SECTION A: THEFT, ROBBERY AND PIRACY AT SEA (TRAPS)

Information Updates:

03 Nov - Boarding/ Sea Theft/ No Injury/ Tug & Barge/ Singapore Flagged/ Underway/ Eastbound Lane of TSS, Singapore Strait/ DB061222 (Information Update on DB071122)

The incident location has been updated to be within the ITW (1°11'21.0"N 103°52'21.6"E).

IFC Comments:

Indonesia ILO shared that seven perpetrators were arrested by Batam authorities while 18 escaped. Six sampans and 400kg of scrap metal have been secured as evidence. Local authorities are currently conducting investigations. Through information sharing by the IFC and Indonesia ILO, the Marine Polairud and TNI AI worked together to ensure operational success. Indonesian authorities updated that there were 20 ships that ambushed the tugboat, and the Marine and Air Police captured four boats, of which seven people were residents of the Tanjong Uma sub-district.

Incidents:

06 Dec - Boarding/ Sea Theft/ No Injury/ Tug and Barge/ Singapore Flagged/ Anchored/ Vung Tau Anchorage Area, Viet Nam/ DB081222

At the time of inspection, there were 2 subjects on the vehicle were transporting scrap iron on the vehicle.

The two subjects claimed to have stolen the scrap iron from barge in the amount of about 1 ton. Currently, there are 2 other subjects who were on the barge LKH 7887 SC 4719A.

The patrol team approached the barge LKH 7887 SC 4719A and the tractor HK TUG9, informing the captain of the HK TUG9 that 2 unknown persons broke into the barge suspected of theft of property.

The captain of the tractor HK TUG9 confirmed that the 2 strangers were not part of the ship's crew and asked the Border Guards to approach and arrest.

As a result of the initial struggle, the above 4 subjects all admitted that there was discussion and organization to carry out the theft of property on foreign ships in the Vung Tau "0" buoy area. The actual number of assets after being counted is 1, 501 kg of scrap iron.

IFC RECOMMENDATIONS

The IFC advises:

- 1. All mariners to report any maritime security incidents timely to the nearest coastal state and inform the IFC at the earliest possible time.
- 2. All mariners are strongly recommended to be vigilant, in particularly when operating in IFC identified hotspots (Sulu-Celebes seas, Eastbound Lane of Traffic Separation Scheme in Singapore Strait, Jakarta Port in Indonesia and South Harbor Anchorage in Philippines).
- 3. All mariners are advised to adopt Ship Protection Measures recommended in the Regional Guide to Counter Piracy and Armed Robbery Against Ships in Asia (e.g., illuminating the accommodation block and poop deck, deploying sentries and increase frequency of security rounds).
- 4. All mariners to take note on the description of the perpetrators and to take photos of the perpetrators if possible. Where available, CCTV footage capturing the incident should be provided to the coastal state authorities for follow-on investigation.
- 5. All mariners are advised to participate in IFC Voluntary Community Reporting (VCR) as depicted in MARSEC Chart Q6112 and Q6113. In case of any doubt, incident at sea, suspicious approach or unusual observed activity at sea, please contact the IFC Duty Officer:
