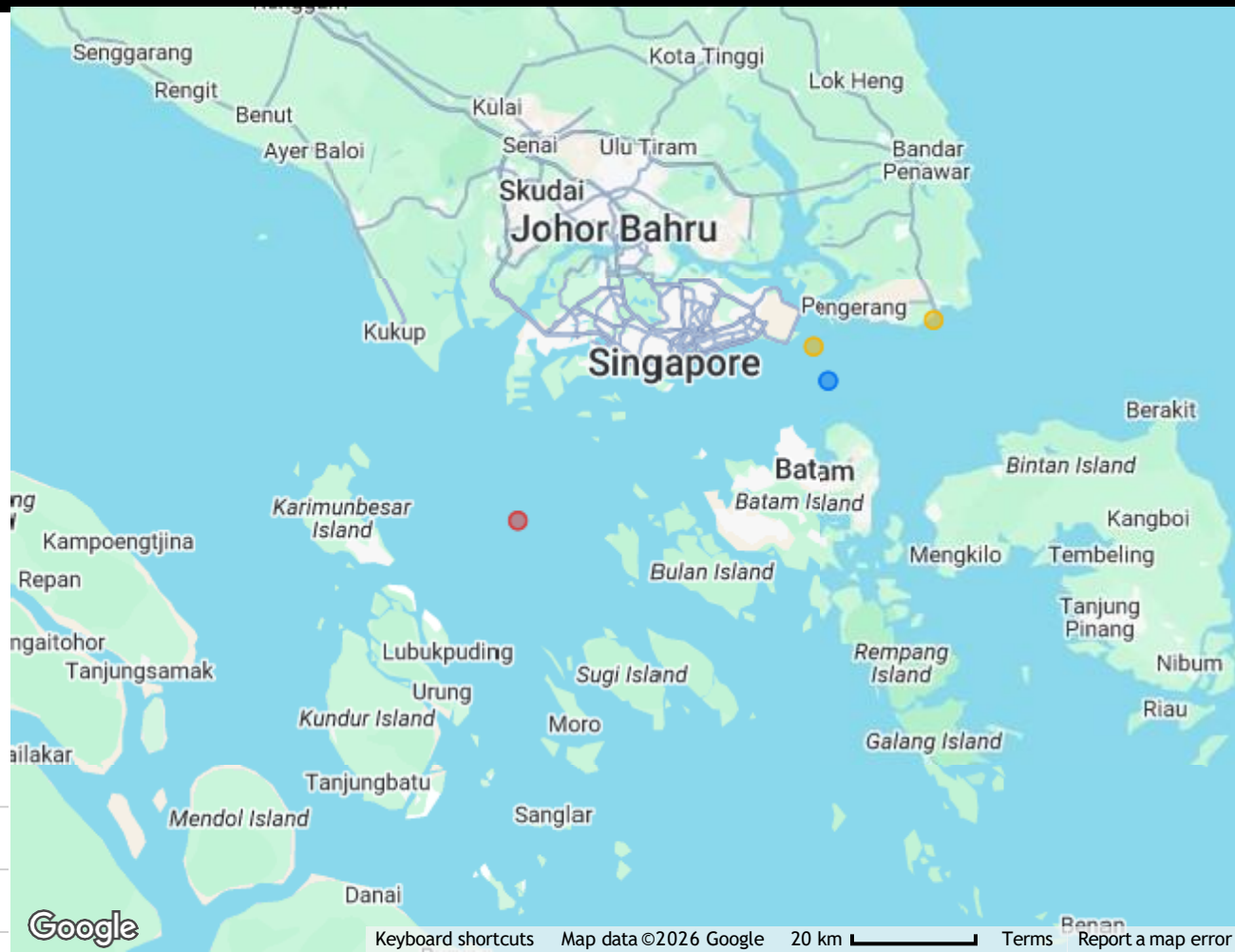
Overview of MARSEC Incidents in the Singapore Strait



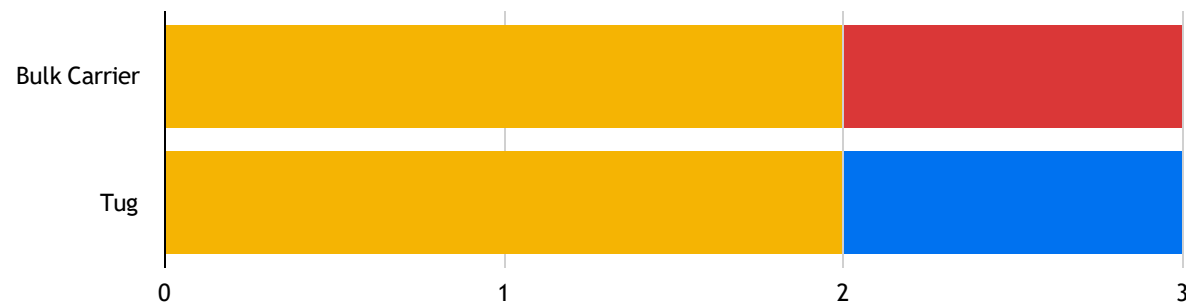

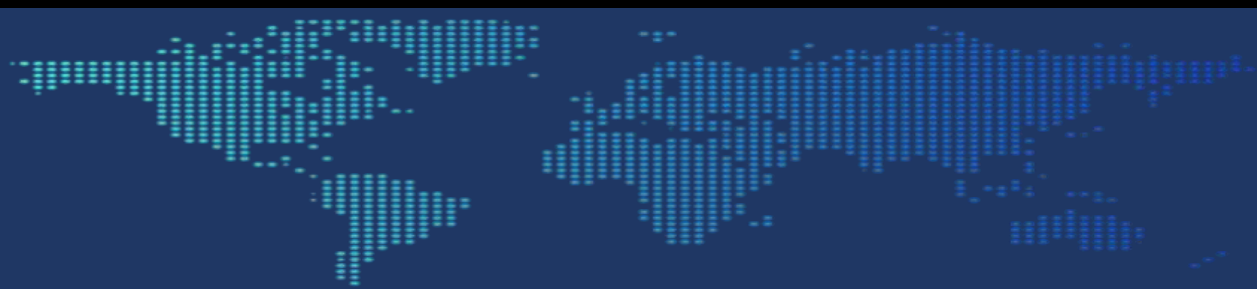


Number of Vessels





Executive Summary



Theft, Robbery and Piracy at Sea: 2 TRAPS incidents were reported in May 2026. Of note, one incident took place in the Phillip Channel, Singapore Strait (SS) and another incident off Chittagong, Bangladesh.

Maritime Incidents: 66 MI incidents were reporting in May 2026. Sunk-Capsized being the most common reported cause of incident this month which accounted for 19 of the 66 incidents.

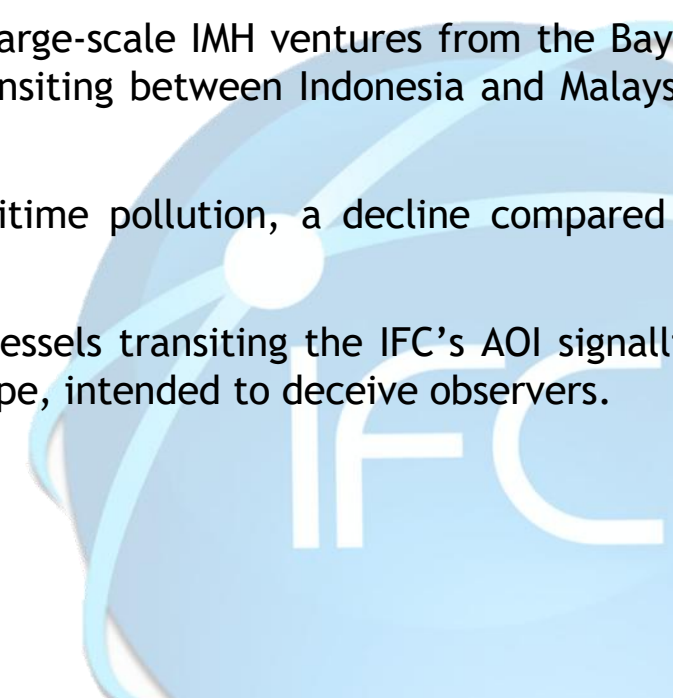
Illegal, Unreported, and Unregulated Fishing: 26 IUUF incidents were reported in May 2026, a noticeable decline overall and remained well below the levels recorded in May 2024, 2025. Local violations remained the main contributor, while poaching incidents increased slightly but were concentrated mainly in Australian waters.

Contraband Smuggling: 56 CS incidents were reported in May 2026, down from the previous month, but smuggling continued across domestic products, fuel, tobacco, and drugs. The incidents were spread broadly across maritime routes in Southeast Asia and parts of East and South Asia.

Irregular Human Migration: 10 IHM incidents were reported in May 2026, there were no large-scale IMH ventures from the Bay of Bengal to Malaysia or Indonesia this month. The incidents consists of migrant workers transiting between Indonesia and Malaysia, except one case of a Chinese individual illegally entering South Korea.

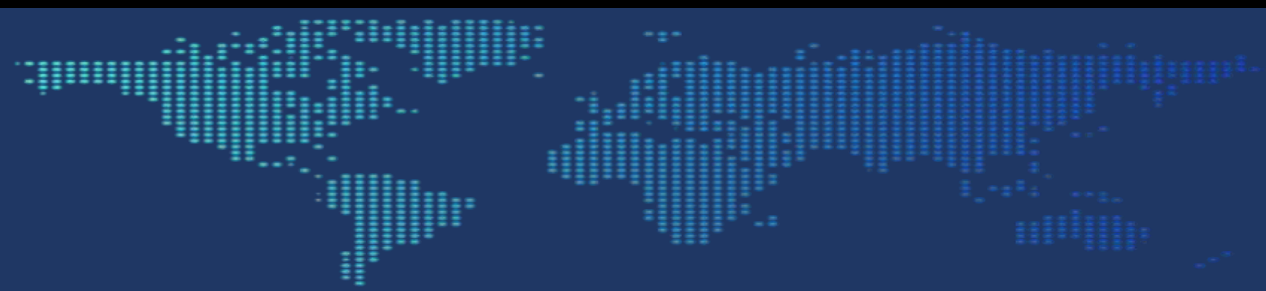
Environment Security: 10 ENVSEC incidents were reported in May 2026, involving maritime pollution, a decline compared to previous month but a significant increase compared to past years, 2024 and 2025.

Cyber Security: 18 CYBSEC incidents were reported in May 2026, all incidents involved vessels transiting the IFC's AOI signalling false information over AIS. This information may have included false name, flag or vessel type, intended to deceive observers.

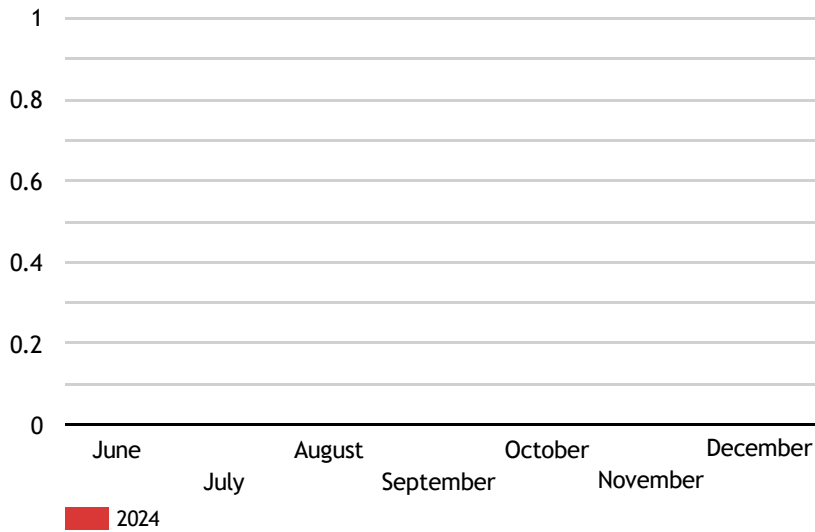

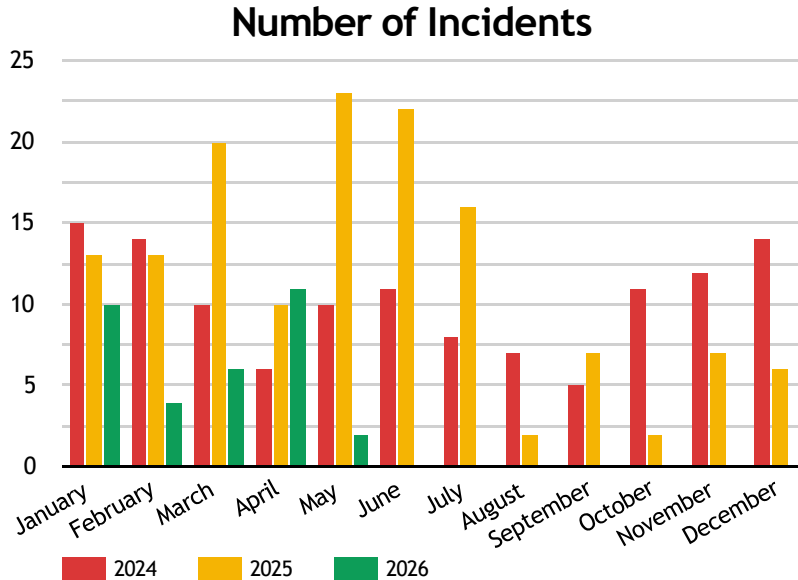
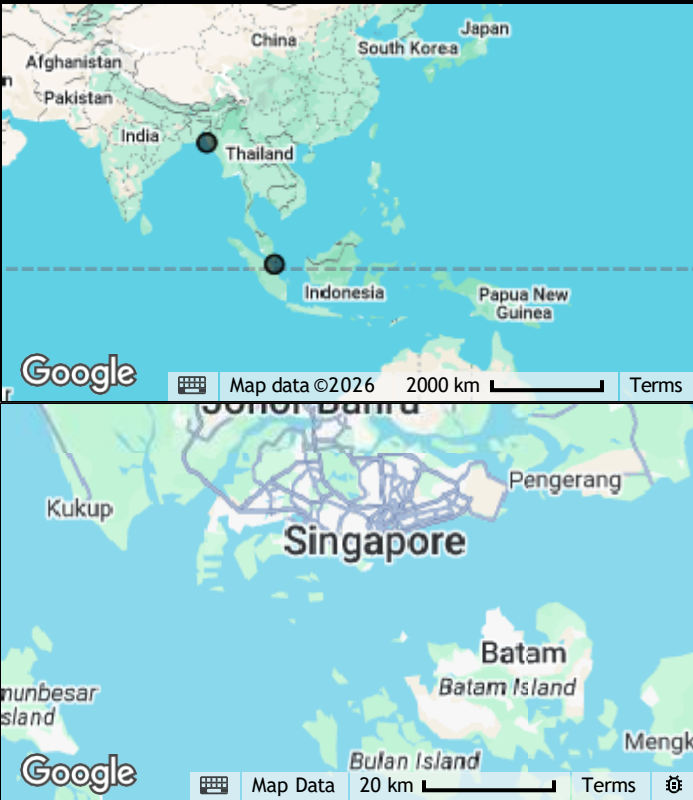

Theft, Robbery and Piracy at Sea (TRAPS)



OBSERVATIONS

Statistics.

- A total of 2 TRAPS incidents (Boarding) were reported in May 2026, with one incident each in the Phillip Channel, Singapore Strait (SS) and off Chittagong, Bangladesh. This represented a significant decrease compared to the same period in 2025 (23) and 2024 (10).

- Both incidents occurred during the Period of Darkness (PoD), involving a Container Vessel and a Bulk Carrier respectively.

Singapore Strait.

- One incident was reported on 13 May 2026 involving a Bulk Carrier while it transited the Phillip Channel, in the Singapore Strait. No injury to crew was reported. A crew member reportedly sighted a perpetrator armed with a knife in the engine room workshop. The perpetrator fled the vessel upon hearing the ship's alarm. No item was reported stolen.

Bangladesh.

- One incident was reported on 07 May 2026 involving a Container Vessel while anchored off Chittagong, Bangladesh. No injury to crew was reported. Approximately 8 to 10 perpetrators armed with long knives were reportedly sighted onboard the vessel. The perpetrators fled upon hearing the ship's alarm. Paint was reported stolen.

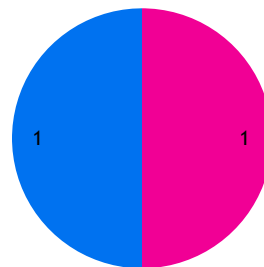
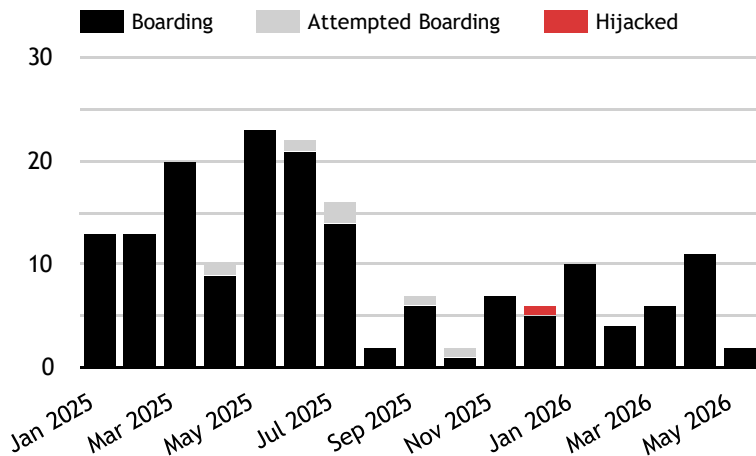
- Based on crew account and incident reports, the Modus Operandi of the perpetrators remain largely opportunistic in nature, typically operating in periods of darkness and amongst high shipping/boat concentrations, which make detection difficult. Perpetrators also often avoid confrontation where possible, opting to flee upon being detected.

- With the Northeast Monsoon abating and weather conditions expected to become more favorable for fishing activities, the IFC assesses that incident numbers would likely remain low in the coming quarter. Notwithstanding, risks of incidents occurring remain, particularly in known areas of concern. All vessels are thus strongly advised to maintain heightened vigilance and adhere to recommended security actions when transiting the Singapore Strait.

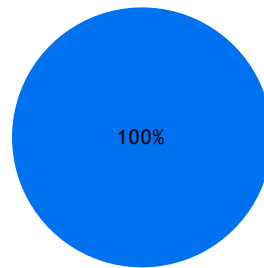

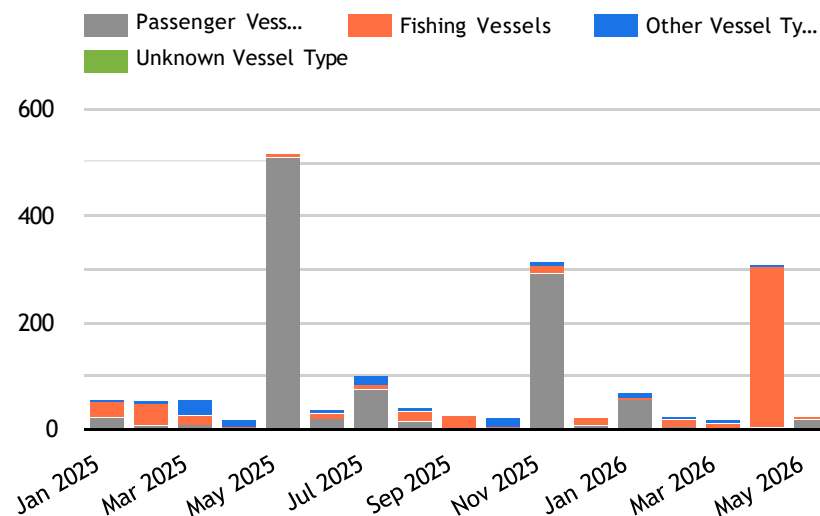
- Statistics:**
- A total of 66 Maritime incidents were reported for the month of May which is higher than the number recorded in 2025 (65) but lower than in 2024 (83).
 - The largest number of reported incidents was sunk-capsized (19), followed by Adrift (17), then Collision-Grounding (11).
 - The cause of incident with the highest number is Equipment Failure (16), then Bad Weather (14), and Unauthorized Operation (7).
 - The types of vessels which have the highest number of incidents are Fishing Vessel (36), followed by Small Boat (12), then by Tug (10)
 - In terms of location, the highest number of reported incidents occurred in the waters of ROK (17), followed by both Vietnam (10) and Malaysia (10), then by Philippines (9) and Thailand (9).

- A total of (23) individuals were reported dead or missing this month, which is lower than last month (308). Overall, (47) SAR operations were conducted, resulting in the rescue of (361) individuals.
- Comments:**
- The number of dead or missing for this month is comparatively low compared to last month high number of dead and missing which is primarily resulting from the sunk-capsized incident in the Andaman Sea involving a fishing trawler carrying Rohingya refugees and Bangladeshi nationals wherein 280 individuals were reported missing.

Number of Vessels, by Type of Incident

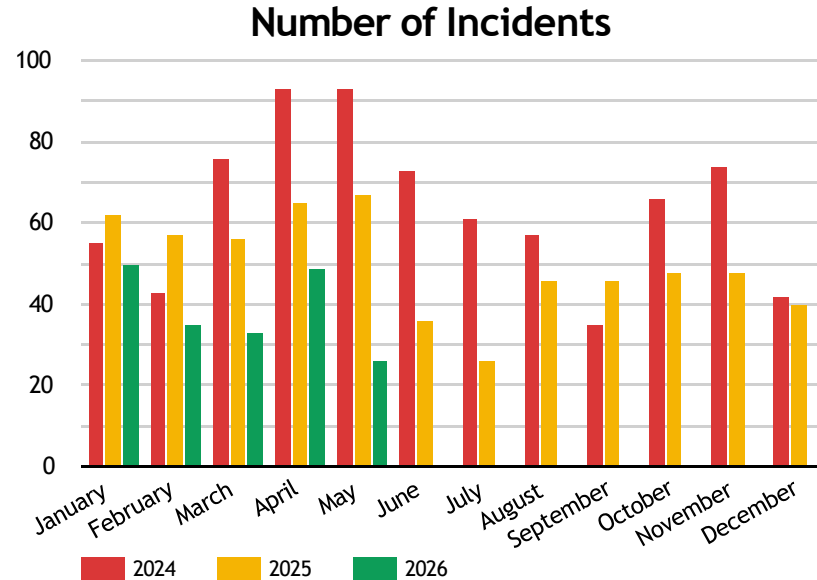

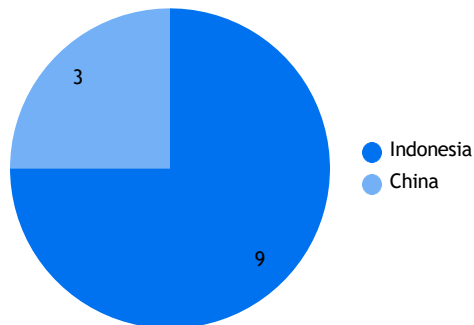

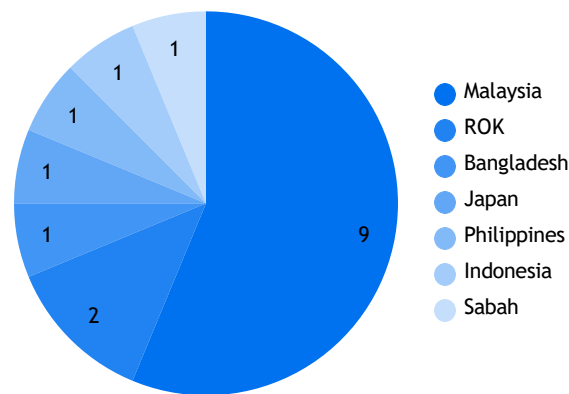

OBSERVATIONS

Statistics :

- A total of 26 IUUF incidents were recorded in May 2026, marking a notable decline from April 2026 (49 incidents) and March 2026 (33 incidents). Compared with the same month in previous years, the number of incidents remains significantly lower than May 2025 (67 incidents) and May 2024 (93 incidents). This indicates that while IUUF activities continue to occur across the region, the overall level of reported incidents has decreased and remains well below the higher levels observed in preceding years, reflecting a generally improved enforcement and monitoring environment.
- Most IUUF incidents were concentrated in Malaysia (9 incidents, 35%) and Australia (8 incidents, 31%), together accounting for 66% of all reported cases. The Republic of Korea (ROK) recorded 4 incidents (15%), while Sabah, Indonesia, the Philippines, Bangladesh, and Japan each reported 1 incident (4%), highlighting Malaysia and Australia as the primary IUUF hotspots during the reporting period.

- **Local:** A total of 15 local IUUF incidents were recorded in May 2026, significant decline from April (42 incidents) and March (25 incidents). The figure was also well below May 2025 (36 incidents) and May 2024 (69 incidents), indicating that local IUUF activity remained at a relatively low level during the reporting period.

- Malaysia accounted for majority of local IUUF incidents with 8 cases (53%), followed by the Republic of Korea (ROK) (2 cases, 13%). Sabah, Indonesia, the Philippines, Bangladesh, and Japan each recorded 1 incident (7%), highlighting Malaysia as the main hotspot for local IUUF activity during the reporting period.

- **Poaching:** A total of 11 poaching-related IUUF incidents were recorded in May 2026, up from April (7 incidents) and March (8 incidents). However, the figure remained well below May 2025 (31 incidents) and May 2024 (24 incidents), indicating that poaching activity, despite the recent increase, remained relatively low compared to previous years.

- Australia accounted for the majority of poaching incidents with 8 cases (73%), followed by the Republic of Korea (ROK) (2 cases, 18%) and Malaysia (1 case, 9%), highlighting Australian waters as the primary poaching hotspot during the reporting period.

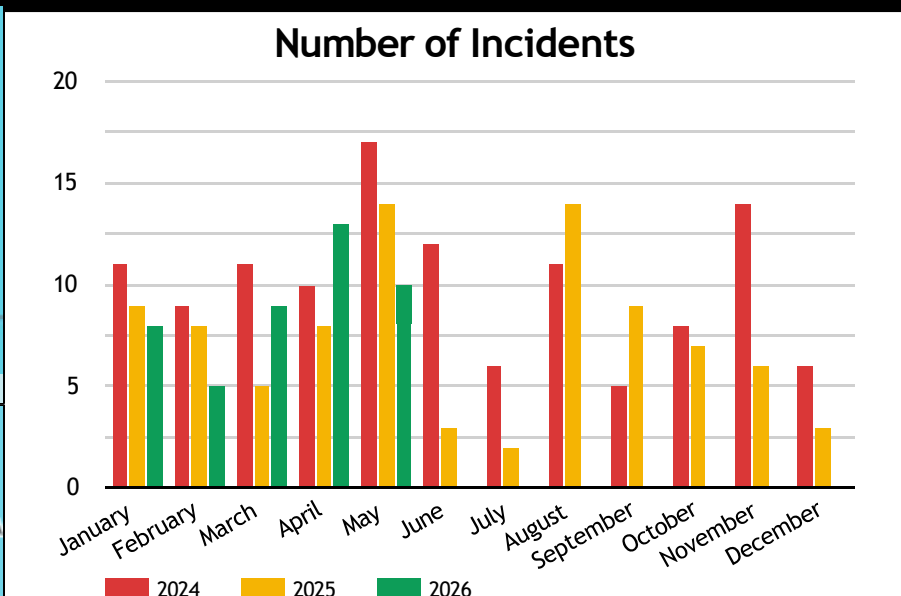
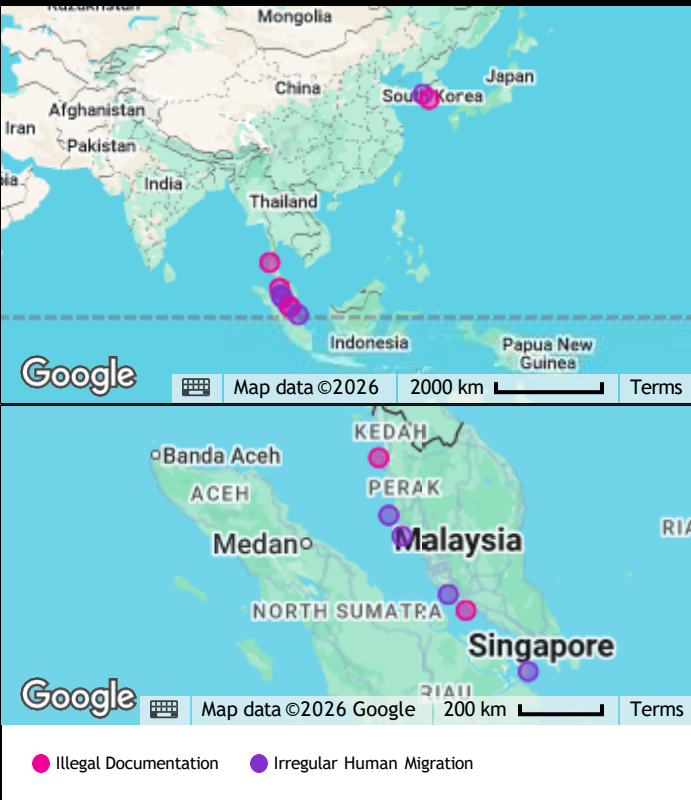
- **International :** NSTR.

Comments :

- IUUF incidents in May 2026 declined overall and remained well below the levels recorded in May 2025 and May 2024. Local violations remained the main contributor, with Malaysia identified as the key hotspot, while poaching incidents increased slightly but were concentrated mainly in Australian waters. Continued monitoring and regional cooperation remain necessary to sustain the downward trend and prevent localized resurgence.

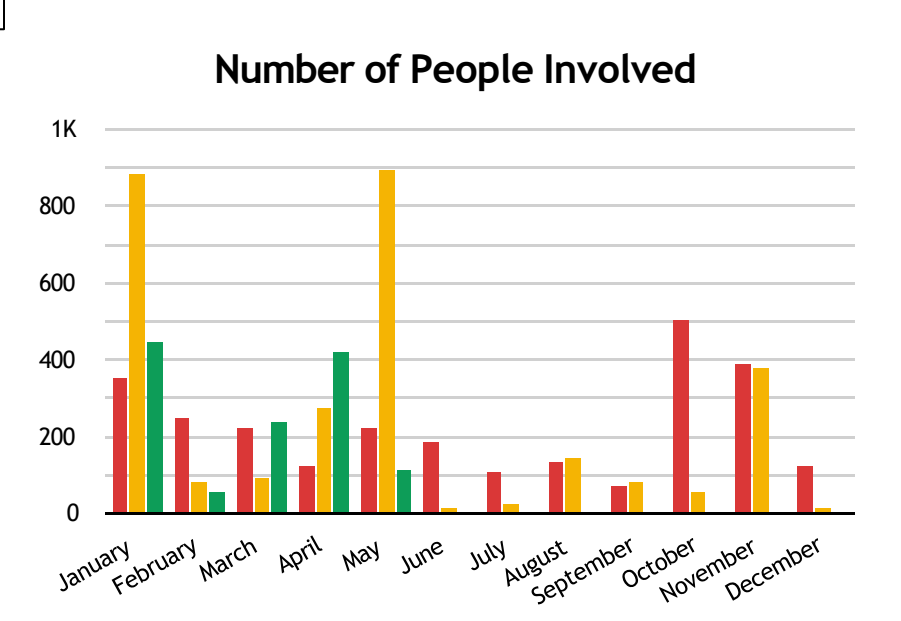


Irregular Human Migration (IHM)

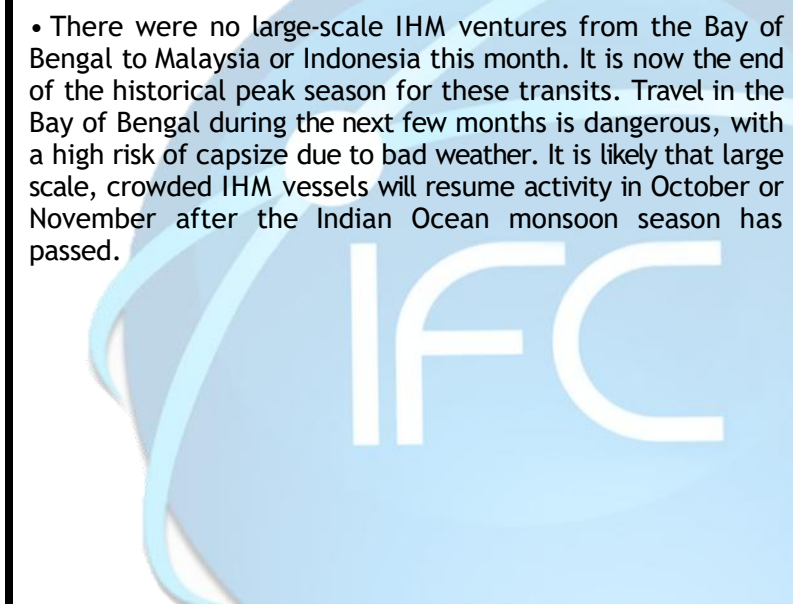
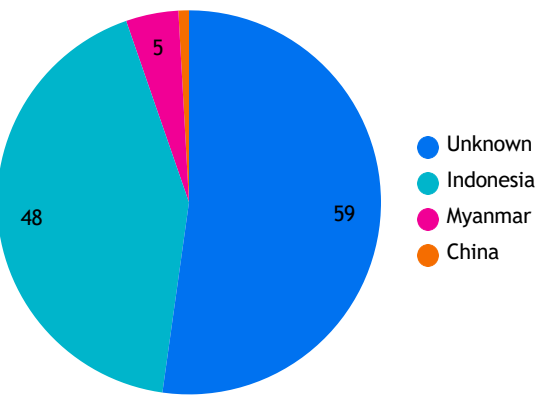
Statistics:

- There were a total of 10 IHM incidents reported in May 2026. There were four cases of Illegal Documentation and six cases of routine Irregular Human Migration.

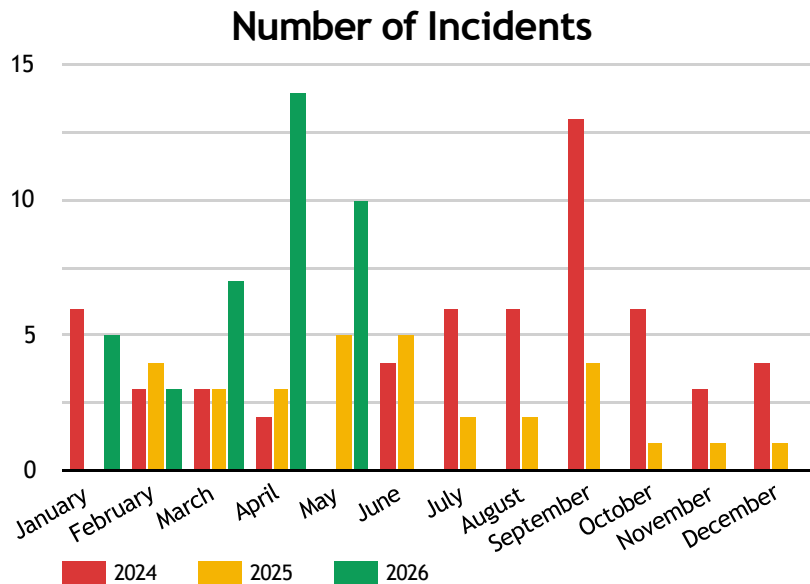
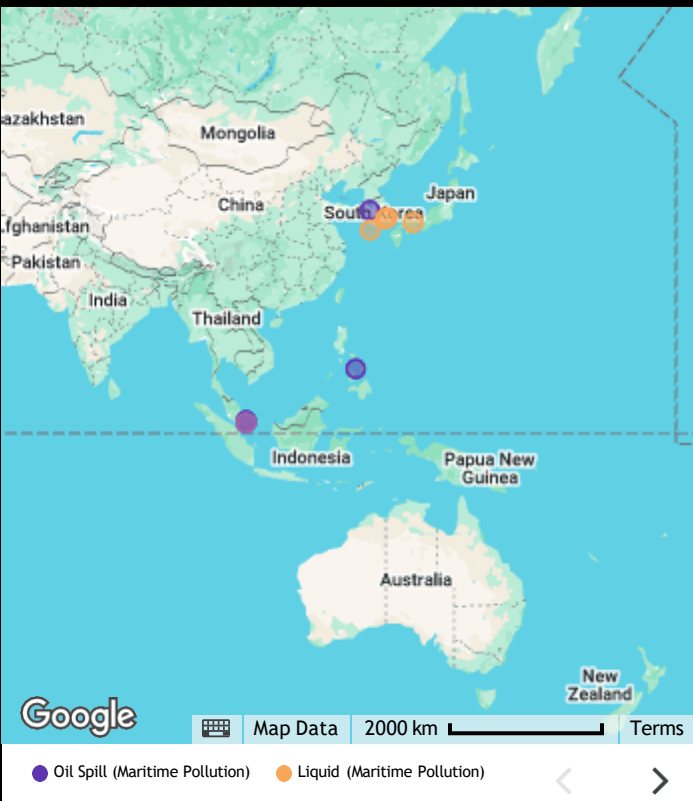
- 1 incident, from 9 April, was a large scale IHM incident involving up to 280 Rohingya immigrants. Tragically, the boat was found capsized with only 9 persons rescued. A second, smaller boat containing 25 persons also arrived in Malaysia from the Bay of Bengal.
- Three illegal documentation incidents involved foreign workers working illegally on vessels in the Malacca Strait. The fourth was an illegal migrant arrested for working on a fishing boat in South Korea.
- The routine IHM incidents were almost all migrant workers transiting between Indonesia and Malaysia, except one case of a Chinese man illegally entering South Korea.

Environmental Security (ENVSEC)



OBSERVATIONS

Statistics :

- A total of 10 ENVSEC incidents were reported in May 2026, representing a decrease from April 2026 (14 incidents) but remaining higher than March 2026 (7 incidents). Compared with the same period in previous years, the number was significantly higher than May 2025 (5 incidents) and May 2024 (0 incidents). Overall, this indicates that environmental security incidents remained above historical levels despite a decline from the previous month.
- Most incidents occurred in the SW of the South China Sea (4) and the Republic of Korea (ROK) (4), while Japan and the Philippines recorded 1 incident each. Among incidents where vessel types were identified, fishing vessels accounted for the largest share (3), followed by tankers (1) and small boats (1), highlighting fishing vessels as the most frequently identified vessel type during the reporting period.

Maritime Pollution (MARPOL) : A total of 10 maritime pollution incidents were recorded in May 2026, representing a decrease from April 2026 (14 incidents) but remaining higher than March 2026 (7 incidents). Compared with the same period in previous years, the figure was higher than May 2025 (5 incidents) and May 2024 (0 incidents). Most incidents occurred in the SW of the South China Sea (4) and the Republic of Korea (ROK) (4), while Japan and the Philippines recorded 1 incident each. Overall, maritime pollution incidents remained above historical levels despite a decline from the previous month.

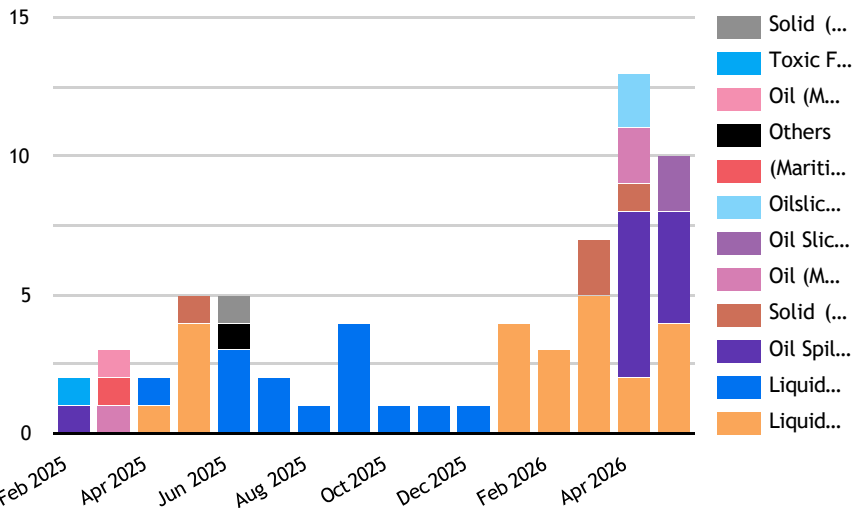

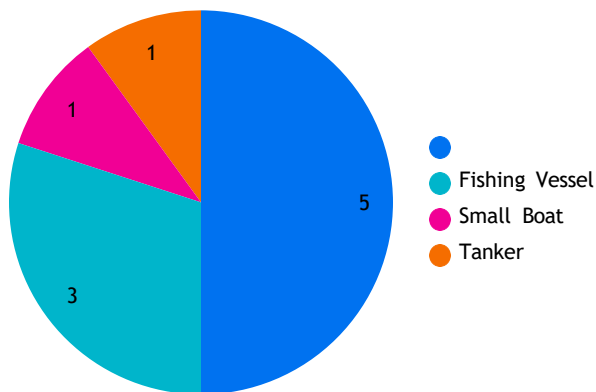
Comments :

- ENVSEC incidents in May 2026 declined from the previous month but remained above levels recorded in previous years, driven entirely by maritime pollution cases. Incidents were mainly concentrated in the SW of the South China Sea and the Republic of Korea (ROK), reflecting continued pollution risks in active maritime areas. Although no major environmental disaster was reported, sustained monitoring, timely reporting, and regional cooperation remain essential to mitigate potential impacts on the marine environment.

Types of Violation

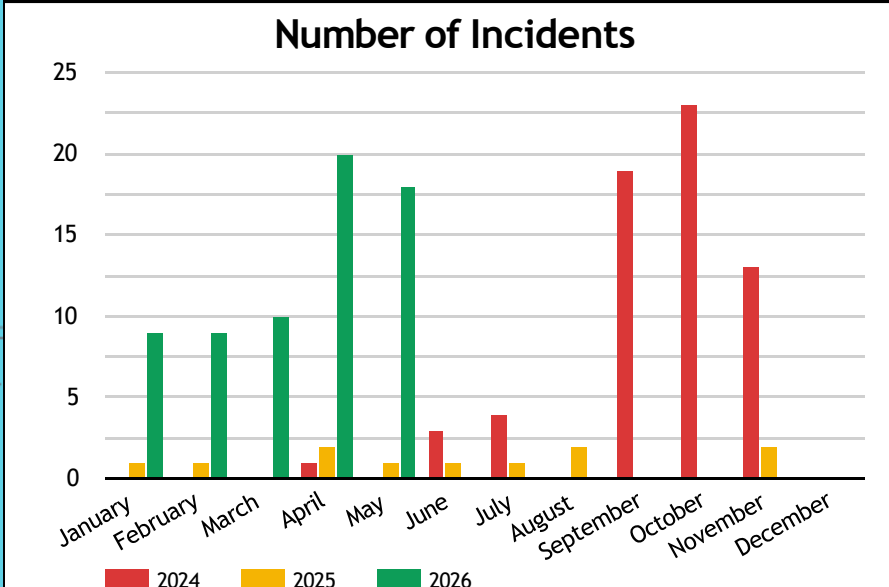


Sources of Incidents

- There were 18 CYBSEC incident reported in May 2026.

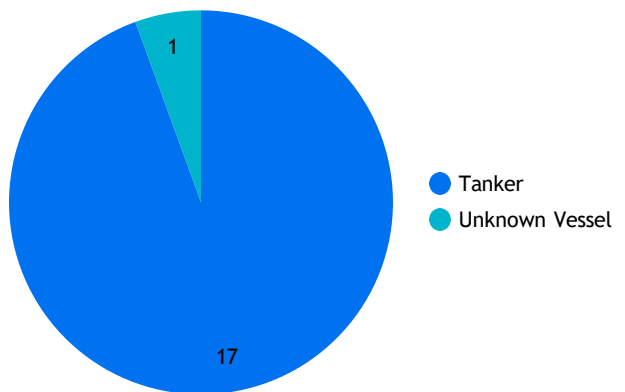
Comments:

- All of the incidents involved a vessel transiting the IFC AOR signalling false information over AIS. This information may have included a false name, flag or vessel type, intended to deceive observers as to the nature and purpose of the vessel.
- There were no reports of damage to underwater telecommunications cables and no reports of an incident in maritime cyberspace.

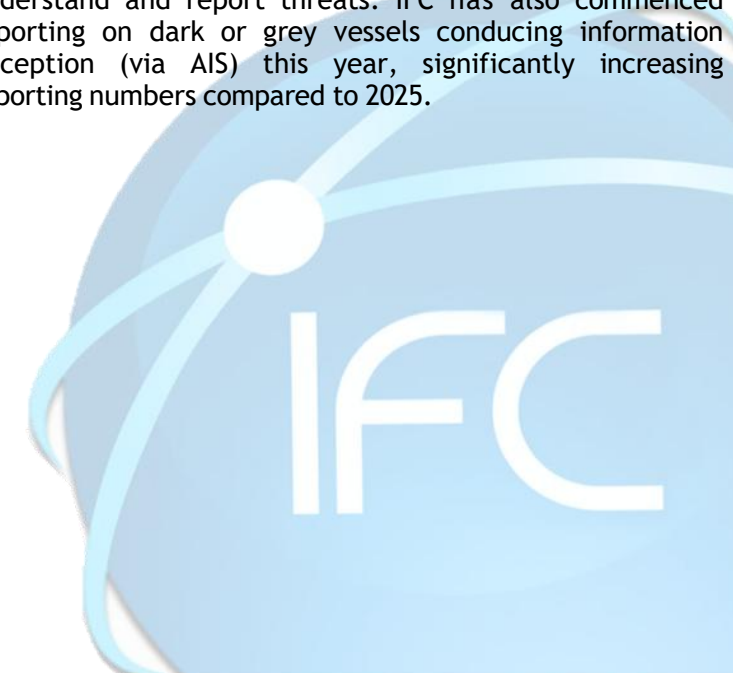
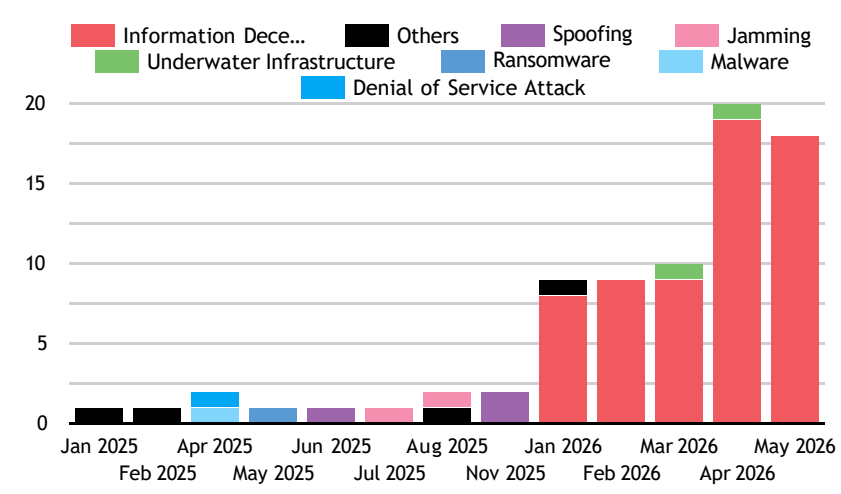
Note:

- As of Jan 2026, IFC has updated how we report on CYBSEC incidents, moving to a target-centric reporting focus rather than method-centric. This will allow IFC to better categorise and analyse CYBSEC incidents in the region and more easily understand and report threats. IFC has also commenced reporting on dark or grey vessels conducting information deception (via AIS) this year, significantly increasing reporting numbers compared to 2025.

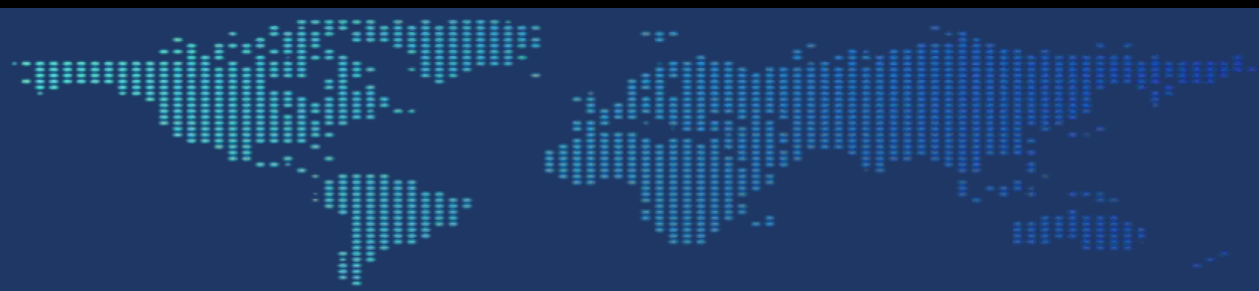


Types of Incident

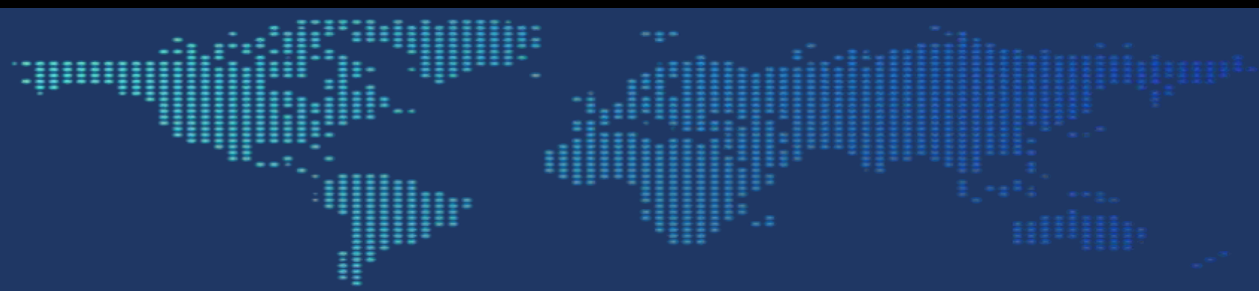

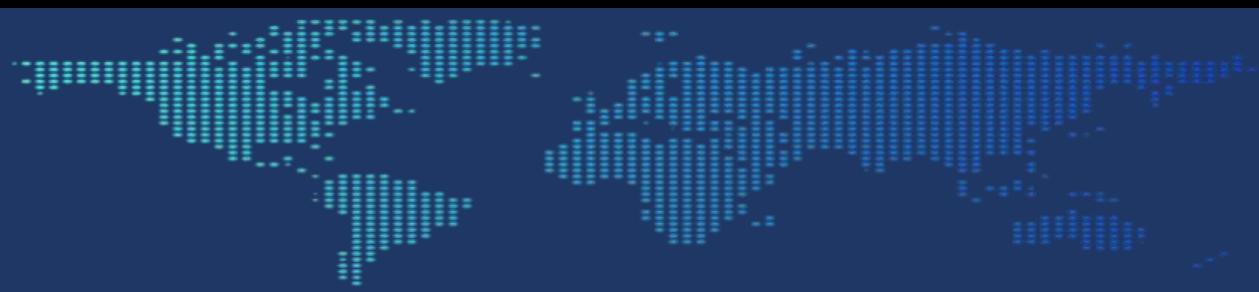

IFC Recommendations



1. All mariners to report any maritime security incidents timely to the nearest coastal state and inform the IFC at the earliest possible time.
2. All mariners are strongly recommended to be vigilant, in particularly when operating in IFC identified hotspots (**Westbound lane of Traffic Separation Scheme in Singapore Strait, Eastbound lane of Traffic Separation Scheme in Singapore Strait, Belawan and Dumai Anchorages in Indonesia, Manila Anchorage in the Philippines, and Chittagong Outer Anchorage in Bangladesh**).
3. All mariners are advised to adopt **Ship Protection Measures** recommended in the **Regional Guide to Counter Piracy and Armed Robbery Against Ships in Asia** (e.g., illuminating the accommodation block and poop deck, deploying sentries and increase frequency of security rounds).
4. All mariners to take note on the description of the perpetrators and to take photos of the perpetrators if possible. Where available, CCTV footage capturing the incident should be provided to **the coastal state authorities** for follow-on investigation.
5. All mariners are advised to participate in **IFC Voluntary Community Reporting (VCR)** as depicted in **MARSEC Chart O6112 and O6113**. In case of any doubt, incident at sea, suspicious approach or unusual observed activity at sea, please contact the IFC Duty Officer:

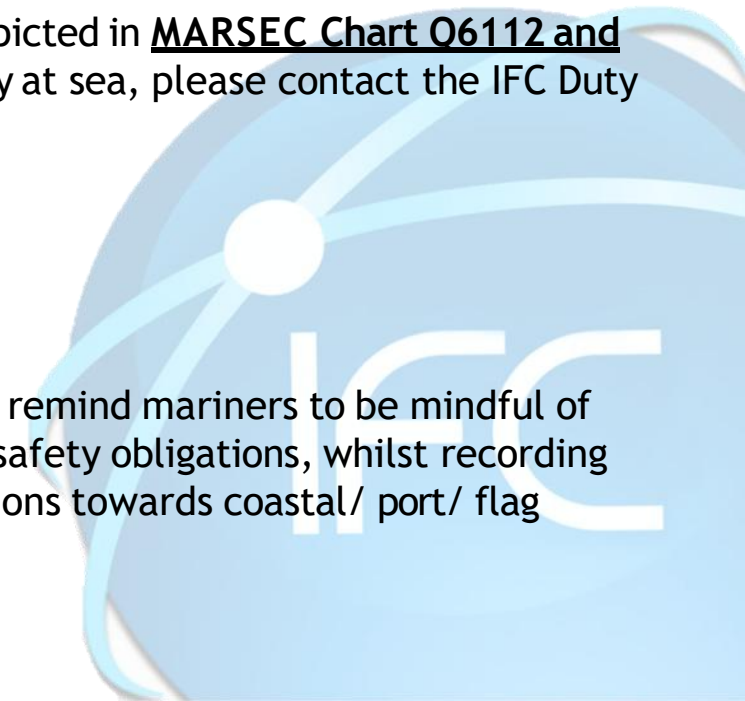
