18 Sep - Boarding/ Sea Robbery/ Ken Ann, Panama-Flagged Bulk Carrier/ No Injury/ Anchored/ In Tanjung Priok Port, Indonesia/ DB131125

On 18 Sep at 20:00 (UTC+8), Duty AB onboard a berthed ship spotted three robbers armed with knives emerging from the engine room. One robber attempted to attack the duty crew, who quickly retreated and informed the duty officer.

Three additional robbers were seen disembarking via the gangway. Despite the crew's vigilance, the robbers escape with stolen ship's property. The incident was reported to the Port Facility Security Officer.

17 Sep - Boarding/ Sea Theft/ Athens Spirit, Bahamas-Flagged Tanker/ No Injury/ Anchored/ At Balongan Anchorage, Indonesia/ DB131125

On 17 Sep at 00:45 (UTC+8), while anchored, the 1st Assistant Engineer observed three unidentified individuals exiting the engine room through the internal door leading to the steering gear room. The duty watchkeeper then notified the master, who raised the general alarm.

The intruders then fled the vessel by jumping overboard from the poop deck and escaped via a high-speed craft.

All crew were mustered, and a comprehensive inspection was conducted onboard the vessel. There was no injury to the crew, but some stores were stolen.

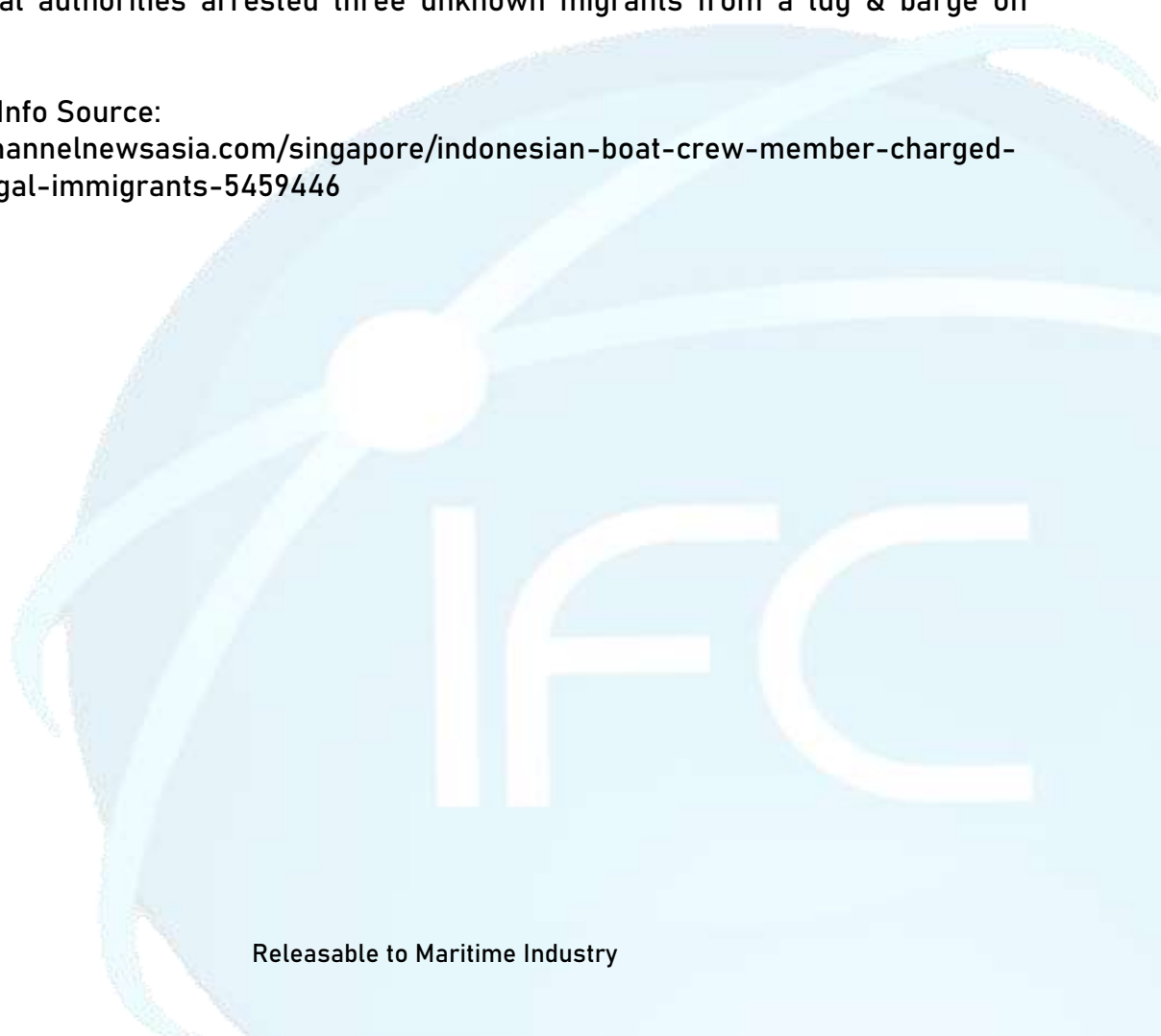

IFC RECOMMENDATIONS

The IFC advises:

1. All mariners report any maritime security incidents timely to the nearest coastal state and inform the IFC at the earliest possible time.
2. All mariners are strongly recommended to be vigilant, in particularly when operating in IFC identified hotspots (Sulu-Celebes seas, Eastbound Lane of Traffic Separation Scheme in Singapore Strait, Jakarta Port in Indonesia and South Harbor Anchorage in Philippines).
3. All mariners are advised to adopt Ship Protection Measures recommended in the Regional Guide to Counter Piracy and Armed Robbery Against Ships in Asia (e.g., illuminating the accommodation block and poop deck, deploying sentries and increase frequency of security rounds).
4. All mariners to take note of the description of the perpetrators and to take photos of the perpetrators if possible. Where available, CCTV footage capturing the incident should be provided to the coastal state authorities for follow-on investigation.
5. All mariners are advised to participate in IFC Voluntary Community Reporting (VCR) as depicted in MARSEC Chart Q6112 and Q6113. In case of any doubt, incident at sea, suspicious approach or unusual observed activity at sea, please contact the IFC Duty Officer:
