Update on 13 Nov - Boarding/ Sea Theft/ Bulk Carrier, Philippines-Flagged/ No Injury/ Underway/ Phillip Channel, Singapore Strait/ DB131124

It was updated that:

Some spare parts were missing from engine room.

Total of three subjects were sighted. Two people were equipped with Machetes and one person was carrying a "gun-like" object. This observation was made by the crew and reported to the local authorities.

POCC reported an unauthorised boarding on a Philippines-flagged Bulk Carrier, as the vessel was transiting in the eastbound lane of TSS in Phillip Channel ( $1^{\circ}04'22.0"N$   $103^{\circ}41'17.0"E$ ) on 13 Nov 24 at 0440 (UTC + 8). Crew reportedly sighted 4 perpetrators in the engine room, alarm was raised and perpetrators left. All crew have been accounted for with no injury.
- 2. Ship will be entering Singapore port and she will be boarded for checks.

- 1. POCC reported that a Hongkong-flagged General Cargo, reported sighted seven to eight perpetrators in the engine room, with one perpetrator armed with unknown object when transiting Phillip Channel, Singapore Strait (1°02'39.6"N 103°38'34.8"E) on 14 Nov 24 at 05:07 (UTC +8).
- 2. Ship master reported that all crew are safe and accounted for and ship search is in progress. The vessel does not require any assistance and will continue her voyage to NPOC, Singapore.

- 1. POCC reported that a Liberia-flagged Bulk Carrier, reported sighting one perpetrator armed with gun-like object at the upper deck when transiting Phillip Channel, Singapore Strait (1°02'37.2"N 103°38'46.8"E) on 14 Nov 24 at 03:55 (UTC +8).
- 2. Ship master reported that all crew are safe and accounted for and will conduct ship search in daylight hours. The vessel does not require any assistance and will continue her voyage to NPOC, China.

- 2. Ship master reported that all crew are safe and accounted for. The vessel does not require any assistance and will continue her voyage to NPOC, China.

13 Nov - Boarding/ Sea Theft/ Crude Oil Tanker, Liberia-Flagged/ No Injury/ Underway/ Philip Channel, Singapore Strait/ DB141124

On 13 Nov 24, at 11:20 (UTC+8) POCC reported a backdated report of unauthorised boarding on a Liberia Registered Tanker. She was reportedly boarded on 13 Nov 24, at 00:12 (UTC+8) at Phillip Channel.

The ship reported perpetrators seen in the poop deck, and 12 pieces of ME fuel injection valves were stolen. However, it was unknown how many perpetrators were onboard. All ship crew were accounted for, and there was no injuries. Additionally, the ship reported that a high speed craft approached the stern of the tanker, however it was not detected by her radar.

20 Oct - Boarding/ Sea Theft/ Chemical Tanker, Panama-Flagged/ No Injury/ Moored/ Batangas Port, Philippines/ DB141124

While at berth, one perpetrator armed with gun-like object boarded the chemical tanker through hawse pipe. The perpetrator was sighted on forecastle deck. The alarm was raised and all crew inside accommodation was mustered. There was no injury to crew members and some ship property/stores were stolen. The incident was reported to Philippine Batangas VTMS and requested for a vessel search by local authorities. The Philippines Coast Guard boarded the ship and carried out a search. No perpetrator was found.

On 16 Oct, at 05:10 (UTC+8), a crew member onboard a bulk carrier noticed an unauthorized person on deck and raised the alarm, resulting in the person escaping. A search was carried out; the engine room stores and ship's spares were reported stolen. No injury was reported.

12 Oct - Boarding/ Sea Theft/ Bulk Carrier, Marshall Islands-Flagged/ No Injury/ Anchored/ Kutubdia Anchorage, Bangladesh/ DB141124

On 12 Oct, at 01:48 (UTC+6), while anchored, the local watchmen onboard noticed two perpetrators on the forward deck and raised the alarm. On hearing the alarm, the perpetrators escaped in a small boat. There were 10-12 perpetrators in total, among whom two boarded the ship by throwing grapnel and rope. The crew and watchmen were safe, but two mobile phones were snatched and some ship property/stores were stolen.

The incident was not reported to the Bangladesh Coast Guard (BCG) immediately. An investigation was carried out by BCG after they were informed.

The crew members were safe.

- 1. All mariners report any maritime security incidents timely to the nearest coastal state and inform the IFC at the earliest possible time.
- 2. All mariners are strongly recommended to be vigilant, in particularly when operating in IFC identified hotspots (Sulu-Celebes seas, Eastbound Lane of Traffic Separation Scheme in Singapore Strait, Jakarta Port in Indonesia and South Harbor Anchorage in Philippines).
- 3. All mariners are advised to adopt Ship Protection Measures recommended in the Regional Guide to Counter Piracy and Armed Robbery Against Ships in Asia (e.g., illuminating the accommodation block and poop deck, deploying sentries and increase frequency of security rounds).
- 4. All mariners to take note of the description of the perpetrators and to take photos of the perpetrators if possible. Where available, CCTV footage capturing the incident should be provided to the coastal state authorities for follow-on investigation.
- 5. All mariners are advised to participate in IFC Voluntary Community Reporting (VCR) as depicted in MARSEC Chart Q6112 and Q6113. In case of any doubt, incident at sea, suspicious approach or unusual observed activity at sea, please contact the IFC Duty Officer:
