



SECTION A: THEFT, ROBBERY AND PIRACY AT SEA (TRAPS)

Incidents:

27 Jun - Boarding/ Sea Robbery/ LILA ACE, Product Tanker, Liberia-Flagged/ No Injury/ Anchored/ Dumai Inner Anchorage, Indonesia/ DB300623

Duty oiler onboard an anchored tanker noticed three robbers armed with steel bars near the engine room. The robbers saw the duty oiler and threatened to attack him, but the oiler managed to run away. Alarm raised and PA announcement made, resulting in the robbers escaping without stealing anything.

All crew mustered and a search was carried out. Incident reported to the authorities through the local agent.

26 Jun - Boarding/ Sea Theft/ Bulk Carrier, Iran-Flagged/ Underway/ Phillip Channel, Singapore Strait/ DB270623

1. POCC reported that an Iran-flagged bulk carrier, reported sighting of one perpetrator having boarded the vessel when transiting along Phillip Channel (1°03'57.0"N 103°35'39.6"E) on 26 Jun 23 at 2215 (UTC +8).

2. Ship master reported that all crew are safe and accounted for. No items were reported stolen yet. The vessel does not require any assistance and will continue her voyage to NPOC, China.

1. IFC received information from POCC that an unauthorised boarding occurred onboard a Hong Kong - Flagged Bulk Carrier, while transiting along Eastbound Lane of TSS, Singapore Strait (1°16'30.0"N 104°11'54.0"E) on 24 Jun 23 at 0030 (UTC + 8).

2. Ship Master reported the sighting of 4 perpetrators in the engine room. Master confirmed that all perpetrators have since left the vessel and does not require assistance. No injuries reported and some engines spare parts were stolen. LPOC was South Africa. NPOC China.

21 Jun - Hijacked/ Sea Robbery/ Fishing Vessel/ No Injury/ Underway/ Off Datu Island, Kalimantan, Indonesia/ DB300623

On 21 Jun, the fishing vessel was approached by four vessels with squid fishing gear whose registration marks and vessel names were covered.

Feeling threatened, the skipper of the fishing vessel walked away, and a chase ensued for about half an hour.

At around 10:30 (UTC+7), the Wahana Nilam IV ship was captured and controlled by the crew of the squid boat. They seized goods such as cigarettes, food, petrol and television sets and forced the captain and crew to move to one of their ships.

IFC Comments:

The incident started as a confrontation between fishermen from West Kalimantan and Central Java (Pati and Rembang) due to unresolved domestic dispute on their rights for fishing, which escalated into a violent confrontation.

IFC RECOMMENDATIONS

The IFC advises:

- 1. All mariners to report any maritime security incidents timely to the nearest coastal state and inform the IFC at the earliest possible time.
- 2. All mariners are strongly recommended to be vigilant, in particularly when operating in IFC identified hotspots (Sulu-Celebes seas, Eastbound Lane of Traffic Separation Scheme in Singapore Strait, Jakarta Port in Indonesia and South Harbor Anchorage in Philippines).
- 3. All mariners are advised to adopt Ship Protection Measures recommended in the Regional Guide to Counter Piracy and Armed Robbery Against Ships in Asia (e.g., illuminating the accommodation block and poop deck, deploying sentries and increase frequency of security rounds).
- 4. All mariners to take note on the description of the perpetrators and to take photos of the perpetrators if possible. Where available, CCTV footage capturing the incident should be provided to the coastal state authorities for follow-on investigation.
- 5. All mariners are advised to participate in IFC Voluntary Community Reporting (VCR) as depicted in MARSEC Chart Q6112 and Q6113. In case of any doubt, incident at sea, suspicious approach or unusual observed activity at sea, please contact the IFC Duty Officer:
