

1. POCC informed that a Barbados-flagged Bulk Carrier, MV SELENA, reported four perpetrators armed with machetes boarded the vessel when transiting along Karimata Strait, Indonesia (01°01'54.0"N 105°05'48.0"E) on 21 May 22 at 0500 (UTC + 8).

3. Ship master reported that all crew are safe, and nothing was stolen. The vessel does not require any assistance is required and will continue her voyage to NPOC, Singapore.

19 May - Boarding/ Sea Theft/ No Injury/ Unoccupied Oil Platform/ Off Tanjung Kidurong, Bintulu, Sarawak, Malaysia/ DB230522

The Malaysia Maritime Enforcement Agency (MMEA) arrested a vessel suspected of trespassing and stealing at an unoccupied oil platform in northwest Tanjung Kidurong, Bintulu around 12.05pm (UTC +8) yesterday (19 May 2022).

KM ARAU detected a fishing vessel without a registration number was moving in a suspicious condition around 10.30 am (UTC +8) from an unoccupied platform in Bintulu waters.

Suspecting the suspect, KM ARAU chased the vessel which tried to escape and within almost two hours managed to intercept and stop the suspect's vessel for inspection and search purposes.

The results of the inspection and search found that the vessel was operated by seven crew members including the skipper, all foreign men aged between 22 and 40 years and all the crew had failed to submit any valid identity documents when inspected.

Enforcement officers also found some equipment belonging to the oil rig which was reported missing by the complainant such as cable ropes, coveralls, blankets, satellite phones, radios and safety jackets on the suspect's vessel and suspected to have been stolen by the vessel's crew from the unmanned platform.

- 3. All mariners are advised to adopt Ship Protection Measures recommended in the Regional Guide to Counter Piracy and Armed Robbery Against Ships in Asia (e.g., illuminating the accommodation block and poop deck, deploying sentries and increase frequency of security rounds).
- 4. All mariners to take note on the description of the perpetrators and to take photos of the perpetrators if possible. Where available, CCTV footage capturing the incident should be provided to the coastal state authorities for follow-on investigation.
