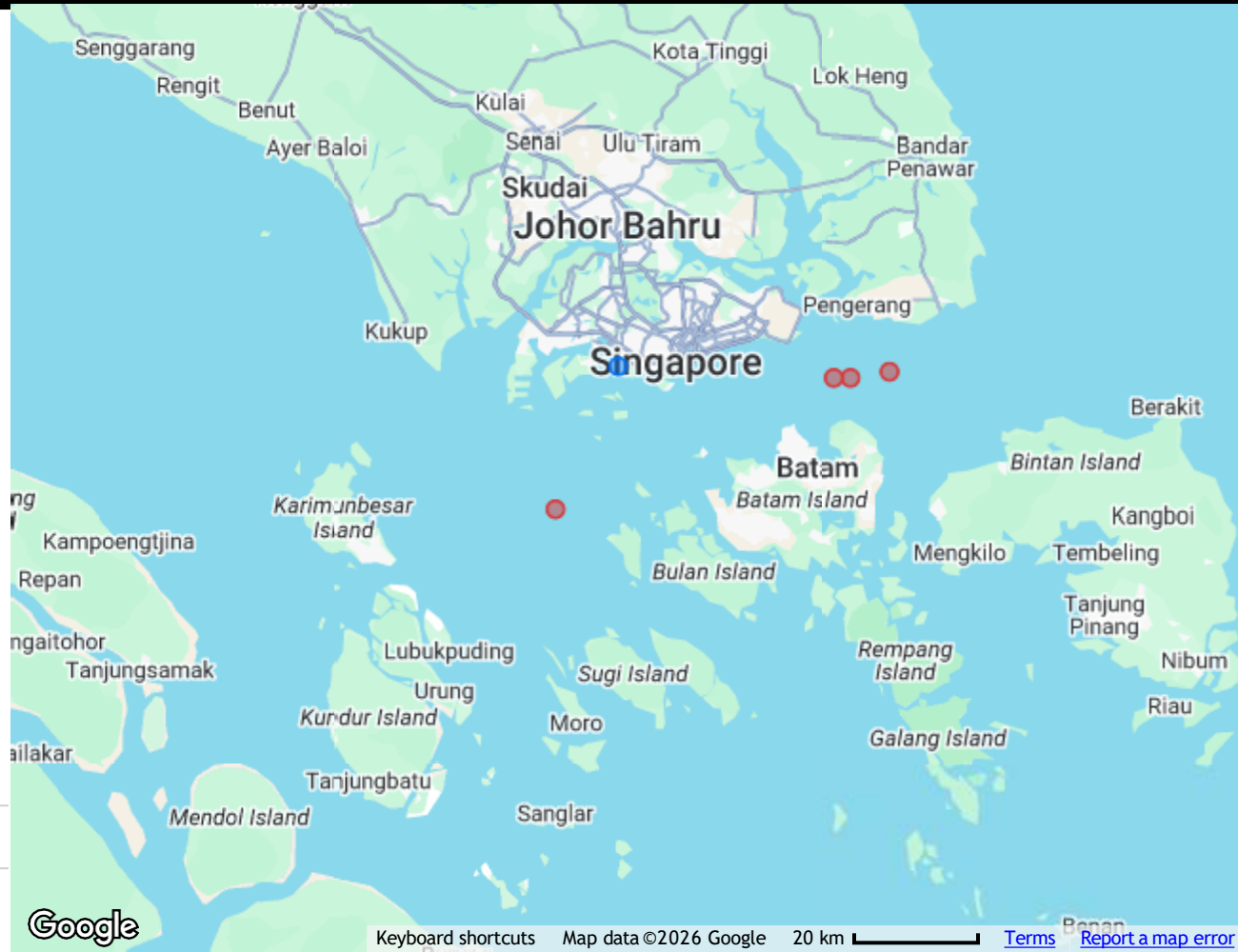
Overview of MARSEC Incidents in the Singapore Strait

Number of Incidents

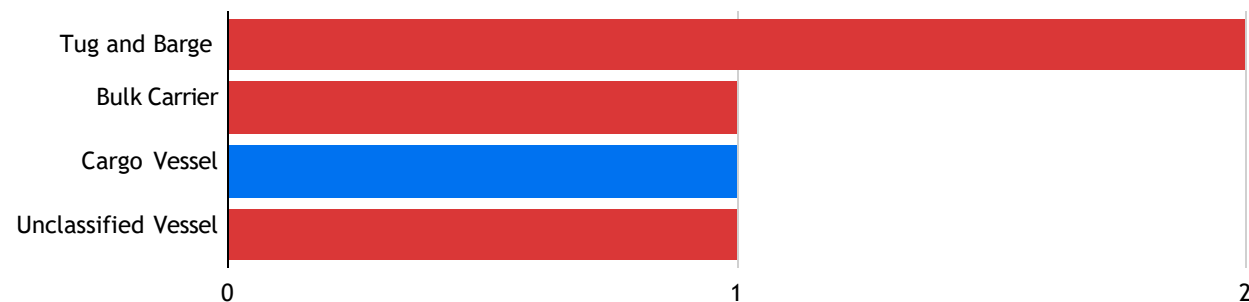

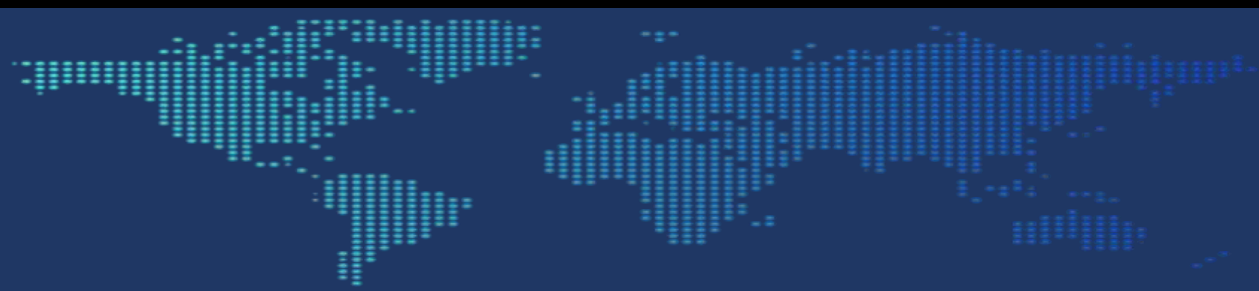

Executive Summary



Theft, Robbery and Piracy at Sea: 10 TRAPS incidents were reported in IFC's AOI for Jan 2026. This marks a decrease as compared to 2025 (15) and 2024 (13). Of note, 5 incidents were reported off Philippines, 4 in Singapore Strait and 1 in Bangladesh.

Maritime Incidents: 48 MI incidents were reported in Jan 2026. There were no major storms in the IFC's AOI this month. Equipment failure is the most commonly reported cause of incident this month which account for (12) of the (48) incidents. Additionally Bad Weather remains a major cause of incident with a total of (8) incidents this month.

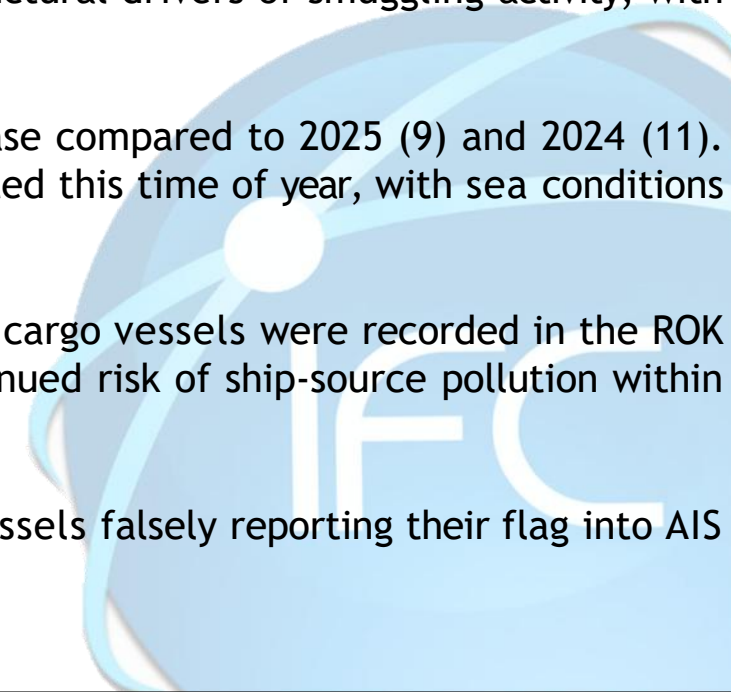
Illegal, Unreported, and Unregulated Fishing: 36 IUUF incidents were recorded in Jan 26, marking a notable decrease compared with Jan 25 (62) and Jan 24 (55). Overall, IUUF incidents declined in Jan 26, though continued local violations highlight the need for sustained enforcement.

Contraband Smuggling: 52 CS incidents were reported in Jan 2026, representing an increase compared to Jan 2025 (48) but remaining significantly lower than Jan 2024 (76), with incident levels broadly consistent with Dec 2025, indicating a sustained elevated baseline rather than a short-term fluctuation. This trend suggests continued structural drivers of smuggling activity, with limited evidence of a significant escalation during the reporting period.

Irregular Human Migration: 7 IHM incidents were reported in Jan 2026, marking a decrease compared to 2025 (9) and 2024 (11). There is a noticeable increase in overcrowded vessels, these types of incidents are expected this time of year, with sea conditions being most favourable for heavily laden small boats from November to March.

Environmental Security: 2 IUUF incidents were reported in Jan 2026, 2 incidents involving cargo vessels were recorded in the ROK area, reflecting an increase from the previous reporting period and highlighting the continued risk of ship-source pollution within busy maritime routes.

Cyber Security: 2 CYBSEC incidents were reported in Jan 2026. Both incidents involved vessels falsely reporting their flag into AIS while transiting the IFC AOI.

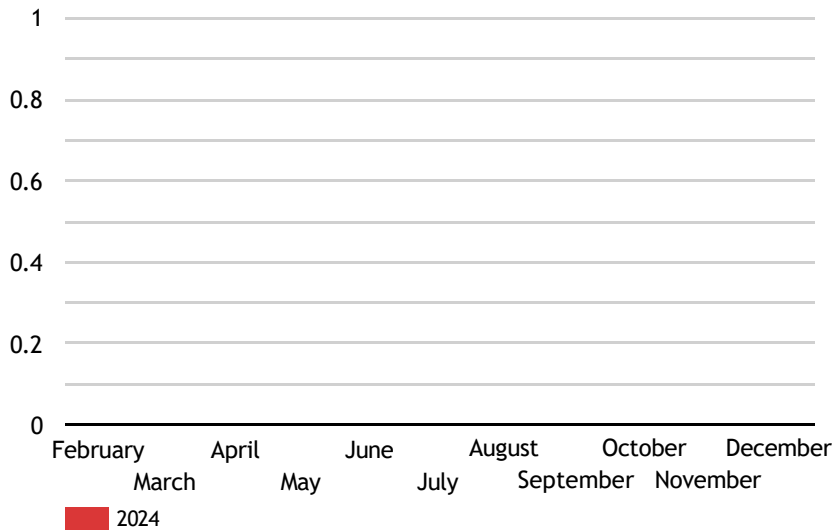

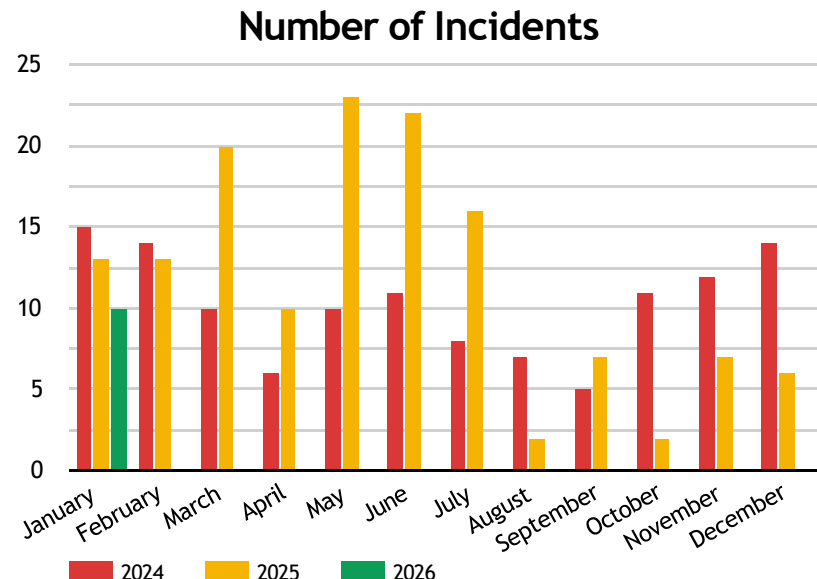
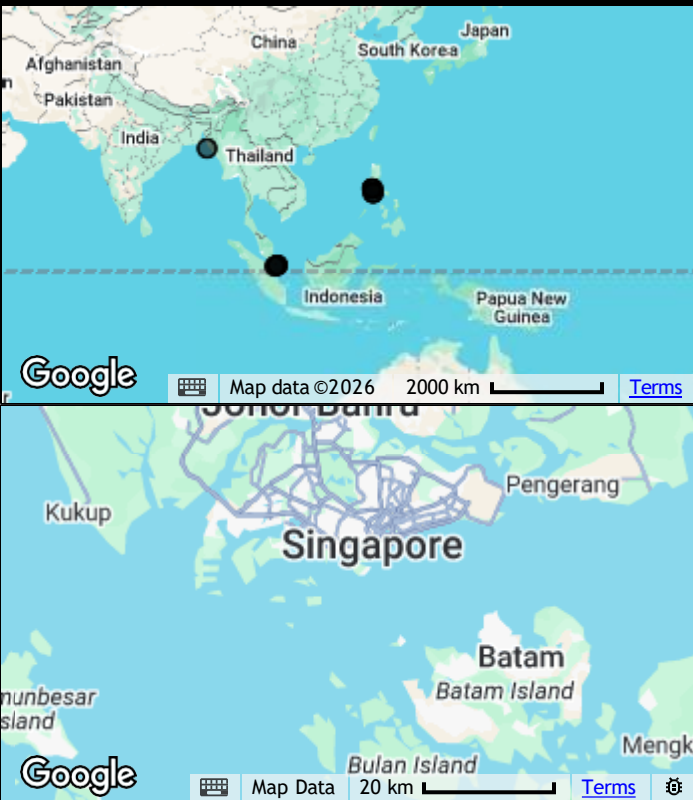

OBSERVATIONS

Statistics.

- Total of 10 (Boarding) TRAPS incidents reported in Jan 2026, represented a decrease compared to the same period in 2025 (15) and 2024 (13).
- Of note, 5 incidents reported off Philippines, 4 in Singapore Strait and 1 in Bangladesh. These incidents 3 tugs with barges, 2 bulk carriers, 2 container vessels and 1 cargo vessel, passenger vessel and fishing vessel respectively.
- All incidents occurred during Period of Darkness (POD) less 3 incidents occurred during daytime involving Tugs with heavy-laden Barges.

Philip pines.

- Three (3) incidents occurred off Batangas and two (2) incidents reported off Manila while ships at anchor.
- Of the five (5) incidents in Philippines, two (2) incidents [22 and 26 Jan] involved perpetrators reportedly armed with knives with one (1) confrontation reported [26 Jan]. No injury was reported.
- Four (4) incidents [3, 15, 25 and 26 Jan] reported cables, ship's properties, drums of paints, hydrant cups and walkie talkie respectively.

Singapore Strait.

- Total 4 incidents (Sea Theft) reported - three (3) in Eastbound Lane of Traffic Separation Scheme (TSS) and 1 off Philip Channel.
- Of note, one (1) incident off Philip Channel involving Bulk Carrier where perpetrators armed with knives. Three (3) incidents involving tugs and laden barges reported off Eastbound Lane of TSS during daylight hours, where some scrap metal were reportedly stolen.

Above all, no confrontation nor injuries reported. The ships were able to continue their voyages to the next port without requiring any assistance.

Bangladesh

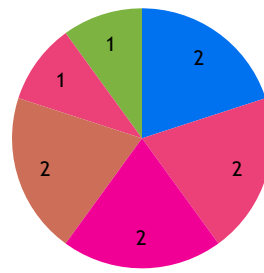
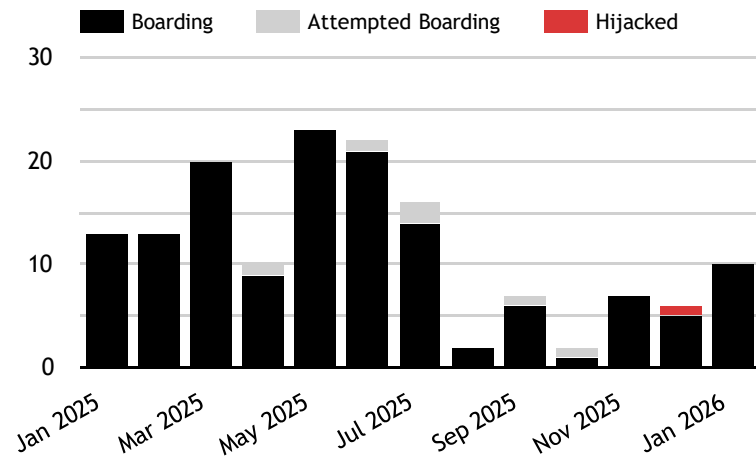
- 1 incident (Sea Robbery) occurred off Inani Beach, Cox's Bazar involving fishing vessels. The incident involved perpetrators who boarded the vessel and robbed them of their fish catch, food supplies, engine, battery, and all necessary equipment aboard before setting the boat adrift.

Comments.

- The incident numbers in Jan 2026 recorded an increase with previous month Dec 2025 [five (5) incidents]. This remain consistent with previous assessments, particularly in SS, driven by the combined effects of (a) prevailing Northeast Monsoon, resulting in unfavorable fishing conditions in the South China Sea that may resort to petty crime to supplement their income; and (b) deterrent effect of enforcement operations starting to wane, leading to a rebound in incidents as opportunistic perpetrators quickly adapted.

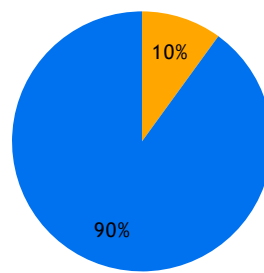
- Modus operandi remained largely consistent with petty crime, and are opportunistic in nature (majority no confrontation reported).
- All companies, sea users, and ship masters are advised to remain vigilant when transiting known areas of concern; Phillip Channel, waters off Batam and Bintan islands.

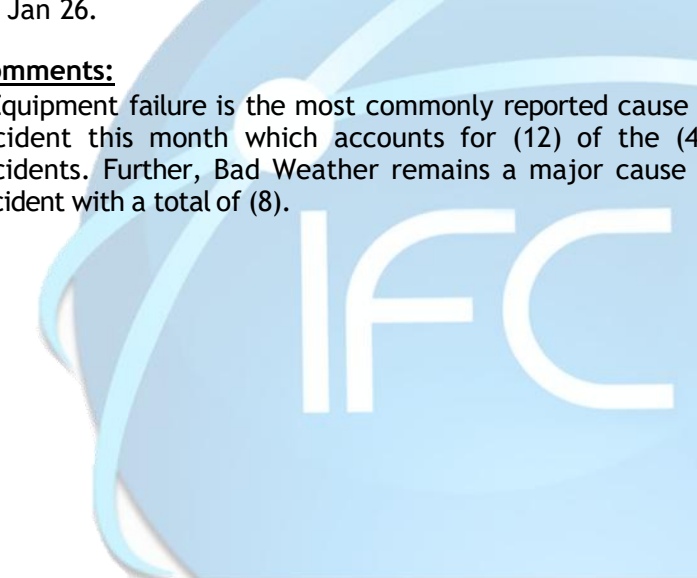
Statistics:

- A total of (48) Maritime incidents were reported this month, which is roughly the same as the number recorded in the same period in 2025 (51) and lower than in 2024 (88).
- The largest number of reported incidents was sunk-capsized (20), followed by Vessel Detained (9) and adrift (9), then collision-grounding (4).
- In terms of location, the highest number of reported incidents occurred in the waters of Philippines (13), followed by ROK (10), then Vietnam (5) and Malaysia (5).

- A total of (65) individuals were reported dead or missing this month, which is higher than the last month (22). Overall, (35) SAR operations were conducted, resulting in the rescue of (836) individuals. The number of rescues was higher than previous months this is due to the rescue of 118 people after a small vessel sank off the coast of Yangon, Myanmar on the 10 Jan 26, and 318 people were rescued after a passenger vessel sank off the coast of Baluk Island in the Philippines on 26 Jan 26.

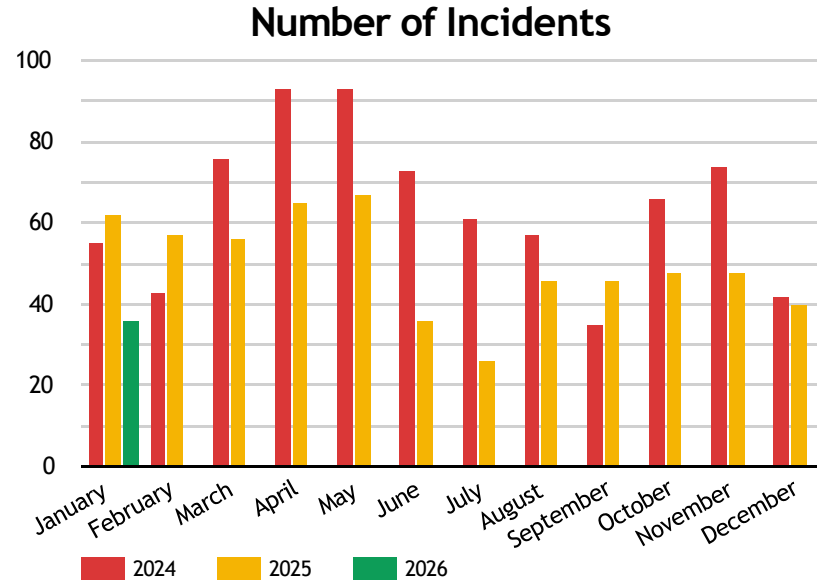
Comments:

- Equipment failure is the most commonly reported cause of incident this month which accounts for (12) of the (48) incidents. Further, Bad Weather remains a major cause of incident with a total of (8).

OBSERVATIONS

Statistics :

- A total of 36 IUUF incidents were recorded in Jan 26, marking a notable decrease compared with Jan 25 (62 incidents) and Jan 24 (55 incidents). There is a slight decline from Dec 25 (39 incidents), indicating the continuation of a broader downward trend despite normal monthly fluctuations.

- Local:** A total of 28 local IUUF incidents were recorded in Jan 26, representing an increase from Jan 25 (22 incidents) while remaining below Jan 24 (37 incidents). This was also marginally lower than Dec 25 (29 incidents), suggesting relatively stable local enforcement conditions.

- Most local incidents occurred in Malaysia (13 incidents; 46.4%), followed by Sri Lanka (5 incidents; 17.9%) and Bangladesh (3 incidents; 10.7%). India and the ROK recorded 2 incidents each (7.1%), while Vietnam, Sabah, and the Philippines reported 1 incident each (3.6%), highlighting Malaysia as the primary hotspot during the reporting period.

- Poaching:** A total of 8 poaching incidents were recorded in Jan 26, significantly lower than Jan 25 (25 incidents) and Jan 24 (18 incidents), and slightly below Dec 25 (10 incidents), reflecting a continued decline in poaching activity.

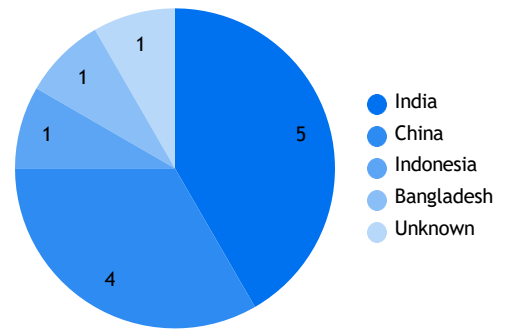
- Poaching incidents were mainly concentrated in Sri Lanka (3 incidents; 37.5%), followed by the ROK (2 incidents; 25.0%), while Jaffna, India, and Malaysia each recorded 1 incident (12.5%).

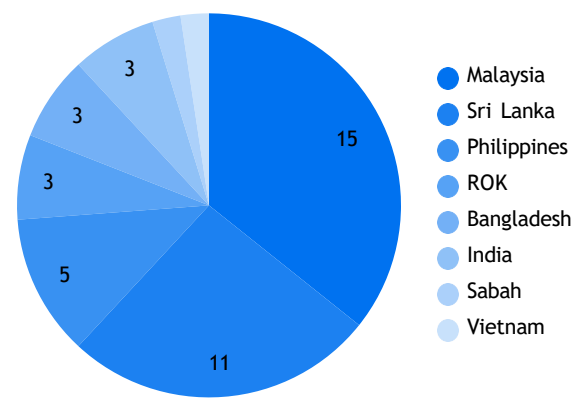
Comments :

- Overall, IUUF incidents declined in Jan 26, though continued local violations highlight the need for sustained enforcement. Targeted monitoring in identified hotspot areas will remain essential to deter recurrent offences. Regional cooperation and information sharing will also be critical to strengthening collective maritime oversight.

Number and Flag of Vessels, Poaching

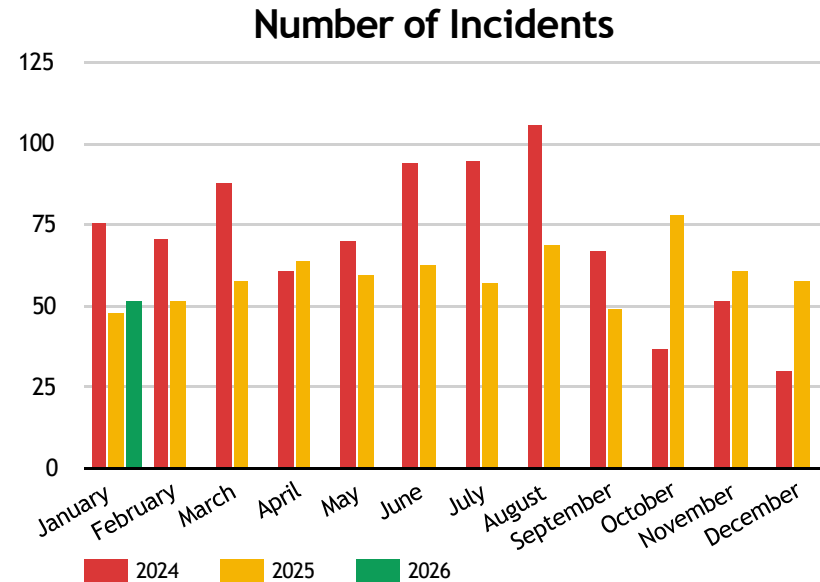
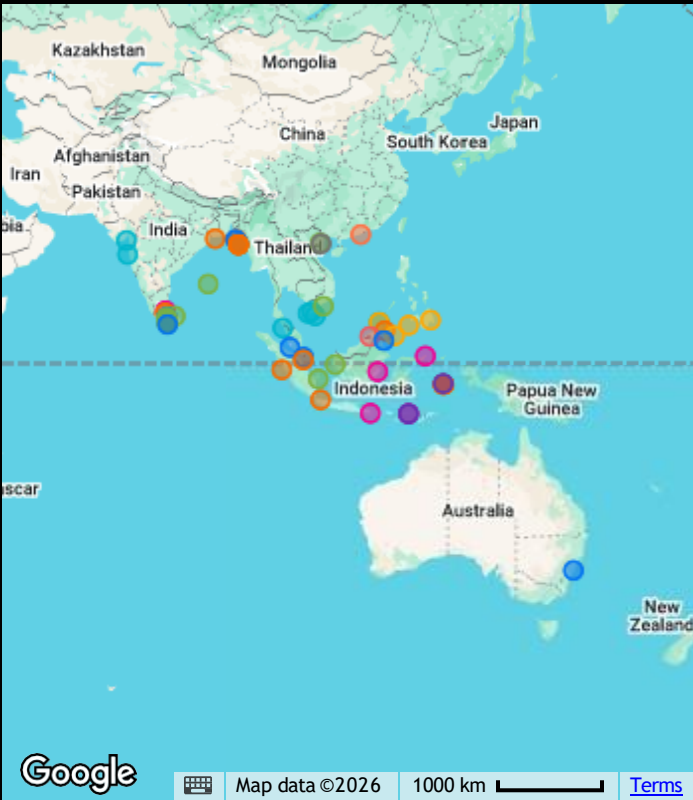


