

16 Oct - Boarding/ Sea Robbery/ Tanker, Panama-Flagged/ Minor Injury/ Underway/ Phillip Channel, Singapore Strait/ DB201023 (Information Update on DB161023)

It was updated that the stolen items are one starting air motor and spare kits, eight sets of connecting bearings, ten sets of main bearings, four pieces of main bearing bolts and nuts, four pieces of side bolts, six pieces of connecting rod metal bush, six rocker assembly, four pieces of push rod, six pieces of indicator cock assembly, six pieces of indicator valve, 12 pieces of exhaust valve seat, 12 pieces of exhaust valve spindle, 12 pieces of indicator valve seat, 12 pieces of indicator valve spindle, ten pieces of injector spare kits, 12 sets of piston rings set, eight sets of fuel pump parts and o/h kits, seven pieces of micro switch, one set of main lube oil pump parts, three sets of tachometer, three pieces of turbo charger o/h kit and 8 pieces of connecting rod bolts.

14 Oct - Boarding/ Sea Theft/ Tanker, Marshall Islands-Flagged/ No Injury/ Underway/ Phillip Channel, Singapore Strait/ DB191023 (Information Update on DB161023)

It was updated that all four perpetrators are males carrying backpacks; some were carrying knives. Based on CSO's assessment and information gathered, footmark was visible on the shipside at the starboard quarter of the vessel, and the robbers probably boarded the vessel using rope and hook. There was no confrontation; as soon as the perpetrators were sighted by the ship crew, alarm was raised, and all the perpetrators fled. The perpetrators were estimated to be onboard for a period of 20 to 30 minutes.

1. POCC reported an unauthorised boarding involving a Panama-Flagged tanker, as the vessel transited along the Phillip Channel, Singapore (1°04'49.2"N 103°42'27.0"E) on 16 Oct 23 at 03:10 (UTC +8). Crew reportedly sighted 5-6 armed perpetrators (armed with knives and poles) in the engine room. Four crew were tied up, of which one crew was hit on the head but there was no visible injury. No medical assistance is required.

2. Ship master reported that starter motors, ball bearings, piston and cables were missing. The vessel is currently enroute to NPOC, Hong Kong.

1. POCC reported an unauthorised boarding involving the Marshall Islands-flagged tanker, as the vessel transited along the Phillip Channel, Singapore (1°03'12.0"N 103°38'30.0"E) on 14 Oct 23 at 01:00 (UTC +8). Crew reportedly sighted 4 unarmed perpetrators in the engine room.

2. Ship master reported that all crew are safe and accounted for, and some engine spares were stolen. The vessel does not require any assistance and will continue her voyage to her NPOC, Singapore.

- 1. All mariners to report any maritime security incidents timely to the nearest coastal state and inform the IFC at the earliest possible time.
- 2. All mariners are strongly recommended to be vigilant, in particularly when operating in IFC identified hotspots (Sulu-Celebes seas, Eastbound Lane of Traffic Separation Scheme in Singapore Strait, Jakarta Port in Indonesia and South Harbor Anchorage in Philippines).
- 3. All mariners are advised to adopt Ship Protection Measures recommended in the Regional Guide to Counter Piracy and Armed Robbery Against Ships in Asia (e.g., illuminating the accommodation block and poop deck, deploying sentries and increase frequency of security rounds).
- 4. All mariners to take note on the description of the perpetrators and to take photos of the perpetrators if possible. Where available, CCTV footage capturing the incident should be provided to the coastal state authorities for follow-on investigation.
- 5. All mariners are advised to participate in IFC Voluntary Community Reporting (VCR) as depicted in MARSEC Chart Q6112 and Q6113. In case of any doubt, incident at sea, suspicious approach or unusual observed activity at sea, please contact the IFC Duty Officer:
