SECTION A: THEFT, ROBBERY AND PIRACY AT SEA (TRAPS)

02 Nov - Boarding/ Sea Robbery/ Cargo Ship, Panama-Flagged/ No Injury/ Anchored/ Lubuk Gaung Dumai, Indonesia/ DB091123

While at anchor, the crew on duty sighted five perpetrators wearing masks and carrying knives. When the crew attempted to drive the perpetrators away, they were threatened with a knife, so they returned to the accommodation area and closed the door. The crew called the bridge and reported the incident to the shipmaster. The crew members searched the accommodation area, engine room, and on deck, with no further sightings of the perpetrators. The crew members were safe, and spare parts for the generator were reported stolen.

Robbers boarded an anchored general cargo ship unnoticed and escaped with the ship's stores. During security rounds, the watchman noticed footprints on the deck and observed the paint store padlock broken and stores missing. Alarms were raised, the crew mustered, and a search was carried out. The incident was reported to port control.

04 Nov - Boarding/ Sea Robbery/ Small Boat/ Off Kodiyakarai, Palk Strait/ DB061123

On 4 Nov, in two separate incidents, eight fishermen from the coastal villages of Pudupettai in Mayiladuthurai district and Vanavanmahadevi in Nagapattinam district were allegedly attacked and robbed of their belongings by a group of unidentified persons at sea when they were fishing 7nm off the Kodiyakkarai coast.

Sources at the Coastal Security Group (CSG) said the fishermen had ventured into the sea on a small boat. When they were fishing to the east of the Kodiyakkarai coast, three unidentified persons came in a small boat and intercepted them. Two of them boarded the fishermen's boat and assaulted the fishermen with a wooden log. In the assault, one of the fishermen suffered bleeding injuries on his head, while another suffered wounds on his left leg. The other two suffered internal injuries. The assailants stole a battery, a GPS device, fish, cell phones, and torchlights. The fishermen managed to return to the Kodiyakkarai coast on 4 Nov around 09:00 (UTC+6) and they were administered first aid at the primary health center in Kodiyakkarai. The Vedaranyam Marine Police of the CSG have registered a case, and investigations are on.

After a few hours, four more fishermen who were attacked mid-sea in another incident reached the Kodiyakkarai coast.

CSG sources said the fishermen went fishing on 4 Nov. When they were around 15nm to the east of Kodiyakkarai coast, a group of three unidentified persons, suspected to be Sri Lankans, intercepted them in a small boat. Two boarded the boat and assaulted the fishermen with wooden logs. They also stole a GPS device, a torchlight, a cell phone, a battery, and a 200-kg fishing net. The fishermen reached the Kodiyakkarai coast on 4 Nov and two of them were treated as outpatients at the Government Hospital in Vedaranyam.

- 2. All mariners are strongly recommended to be vigilant, in particularly when operating in IFC identified hotspots (Sulu-Celebes seas, Eastbound Lane of Traffic Separation Scheme in Singapore Strait, Jakarta Port in Indonesia and South Harbor Anchorage in Philippines).
- 3. All mariners are advised to adopt Ship Protection Measures recommended in the Regional Guide to Counter Piracy and Armed Robbery Against Ships in Asia (e.g., illuminating the accommodation block and poop deck, deploying sentries and increase frequency of security rounds).
- 4. All mariners to take note on the description of the perpetrators and to take photos of the perpetrators if possible. Where available, CCTV footage capturing the incident should be provided to the coastal state authorities for follow-on investigation.
- 5. All mariners are advised to participate in IFC Voluntary Community Reporting (VCR) as depicted in MARSEC Chart Q6112 and Q6113. In case of any doubt, incident at sea, suspicious approach or unusual observed activity at sea, please contact the IFC Duty Officer:
