

It was updated that fuel injection pump, some main engine and generator spares were stolen.

- 1. POCC reported of an unauthorised boarding onboard a Cyprus-flagged bulk carrier while underway off Phillip Channel, Singapore Strait. Crew sighted 3 perpetrators (reportedly unarmed) in the engine room (1°04'45.0"N 103°42'20.0"E) on 9 Aug 23 at 0335 (UTC + 8).
- 2. Ship master reported that all crew are safe, and engine spares were found missing. A plastic moulded replica toy gun was later found by the crew during security checks. The vessel does not require any assistance and will continue to her NPOC, Singapore.

- 2. Ship master reported that all crew are safe, and some main engine spares were stolen. The vessel does not require any assistance and will continue to her NPOC, Singapore.

- 1. POCC reported that a Liberia-flagged bulk carrier reported sighting of 4 perpetrators (reportedly armed with knives) boarded the vessel when transiting along Phillip Channel (1°02'37.8"N 103°39'13.2"E) on 8 Aug 23 at 2230(UTC +8). One crew was reportedly tied up and found unharmed in the engine room.
- 2. Ship master reported that all crew are safe and accounted for. The vessel required assistance and Singapore Police Coast Guard will render assistance to her.

POCC reported of an unauthorised boarding onboard a Marshall-Islands registered bulk carrier, while underway in the Eastbound Lane of TSS, Singapore Strait (1°16'43.8"N 104°16'40.2"E) on 7 Aug 23 at 00:58 (UTC+8). Crew sighted one unarmed perpetrator in the engine room, and he fled upon being sighted.
- 2. Ship master reported that all crew are safe, and some main engine, generator and fuel injection spares were missing after a search. The vessel does not require any assistance and will continue to the NPOC, China.

(Information Update on DB070823)

It was updated that, as of 8 Aug, at least three tonnes of oil from a slick suspected to have come from a ship, have been removed from Sirinan National Park and Koh Racha Yai after being washed ashore. The spill is believed to have originated from neighbouring Phangnga province on 2 Aug before reaching Koh Racha Yai in Phuket on 6 Aug.

The environmental impact was also being assessed as the slick posed a threat to 4,000 rai of undersea coral extending from Phangnga to Phuket. Four sea turtles had died as a result of the slick, with oil found in their stomachs suggested it had come from a tanker or cargo ship.

To establish the slick's source, the department has conducted a simulation of sea currents and wind speed over the past 10 days. The test results showed the spill might have occurred about 90 nautical miles east of Phuket.

- 1. All mariners to report any maritime security incidents timely to the nearest coastal state and inform the IFC at the earliest possible time.
- 2. All mariners are strongly recommended to be vigilant, in particularly when operating in IFC identified hotspots (Sulu-Celebes seas, Eastbound Lane of Traffic Separation Scheme in Singapore Strait, Jakarta Port in Indonesia and South Harbor Anchorage in Philippines).
- 3. All mariners are advised to adopt Ship Protection Measures recommended in the Regional Guide to Counter Piracy and Armed Robbery Against Ships in Asia (e.g., illuminating the accommodation block and poop deck, deploying sentries and increase frequency of security rounds).
- 4. All mariners to take note on the description of the perpetrators and to take photos of the perpetrators if possible. Where available, CCTV footage capturing the incident should be provided to the coastal state authorities for follow-on investigation.
- 5. All mariners are advised to participate in IFC Voluntary Community Reporting (VCR) as depicted in MARSEC Chart Q6112 and Q6113. In case of any doubt, incident at sea, suspicious approach or unusual observed activity at sea, please contact the IFC Duty Officer:
