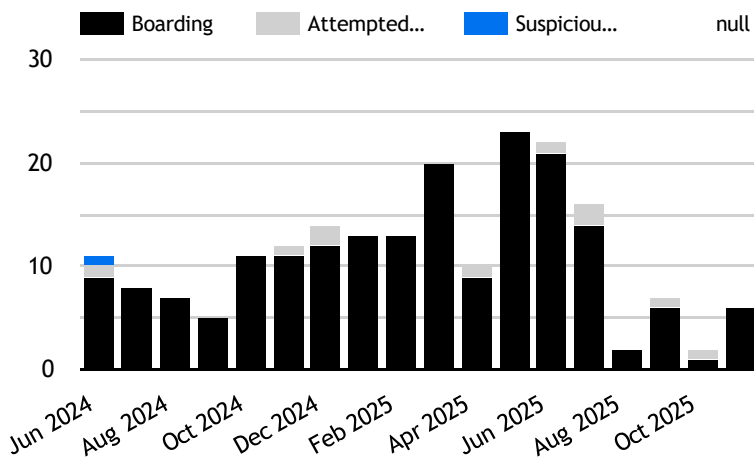

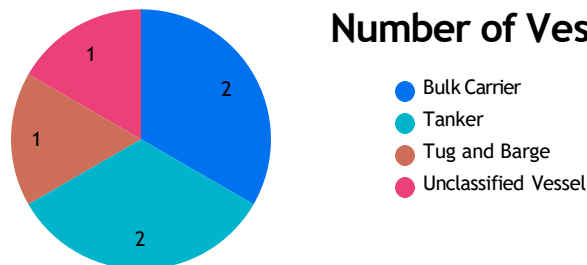

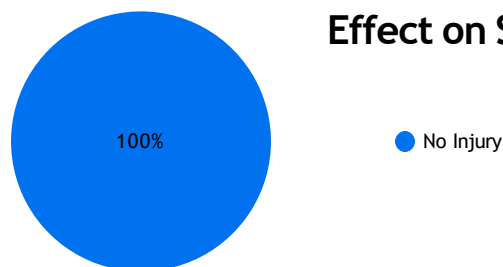

OBSERVATIONS

Statistics.

- Total of 6 (Boarding) TRAPS incidents in Nov 2025 represented a decrease compared to the same period in 2024 (11), and 2023 (9).
- Of note, 5 incidents occurred during the Period of Darkness (PoD) whilst 1 incident during daylight hours.

Singapore Strait (SS).

- 5 Sea Theft incidents recorded while the vessels were underway; 3 in the Philip Channel and 2 in Eastbound Lane of Traffic Separation Scheme (TSS).
- 3 incidents in the Philip Channel, one incident [24 Nov] involved perpetrators reportedly armed with knives. Of note, no confrontation nor injury were reported and one (1) incident [16 Nov] reported ship items stolen.
- 1 incident in Eastbound Lane of TSS, involving tug and barge occurred during daylight hours when several sampans approached the barge, and unarmed perpetrators boarded. No confrontation and some scrap metal were stolen.

Belawan Anchorage, Indonesia.

- 1 Sea Theft incident reported involving 3 perpetrators and escaped with some ship items once the alarm were raised. All crew members were safe.

Terengganu, Malaysia.

- 1 Sea Theft incident reported on an unmanned oil rig, involving 4 perpetrators and all were detained with traces of dismantled parts such as cut cables, piled-up batteries, food containers and equipment used, namely cable cutters.

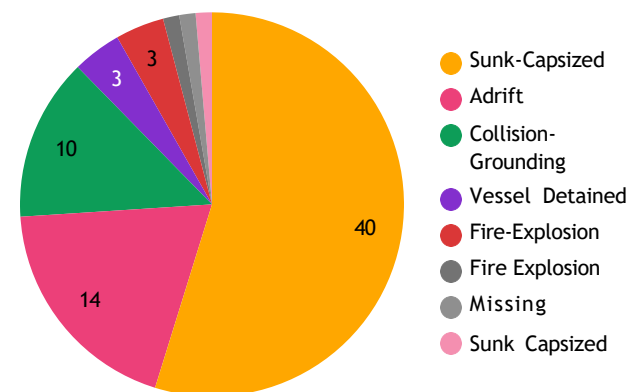
- Nov 2025 recorded an increase compared to previous month of Oct 2025 (2) particularly in SS likely due to combined effects of (a) prevailing Northeast Monsoon, resulting in unfavourable fishing conditions in the South China Sea that may resort to petty crime to supplement their income; and (b) deterrent effect of enforcement operations starting to wane, leading to a rebound in incidents as opportunistic perpetrators quickly adapted.
- Modus operandi remained largely consistent with petty crime, and are opportunistic in nature (majority no confrontation reported).
- All companies, sea users, and ship masters are advised to remain vigilant when transiting known hotspots, Phillip Channel, waters off Batam and Bintan islands.



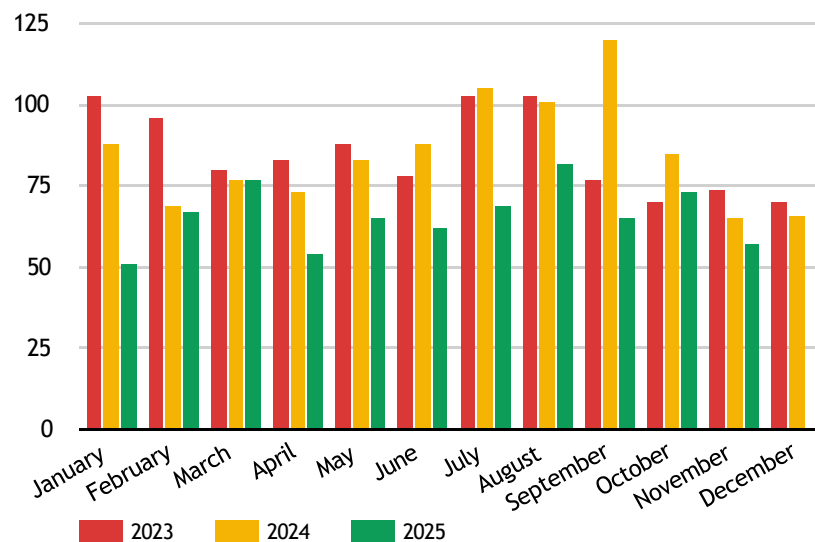
Maritime Incidents (MI)



Number of Vessels, by Type of Incident



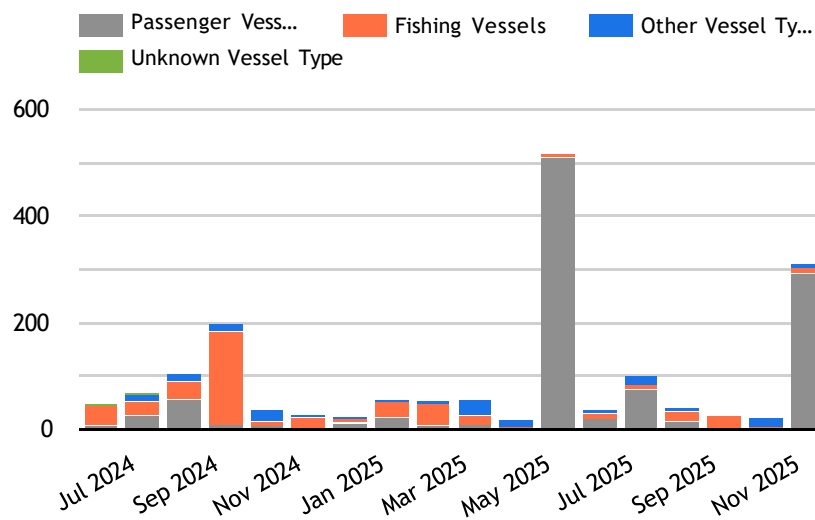

Statistics:

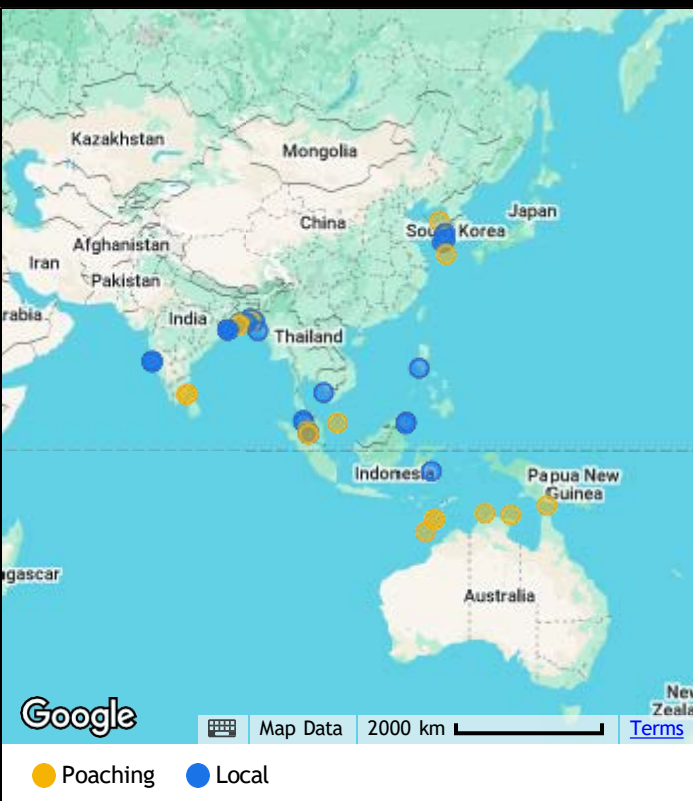
- A total of 57 Maritime Incidents were reported this month, which is lower than the figures recorded for the same period in 2024 (65) and 2023 (74) incidents.
- The largest number of reported incidents was sunk-capsized (31), followed by adrift (13), then collision-grounding (7).
- In terms of location, the highest number of reported incidents occurred in the waters of Vietnam (20), Thailand (7), Philippines (7), and Malaysia (7).
- A total of (315) individuals were reported dead or missing this month, which is higher than the last month (23). Overall, 50 SAR operations were conducted, resulting in the rescue of 936 individuals during this month.

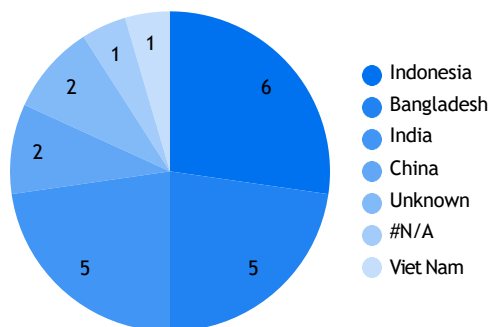
- This month, bad weather conditions were the leading cause of reported incidents, accounting for 24 of the 57 cases. Severe tropical cyclones, including Typhoons Kalmaegi and Fung-wong, inflicted extensive damage, particularly across the Philippines and Vietnam.



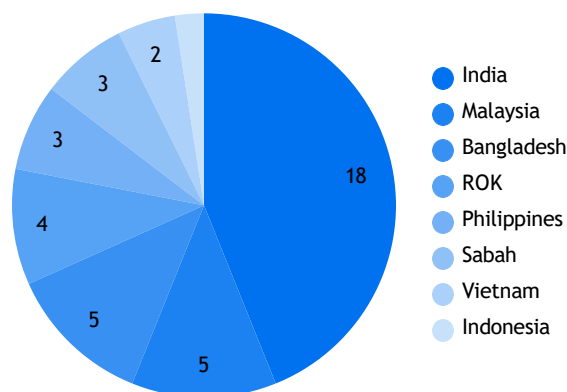
Illegal, Unreported, and Unregulated Fishing (IUUF)



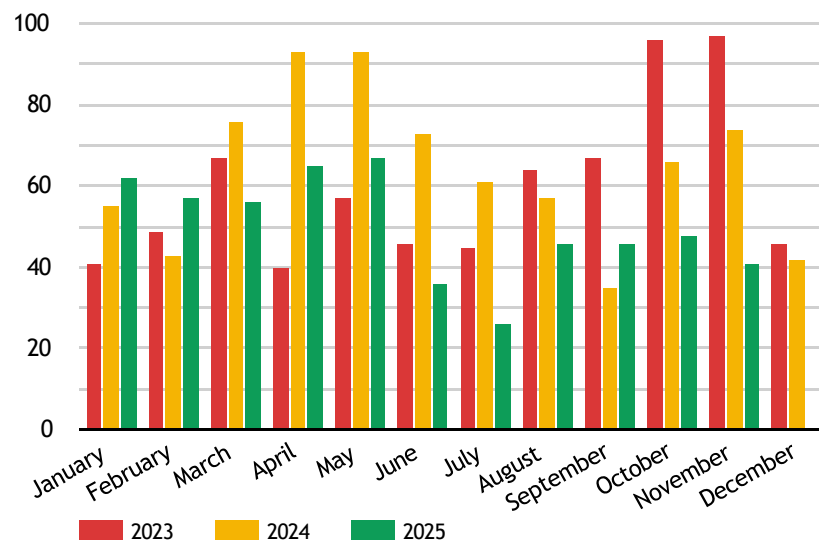
Number and Flag of Vessels, Poaching

OBSERVATIONS

Statistics :

• A total of 41 IUUF incidents were recorded in Nov 2025, marking a notable decrease compared with the same period in 2024 (74) and 2023 (97). While this figure reflects a decrease of 7 incidents compared to Oct 2025 (48), reflecting a continued long-term downward trend in IUUF incidents despite minor month-to-month fluctuations.

• **Local:** A total of 25 local IUUF incidents were reported in Nov 2025, representing an increase compared to the same period in 2024 (16 incidents) and no change compared to 2023 (25 incidents). Notably 8 incidents lower than Oct 2025 (33 incidents), reinforcing a continued downward trend in local activity.

• The majority of local incidents occurred in India (18 incidents; 43.9%), followed by Malaysia and Bangladesh (5; 12.2%), ROK (4; 9.8%), The Philippines and Sabah Malaysia (3; 7.3%), Viet Nam (2; 4.9%), and Indonesia (1; 2.4%).

• **Poaching:** A total of 16 poaching incidents were recorded in Nov 2025, which is significantly lower compared to 2024 (58) and 2023 (72). While this figure reflects a slightly increase of 1 incidents compared to Oct (15), indicating a short-term rise despite no clear long-term upward trend.

• The largest proportion of poaching incidents involved Indonesian vessels (6 incidents; 27.3%), followed by Bangladesh and India (5 incidents; 22.7%), China (2; 9.1%), Viet Nam (1; 4.5%), and vessels of unknown nationality (3 incidents; 13.6%).

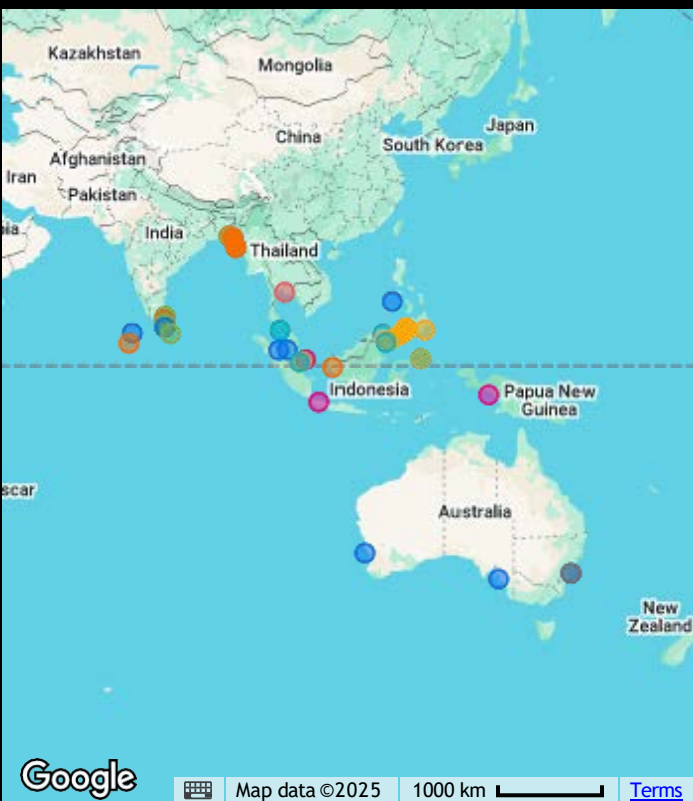

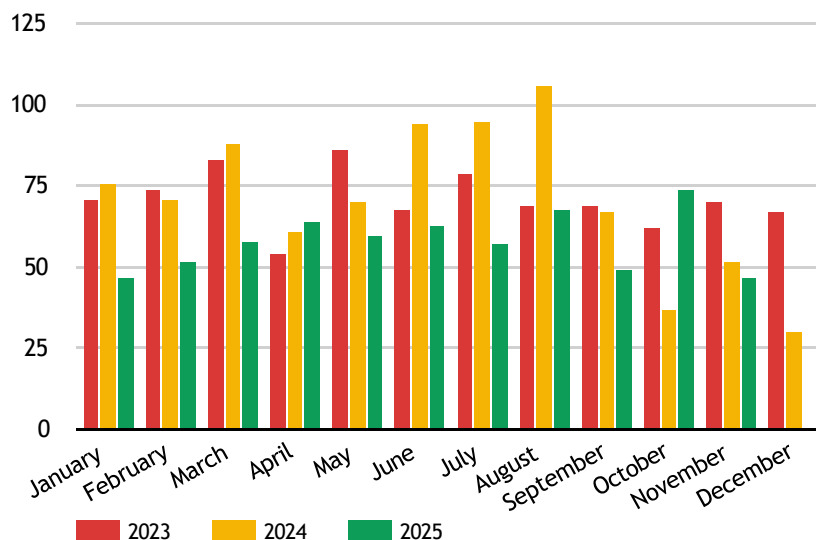
• Overall IUUF incidents continue to decline, though recent increases in local and poaching activity highlight the need for ongoing monitoring and adaptive enforcement.



Contraband Smuggling (CS)



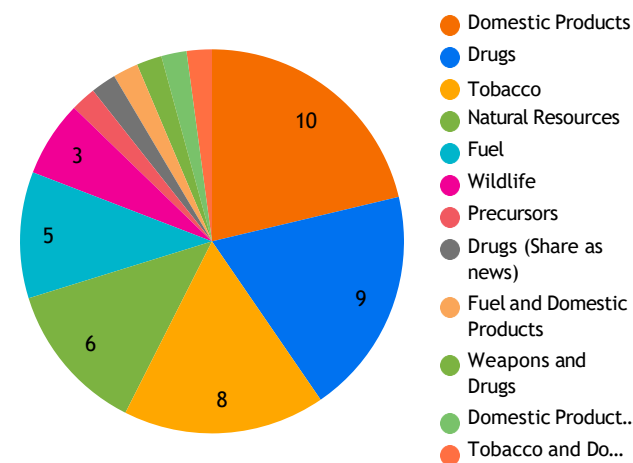

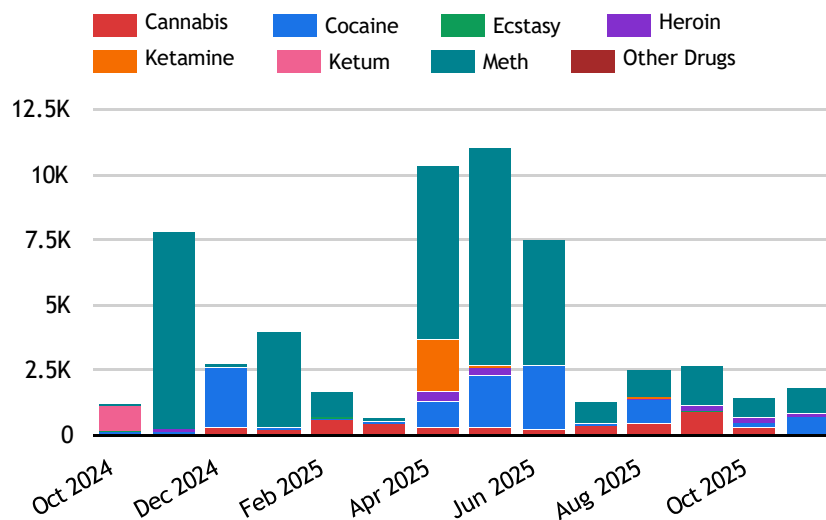

OBSERVATIONS

Statistics:

Total of 47 CS incidents in Nov 2025. This represented a significant decreased as compared to the same period in 2024 (52), and 2023 (70).

Drugs (x9, 1,432.5kg): Australia (x3 Cocaine 670kg, Meth 3kg), Sri Lanka(Cannabis 38kg, Heroin 350kg), Indonesia (Meth 1.5kg), Malaysia(Meth 45kg), Philippines(Cocaine 25kg), Maldive (Heroin and Meth 300kg).

Fuel (x5 49,692.8Liters): Sabah (x2 Diesel 3,200 Liters, Petrol 37 Jerry cans), Indonesia (Diesel 40 tons). Malaysia (Petrol 570 Litres & Diesel 450 Litres), Thailand (Diesel 8,000 Litres).

Domestic Products (x10 33,950kg): Bangladesh (x6), Indonesia (x2), Sri Lanka (x1), Maldive (x1).

Natural Resources (x6, 144,199kg): Sri Lanka (x5), Bangladesh(x1).

Comments:

- The IFC reported a decrease in CS incidents in Nov 2025 compared to Oct, with incident levels remaining comparable to those observed in Sept 2025.

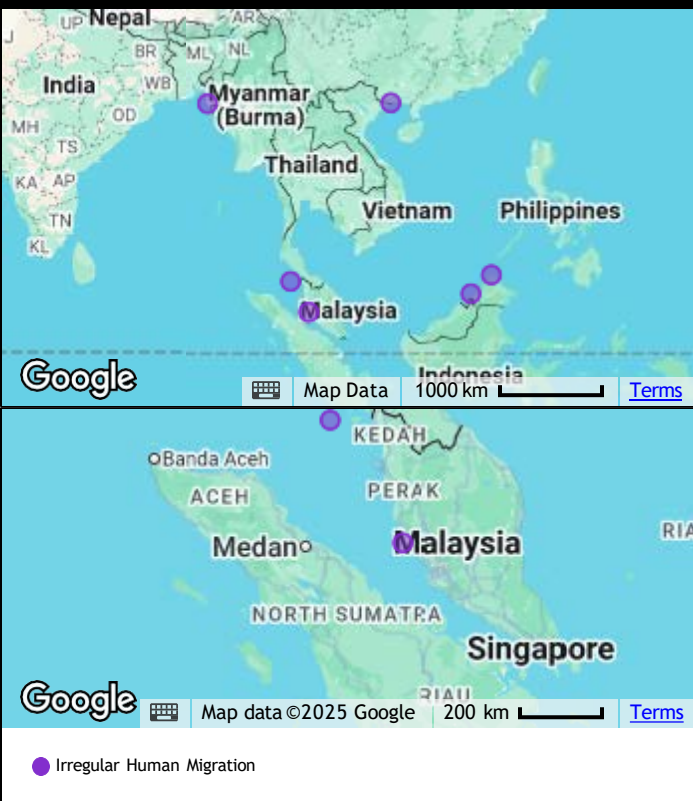
- Drug smuggling activity was the second-largest contributor to CS incidents, recording more than a two-fold decrease from the previous month (22 incidents). Australia registered the highest number of drug related incidents this month, indicating that smugglers may have used larger vessels to transport narcotics into the country. Heroin-related incidents were also recorded in the Indian Ocean region, particularly around Sri Lanka and the Maldives. Fuel-seizure reports remained consistent with last month's figures..

- Fuel-seizure reports remained consistent with last month's figures.

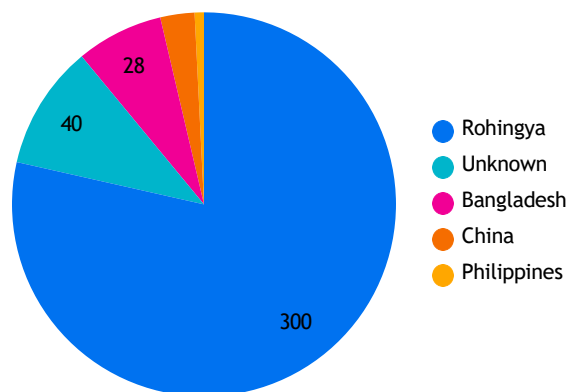
- Domestic-product smuggling recorded a slight decrease compared to the previous month (12 incidents). Bangladesh accounted for the majority of cases, possibly due to the demand for daily-use goods among Bangladeshi communities residing in Myanmar.



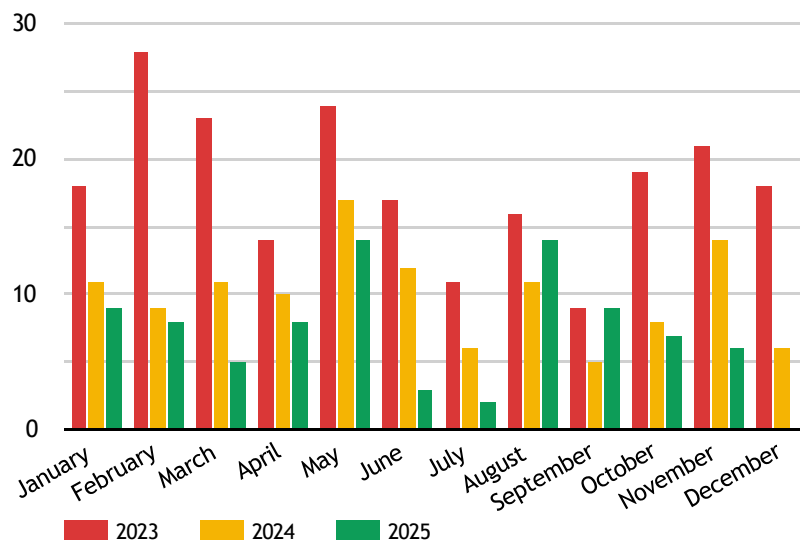
Irregular Human Migration (IHM)



Number and Nationality/Ethnicity of Migrants



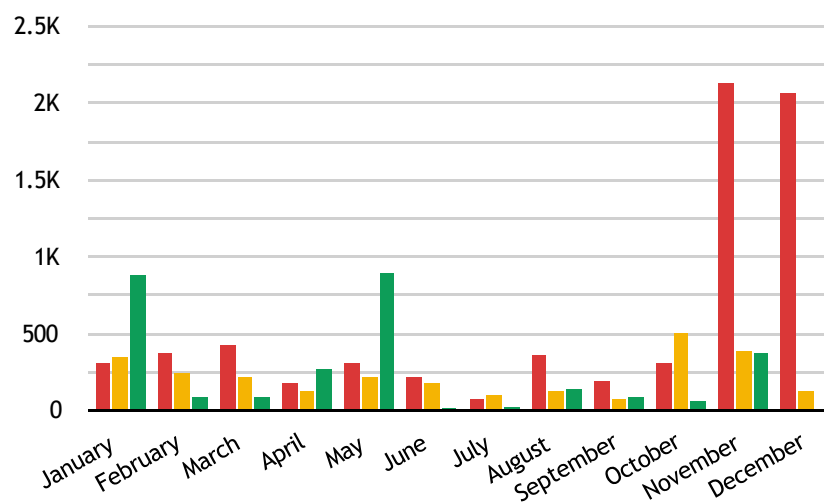

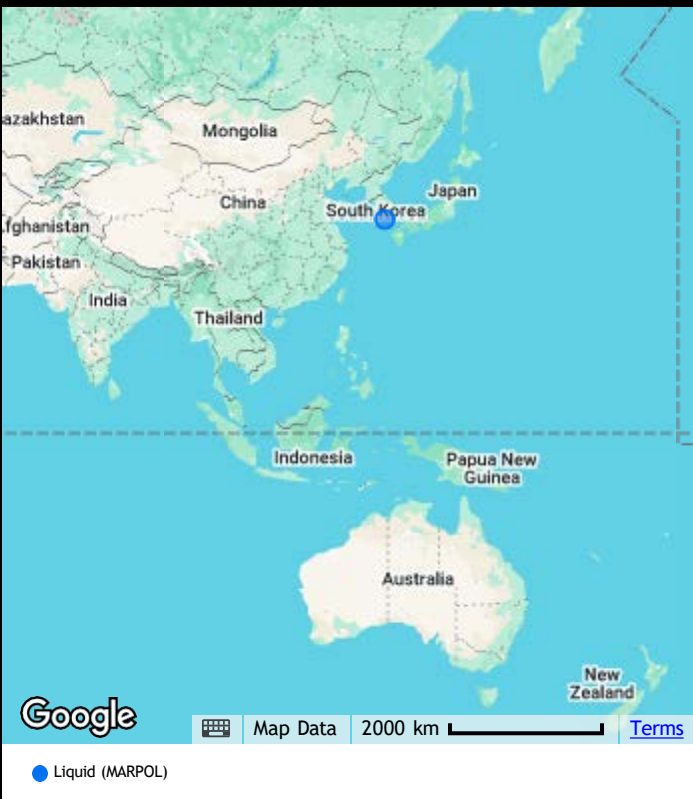
- Total of 6 IHM incidents were reported in Nov 2025 - all classified as routine Irregular Human Migration.

Comments:

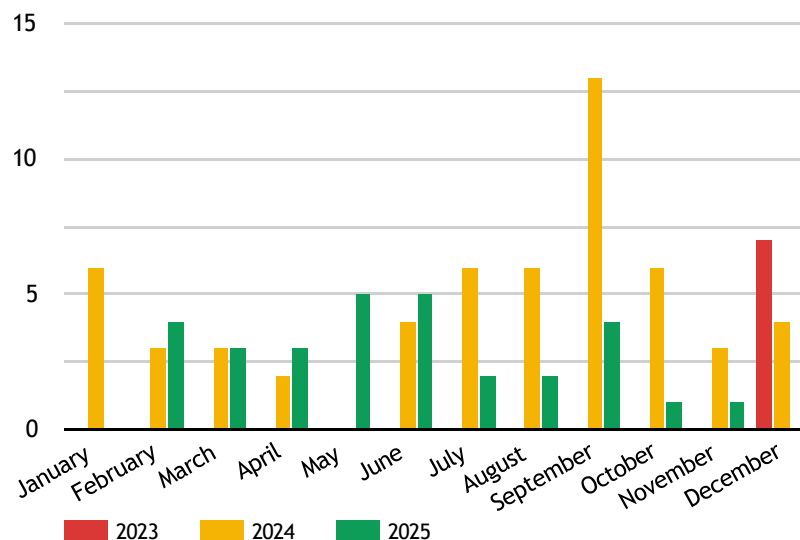
- Three out of the six incidents were small boat movements from Indonesia or Philippines into Malaysia, and likely related to illegal migrant labour. This activity is routine and consistent with IHM patterns in the region.
- Two incidents involved Rohingya and possibly other Myanmar or Bangladesh persons travelling out of the Bay of Bengal to Malaysia or Indonesia. One small vessel was intercepted by Bangladesh coast guard carrying 28 people, and the second vessel was involved in a SOLAS incident near the Malaysia/Thailand board. Of the approximately 70 people believed to be on board, under 20 survivors were recovered. In addition, this boat is believed to be a skiff from a larger vessel, carrying 230 additional people, which has not been located. Bay of Bengal crossings historically peak from October to February due to conducive weather, and it is likely IFC will receive further reports of these incidents in the next few months.
- There was one report of Chinese IHM being arrested while attempting to return to China to Vietnam via small boat.
- Overall IHM is slightly lowered this November compared to previous years. This is likely due to the series of storms that have impacted South East Asia in the last month..

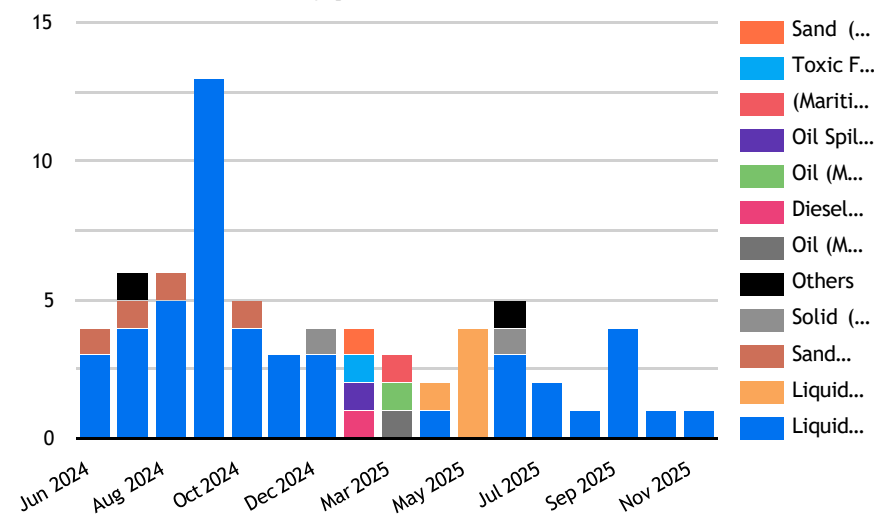

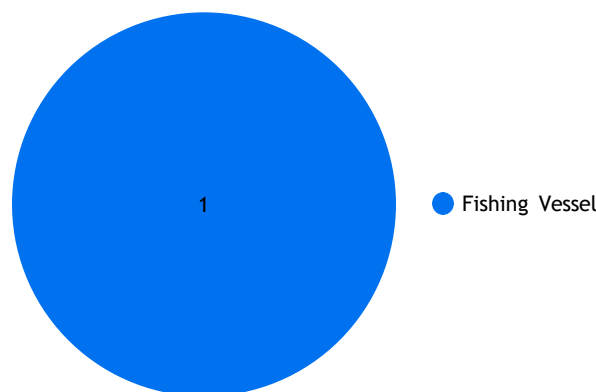

Vessels/Organisations Involved



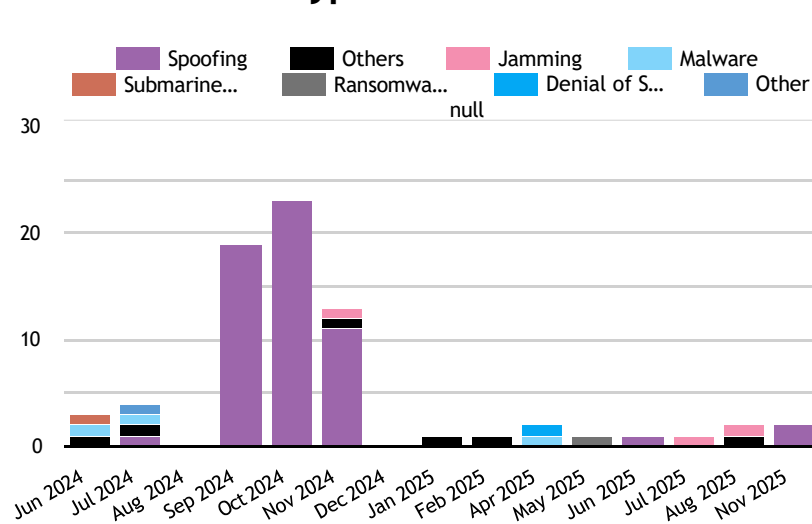

Comments:

- 2 AIS spoofing incidents were recorded in early Nov 2025 in the South China Sea, involving falsified vessel identities and deceptive AIS transmissions.
- The first case, 5 Nov, involved a counterfeit signal impersonating the container vessel MAERSK NOMAZWE, while the second case, 2 Nov, featured a tanker broadcasting a fabricated identity and non-existent flag off Johor, prompting continued monitoring.

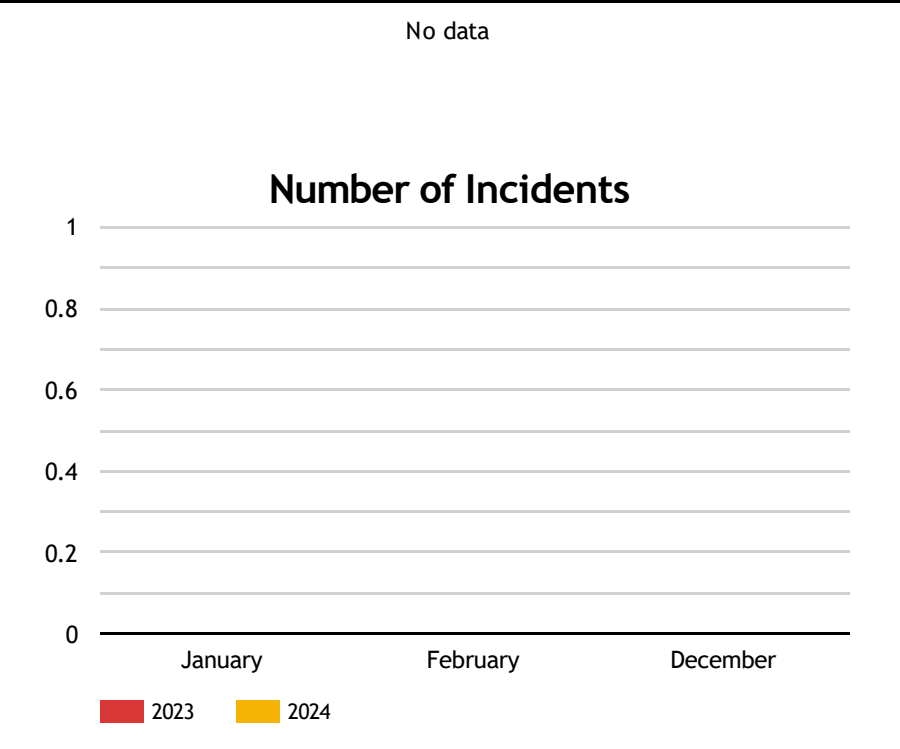

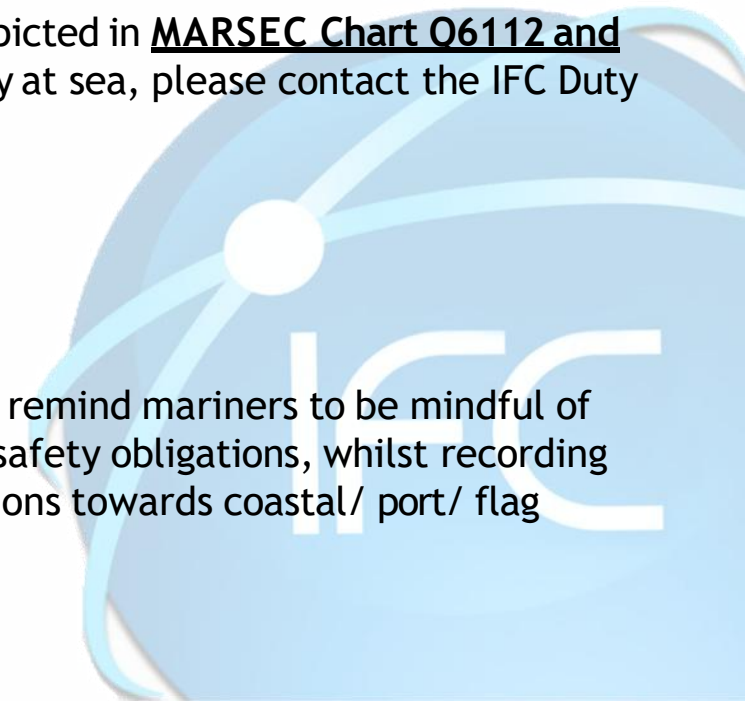


IFC Recommendations



1. All mariners to report any maritime security incidents timely to the nearest coastal state and inform the IFC at the earliest possible time.
2. All mariners are strongly recommended to be vigilant, in particularly when operating in IFC identified hotspots (**Westbound lane of Traffic Separation Scheme in Singapore Strait, Eastbound lane of Traffic Separation Scheme in Singapore Strait, Belawan and Dumai Anchorages in Indonesia, Manila Anchorage in the Philippines, and Chittagong Outer Anchorage in Bangladesh**).
3. All mariners are advised to adopt **Ship Protection Measures** recommended in the **Regional Guide to Counter Piracy and Armed Robbery Against Ships in Asia** (e.g., illuminating the accommodation block and poop deck, deploying sentries and increase frequency of security rounds).
4. All mariners to take note on the description of the perpetrators and to take photos of the perpetrators if possible. Where available, CCTV footage capturing the incident should be provided to **the coastal state authorities** for follow-on investigation.
5. All mariners are advised to participate in **IFC Voluntary Community Reporting (VCR)** as depicted in **MARSEC Chart O6112 and O6113**. In case of any doubt, incident at sea, suspicious approach or unusual observed activity at sea, please contact the IFC Duty Officer:
