## **OBSERVATIONS**

- Slow moving vessel types with low freeboard (bulk carriers, tankers, and tugs) and barges) were the most targeted vessels in the Singapore Strait.
- 2. Tankers and Bulk Carriers were the most targeted vessel types in anchorage areas as in Chittagong, Bangladesh and Belawan, Indonesia.
- 3. 16 incidents involving armed perpetrators (knives, crowbars or gun-like objects) were recorded (13 in 2021), with 2 resulting in injuries.
- 4. Incidents are consistent with known modus operandi of petty crime with minimal or no confrontation.


Spike of incidents in May due to cyclones (ASANI and KARIM).

## **OBSERVATIONS**

- 1. Increase in incidents are likely attributed to (a) lifting of COVID-19 restrictions, and (b) reopening of the fishing industry.
- 2. Waters off Malaysia and Indonesia were the most vulnerable to IUUF incidents.
- 3. Vietnamese fishing vessels were involved in the highest number of poaching incidents, with 39 incidents (33.6%) recorded.
