#### SECTION A: THEFT, ROBBERY AND PIRACY AT SEA (TRAPS)

#### Incidents:

08 Jul - Boarding/ Sea Theft/ Bulk Carrier, Japanese-Flagged/ No Injury/ Underway/ Phillip Channel, Singapore Strait/ DB090724

- 1. POCC reported that an unauthorised boarding involving a Japanese-flagged bulk carrier as the vessel transited along the Phillip Channel, Singapore Strait (1°03'35.0"N 103°39'28.0"E) on 8 Jul 24 at 04:10 (UTC+8). Crew reportedly sighted 4 unarmed perpetrators at the stern and all fled when ship raised the alarm.
- 2. Ship master reported that all crew are safe and accounted for, and nothing was reported stolen. The vessel does not require any assistance and will continue her voyage to NPOC, Singapore.

03 Feb - Boarding/ Sea Theft/ Container Ship, Portugal Flagged/ No Injury/ Anchored/ Chattogram Inner Anchorage, Bangladesh/ DB120724

- 1. It was reported that an unauthorized boarding involving a Portugal-flagged container ship as the vessel was anchored at Chattogram Inner Anchorage, Bangladesh (22° 9' 47.9988" N 91° 46' 23.9988" E) on 3 Feb 2024 at 06:10 (UTC+8). Crew sighted two perpetrators boarding the container ship. The alarm was raised, and the crew mustered, which resulted in the perpetrators escaping.
- 2. Ship master reported that all crew members were safe and accounted for, and nothing was reported stolen. The vessel does not require any assistance.

24 Jan - Boarding/ Sea Theft/ Tanker, India Flagged/ No Injury/ Anchored/ Kakinada Port, India/ DB110724

- 1. There was an unauthorized boarding involving an India-flagged tanker, as the vessel was anchored at Kakinada Port, India (17° 3' 25.2" N 82° 24' 40.2012" E) on 8 Jul 2024. Crew reportedly sighted one person jump into the water from the port side of the ship, while another boat was seen standing by with five persons onboard.
- 2. Ship master reported that all crew are safe and accounted for, and three loose mooring ropes were found missing. The vessel does not require any assistance.

- 14 Jan Attempted Boarding/ Sea Theft/ Tanker, Bangladesh-Flagged/ No Injury/ Anchored/ Chattogram Anchorage, Bangladesh/ DB110724
- 1. There was an attempted boarding involving a Bangladesh-flagged tanker, as the vessel was anchored at Chattogram Anchorage, Bangladesh (21° 50' 30.0012" N 91° 41' 50.3988" E) on 14 Jan 2024. An unknown number of persons onboard a boat propelled by an engine had approached the ship's port bow. The boat attempted to come alongside the ship but was unable to, and the perpetrators aborted their attempt.
- 2. Ship master reported that all crew members were safe and accounted for. The vessel does not require any assistance.

There was an unauthorized boarding occurred involving a Marshall Islands Islands-flagged tanker, as the vessel was anchored at Kakinada Anchorage, India (17° 1' 56.3988" N 82° 21' 38.4012" E) on 7 Jan 2024 at 01:30 (UTC+8). Crew sighted four perpetrators boarding the ship from a fast boat onto the poop deck.
- 2. Ship master reported that all crew members were safe and accounted for, and two mooring ropes were stolen. The vessel does not require any assistance.

- 2. All mariners are strongly recommended to be vigilant, in particularly when operating in IFC identified hotspots (Sulu-Celebes seas, Eastbound Lane of Traffic Separation Scheme in Singapore Strait, Jakarta Port in Indonesia and South Harbor Anchorage in Philippines).
- 3. All mariners are advised to adopt Ship Protection Measures recommended in the Regional Guide to Counter Piracy and Armed Robbery Against Ships in Asia (e.g., illuminating the accommodation block and poop deck, deploying sentries and increase frequency of security rounds).