Number and Flag of Vessels, Local





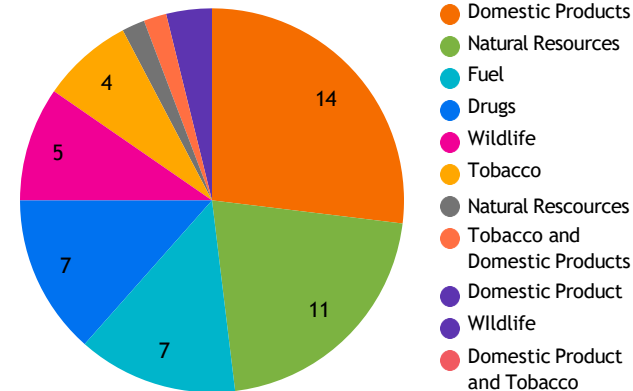

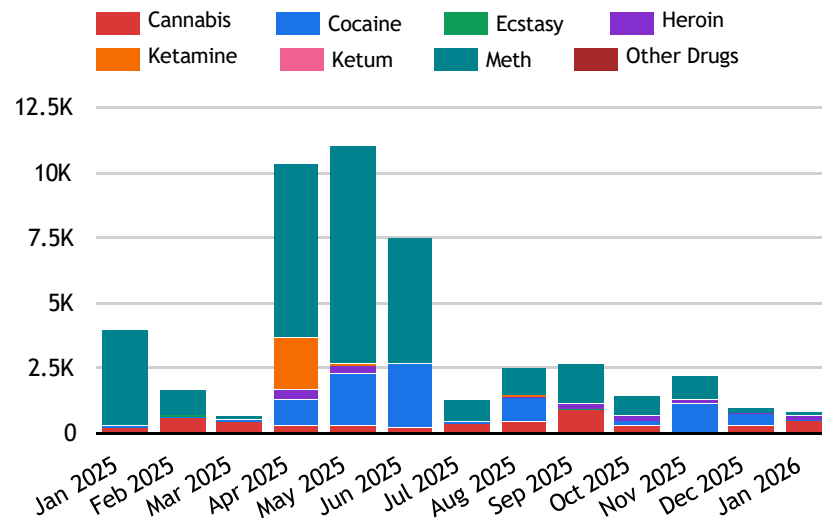

OBSERVATIONS

Statistics:

A total of 52 CS incidents were reported in Jan 2026. This represented an increase compared to the same period in 2025 (48 incidents), but remained significantly lower than Jan 2024 (76 incidents). Overall incident levels remained broadly consistent with those recorded in Dec 2025, indicating a sustained elevated level of smuggling activity rather than a short-term fluctuation.

Drugs (x7): Sri Lanka (x2 Meth 10,000 pieces; pharmaceutical tablets 108,480 tablets), Bangladesh (x1 Meth 75,000 pills), Indonesia (x1 Meth 0.1 kg), Australia (x2 Cocaine 20 kg; Heroin and MDMA approx. 198 kg and 14 kg), Malaysia (x1 Ecstasy and Heroin 4.064 kg).

Domestic Products (x15): Bangladesh (x8), Indonesia (x6), Myanmar (x1).

Natural Resources (x12): Sri Lanka (x5), Vietnam (x4), Indonesia (x3).

Fuel (x7): Vietnam (x3), Thailand (x1), India (x2), Malaysia/Sabah (x1).

Wildlife (x6): Indonesia (x5), Sri Lanka (x1).

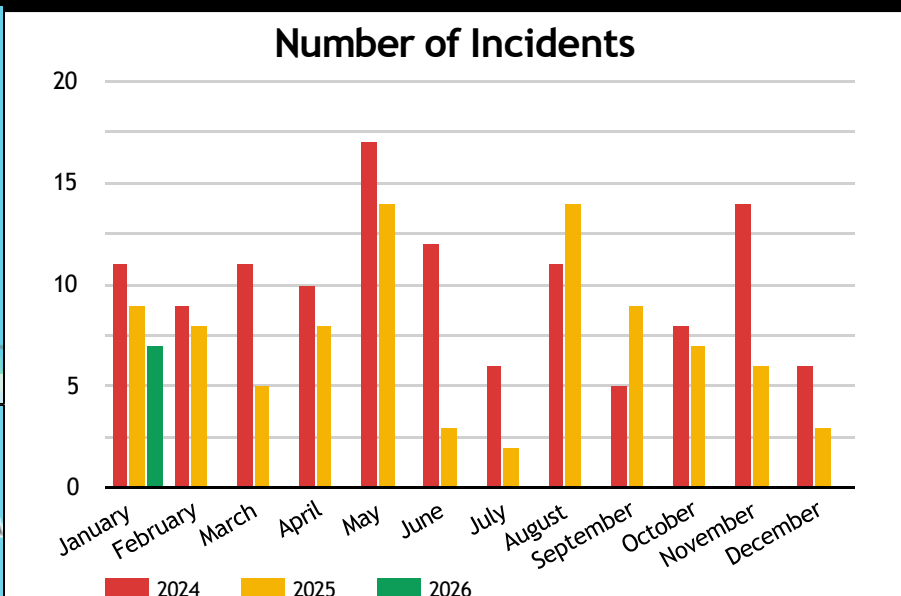

Comments:

- The IFC assessed that CS incident levels in Jan 2026 increased compared to Jan 2025, but remained well below the peak levels observed in Jan 2024, suggesting partial recovery from last year's lower baseline rather than a return to previous highs.
- Domestic-product smuggling continued to account for the largest share of incidents, with Bangladesh and Indonesia recording the majority of cases, likely driven by sustained demand for daily-use goods within cross-border communities.
- Drug-smuggling activity remained stable at seven incidents, with continued use of Indian Ocean routes, particularly involving Sri Lanka and Bangladesh. Fuel-smuggling activity remained consistent with the previous month's figures.
- Natural resources, wildlife, and tobacco smuggling patterns showed no major deviation, reflecting structurally driven activities linked to economic, environmental, and regulatory factors.

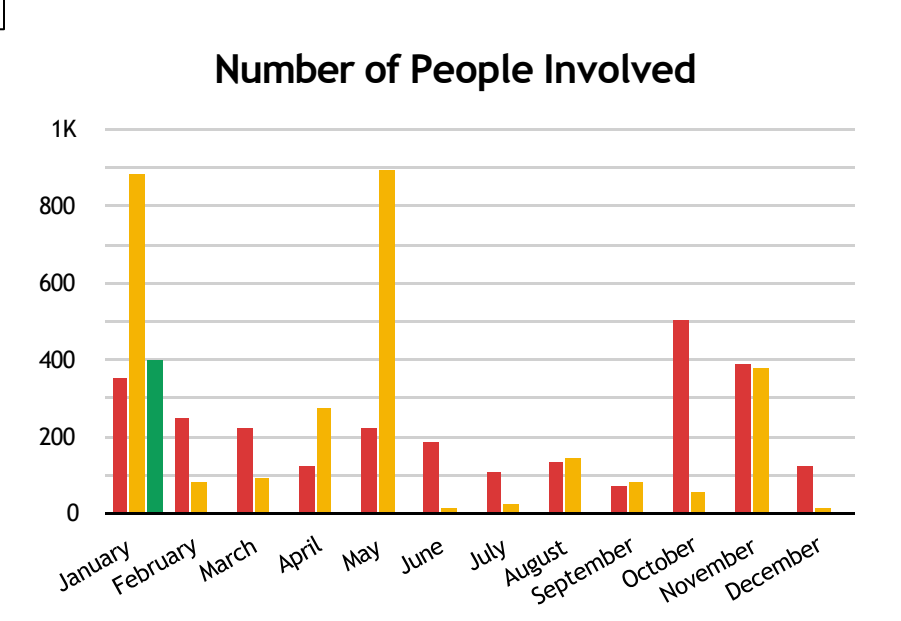


Irregular Human Migration (IHM)

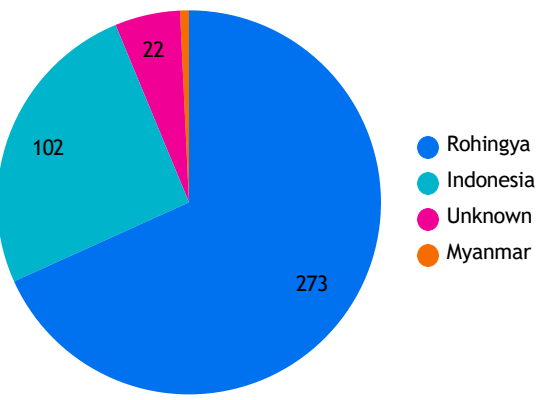

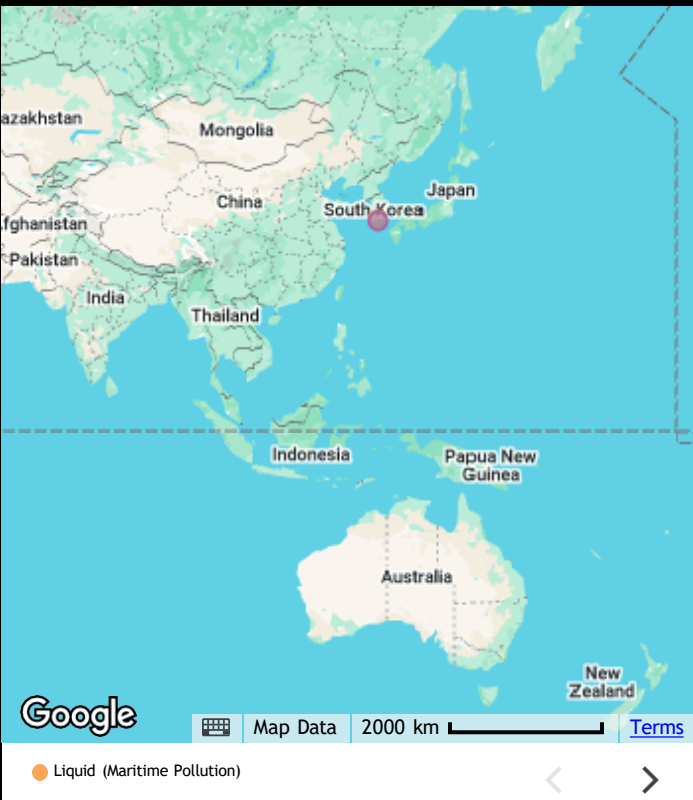
- Statistics:**
- There were a total of 7 IHM incidents reported in Jan 2026, all classified as routine Irregular Human Migration.
- Comments:**
- Two incidents occurred in the Bay of Bengal, with both including migrants attempting to reach Malaysia or Indonesia. One of these vessels was significantly overcrowded, reportedly carrying over 270 people. These types of incidents are expected this time of year, with sea conditions being most favourable for heavily laden small boats from November to March.
 - The remainder of the incidents were routine migrant labour transits between Indonesia, Malaysia and the Philippines. This activity is routine and constant throughout the year.

Number and Nationality/Ethnicity of Migrants

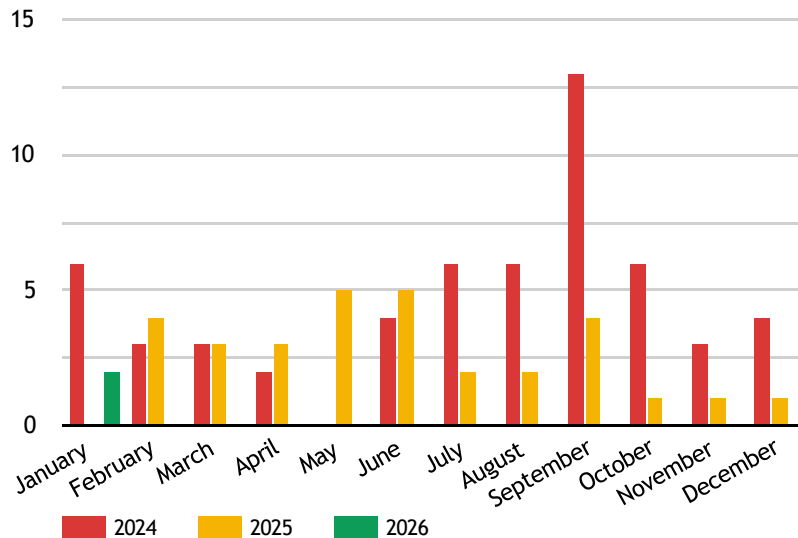

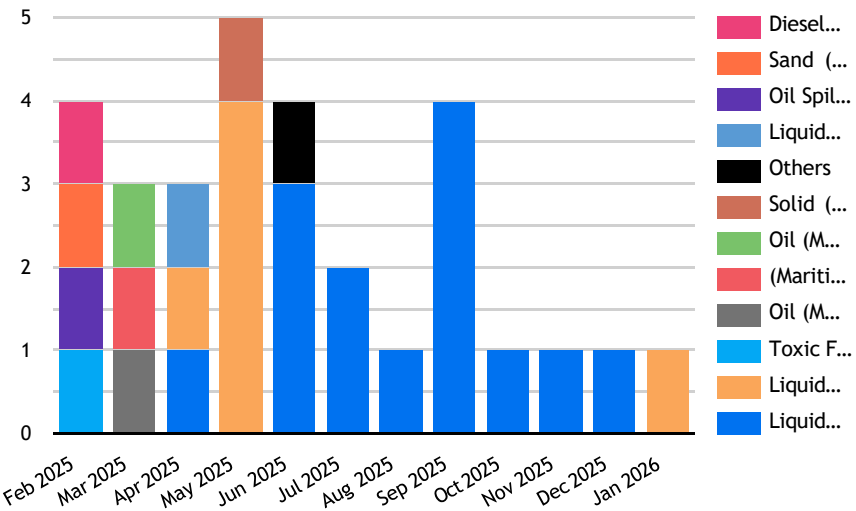

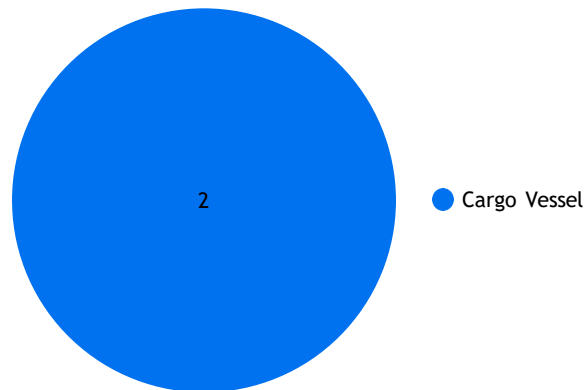

Statistics :

• A total of 2 ENVSEC incidents were reported in Jan 26, representing an increase compared with Jan 25 (0 incidents) while remaining significantly lower than Jan 24 (6 incidents). The figure also reflects a slight rise from Dec 25 (1 incident), suggesting that environmental security incidents remain relatively limited despite minor monthly fluctuations.

Maritime Pollution (MARPOL) : 2 incidents involving cargo vessels were recorded in the ROK area, reflecting an increase from the previous reporting period and highlighting the continued risk of ship-source pollution within busy maritime routes.

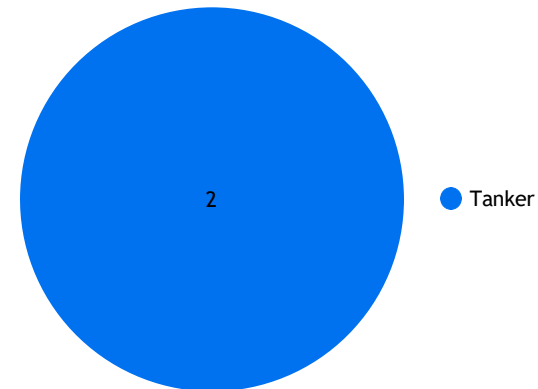
• Overall, ENVSEC incidents remained consistent in Jan 26; however, the rise in maritime pollution cases involving cargo vessels underscores the need for continued monitoring and strict compliance with environmental regulations, particularly as regional enforcement increasingly leverages satellite-based detection and rapid response measures. Enhanced preventive efforts will remain important to mitigate potential ecological impacts and safeguard maritime safety.



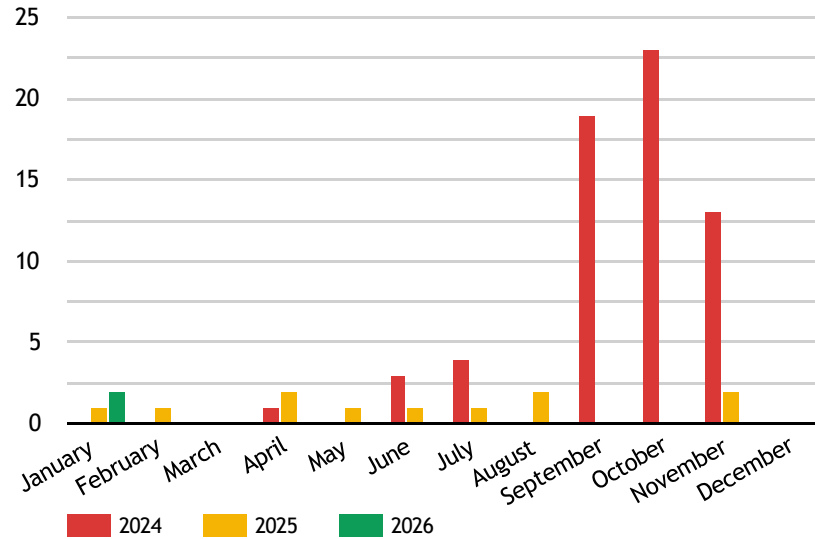

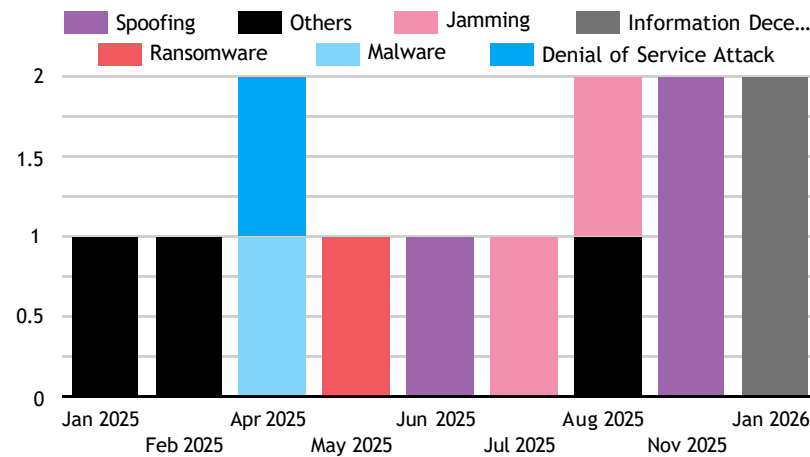

- There were 2 Cyber Security incidents reported in Jan 2026.

Comments:

- There were two Cyber Security incidents reported in Jan 2026. Both incidents involved vessels falsely reporting their flag into AIS while transiting the IFC AOR. Both vessels were stateless and unregistered, and at least one of the vessels were alleged to be involved in illegal STS transfer of crude oil.

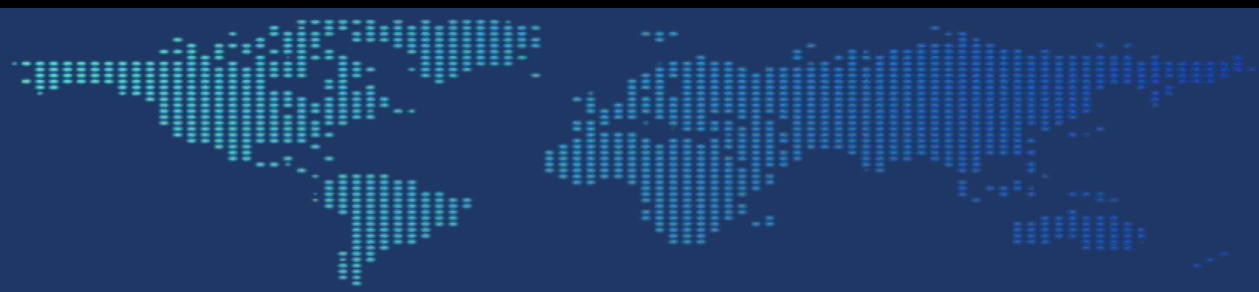
Note:

- As of Jan 2026, IFC has updated how we report on CYBSEC incidents, moving to a target-centric reporting focus, rather than method-centric. This will allow IFC to better categorise and analyse CYBSEC incidents in the region and more easily understand and report threats.





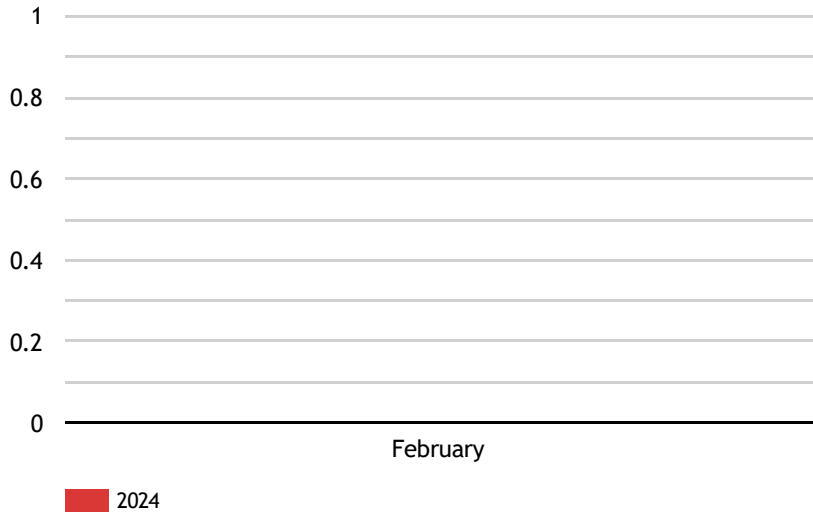

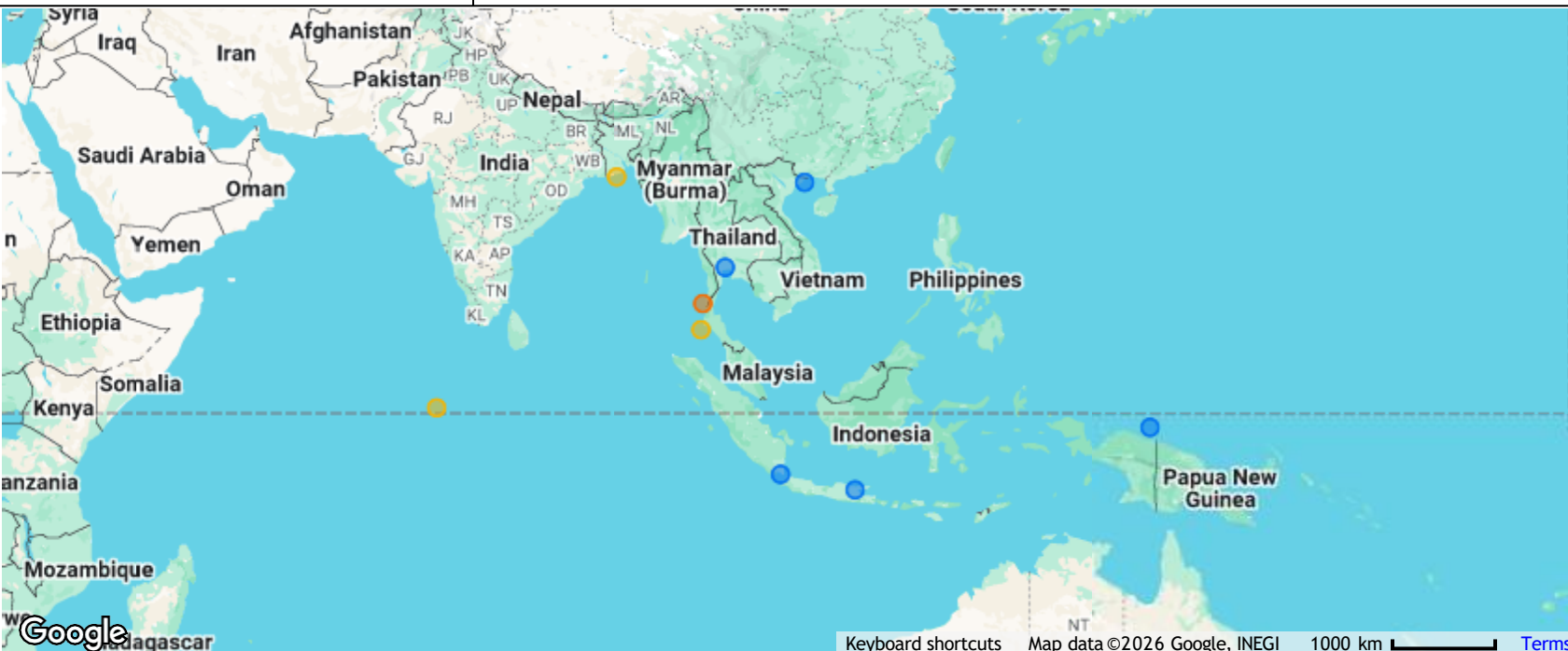

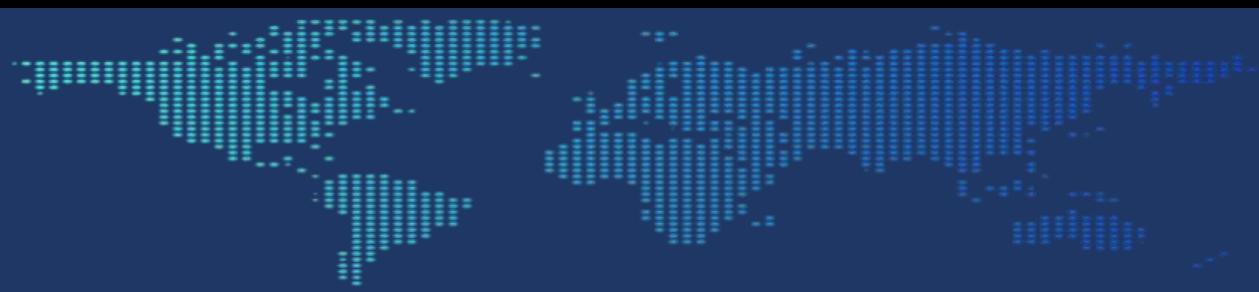

IFC Recommendations



1. All mariners to report any maritime security incidents timely to the nearest coastal state and inform the IFC at the earliest possible time.
2. All mariners are strongly recommended to be vigilant, in particularly when operating in IFC identified hotspots (**Westbound lane of Traffic Separation Scheme in Singapore Strait, Eastbound lane of Traffic Separation Scheme in Singapore Strait, Belawan and Dumai Anchorages in Indonesia, Manila Anchorage in the Philippines, and Chittagong Outer Anchorage in Bangladesh**).
3. All mariners are advised to adopt **Ship Protection Measures** recommended in the **Regional Guide to Counter Piracy and Armed Robbery Against Ships in Asia** (e.g., illuminating the accommodation block and poop deck, deploying sentries and increase frequency of security rounds).
4. All mariners to take note on the description of the perpetrators and to take photos of the perpetrators if possible. Where available, CCTV footage capturing the incident should be provided to **the coastal state authorities** for follow-on investigation.
5. All mariners are advised to participate in **IFC Voluntary Community Reporting (VCR)** as depicted in **MARSEC Chart O6112 and O6113**. In case of any doubt, incident at sea, suspicious approach or unusual observed activity at sea, please contact the IFC Duty Officer:

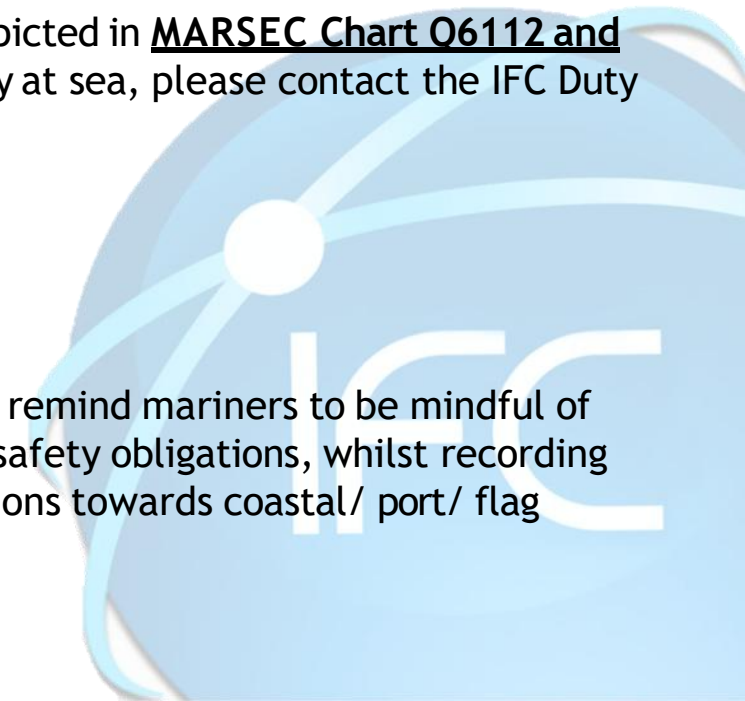
