

12 Jul - Attempted Boarding/Sea Theft/No Injury/Cargo Carrier/Malta Flagged/Anchored/Mongla, Bangladesh/DB200722 (Information update on DB190722)

It was updated that the perpetrators were attempting to board the vessel. Perpetrators were arrested in possession of homemade weapons (chapatis, da, axes and karate, etc).

18 Jul - Boarding/ Sea Theft/ No Injury/ Bulk Carrier/ Bahamas-Flagged/ Underway/ Off Jakarta Anchorage, Indonesia/ DB220722

- 1. It has been reported that a Sea robbery occurred on a bulk carrier as it was approaching Jakarta Anchorage. The duty watchkeeper while on routine rounds noticed three perpetrators armed with a long knife, attempting to board the vessel and immediately informed the bridge.

- d. Ship Operator/ Manager: Gold Tree Shipping SA

- 3. The alarm was raised and the watchkeeper shouted at the robbers, which resulted in them escaping empty handed. The incident was reported to the Tanjung Priok Vessel Traffic Service and local port police boarded the vessel to carry out an investigation. The vessel and crew were reported safe.

- 1. It has been reported that there was an attempted robbery on a heavy load carrier whilst anchored near Mongla.
- 2. Vessel Details
- a. Flag: Malta
- b. Type: Heavy Load Carrier
- c. Ship Owner: Boskalis Offshore Heavy Marine
- d. Ship Operator/ Manager: Boskalis Offshore Heavy Marine
- e. LPOC: Sekupang, Indonesia

- 3. The vessel was approached by a boat with a number of armed perpetrators on board. The port authority was notified and a Coast Guard vessel was dispatched and able to disrupt the perpetrators. Local Law enforcement were able to make seven arrests and confiscate a boat in relation to the incident, following raids that were carried out on 14th July 2022.

- 1. All mariners to report any maritime security incidents timely to the nearest coastal state and inform the IFC at the earliest possible time.
- 2. All mariners are strongly recommended to be vigilant, in particularly when operating in IFC identified hotspots (Sulu-Celebes seas and Eastbound Lane of Traffic Separation Scheme in Singapore Strait).
- 3. All mariners are advised to adopt Ship Protection Measures recommended in the Regional Guide to Counter Piracy and Armed Robbery Against Ships in Asia (e.g., illuminating the accommodation block and poop deck, deploying sentries and increase frequency of security rounds).
- 4. All mariners to take note on the description of the perpetrators and to take photos of the perpetrators if possible. Where available, CCTV footage capturing the incident should be provided to the coastal state authorities for follow-on investigation.
- 5. All mariners are advised to participate in IFC Voluntary Community Reporting (VCR) as depicted in MARSEC Chart Q6112 and Q6113. In case of any doubt, incident at sea, suspicious approach or unusual observed activity at sea, please contact the IFC Duty Officer:
