



## SECTION A: THEFT, ROBBERY AND PIRACY AT SEA (TRAPS)

Incidents:

03 Feb - Boarding/ Sea Theft/ Bulk Carrier, Liberia-Flagged/ Underway/ Phillip Channel/ DB030223

1. POCC reported that a Liberia-flagged bulk carrier was boarded by at least nine perpetrators with knives while transiting along the Phillip Channel (1°3'6.0"N 103°37'00.0"E) on 3 Feb 23 at 0145 (UTC +8).

2. The ship master reported that all crew members are safe and accounted for and that no items were reported stolen. The vessel does not require any assistance and will continue her voyage to her NPOC, Singapore.

IFC Comments: IFC sent an RFI to the COY for incident details on 3 Feb.

01 Feb - Boarding/ Sea Theft/ Tug and Barge, Singapore-Flagged/ Underway/ Westbound Lane of TSS, Singapore Strait/ DB020223

1. POCC informed that a Singapore-flagged tug sighted two perpetrators boarding the barge she was towing while transiting along the Westbound Lane of TSS in the Singapore Strait (1°17'70"N 104°9'55"E) on 1 Feb 23 at 1940 (UTC +8).

2. The ship master reported that all crew members are safe, and some scrap metals were stolen. The vessel does not require any assistance and will continue to her next port of call, Viet Nam.

IFC Comments: RFI has been sent to the shipping company for more incident details.

29 Jan - Boarding/ Sea Theft/ Bulk Carrier, Malta-Flagged/ No injury/ Anchored/ Panjang Anchorage, Indonesia/ DB300123

1. On 29 Jan, 0917 (UTC +8), the CSO of NYK informed IFC that four perpetrators boarded a Malta-flagged bulk carrier at 0400 (UTC +8), at the position (5°30'14"S, 105°17'19"E). An engineer reported that, while working, he sighted four people trying to open the workshop door. Initially, he believed them to be oilers, but then he understood that the oilers were in another location. After warning the perpetrators, the engineer quickly locked the steering flat door. The details were quickly shared with the Indonesia ILO and were subsequently shared with the Indonesia Local authority.

2. The Indonesia Marine Police boarded the bulk carrier and found that the perpetrators had escaped in a vessel. A search was conducted throughout the ship and no anomaly was found. The ship Master reported that the crew is safe, and nothing was stolen.

2. The ship master reported that all crew are safe, and nothing was stolen. The vessel does not require any assistance and will continue to her NPOC, Singapore.

IFC sent an RFI to the COY for incident details on 28 Jan. On 28 Jan, COY replied and confirmed that nothing was stolen. This is the 4th Incident that happened in the Singapore Strait. The last was on 20 Jan.

# **IFC RECOMMENDATIONS**

The IFC advises:

- 1. All mariners to report any maritime security incidents timely to the nearest coastal state and inform the IFC at the earliest possible time.
- 2. All mariners are strongly recommended to be vigilant, in particularly when operating in IFC identified hotspots (Sulu-Celebes seas, Eastbound Lane of Traffic Separation Scheme in Singapore Strait, Jakarta Port in Indonesia and South Harbor Anchorage in Philippines).
- 3. All mariners are advised to adopt Ship Protection Measures recommended in the Regional Guide to Counter Piracy and Armed Robbery Against Ships in Asia (e.g., illuminating the accommodation block and poop deck, deploying sentries and increase frequency of security rounds).
- 4. All mariners to take note on the description of the perpetrators and to take photos of the perpetrators if possible. Where available, CCTV footage capturing the incident should be provided to the coastal state authorities for follow-on investigation.
- 5. All mariners are advised to participate in IFC Voluntary Community Reporting (VCR) as depicted in MARSEC Chart Q6112 and Q6113. In case of any doubt, incident at sea, suspicious approach or unusual observed activity at sea, please contact the IFC Duty Officer:
