

SECTION A: THEFT, ROBBERY AND PIRACY AT SEA (TRAPS)

Information Update:

04 Jan - Boarding/ Sea Robbery/ Bulk Carrier, Singapore-Flagged/ No Injury/ Underway/ Phillip Channel, Singapore Strait/ DB080124 (Information Update on DB040124)

It was updated that the robbers were armed with long knives, as explained by 3/E, who was present in the E/R along with the oiler. The third engineer was hand-tied with plastic rope and blindfolded until the time the robbers were in the engine room. He was later freed by the duty oiler, who was in the engine control room doing watch. It was also updated that the cost of items stolen from the engine room is approximately US\$ 20,000.

10 Jan - Boarding/ Sea Theft/ Bulk Carrier, Panama-Flagged/ No Injury/ Underway/ Eastbound Lane of TSS, Singapore Strait/ DB100124

1. POCC reported that an unauthorised boarding involving Panama-flagged bulk carrier, as vessel transited along the Eastbound, Singapore Strait (1°03'00.7"N 103°41'00.8"E) on 10 Jan 24 at 02:40 (UTC +8). Crew reportedly sighted 5 perpetrators, one of whom was reportedly armed with knife, in the engine room.

2. Ship master reported that all crew are safe and accounted for, and nothing was yet reported stolen. The vessel does not require any assistance and will continue her voyage to NPOC, Singapore.

03 Jan - Boarding/ Sea Robbery/ Panama-Flagged Cargo Ship/ No Injury/ Anchored/ Lubuk Gaung Anchorage, Indonesia/ DB080124

Three robbers, armed with guns and knives, boarded an anchored general cargo ship. They took the duty engine crew hostage and tied his hands. The robbers stole the ship's engine spare parts and escaped. The duty crew managed to alert the OOW and raise the alarm. The crew mustered and a search was carried out. No robbers were found onboard.

During security rounds, duty AB onboard an anchored bulk carrier sighted a white hull skiff near the anchor chain. One person was seen climbing the chain. He immediately informed the OOW, who raised the emergency alarm and sounded the ship's whistle. Hearing the alert made by the ship crew, the attempted boarding was aborted. Vessel and crew safe.

Four robbers, armed with knives, boarded an anchored tanker. They took hostage the duty AB and tied him up. The onboard shore security watchman abandoned his post when threatened with knives. Duty engineer on routine rounds noticed the robbers and raised the alarm, resulting in robbers escaping with stolen engine spares. The incident was reported to the port authority via a local agent.

- 2. All mariners are strongly recommended to be vigilant, in particularly when operating in IFC identified hotspots (Sulu-Celebes seas, Eastbound Lane of Traffic Separation Scheme in Singapore Strait, Jakarta Port in Indonesia and South Harbor Anchorage in Philippines).
- 3. All mariners are advised to adopt Ship Protection Measures recommended in the Regional Guide to Counter Piracy and Armed Robbery Against Ships in Asia (e.g., illuminating the accommodation block and poop deck, deploying sentries and increase frequency of security rounds).
- 4. All mariners take note on the description of the perpetrators and to take photos of the perpetrators if possible. Where available, CCTV footage capturing the incident should be provided to the coastal state authorities for follow-on investigation.
- 5. All mariners are advised to participate in IFC Voluntary Community Reporting (VCR) as depicted in MARSEC Chart Q6112 and Q6113. In case of any doubt, incident at sea, suspicious approach or unusual observed activity at sea, please contact the IFC Duty Officer:
