Incidents:

02 Jul - Boarding/ Sea Theft/ Tanker, Indonesia-Flagged/ No Injury/ Anchored/ Tanjung Priok Anchorage, Jakarta, Indonesia/ DB050723

Duty Crew on rounds onboard and anchored tanker noticed an unauthorized person of the aft deck. Alarm raised and crew mustered. Hearing the alarm, the person escaped with his accomplices in their boat, a search was carried out and nothing was reported stolen.

- 1. IFC received information from the Ship Master that an unauthorised boarding occurred onboard a Malaysia-flagged tug & barge, while transiting along Westbound Lane TSS, Singapore Strait (1°16'37.0"N 104°08'35.0"E) on 4 Jul 23 at 0900 (UTC + 8).
- 2. Ship Master reported the sighting of one sampan, and four perpetrators on the barge transferring scrap metal from the tug. LPOC: Brunei, NPOC is Malaysia.

- 1. IFC received information that an unauthorised boarding occurred onboard a Malaysia-flagged Tug & Barge, (1.222217, 103.502217) on 1 Jul 23 at 2050 (UTC + 8).
- 2. It was reported that there were 5 perpetrators on the barge and were transferring scrap metals onto 2 sampans.
- 3. The 5 perpetrators and 2 sampans were detained, and an estimated 100 tons of stolen scrap metal, valued at RM180,000 (US\$ 38,520) were seized by the Malaysian Marine Police Johor.

IFC Comments:

Malaysia ILO verified the information with the Malaysia Marine Police and confirmed that the incident occurred 2.4nm off Tanjung Piai, and the perpetrators have been arrested. Investigations are still ongoing.

RFI received from shipping company and confirmed that 5 perpetrators were arrested.

IFC RECOMMENDATIONS

The IFC advises:

- 1. All mariners to report any maritime security incidents timely to the nearest coastal state and inform the IFC at the earliest possible time.
- 2. All mariners are strongly recommended to be vigilant, in particularly when operating in IFC identified hotspots (Sulu-Celebes seas, Eastbound Lane of Traffic Separation Scheme in Singapore Strait, Jakarta Port in Indonesia and South Harbor Anchorage in Philippines).
- 3. All mariners are advised to adopt Ship Protection Measures recommended in the Regional Guide to Counter Piracy and Armed Robbery Against Ships in Asia (e.g., illuminating the accommodation block and poop deck, deploying sentries and increase frequency of security rounds).
- 4. All mariners to take note on the description of the perpetrators and to take photos of the perpetrators if possible. Where available, CCTV footage capturing the incident should be provided to the coastal state authorities for follow-on investigation.
- 5. All mariners are advised to participate in IFC Voluntary Community Reporting (VCR) as depicted in MARSEC Chart Q6112 and Q6113. In case of any doubt, incident at sea, suspicious approach or unusual observed activity at sea, please contact the IFC Duty Officer:
