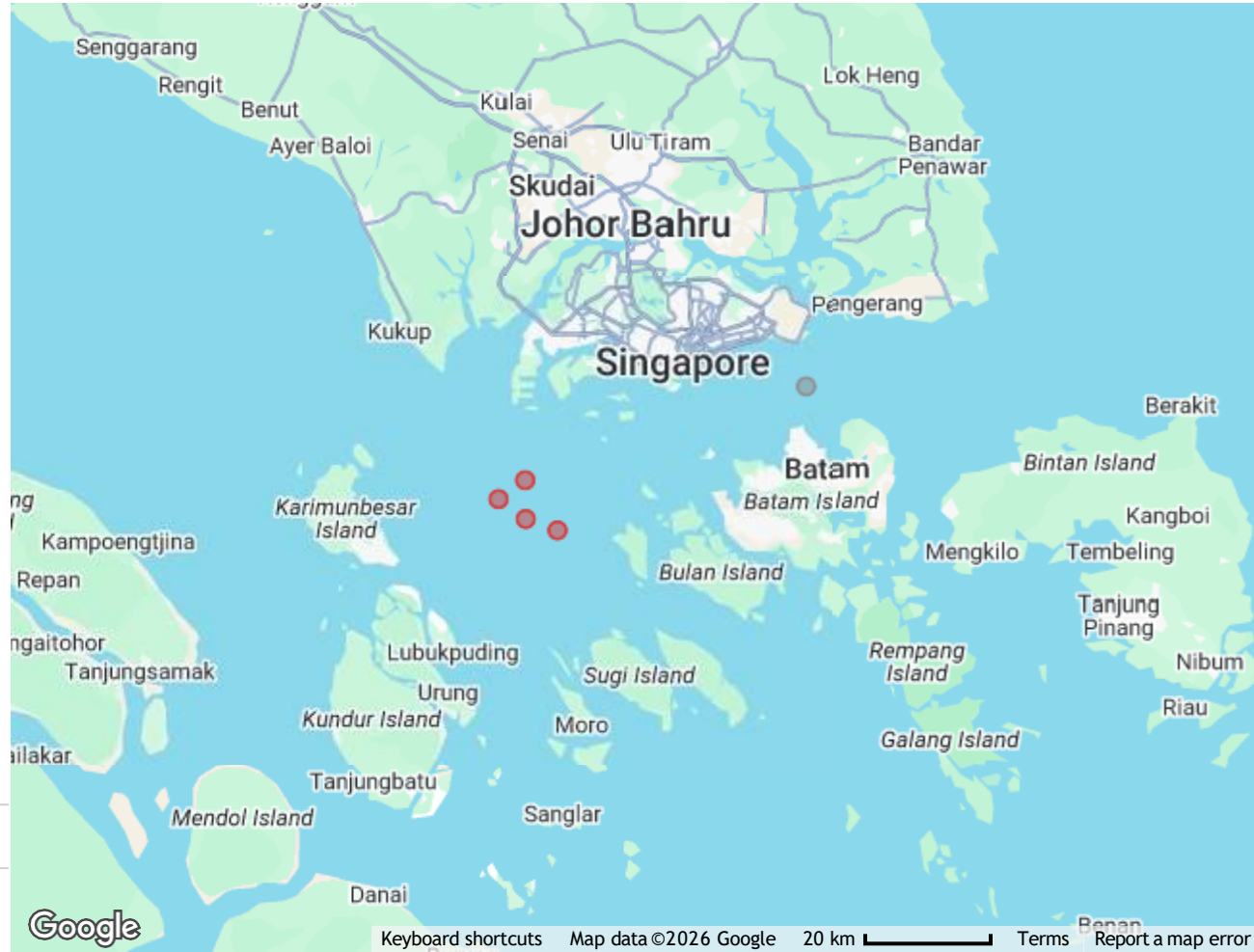


Overview of MARSEC Incidents in the Singapore Strait

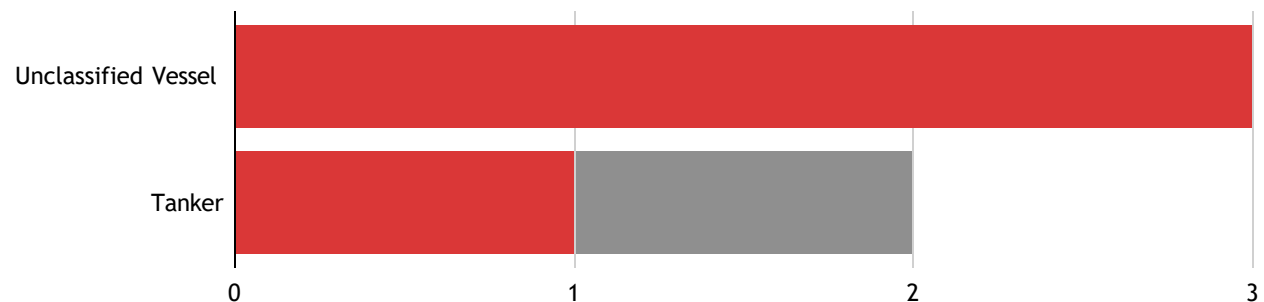
Number of Incidents



Number of Incidents, and Change from Last Year



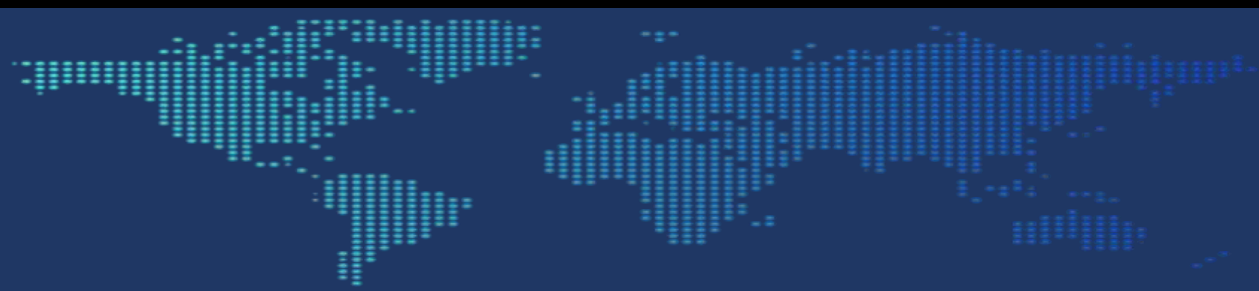

Executive Summary



Theft, Robbery and Piracy at Sea: 4 TRAPS incidents were reported in Mar 2026. This is a significant decrease compared to 2025 (20) and 2024 (10). Of note, the 4 incidents took place in Phillip Channel, Singapore Strait.

Maritime Incidents: 41 MI incidents were reported in Mar 2026. Equipment Failure is the most commonly reported cause of incident this month which accounts for (10) of the (41) incidents.

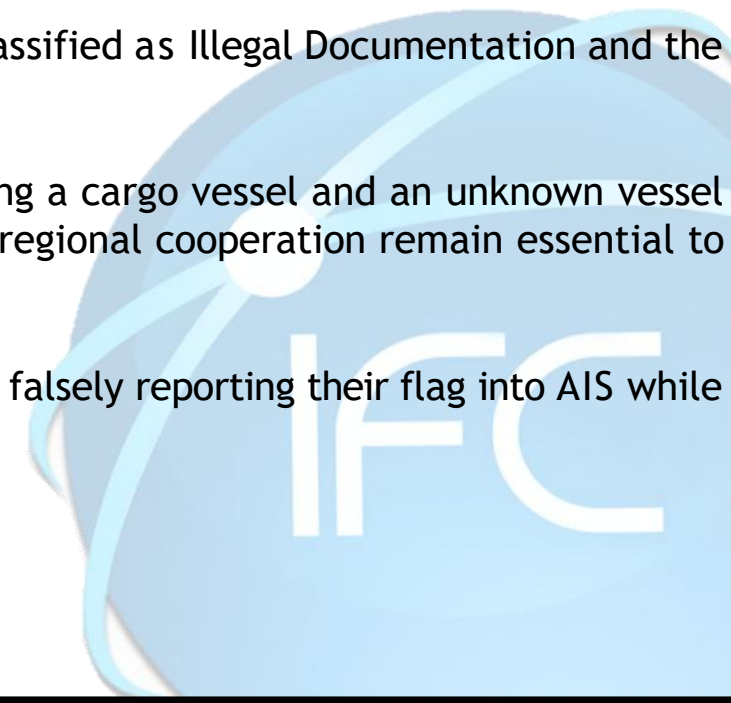
Illegal, Unreported, and Unregulated Fishing: 29 IUUF incidents were recorded in Mar 2026, this indicates a consistent downward trend in IUUF incidents, suggesting continued vigilance, targeted enforcement, and strengthened regional cooperation to prevent any potential resurgence.

Contraband Smuggling: 69 CS incidents were reported in Mar 2026. Drug smuggling and Domestic-product smuggling continued to account for the largest share of incidents, with Bangladesh and Thailand recording the majority of cases, likely driven by a sharp increase in Methamphetamine trafficking and sustained demand for daily-use goods within cross-border communities.

Irregular Human Migration: 5 IHM incidents were reported in Mar 2026. One incident was classified as Illegal Documentation and the rest were classified as routine Irregular Human Migration.

Environmental Security: 2 ENVSEC incidents were reported in Mar 2026, 2 incidents involving a cargo vessel and an unknown vessel recorded in Sri Lanka and ROK respectively. Continued monitoring, effective reporting, and regional cooperation remain essential to support timely response and mitigate potential impacts on the environment.

Cyber Security: 1 CYBSEC incident was reported in Mar 2026. The incident involved a vessel falsely reporting their flag into AIS while transiting the IFC AOR. Vessel was stateless and unregistered.

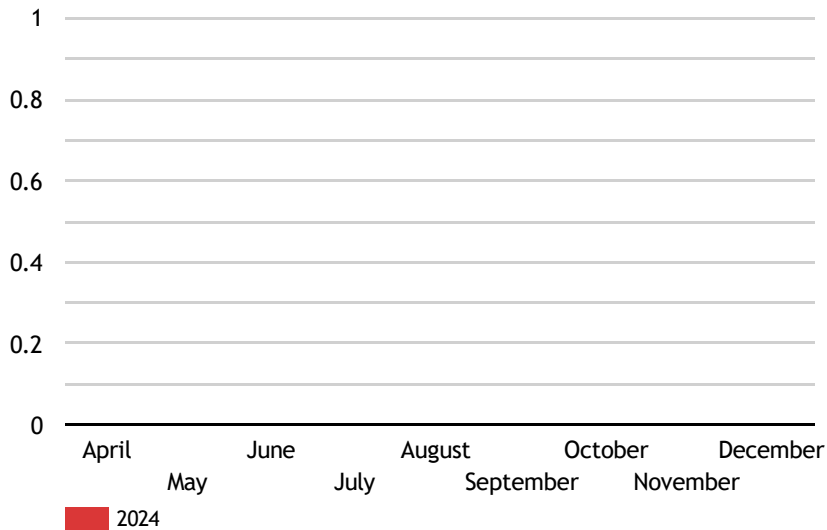

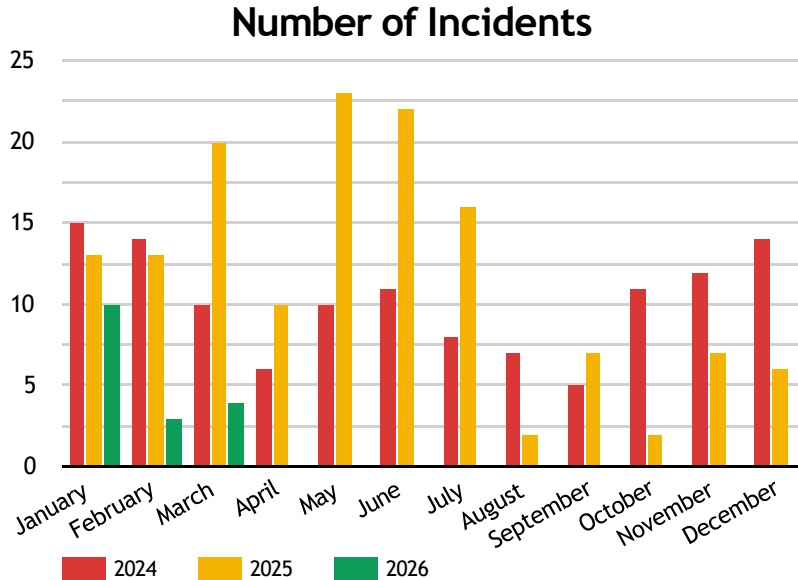
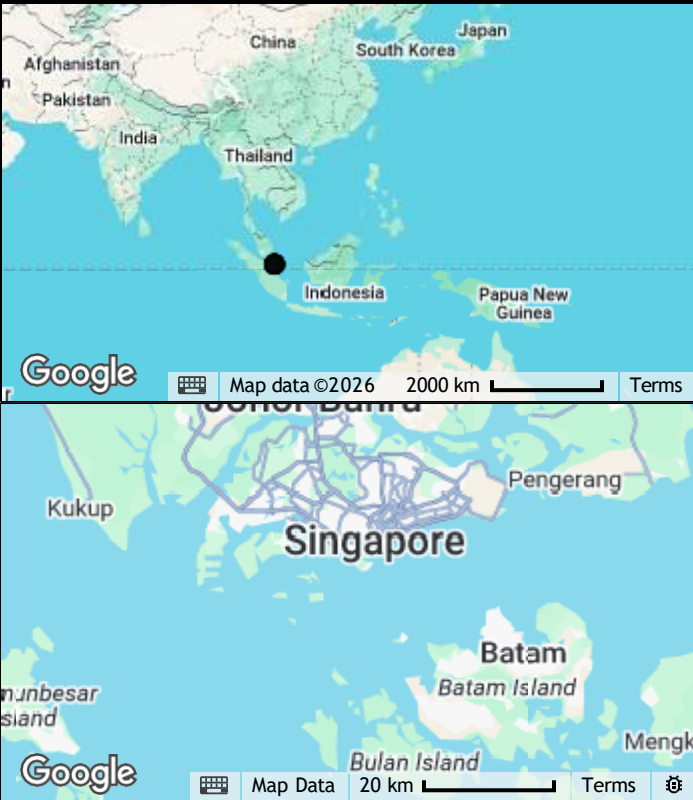

Theft, Robbery and Piracy at Sea (TRAPS)



OBSERVATIONS

Statistics.

- Total of 4 (Boarding) TRAPS incidents reported in March 2026, represented a decrease compared to the same period in 2025 (18) and 2024 (10).
- All incidents occurred during hours of darkness, and are consistent with past observations where perpetrators utilise cover of darkness to reduce likelihood of detection and conduct boardings in the Phillip Channel.
- All incidents (Sea Theft) reported occurred in Phillip Channel.
- The majority of incidents involved bulk carriers and tankers. Perpetrators may be armed (e.g. knives, gun-like objects or metal bars). Reported thefts mainly involve engine parts and ship stores.
- Of note, one crew member sustained minor injury in the incident on 19 March at 0155H (UTC+8). The ships were able to continue their voyages to the next port without requiring any assistance.

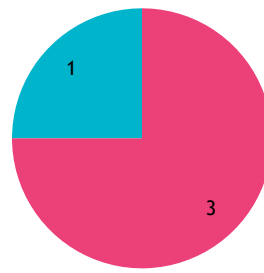
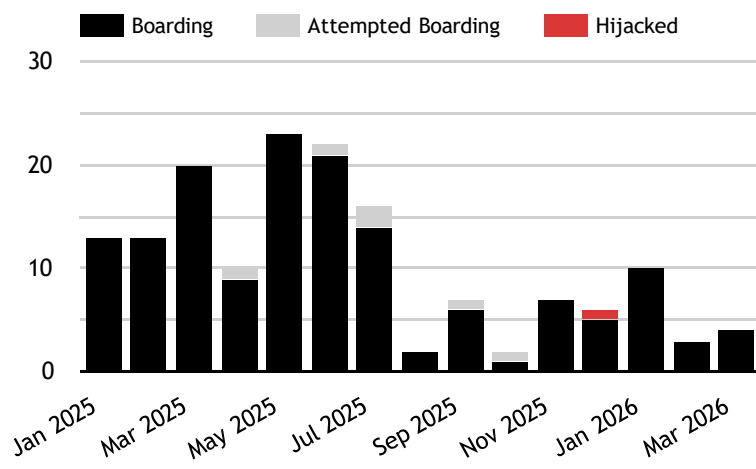
Comments.

- With the Northeast Monsoon abating, weather conditions are likely to improve, enabling the resumption of fishing activities. Based on past trends, we can expect incident numbers to decline in the coming months.
- While regional authorities remain committed to step up enforcement efforts to keep incident numbers low, all vessels are strongly advised to maintain heightened vigilance and implement necessary ship protection measures at all times. Timely reporting and the preservation of evidence remain essential to support follow-on investigations and strengthen overall deterrence.
- Modus operandi remained largely consistent with petty crime, and are opportunistic in nature (majority no confrontation reported).
- All companies, sea users, and ship masters are advised to remain vigilant when transiting known areas of concern, Phillip Channel, waters off Batam and Bintan islands.

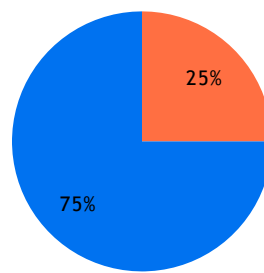

OBSERVATIONS

Statistics:

- A total of 41 Maritime incidents were reported this month, which is lower than the number recorded in the same period in 2025 (77) and in 2024 (77).
- The largest number of reported incidents was sunk-capsized (14), followed by Adrift (9), then Vessel Detained (6), and Fire-Explosion (6).
- In terms of location, the highest number of reported incidents occurred in the waters of Philippines (8) and Vietnam (8), followed by Malaysia (7), then ROK (5).
- A total of (15) individuals were reported dead or missing this month, which is lower than last month (24). Overall, (34) SAR operations were conducted, resulting in the rescue of (427) individuals.

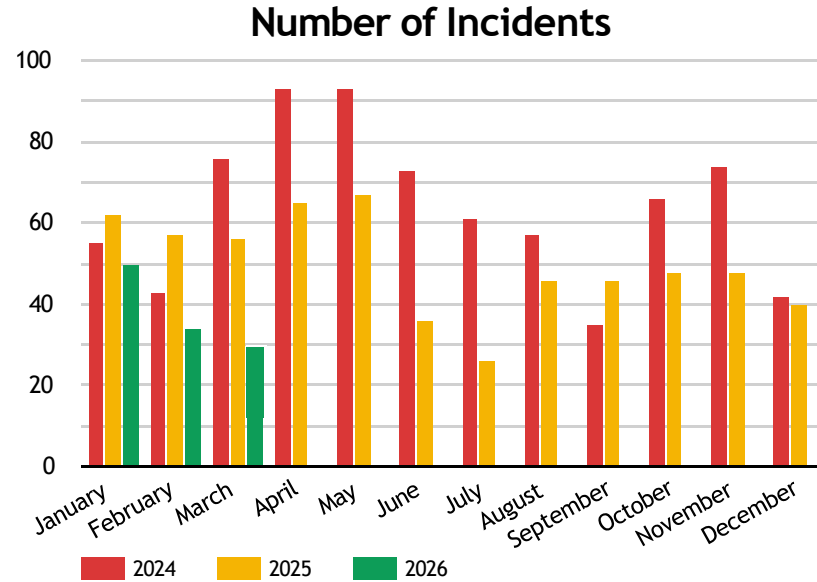
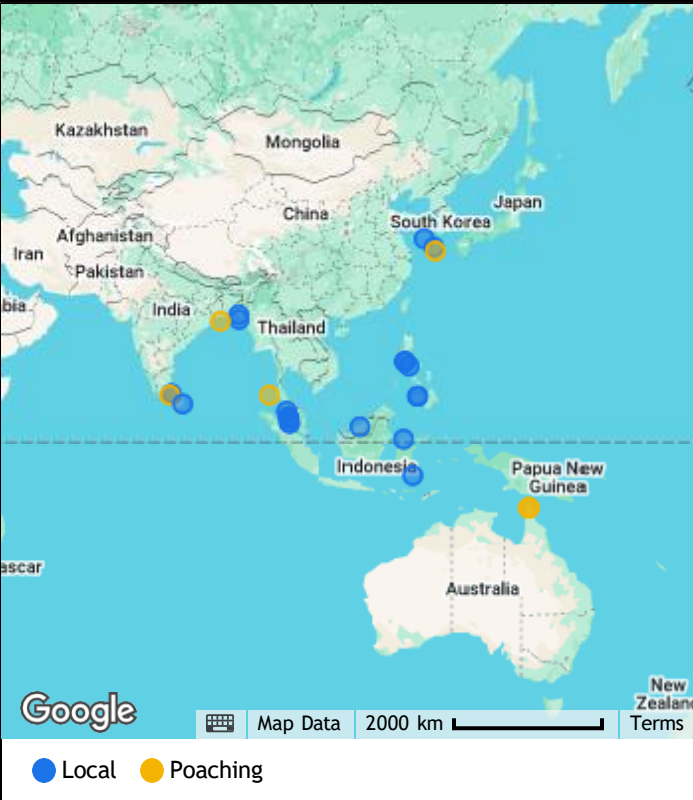

Illegal, Unreported, and Unregulated Fishing (IUUF)



OBSERVATIONS

Statistics :

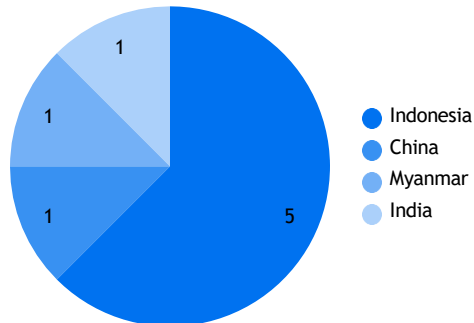
- A total of 29 IUUF incidents were recorded in Mar 26, showing a clear decrease compared to the previous month Feb 26 (34), and a further drop from Jan 26 (50). The same period in previous years, the number is significantly lower than Mar 25 (56) and Mar 24 (76). This indicates a consistent downward trend in IUUF incidents during March 2026, suggesting that the situation has eased compared to both recent months and historical levels.
- Local: A total of 18 local IUUF incidents were recorded in Mar 26, showing a decrease compared to the previous month Feb 26 (20), and a drop from Jan 26 (31). Looking at the same period in previous years, the number is significantly lower than Mar 25 (32) and Mar 24 (44).
- Most local incidents occurred in Malaysia (6; 30%), followed by the Philippines (6; 30%). The ROK recorded 3 incidents (15%), while Bangladesh and Sri Lanka recorded 2 incidents each (10%). Indonesia recorded 1 incident (5%).

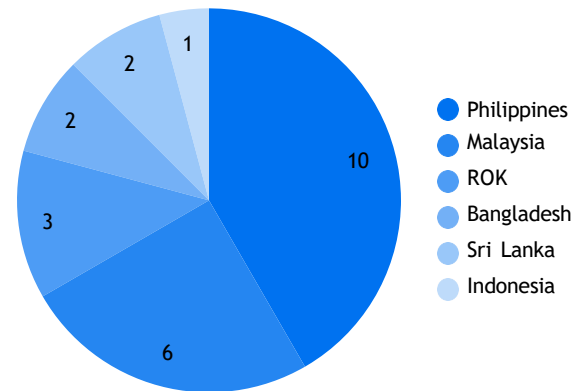

- Poaching: 4 poaching IUUF incidents were recorded in Mar 26, showing a significant decrease compared to the previous month Feb 26 (14), and a sharp drop from Jan 26 (19). Looking at the same period in previous years, the number is also markedly lower than Mar 25 (24) and Mar 24 (32).
- Poaching incidents were evenly distributed among vessels flagged to China, Myanmar, India, and Indonesia (1 incident each; 25%), indicating no single dominant flag state in poaching-related IUUF activities during this period.

Number and Flag of Vessels, Local

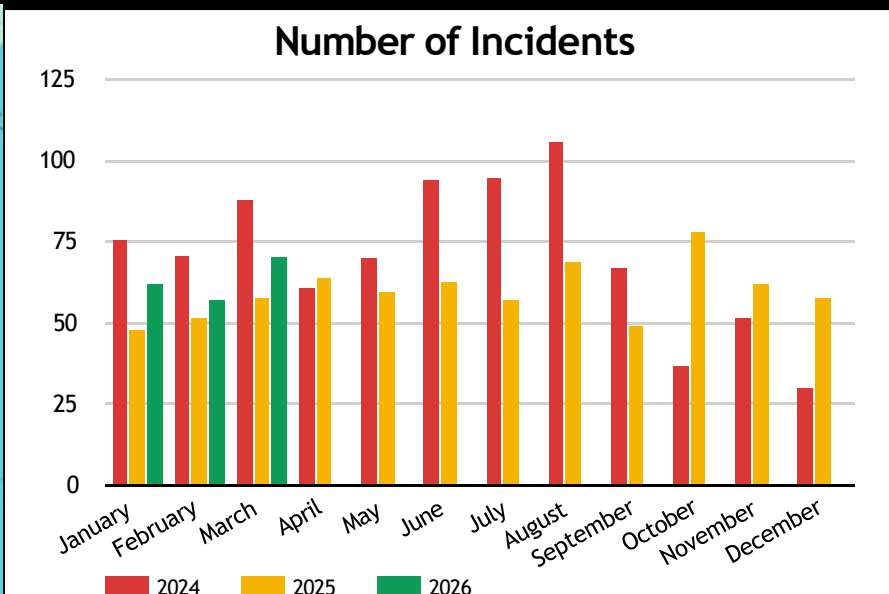


Comments :

- IUUF incidents in Mar 26 show a clear and continued decline compared to both the previous month and historical levels, with reductions observed across both local and poaching categories. Local violations remain the main contributor at a reduced level, while poaching activities have decreased significantly and are limited in scale with no dominant flag state. Continued vigilance, targeted enforcement, and strengthened regional cooperation is essential to sustain this downward trend and prevent any potential resurgence.

OBSERVATIONS

Statistics:
 A total of 69 CS incidents were reported in Mar 2026. This represented an increase compared to the same period in 2025 (58) but remained below the peak levels recorded in Mar 2024 (88). Overall incident levels showed a notable rise compared to Feb 2026 (57), indicating a robust resurgence in regional smuggling activity.

Drugs (x18): Bangladesh (x6 Meth 45,000 pills & 1.3kg), Thailand (x3 Cannabis 1,019kg), Hong Kong (x3 Cannabis 32kg, Cocaine 2kg), Malaysia (x2 Meth 118kg, Cannabis 25kg), Indonesia (x2 Meth 5kg), India (x1), South Korea (x1 Ketamine 1kg).

Domestic Products (x15): Bangladesh (x10), Malaysia (x4), Indonesia (x1).

Fuel (x14): Thailand (x8 Diesel 85,000L), Malaysia (x5 Diesel 750,000L), Indonesia (x1).

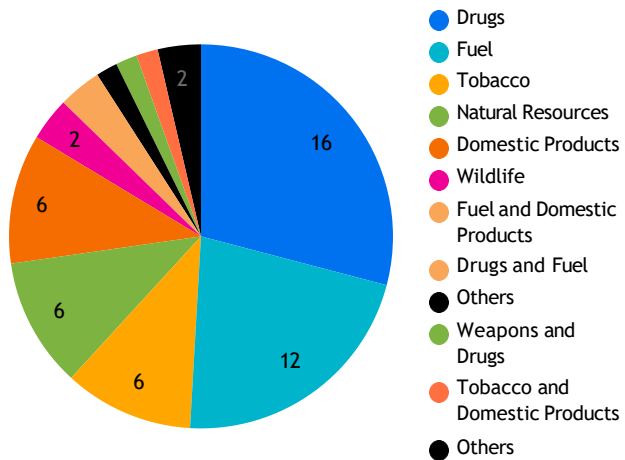

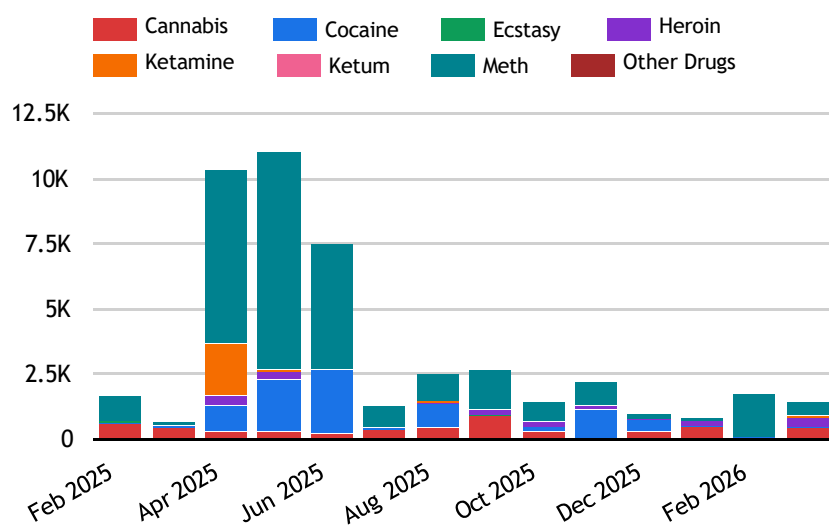
Comments:

- The IFC assessed that CS incident levels in Mar 2026 increased significantly compared to the previous month, surpassing the Mar 2025 baseline but still tracking below the historical highs of 2024. This suggests a strengthened recovery of maritime illicit trade networks across Southeast Asia.
- Drug-smuggling activity** saw a sharp increase, doubling from nine incidents in February to 18 this month. Bangladesh remains the primary destination for Methamphetamine trafficking (Yaba), while massive seizures of Cannabis in Thailand (over 1 ton) highlight a diversifying and high-volume smuggling landscape.
- Domestic-product smuggling** remained the leading category in terms of frequency, with Bangladesh accounting for the majority of cases (x10), likely driven by sustained demand for daily-use goods within cross-border communities.
- Fuel-smuggling activity** surged from 10 to 14 incidents. Enforcement was particularly active in the Gulf of Thailand and the Malacca Strait, where large-scale Ship-to-Ship (STS) transfers of diesel (notably 750,000L in a single Malaysian operation) were disrupted.
- Natural resources smuggling** rebounded from five incidents in the previous month to 10 incidents in March, with Sri Lanka emerging as a significant hotspot for the illicit trade of Kendu leaves.

Types of Smuggled Goods

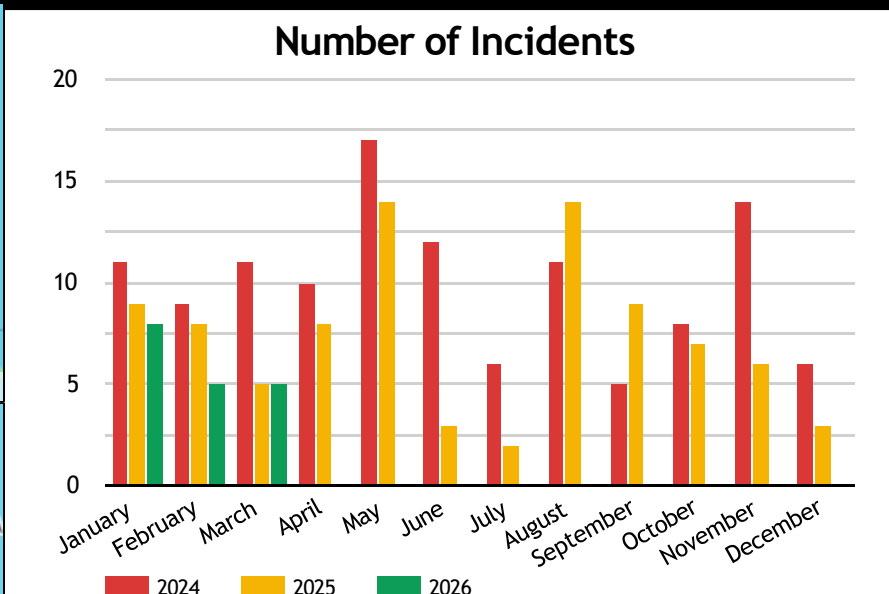


Kilograms of Drugs Seized



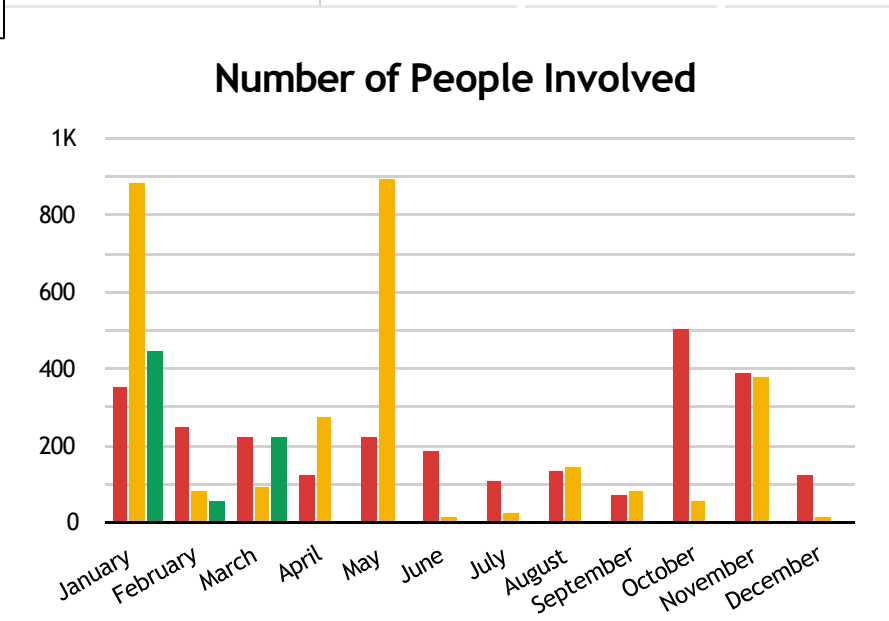

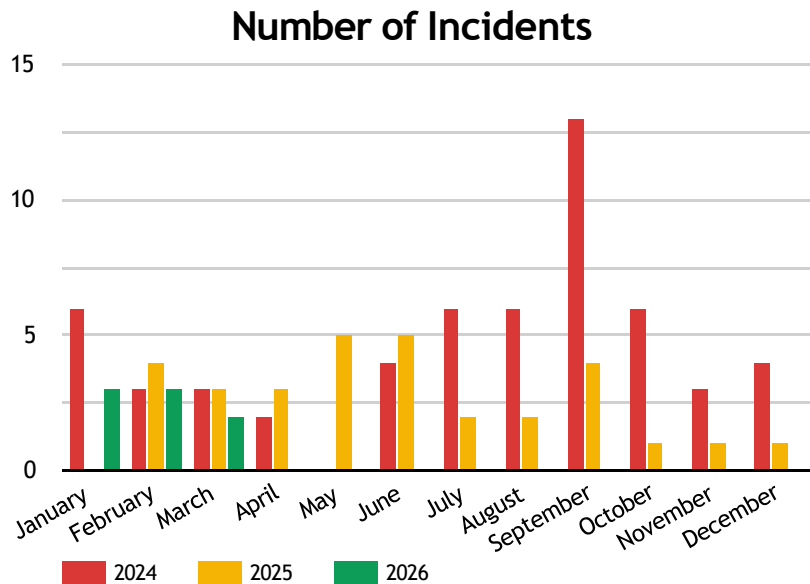
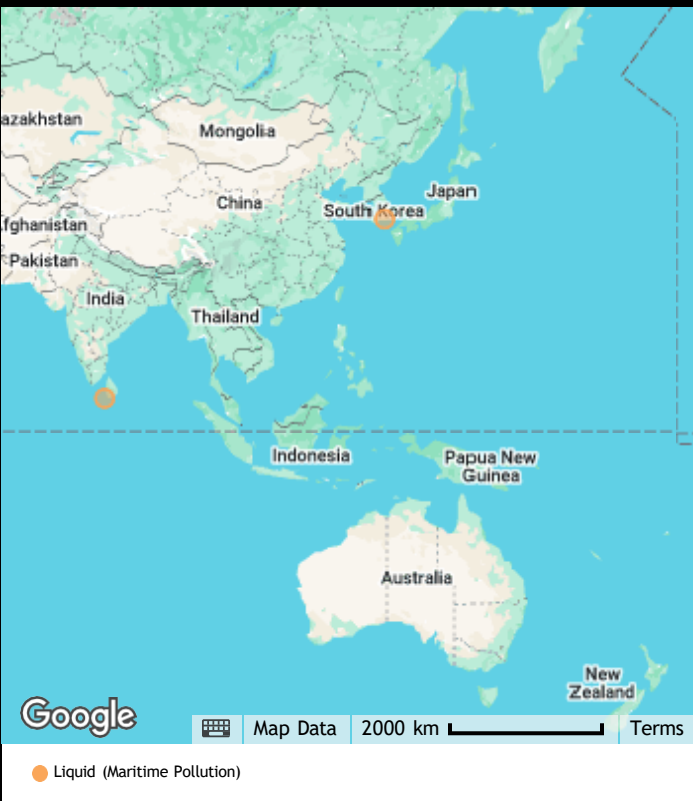
- Statistics:**
- There were a total of 5 IHM incidents reported in March 2026. One incident was classified as **Illegal Documentation** and the rest were classified as routine Irregular Human Migration.
- Comments:**
- 1 incident, from 01 March, was a large scale IHM incident involving 153 Bangladesh and Rohingya migrants attempting to travel to Malaysia.
 - The 1 illegal documentation incident involved Myanmar see fishermen working on a Malaysian fishing vessel without the required immigration worker permits.
 - The remaining incidents involved routine migrant workers transiting in small boats between Indonesia and Malaysia.
 - While it is now the end of the historical peak season for large-scale IHM venture from the Bay of Bengal, it is possible that there will be more in April or May.

OBSERVATIONS

Statistics :

- A total of 2 ENVSEC incidents were reported in Mar 2026, showing a slight decrease compared to the previous month Feb 26 (3), and remaining lower than Jan 26 (3). Compared to the same period in previous years, the number is also lower than Mar 25 (4) and slightly below Mar 24 (3). Overall, this indicates that environmental security incidents remain low, with a gradual downward trend during March 2026.

Maritime Pollution (MARPOL) : A total of 2 maritime pollution incidents were recorded in Mar 26, showing a slight decrease compared to the previous month Feb 26 (3), and remaining lower than Jan 26 (3). Compared to the same period in previous years, the figure is also lower than Mar 25 (4) and slightly below Mar 24 (2). The incidents occurred in Sri Lanka (1) and the ROK (1), involving one cargo vessel and one unknown vessel, reflecting ongoing challenges in vessel identification. Overall, while the number of cases remains low, such incidents continue to highlight environmental risks associated with maritime activities in the region.

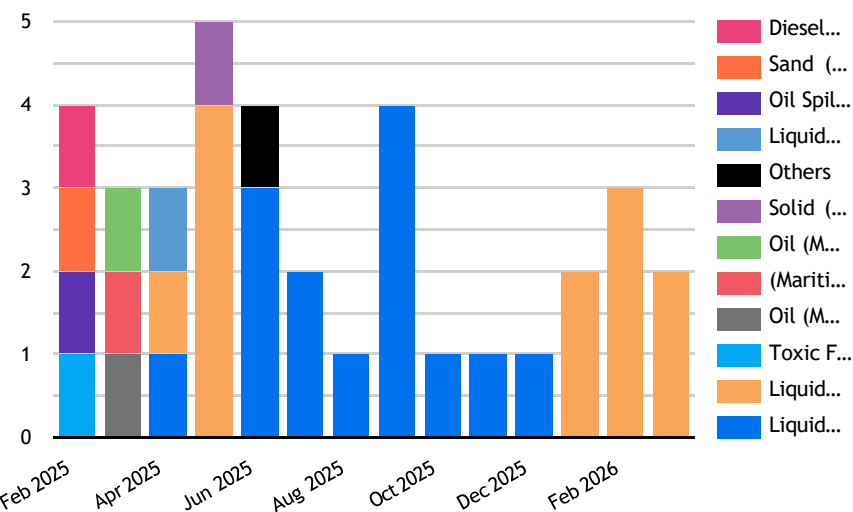

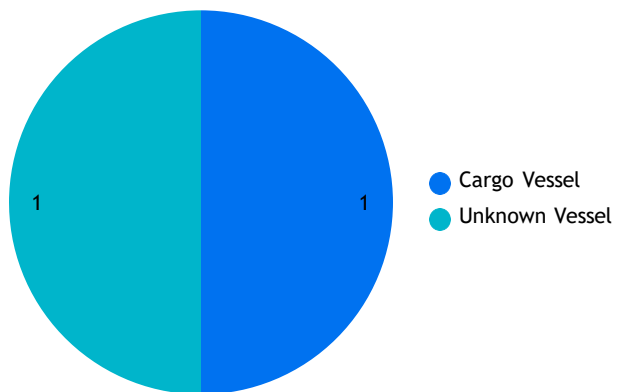
Comments :

- Overall, ENVSEC incidents in Mar 2026 remained low and showed a slight decline compared to previous months, with cases limited to ship-source maritime pollution in Sri Lanka and the ROK. While the scale of incidents is minimal, the involvement of both identified and unknown vessels highlights ongoing challenges in vessel identification and the persistent environmental risks associated with maritime activities. Continued monitoring, effective reporting, and regional cooperation remain essential to support timely response and mitigate potential impacts on the marine environment.

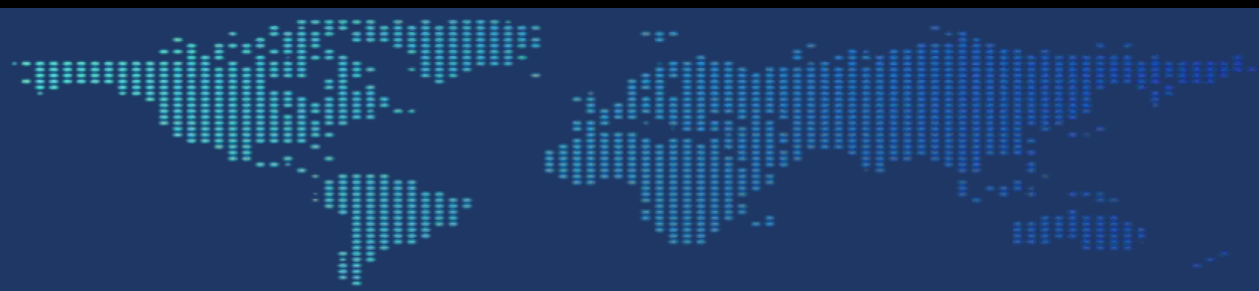
Note:

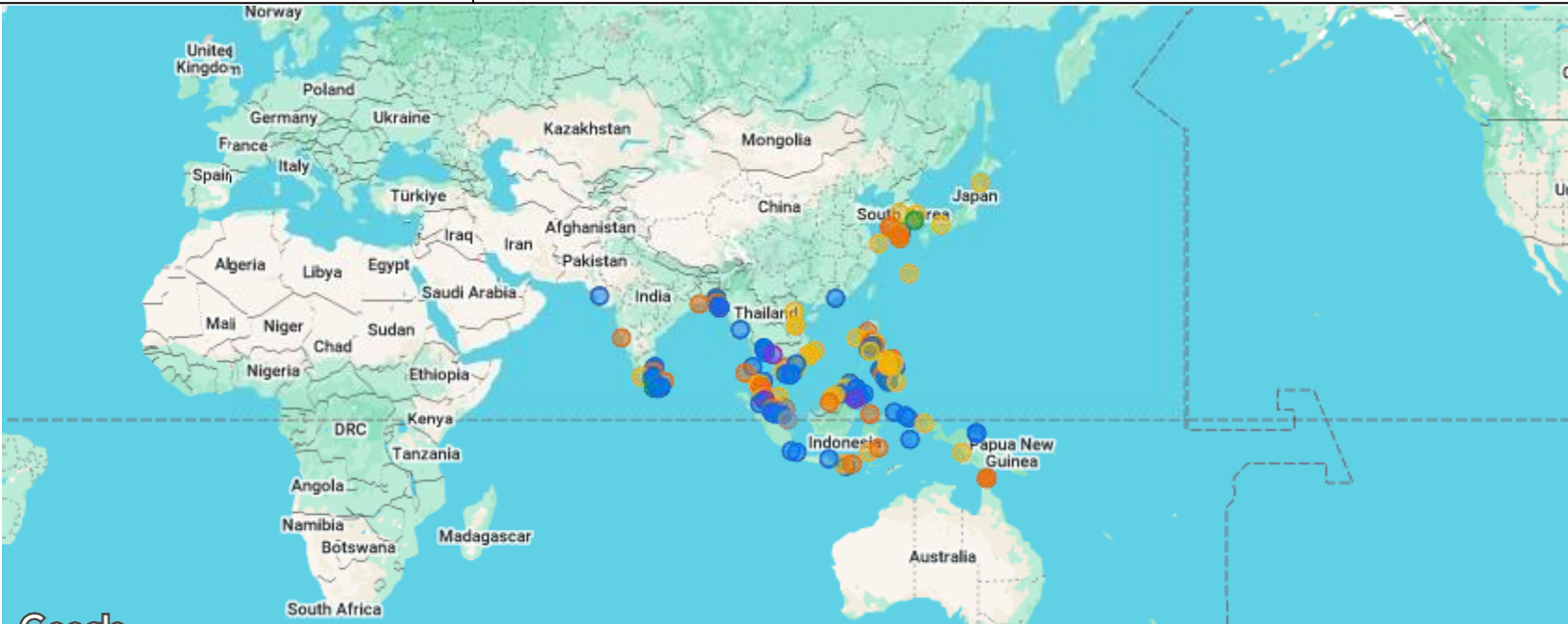

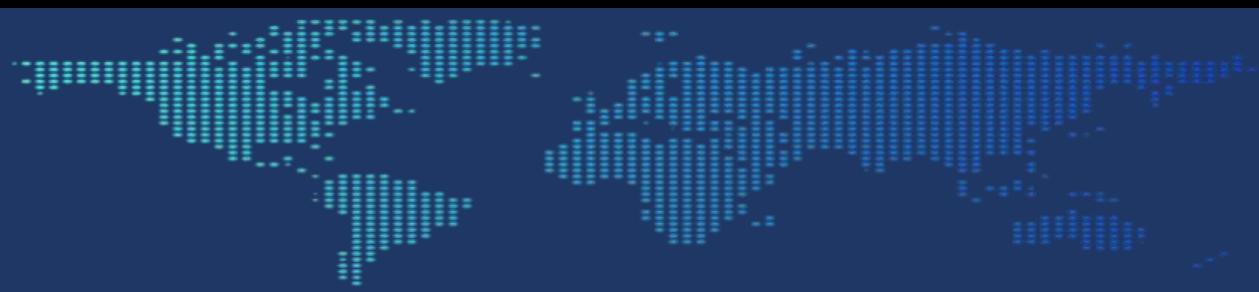

IFC Recommendations



1. All mariners to report any maritime security incidents timely to the nearest coastal state and inform the IFC at the earliest possible time.
2. All mariners are strongly recommended to be vigilant, in particularly when operating in IFC identified hotspots (**Westbound lane of Traffic Separation Scheme in Singapore Strait, Eastbound lane of Traffic Separation Scheme in Singapore Strait, Belawan and Dumai Anchorages in Indonesia, Manila Anchorage in the Philippines, and Chittagong Outer Anchorage in Bangladesh**).
3. All mariners are advised to adopt **Ship Protection Measures** recommended in the **Regional Guide to Counter Piracy and Armed Robbery Against Ships in Asia** (e.g., illuminating the accommodation block and poop deck, deploying sentries and increase frequency of security rounds).
4. All mariners to take note on the description of the perpetrators and to take photos of the perpetrators if possible. Where available, CCTV footage capturing the incident should be provided to **the coastal state authorities** for follow-on investigation.
5. All mariners are advised to participate in **IFC Voluntary Community Reporting (VCR)** as depicted in **MARSEC Chart O6112 and O6113**. In case of any doubt, incident at sea, suspicious approach or unusual observed activity at sea, please contact the IFC Duty Officer:

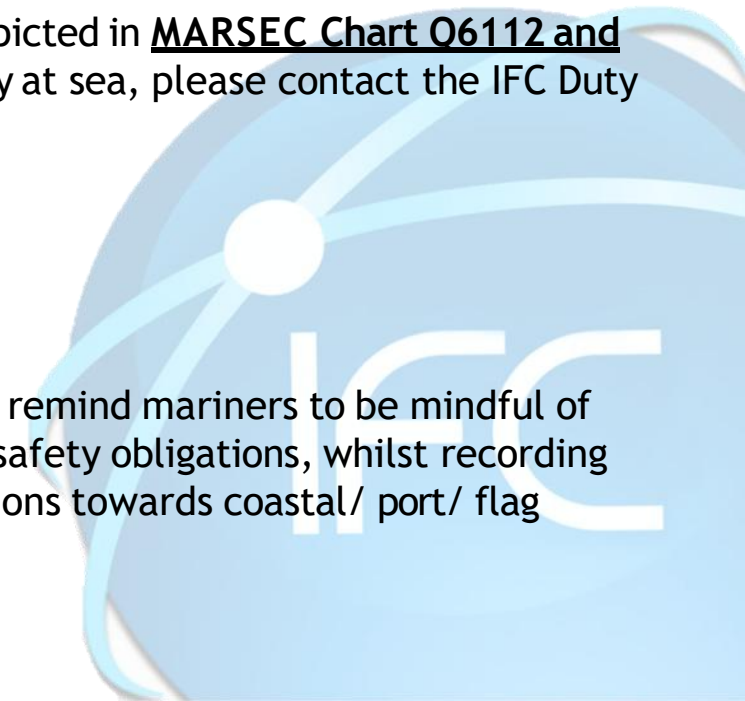
