

1. POCC informed that a Marshall Island flagged bulk carrier reported one perpetrator with weapon-like object had boarded the vessel when transiting along Eastbound Lane of TSS, Singapore Strait (1°16'52.2"N 104°19'06.6"E) on 23 Jun 22 at 0401 (UTC + 8).

2. Ship master reported that all crew are safe and nothing reported stolen. Singapore Police Coast Guard rendered the assistance and conducted checks onboard the vessel, and no perpetrator was found. The vessel continued her voyage to NPOC, China.

1. POCC informed that a Panama flagged bulk carrier reported two perpetrators had boarded the vessel when transiting along Eastbound Lane of TSS, Singapore Strait (1°16'42.0"N 104°15'24.0" E) on 20 Jun 22 at 0130 (UTC + 8).

2. Ship master reported that all crew are safe, and nothing reported stolen. Ship master updated also that a search was conducted throughout the ship, and confirmed that the two perpetrators fled. The vessel no longer required assistance, and continue with their voyage to NPOC, China.

21 Jun - Boarding/ Sea Robbery/ No Injury/ KM REMUNG/ Cargo Vessel/ Off Samarinda, Indonesia/ DB230622

Kamla Office of the Bakamla Central Maritime Zone of the Republic of Indonesia with KN KUDA LAUT-403, successfully thwarted coal theft in the Muara Tengah Waters, Samarinda, East Kalimantan on 21 June.

When the arrest was made, the perpetrator of the coal theft tried to escape. KN's visit board, search, and seizure (VBSS) personnel. KUDA LAUT-403 issued a warning shot in a measured manner. The thief tried hard to escape and dodge. A total of 17 shots were fired, until finally the group of thieves was caught.

Based on the initial inspection, the VBSS Team managed to secure 25 tons of coal and other evidence. For example, KM REMUNG which was successfully secured, 11 shovels, two machete-type sharp weapons, and one hammer.

In addition, all eight perpetrators are currently in KN custody. Until this news was passed down, the perpetrators and evidence were taken to Balikpapan, with the aim of staying away from the territory of the thief group.
