- 1. It was reported that an unauthorised boarding involving a Panama-flagged bulk carrier as the vessel was anchored at Kuala Tanjung Anchorage, Indonesia (3° 25' 59.9988" N 99° 27' E) on 20 Jul 2024. Crew reportedly sighted three perpetrators armed with knives. They entered the engine room, took hostage of the duty crew, and tied him up.
- 2. Ship master reported that all crew are safe and accounted for, and before the perpetrators left the ship they stole engine spares and released the duty crew.
