

#### SECTION A: THEFT, ROBBERY AND PIRACY AT SEA (TRAPS)

26 Apr - Boarding/ Sea Theft/ No Injury/ STI MAGISTER/ Chemical Tanker/ Singapore-Flagged/ Anchored/ Unknown Location/ DB290422

1. Upon sighting the perpetrators, the duty officer immediately raised the alarm, informed the master and mustered the ship crew. The duty officer observed further on CCTV that the door of the fore peak store was opened and three perpetrators came out of the store upon hearing the alarm. The duty officer then sent some of the ship crew to the forward deck and the crew saw the perpetrators escaping from the ship by either jumping into the water or climbing down the anchor chain. About seven or eight perpetrators were making their escape in a small boat.

3. A search on board was conducted by the crew and no other perpetrators were spotted. One set of gangway wire coil was found missing. There was no reported damage to the ship and the crew was not injured. The incident was reported to the local port control centre and Bangladesh Coast Guard. Three Coast Guard personnel boarded the ship at about 0240 hrs (UTC+6) on the same day to collect evidence. The Coast Guard personnel found footprints and a broken lock from the fore peak store

POCC informed that Panama-flagged bulk carrier, LADY FLORA, reported one unauthorised personnel were sighted in the engine room when transiting along Eastbound Lane of TSS, Singapore Strait (1°16'40.8"N 104°17'46.8"E) on 27 Apr 22 at 0226 (UTC + 8).

- 1. On 16 Apr 22, an incident of sea theft was reported onboard a Bangladesh flagged LPG tanker BLPG SOPHIA off Chittagong Port, Bangladesh. Reportedly, a perpetrator boarded the vessel while anchored. The crew raised an alarm and a search was conducted onboard.
