01 Jan - Boarding/ Sea Theft/ Bangladeshi-Flagged Fishing Vessel/ No Injury/ Underway/
Off Inani Beach, Bangladesh/ DB050126

On 1 Jan, the Bangladesh Coast Guard rescued 10 fishermen and their fishing vessel after another fishing boat requested help on their behalf via VHF. The distressed vessel was located 15nm off Inani Beach, Cox's Bazar, Bangladesh, when it encountered sea robbers who boarded the vessel and robbed them of their fish catch, food supplies, engine, battery, and all necessary equipment aboard before setting the boat adrift. The Coast Guard provided first aid and necessary food supplies before escorting them and their vessel safely alongside for handover to the owner

05 Jan - Boarding/ Sea Theft/ Tug & Barge/ No Injury/ Underway/ Eastbound Lane of TSS,
Singapore Strait/ DB060126

1. POCC reported an unauthorised boarding involving Singapore-flagged tugboat, towing a barge, when transiting in the Eastbound Lane of TSS, Singapore Strait (1°15'38.4"N 104°04'43.8"E) on 05 Jan, at around 13:41 (UTC+8). Ship Master reportedly sighted unknown numbers of perpetrators onboard the barge.

2. Ship master reported that perpetrators had disembarked, all crew are safe and some scrap metal was stolen. The vessel does not require any assistance, and will continue her voyage to NPOC, Vietnam.

03 Jan - Boarding/ Sea Theft/ Panama-Flagged Cargo Vessel/ No Injury/ Anchored/ Off Buan Batangas, Philippines/ DB060126

On 3 Jan, the Philippine Coast Guard (PCG) intercepted five unauthorised individuals attempting to illegally board a cargo vessel with intent to commit theft at the vicinity waters off Buan, Batangas, Philippines.

At around 20:00 (UTC+8) the PCG team conducted seaborne patrol operations, following a report of an alleged theft involving an anchored vessel.

At approximately 23:50 (UTC+8), the team intercepted a motorbanca attempting to board the cargo vessel.

One individual was apprehended onboard the motorbanca, where cables were recovered, indicating preparation for illegal activity. Other suspected accomplices were believed to be onboard the vessel.

Additional maritime law enforcement personnel were deployed to secure the area and conduct perimeter patrols.

A comprehensive search of the vessel resulted in the apprehension of four more individuals onboard.

All five respondents were brought to the Coast Guard Sub-Station Buan for documentation and medical examination.

IFC RECOMMENDATIONS

The IFC advises:

1. All mariners report any maritime security incidents timely to the nearest coastal state and inform the IFC at the earliest possible time.
2. All mariners are strongly recommended to be vigilant, in particularly when operating in IFC identified hotspots (Sulu-Celebes seas, Eastbound Lane of Traffic Separation Scheme in Singapore Strait, Jakarta Port in Indonesia and South Harbor Anchorage in Philippines).
3. All mariners are advised to adopt Ship Protection Measures recommended in the Regional Guide to Counter Piracy and Armed Robbery Against Ships in Asia (e.g., illuminating the accommodation block and poop deck, deploying sentries and increase frequency of security rounds).
4. All mariners to take note of the description of the perpetrators and to take photos of the perpetrators if possible. Where available, CCTV footage capturing the incident should be provided to the coastal state authorities for follow-on investigation.
5. All mariners are advised to participate in IFC Voluntary Community Reporting (VCR) as depicted in MARSEC Chart Q6112 and Q6113. In case of any doubt, incident at sea, suspicious approach or unusual observed activity at sea, please contact the IFC Duty Officer:
