

Immediately, the Coast Guard Station Manila provided the necessary assistance and conducted an investigation. The initial inquiry with the crew ended at around 13:30 (UTC+7). The PCG collected a statement of facts, documents of the subject ship, and a list of lost items.

IFC Comments:

PH CG ILO updated that the ship's master reported that while anchored, their duty watch noticed that the vessel's safety store (forecastle) was broken and some items were stolen. All crew members were reported as safe.

The Philippine Coast Guard (PCG) responds to a robbery at sea in the vicinity waters off Manila International Container Terminal (MICT), Manila Bay Anchorage Area on 26 Nov.

At around 07:00 (UTC+8), the PCG Command Center received a report that a robbery at sea transpired aboard a bulk carrier at around 02:45 (UTC+8).

Immediately, the Coast Guard Station Manila provided the necessary assistance and conducted an investigation.

The initial inquiry with the crew ended at around 13:30 (UTC+8). The PCG collected a statement of facts, documents about the subject ship, and a list of lost items.

The crew reported that five unauthorised persons boarded an anchored ship through the hawse pipe. Duty AB on rounds noticed the persons and raised the alarm, resulting in the persons escaping with stolen ship's properties.
